2021-22 NOTES

- Colgate finished with an 18-18-4 record during the 2021-22 season.
- The Raiders reached the ECAC Hockey semifinals in Lake Placid for the frist time sicne 2015. Colgate swept Yale in the first round of the conference playoffs and upset No. 18 Cornell on the road in the quarterfinals.
- The regular season also saw the Raiders take down the #11/13 Big Red 2-1 in overtime. Colgate picked up a sweep against Vermont in a non-conference weekend series and also swept its season series against Yale.
- Following the season, Paul McAvoy, Griffin Lunn and Josh McKechney all signed pro contracts.
- Colton Young (15-17-32) led the team in goals and points last season, and he also tallied four game-winning goals. Young finished tied for fourth in ECAC Hokcey in borth goals and assists
- Alex Young (10-21-31) led the Raiders and finished tied for sixth in the conference in assists.
- Pierson Brandon led Colgate in blocked shots, recording 78.
- D-man **Tommy Bergsland** finished second on the team in blocked shots with 46, **while also leading the way with a +15 rating.**

SCOUTING THE BIG RED

- Cornell comes into the game as the 11th-ranked team in the country in both polls with a 15-7-1 overall record and a 12-4-0 ECAC Hockey mark. The Big Red are coming off a weekend sweep of RPI and Union as it defeated the Engineers 3-1 last Friday and the Dutchmen 10-1 Saturday.
- Sam Malinski (8-17-25) is tied for the team lead in assists and ranks tied for fifth in ECAC Hockey. He is also tied for the team lead in goals with Dalton Ban-croft (8-10-18), who also leads the Big Red in power play goals (5) and sits tied for the lead in game-winning goals (2).
- Gabriel Seger (6-17-23) is tied with Malinski in assists and has also notched four power play goals. Ben Berard (5-15-20) is tied with Malinski for Cornell's lead in shots (61) and is also second on the team in assists.
- Max Andreev (5-13-18) has scored a pair of gamewinning goals and four power play goals. Ondrej Psenicka has logged a team-best +10 rating, while Travis Mitchell is Cornell's leader in blocked shots with 41
- Ian Shane has logged a 1.85 GAA, which ranks second in ECAC Hockey and fourth in the nation. He has posted a .912 save percentage and a 14-6-1 record. Shane has also tallied 393 saves and has recorded three shutouts.
- As a team, Cornell is the league leader in power play percentage (.325). The Big Red is also second in ECAC Hockey and tied for sixth in the nation in face-off win percentage at .537. Additionally, Cornell ranks second in the conference in goals per game (3.65), goals allowed per game (2.13), points per game (10.09), and assists per game (6.43).

WE'VE GOT HISTORY

- Colgate and Cornell face off in a local rivalry dating back to the 1920-21 season, as this will be the 164th meeting between the two teams. The Big Red holds the advantage in the series with an 86-61-16 record.
- The Raiders and Big Red played five times last season, including a matchup in the ECAC quarterfinals. During the regular season, Colgate beat Cornell 3-2 at home, as it was the Raiders' first home win over the Big Red since the 2013-14 season. The two teams then played to a 2-2 tie in Ithaca the following day, with Colgate winning the shootout for the extra point in the standings.
- In the playoffs, the Raiders dropped Game 1 of the best-of-three series at Lynah, **before winning two in a row to take the series two games to one** as they advanced to the ECAC Hockey semifinals in Lake Placid.
- Colgate is 3-5-2 in its last 10 games against Cornell.
 Two of those went into overtime, and all but one game were decided by two goals or less.

LAST TIME OUT

- A late third-period goal from Colton Young was not enough last Friday as the Raiders fell 3-1 to Union. Young scored with four minutes remaining off of passes from Alex Young and Simon Labelle to cut the Dutchmen lead to one at 2-1 before Union added an empty net goal to seal the deal. Colgate outshot the Dutchmen 29-13 in the game but could only find the back of the net once.
- On Saturday, Alex Young scored his league-leading 17th goal of the season, but Colgate fell to RPI 2-1.
 Young's goal also extended the junior's point streak to 12 games. Carter Gylander tallied 22 saves in the net for the Raiders.

LEADING THE WAY

- Alex Young (17-13-30) leads ECAC Hockey in goals and sits tied for second in the nation. He also ranks tied for third in the conference in points. Young is cur-rently on a 12-game point streak, having tallied 17 points with 12 goals and five assists in that span. Young has notched a conference-best eight power-play goals this season, which also ranks tied for second-most in the nation.
- Matt Verboon (12-14-26) currently sits tied for fifth in ECAC Hockey in goals and is tied for sixth in points. Additionally, he is tied for fifth in ECACH in shots with 76.
- Ross Mitton (6-16-22) is tied for the team lead in assists and ranks tied for sixth in ECAC Hockey. He is also tied for third on the team in points. The junior has tallied six points in Colgate's last seven games.
- Colton Young (6-11-17) is second in ECAC Hockey in shots (107) and is third in shots per game (3.82). He has recorded a point in four-straight games for the Raiders.

- Pierson Brandon leads ECACH in blocked shots with 61. The junior has had at least one blocked shot in every game he has played.
- Fellow D-man **Nick Anderson (2-16-18)** is Colgate's top-scoring blueliner and is tied for the team lead in assists. The junior has recorded four points in Col-gate's last five games.

SOLID IN NET

- Carter Gylander has made 718 saves so far this season which is eighth-best in the nation and leads ECAC Hockey. He is also fourth in the conference in saves per game (26.59) and tied for fourth in save percentage (.921), which is also tied for tenth-best in the nation. Additionally, his 2.29 GAA is the fifth-best in ECACH.
- The junior was named to the Mike Richter Award Watch List on Jan. 12, an honor given to the top goalie in NCAA Division I men's hockey.

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP

- The Raiders' sophomore class has contributed 64 points this season which is second-most behind the junior class. Alex DiPaolo (8-14-22) is tied for second on the team in assists and is tied for third in points and goals. He is also tied for Colgate's lead in plus-minus with a +8 rating and leads the Raiders in shot percentage at .242.
- -Nic Belpedio (4-8-12) is second in points among the Raiders' D-men and has already topped his points total from last season. Reid Irwin has also contributed nine assists for Colgate.
- Ryan McGuire (4-4-8) has scored two-game winning goals this season which ranks tied for second-most on the team. Tommy Bergsland (0-5-5) is second on Colgate in blocked shots with 35.

HOME SWEET HOME

- •The Raiders are 7-2-1 in their last 10 games at the Class of 1965 Arena and have averaged 3.8 goals per game in that span. Colgate's loss to Union last Friday was its first at home since Oct. 28. It was also the team's first home conference loss of the season.
- Colgate now holds a 7-5-2 overall home record this season.

QUICK FACTS / UPDATES

- Colgate is third in ECAC Hockey in faceoff wins with 829. The Raiders are led by Alex DiPaolo, who ranks third in the conference in FO wins with 239.
- The Raiders have logged a .842 penalty kill percentage which is third-best in ECACH and 11th in the nation. Colgate is also second in ECACH in shots on goal with 845.
- Prior to last weekend's losses, Colgate started 10-4-0 in ECACH, which was its best league start through 14 games since the 2013-14 season when the Raiders went 9-4-1.
- The Raiders are averaging 3.14 goals per game in their last seven contests while giving up just 2.0 per game in that span. Colgate is allowing 2.46 goals per game total this season which is the 11th-fewest in the nation and fourth-fewest in ECACH.
- •Alex Young got named to the Hobey Baker Watch List on Jan. 19. The top-ten finalists will be revealed on March 10.

COACH VAUGHAN REACHES LANDMARK SEASON

- The 2022-23 season will be Head Coach Don Vaughan's 30th season leading the Raiders' program.
 It is the third longest tenure among active NCAA Division I coaches. Only Rick Gotkin (35 seasons) from Mercyhurst and Bob Daniels (31 seasons) from Ferris State have longer tenures.
- Coach Vaughan held a 453-488-118 record at Colgate entering the 2022-23 season. He currently sits as the program's all-time leader in wins.

COLGATE COACHING CAREER

Most recently, Vaughan led Colgate to an 18-18-4 record during the 2021-22 season, helping the team reach the ECAC Hockey semifinals in Lake Placid. Colgate defeated Yale in the first round of the conference playoffs and then upset No. 18 Cornell on the road in the quarterfinals. The regular season also

saw the Raiders take down the #11/13 Big Red 2-1 in overtime. Colgate picked up a sweep against Vermont in a non-conference weekend series and also swept its season series against Yale.

The Raiders advanced to the ECAC Semifinals in the 2020-21 campaign behind six wins, including ones ove No. 8/9 Clarkson, No. 13 Clarkson, and No. 10/11 Quinnipiac.

The Raiders garnered a 12-16-8 overall record in the 2019-20 campaign, along with an 8-9-5 mark in the ECAC regular season. Colgate finished with the No. 8 seed for the ECAC Tournament, earning home ice for the First Round. The Raiders swept Brown behind a 3-0 shutout and a 3-2 overtime win, before the cancellation of the ECAC Tournament. It had marked the first time the Raiders swept a playoff series since the 2014-15 season.

The 2018-19 season featured four wins over nationally ranked opponents. Although Colgate held the only all rookie goaltending group in the nation, the Raiders held its opponent scoreless on the power play 16 times and earned three weekend sweeps. In a 3-2 overtime win on Jan. 26, Colgate earned its first victory over Cornell since Feb. 8, 2014 while it also marked the first win in Ithaca since Jan. 27, 2012.

Vaughan led the Raiders to their 24th ECAC Hockey Tournament appearance in 2017-18. It was a season where Vaughan tallied his 400th career win by a 2-1 final at Brown. The previous 2016-17 season was highlighted by Vaughan guiding the Raiders to the 1,000th win in program history, becoming the 23rd team in college hockey history to do so. His 961 games at the helm of the program is the third-longest tenure in college hockey behind Rick Gotkin (Mercyhurst, 31), and Bob Daniels (Ferris State, 27).

During his tenure, Vaughan has graduated 99 percent of his players and since 2002, his athletes have been named to the ECAC Hockey All-Academic Team 200 times.

The Raiders began the 2015-16 season being ranked in the top-20 of the USCHO.com Preseason Poll for the second straight year after a standout 2014-15 campaign. That year, the Raiders advanced to the ECAC Championship for the second straight season. Colgate was nationally ranked for majority of the year as it reached as high as No. 4 in both polls.

Vaughan had previously led Colgate to a highly successful 2013-14 season that featured the Raiders first NCAA Tournament berth in nine seasons by an at-large record of 20-14-5. Piloting a youthful lineup of 17 underclassmen, Colgate recorded eight victories against ranked teams, before ending the season at No. 13. The same year, Colgate claimed the Mariucci Classic title in Jan. 2014 when it recorded a shootout win against No. 1 Minnesota and a shutout of No. 2 Ferris State.

Vaughan's 15th season was a special one as on Feb. 16, 2008, he became the school's all-time winningest vaugnans 15th season was a special one, as on reb. 1o, 20us, ne became the schools all-time winningest coach as Colgate blanked Union 8-0. During the 2005-06 campaign, Vaughan continued to lead Colgate to new heights, as the Raiders captured their second ECAC Hockey Regular Season title in three years, and won 20-plus games for the third consecutive season, a first in program history. The year prior, Vaughan recorded the most wins in his tenure, as he led the Raiders to 25 victories and a berth in the 2005 NCAA Tournament.

AWARDS

Vaughan's effort in leading his team to 24 victories and a final ranking of No. 9 in the 1999-20 season earned him his first ECAC Coach of the Year accolade

As the Raiders excelled to a second place finish in the ECAC in 2013-14. Vaughan was recognized as ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year for the second time in his career

In 2004, Vaughan was presented with a Silver Puck Award for his work with the Raider hockey program, before being honored with a Maroon Citation for his service to the University. On Nov. 11, 2007, President of Colgate University Rebecca S. Chopp announced the creation of the Donald F. Vaughan Endowed Coaching Chair for Men's Ice Hockey

OTHER ORGANIZATIONS

Vaughan stepped away from the ice during the 2003-04 academic year to serve as the university's interim athletics director, where five teams won conference championships, six coaches were honored as league coaches of the year, and the Raider football team advanced to the NCAA Division I-AA national championship game. Vaughan continues to serve Colgate in an administrative capacity as an assistant athletics director.

An active member of the American Hockey Coaches Association, Vaughan is a former chair of the group's Division I Committee, and previously a member of the NCAA Rules Committee from 1998-02. He currently serves on the NCAA Division I Men's Hockey Committee.

BEFORE COLGATE

Vaughan began his coaching career as a player/coach with the Enschede Lions of the Dutch Professional Hockey League from 1984-85, before returning to serve as a graduate assistant coach at St. Lawrence during 1985-86, where he specialized in coaching special teams, served as the recruiting coordinator, and as head coach of the junior varsity team. SLU earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament for the first time since Vaughan was a player

Vaughan next went to Cornell, where they reached the ECAC Final Four both seasons he was with the program. His personal string of Final Four appearances extended to six as he completed his second stint as an assistant coach at St. Lawrence, where he earned his second ECAC Tournament Title and made his third trip to the NCAA Tournament.

A 1984 graduate of St. Lawrence, Vaughan played three seasons of varsity hockey for the Saints after earning All-America status in his only season at Canton College. While with the Saints, Vaughan tallied 41 goals and 49 assists for 90 points in 96 games as a center. In 1983, Vaughan and St. Lawrence earned an NCAA Tournament appearance and first-place finish in the ECAC's West Region. He graduated from St. Lawrence in 1984 with a bachelor's degree in economics, later earning a master's degree in general studies in 1987.
