HOCKEY NOTES ON GAME DAY

■ **COLGATE-DARTMOUTH SERIES** | The Raiders lead the all-time series against the Green Wave, 57-54-9. Colgate has won seven of the past eight meetings, including both contests last year. Of the seven wins, five were by just one goal. Colgate has won four of the last five contests in Hanover.

■ **COLGATE-HARVARD SERIES** | The Crimson lead the all-time series against the Raiders, with Colgate posting a 29-61-10 record. The teams have split the regular season series in each of the past three years.

■ **ECAC ACTION** | The Raiders will face off against ECAC competition for the first time this season. Colgate was selected to finish seventh in the conference after a third-place finish in 2024-25.

■ **RELY ON REID** | During last week's two game set against RIT, first year goalie Reid Dyck made back-to-back starts for the first time in his career. Dyck posted a .913 save percentage across the two games and logged his first career point with an assist on Michael Neumeier's goal.

■ **AT THE DOT** | Through the first four weeks of action, Ryan Sullivan ranks first in the ECAC and 14th in the nation in faceoffs won. Sullivan has won 89 of his faceoffs so far. Sully buried Colgate's lone goal in Saturday's 4-1 loss to RIT.

■ **POWER PLAY POACHERS** | Colgate's power play has been one of the best in the nation so far this season. The Raiders own a .235 conversion mark, and their eight goals on the man advantage rank an on-brand 13th in the nation so far.

■ **RAIDER RECOGNITION** | Jack Brandt earned ECAC Forward of the Month and Isaiah Norlin picked up ECAC Defender of the Month for October.

Brandt is named Forward of the Month after two consecutive Forward of the Week honors in the last two weeks of October. The sophomore scored five goals and added five assists in October including a three-point night against Canisius. Norlin collects his first award as a Raider after transferring from the University of Nebraska Omaha. The sophomore leads all defenders in the ECAC in points through the opening eight games.

■ **IN THE BIG LEAGUES** | Four Raiders were invited to NHL development camps that took place this past summer. Sophomore Michael Neumeier earned his second invite to an NHL development camp, while Ryan Spinale and Ryan Sullivan each earned their first invite. First-year goaltender Reid Dyck also received an invite and attended the New York Islanders' camp.

■ **SCHEDULE OUTLOOK** | Colgate will be back next weekend, hosting Yale and Brown on Nov. 14 and Nov. 15. The Raiders travel to Michigan State for a Thanksgiving week series in East Lansing.

■ **FRIENDSHIP FOUR** | Colgate men's hockey will compete in the Friendship Four in Belfast, Northern Ireland in 2026. Along with the Raiders, the University of Connecticut, Providence College, and the University of Minnesota Duluth will be competing at The SSE Arena in November 2026. Colgate has featured in the Friendship Four twice before with its last.

■ **LUCKY NUMBER 13** | Colgate considers 13 to be a lucky number. The University celebrates Colgate Day every Friday the 13th. In 1817, 13 men met in the frontier settlement of Hamilton, N.Y., to found the Baptist Education Society of New York. They are said to have backed up their experiment in education with 13 dollars and 13 prayers, which is why 13 is considered a lucky number at Colgate.

THE HARDER FILE

- Mike Harder '97 was named the Donald F. Vaughan Head Men's Hockey Coach in June 2023, returning to Colgate after previously serving six years (2013–2019) as an assistant coach.
- First Season Success: In his first year as head coach, Harder led Colgate to a 16-16-4 record, a No. 3 ECAC seed, and one of the nation's top power plays (.264). Two players earned All-League honors.
- Career Highlights as Assistant Coach: Helped Colgate earn 89 wins, two ECAC Championship appearances, and an NCAA Tournament bid; served as director of recruiting for five years, producing a Hobey Baker finalist.
- Decorated Playing Career: Colgate's all-time leading scorer (214 points), All-American, Hobey Baker finalist, and Hall of Honor inductee. Earned numerous ECAC and team awards during his four-year collegiate career.
- Professional Experience: Played 13 professional seasons in North America and Europe, winning the 2000 AHL Calder Cup and a 2004 German Elite League championship.
- Leadership Beyond Colgate: Founded and directed Hockey Club Reno Ice, growing it to over 500 youth players and establishing para and semi-pro teams.

ASSISTANT COACH

- Joined Colgate after serving as an assistant with the Dubuque Fighting Saints (USHL, 2022–23), coaching forwards and the power play, including two All-USHL Second Team selections.
- Enters his eighth season in coaching, previously an assistant at Trinity College (2019–2022) — helping lead the Bantams to two NESCAC Championship appearances and an NCAA Tournament berth.
- Served three seasons at UW–Stevens Point (2016–2019), including a National Championship (2018–19) and an undefeated 29-0-2 season.
- Played two seasons of college hockey at UW–Stevens Point before a career-ending neck injury; also played junior hockey in the NAHL, finishing as assistant captain of the Port Huron Fighting Falcons.



ANTHONY WALSH
ASSISTANT COACH

- Joined Colgate in July 2023 after serving as an assistant coach with the U.S. National Team Development Program, helping the U18 team capture gold at the 2023 IIHF World Championships.
- Began his coaching career at SUNY Fredonia (2021–22) before moving to the NTDP.
- Yale alumnus (Class of 2019), where he was a four-year letterwinner, team captain, and recipient of the Malcolm G. Chace Award for leadership and sportsmanship.
- Played 114 USHL games with Green Bay and Sioux City prior to college; earned a B.A. in Political Science from Yale.



CHRIS NELL
ASSISTANT COACH/DIR. OF OPS

- Named Colgate's assistant coach/director of operations in August 2024, working primarily with the Raiders' goaltenders.
- Previously served as assistant/goalie coach with the Green Bay Gamblers (USHL, 2023–24), guiding Adam Gajan to fourth in USHL wins and Gavin Moffat to 11th in save percentage.
- Began collegiate coaching at Marian University, coaching men's and women's goalies, with multiple netminders earning All-NCHA honors.
- Played professionally from 2017–2022, including ECHL and AHL stints, posting career highs of a 3.18 GAA and .893 save percentage in the AHL.
