## THE STORYLINES

## TIP-OFF

The Columbia women's basketball team returns to action Saturday, Jan. 24 when it returns to Levien Gymnasium for a rematch with Cornell. The Lions and Big Red are set for a 4:30 p.m. tip live on The Ivy League Digital Network.

#### **LOWDOWN ON THE LIONS**

Columbia (6-9, 0-1 lvy League) had its two-game win streak a week ago when it fell to Cornell, 59-39, in both team's lvy League opener. The Lions return to the friendly confines of Levien where five of their six victories have come this season thanks in part to a 37.6 connection rate from the floor under the roof of Levien compared to a 33.6 shooting percentage away from home.

Tori Oliver, who ranks second in the league with 17.9 points per outing, paces the Lions' second-best offense in the league of 66.0 ppg. First-years Camille Zimmerman (15.1 ppg) and Alexa Giuliano (10.5) are also scoring in double figures. Zimmerman has notched double digits in every contest except one while Giuliano is Columbia's threat from beyond-the-arc, connecting on 2.6 threes per game.

Defensively the Lions pull down a league-best 42.4 rebounds per game. Amara Mbionwu leads the way on the glass with the second-highest boards per game amongst the lvies with 9.6 while Oliver and Zimmerman grab 9.6 rebounds per contest each.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

The Columbia women's basketball team was stumped in its Ivy League opener by the Big Red of Cornell, 59-39, Saturday afternoon at Newman Arena.

For the sixth time this season, Tori Oliver paced Columbia as the sophomore contributed 15 points. Camille Zimmerman chipped in double figures with 10 while Amara Mbionwu pulled down 12 boards to pace the Lions on the glass.

#### **DOUBLE DIP**

For the final time this season, the Columbia women's basketball team will take part in a double feature with the men's squad. The women will take the floor first at 4:30 p.m. while the men tipoff at 7 p.m.

#### **BETTER AND BETTER**

Through 15 games this season, nine Lions student-athletes have matched or bested their career highs in points and/or rebounds. The athletes include: Tori Oliver (38 points, 14 rebounds), Camille Zimmerman (24 points, 12 rebounds), Alexa Giuliano (20 points, 8 rebounds), Sara Mead (18 points), Amara Mbionwu (12 points, 16 rebounds), Ara Talkov (9 points), Paige Tippet (5 points, 3 rebounds), Kate Ryan (3 points, 1 rebound), and Jillian Borreson (2 points).

#### **CONSISTENT CAMILLE**

Camille Zimmerman has been a consistent figure for Columbia on both ends of the hardwood this season. The first-year ranks among the lvy League leaders in several statistical categories including scoring (15.1 sixth), rebounding (6.9, 10th) and blocked shots (1.1, tied for fifth). The 6-foot-1 forward has registered three double-doubles on the year, led the Lions in scoring in five contests and posted double figures in points in all, but one outing.

#### IF IT'S FREE

The Lions have made teams pay for sending them to the free throw line this season as they boast a league-leading 75.7 (259-342) connection rate at the line.

Camille Zimmerman has made her presence known at the line as the first-year leads the team and is second in the league with an 82.9 connection rate (58-70). Tori Oliver continues to be consistent at the charity stripe, as the sophomore has connected on 85-113 attempts for a 75.2 percentage. All-time Oliver is a 197-268 (.735) from the line to sit among the Lions' top five.

#### **CLEANING THE GLASS**

Columbia has cleaned up the glass this season as the Lions have pulled down 42.4 rpg, the best number among the Ivies.

At San Jose State Columbia grabbed 60 rebounds, the most since the Lions recorded 62 at Yale Jan. 11, 2002. The 60 boards are also the most in the Stephanie Glance era.

Amara Mbionwu leads the Lions on the glass with the second-best average in the league at 9.6 rpg.

#### **GIULIANO SCORING IN BUNCHES**

Through non-conference action and just 15 games into her collegiate career, Alexa Giuliano averages 10.5 points per game and is currently the third-highest scoring Lion.

Giuliano showed a penchant for scoring

in bunches at critical junctures versus San Francisco, Rhode Island and Bradley. The sharpshooter netted a game-high 20 points, including six triples, in the season opener against the Dons. Against the Rams, she sunk a NBA-range buzzer beater to force overtime and followed that performance with 20 points versus the Braves. In back-to-back outings – versus FDU and at NJIT – Giuliano was one point shy of her career high with 19.

#### **NON-CONFERENCE NONSENSE**

Columbia closed out the non-conference portion of its scheduled with a 6-8 record, marking the program's seventh best non-conference record and best under head coach Stephanie Glance. The Lions have now posted at least six non-conference wins in nine seasons.

The 2009-10 squad owns the program record for non-conference wins at 9-5 while the 1987-88 Lions went 8-4 away from the Ivy League.

#### **10 FROM 3**

For the third time this season and fifth time under Stephanie Glance Columbia netted 10 shots from behind the arc against Fairleigh Dickinson Jan. 7 as three Lions combined for the number.

Four Lions combined for that total in the season opener at San Francisco Nov. 14 and in the overtime win against Rhode Island Nov. 24.

#### **TO 50 AND BEYOND**

The Lions scored 50 or more points in a single half for just the tenth time in program history when they posted 50 in the second half at Wagner on Dec. 30. The Lions record for points in a half is 57, set back in the first half of an 86-44 win against Manhattanville on Nov. 29, 2001. The Lions have scored 50 points in each half of one game once in Columbia women's basketball history; the feat occurred on Jan. 12, 1987 in a 101-51 win over smith.

#### **GET THAT OUT OF HERE**

The Lions swatted away a season-high 10 shots against LIU Brooklyn on Dec. 7. The rejections were the most by a Columbia team since tallying 11 in a 61-54 win over Cornell Jan. 15, 2011. Six Lions combined for the feat with Camille Zimmerman's personal best of four leading the way. Tori Oliver and Amara Mbionwu turned away two while Sara Mead and Miwa Tachibana posted one each.

#### **DROPPING 30**

Tori Oliver continues to prove she's one of the most influential Lions on offense in the past four years as the sophomore has poured in 30 points three times in her career and twice this season. Oliver notched the highest offensive output for a player in Columbia Blue since 1986 at Wagner December 30 when she scored 38 points off a 10-of-18 performance from the field and went 18-of-23 from the line. The 38 points are one shy of Columbia's singlegame record by a player, which Ellen Bossert set against New Rochelle Feb. 17, 1986. The 38 points also mark the highest single-game scoring output by an Ivy player since Penn's Alyssa Baron netted 38 against Harvard on Feb. 5, 2011

The sophomore forward first eclipsed 30 points this season at Stony Brook Nov. 21. Oliver is the first Columbia player to top 30 points in a game since Judie Lomax did so Jan. 23, 2010.

#### **BREAKING DOWN THE BIG RED**

Cornell (10-5, 1-0 lvy League) carries a fourgame win streak into action Saturday after defeating Columbia a week ago.

Cornell has outscored its opponents by an average of 4.7 and its shooting 41.4 percent from the field. Nia Marshall is one of two Big Red to score in double digits as the sophomore forward enters play Saturday leading the league averaging 18.3 ppg. Nicholle Aston, meanwhile, contributes 11.7 ppg.

#### **ROOKIE RECOGNITION**

Columbia has had a presence in the Ivy League Rookie of the Week awards this season. When Alexa Giuliano picked up her first honor of the season Jan. 5, the Lions set a new program-record of five Rookie of the Week honors in a single season. The following week, another Columbia record fell as Camille Zimmerman pulled down her fifth rookie accolade of the year, surpassing the mark of four, that was previously set by Courtney Allshouse '98CC (1993-94) and Lauren Dwyer '11CC (2007-08).

#### SHE'S BACK

Miwa Tachibana, who was the Lions staple behind the arc for the past three seasons, entered the fifth contest of the 2014-15 campaign without a single trey to her credit. The senior guard found her stroke from deep against Rhode Island, however, as she sunk her first triple of the season and went on to match her career-high of five three's to finish the night.

#### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

First-year Camille Zimmerman recorded her first career double-double versus Lafayette with 19 points and 11 rebounds. With the performance she became the first Lion to register a double-double since Courtney Bradford '14CC did so against Stony Brook, Jan. 5, 2014.

The Tempe, Arizona, native has tacked on two more double-double efforts this season and in back-to-back outings. First Zimmerman contributed 17 points and 10 rebounds versus UMBC December 5 before notching a 10-point, 12-rebound effort against LIU Brooklyn two days later.

#### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Stephanie Glance and the Lions have improved on their 154-366 (.296) home record early on this season.

The Lions started things off inside Levien on a strong note as they downed Lafayette 72-65 to move to 14-15 all-time in the first game of the year played at home.

In 2014-15, Columbia will played nine of its 14 non-conference games at home, only leaving Morningside Heights to visit out of league foes on five occasions including a two-game trip to California.

#### WE'RE GOING INTO OVERTIME

The Lions played in their first overtime game in the Stephanie Glance era against Rhode Island Nov. 24. With a 79-69 victory over the Rams, Columbia notched its first win with an extra period since taking down Dartmouth 69-55 in 2009-10.

Two days after playing an extra session contest the Lions did it again versus Bradley to play in the first back-to-back overtime game in program history. More was written in the record books Wednesday as Columbia took down the Braves, 81-74.

#### **GOOD WORK**

Sophomore forward Devon Roeper is one of 93 women's basketball student-athletes to be nominated for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team for her finest in the areas of leadership and charitable achievements amongst her peers.

#### **LET'S GET IT STARTED**

Columbia is 14-16 all-time in the first game of the season and 1-1 under the direction of Stephanie Glance. Last season Glance joined Traci Walters as the only two coaches to win their first games as the floor general of the Lions with a 62-59 victory over LIU Brooklyn.

The Lions have opened up its campaign on the road 13 times and has been in the friendly confines of Levien for the season opener 14 times. The Lions have taken the court at a neutral site for the first game of the year on three occasions.

#### **BACK FOR MORE**

The Lions return nine letterwinners from last year's squad, including two of their top three scorers in sophomore Tori Oliver (10.8 ppg) and senior Miwa Tachibana (9.6 ppg), who connected on 47 of 133 attempts (.353) behind the arc. Oliver joined senior Amara Mbionwu as Columbia's defensive force on the glass, as the six-foot guard grabbed 5.1 rebounds per game while Mbionwu pulled down 5.7 boards per contest.

Also returning for the Lions are sophomores Carolyn Gallagher and Ara Talkov. Gallagher notched a .433 field goal percentage, while Talkov contributed a 66.7-shooting clip from the charity strip.

#### **NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES**

Columbia has welcomed five new faces to the team for 2014-15, the first recruiting class of the Stephanie Glance era. The Lions members of the Class of 2018 include center Jillian Borreson, guards Alexa Giuliano, Kathleen Ryan and Paige Tippet, and forward Camille Zimmerman.

#### ON THE BENCH

Head coach Stephanie Glance returns for her second season as the head coach of the Columbia women's basketball team. Along with years of coaching experience, Glance brought her five-time assistant coach Sheila Roux who will be on the Lions' sideline as Associate Head Coach this year. Joining Glance's staff for their first seasons is assistant coach Ollin Dunford and former Lion backcourt standout Taylor Ward, who will serve as a volunteer assistant coach.

#### **LEADERS OF THE LIONS**

A quartet of has been elected to lead the Lions this season as seniors Campbell Mobley and Miwa Tachibana, junior Sara Mead and sophomore Tori Oliver share the leadership responsibilities.

#### **MATHCES MILESTONES**

The 2014-15 season will be historical for the Lions as Columbia will take the court for the 800th time overall when it hosts Kennesaw State Saturday, Nov. 29 and play in its 400th lvy League contest Saturday, Feb. 7 at Penn.

#### **UNBEATEN**

Since women's basketball began at Columbia in 1984-85, the Lions have taken the hardwood against 145 opponents. Columbia has not dropped a game to 32 of its all-time competition to hold an unbeaten record against .221 percent of its all-time foes. This season the Lions remained unbeaten against NIIT

#### HI, MY NAME IS...

The Lions played three consecutive first-time opponents during 2014-15 with games against Rhode Island (Nov. 24), Bradley (Nov. 26) and UMass Lowell (Dec. 3). Columbia defeated the Rams (79-69) and the Braves (81-74) in overtime, but slipped to the Riverhawks (59-69).

#### **GEOGRAPHY 101**

The 15 players comprising the Lions' 2014-15 roster hail from 10 different states: California (3); Arizona (2); New Jersey (2); Texas (2); Virginia (2); Maryland (1); Massachusetts (1); New York (1) and Tennessee (1).

#### **GLANCE ERA**

Stephanie Glance was named the sixth head coach in Columbia women's basketball history on April 1, 2013. Glances came to Columbia with over 25 years of collegiate coaching experience and most recently was the head coach at Illinois State where she led the Red Birds to three consecutive NIT appearances.

#### **HARDWOOD CLASSICS**

During the off-season, Columbia Athletics began construction on a brand new gymnasium floor inside Levien Gymnasium. Officially completed on in August, the Lions women's basketball team will have their first crack on the new hardwood on Wednesday, Nov. 19 when it entertains Lafayette at 7 p.m.

#### **COMING UP**

Columbia will embark on its first full weekend of lvy League action when it makes the trip to Yale and Brown. The Lions will visit the Bulldogs Friday, Jan. 30 before stopping by Providence, Rhode Island, for a matchup with the Bears Saturday, Jan. 31.



Stephanie Glance, a veteran collegiate women's basketball coach and the former head coach at Illinois State University, enters her second season as Columbia University's head women's basketball coach in 2014-15. Dr. M. Dianne Murphy, the Director, Intercollegiate Athletics and Physical Education at Columbia University, named Glance as the Lions head coach on April 1, 2013.

In her first season at Columbia, Glance joined Traci Walters as the only two coaches to win their first game as the floor general of the Lions, with a 62-59 victory over LIU-Brooklyn Nov. 9, 2013. The win also marked the first on opening night for Columbia since 2009-10 when it downed Sacred Heart, 79-55. Glance and the Lions went 6-22 overall and 3-11 against lvy League opponents in 2013-14.

Glance has more than 25 years of collegiate coaching experience in NCAA Division I. Before venturing to Morningside Heights, she led the Illinois State Redbirds to three consecutive seasons with 19-plus wins, two 24-win seasons, three WNIT appearances and a 67-35 record overall. Prior to her tenure at Illinois State, Glance served one year as the recruiting coordinator and special assistant to head coach Pat Summitt at the University of Tennessee. Glance previously had served as the assistant coach, associate head coach and interim head coach at North Caroline State University of 15 years.

"Stephanie Glance is an outstanding women's basketball coach," Dr. M. Dianne Murphy, Director, Intercollegiate Athletics and Physical Education at Columbia University said. "She brings tremendous experience with a number of impressive mentors, including Hall of Fame coaches Pat Summitt and the late Kay Yow. Stephanie has a demonstrated record of success as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach of a NCAA Division I women's basketball program. We know she is the right coach for Columbia."

"As soon as I stepped on campus, I realized how special Columbia University is. Coaching at an elite institution in the greatest city in the world is an amazing opportunity. What excited me the most about this position was that everyone I spoke with had a visible enthusiasm and commitment to the athletics program and for women's basketball program in particular," Glance said. "With Dianne's [Murphy] leadership and the support that is in place here, I know that we can give Columbia University an extremely competitive women's basketball program."

"I must thank Dianne Murphy and President Lee C. Bollinger for this fantastic opportunity," Glance concluded

Glance started her coaching career as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at South Florida from 1988-93 and served as an assistant coach at Southwest Texas State during the 1993-94 season. For the next 15 years Glance served as the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina State University. She helped guide the Wolfpack to record of 285-178 and 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, reaching the Sweet 16 four times and the 1998 Final Four.

While at N.C. State, Glance developed a very close working relationship with head coach Kay Yow, and served as the interim head coach during parts of the 2004-05, 2006-07 and 2008-09 seasons, while the coach battled breast cancer. Glance oversaw all aspects of the Wolfpack program, including player development, game-plan and practice planning, academic development, scheduling, community service and fundraising.

During her time at North Carolina State, Glance was instrumental in the development of 27 All-ACC selections, the 1995 and 1997 ACC Rookies of the Year and the 1999 ACC Player of the Year. Ten players Glance coached at N.C. State went on to play professionally, including eight that were drafted in either the WNBA or ABL.

As recruiting coordinator, Glance was responsible for all aspects of the N.C. State recruiting efforts. She put together 14 recruiting classes that ranked in the top-30 in the nation, including four in the top-10.



She recruited three junior college All-Americans and one JUCO National Player of the Year.

Glance worked with Pat Summitt at Tennessee in 2009-10. She was hired as an assistant to the head coach and was appointed to assistant coach in December. She also served as the Lady Vols' recruiting coordinator. Tennessee went 32-3 that season, won the SEC regular-season and tournament championships and advanced to the Sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament

Since she has become a head coach, Glance has been honored twice by various organizations for her excellent work. In 2010-11, she was named the Women's Basketball Coaches' Association (WBCA) Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year after leading the Illinois State Redbirds to a 24win season. The next season, after a second-place conference finish in the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC), Glance was named the MVC Women's Basketball Coach of the Year.
