

NEWS AND NOTES

TWO GAMES, THREE DAYS

Columbia will hit the road this weekend as they head up to Kingston, Rhode Island, on Saturday, December 12, to take on Rhode Island at 2 p.m. before returning to Brooklyn, New York, to take on cross-borough rival LIU Brooklyn on Monday, December 14, at 7 p.m.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

The Lions are 2-1 when playing on the road this year, shooting 42.4 percent (72-for-170) fromt he field while averaging 62.0 points and 38.3 rebounds. Three different players are averaging double-figures on the road this year with Camille Zimmerman (13.7) and Tori Oliver (13.3) leading the way while Alexa Giuliano has 10.0.

SHARING THE BALL

The Columbia offense has been sharing the ball well this year, picking up 134 assists on 232 field goals made while with five players head into Saturday's matchup averaging at least 2.0 assists per game.

SHOOTING THE BALL

Columbia heads to Rhode Island averaging 69.0 points per game this season, nearly eight points higher than last year's 61.4 points per game, while shooting 41.7 percent from the field compared to the 36.2 percent that they finished with last season.

SPREAD OUT SCORING

The Lions have spread out their scoring this year with five different players averaging at least 8.0 points per game. While each of the starting five hold at least 4.5 points per game, Devon Roeper (10.1) has been a key contributer off the bench this season.

STRONGER IN THE SECOND HALF

The Lions have proven to be a strong second-half team this year, outscoring their opponents, 318-299, for an average of 35.3 points and 21.0 rebounds per game while shooting 42.4 percent from the field and 31.3 percent from downtown in the last 20 minutes of action. Comparatively, the Lions are averaging 32.7 points and 21.0 rebounds while shooting 40.9 percent from the field and 27.8 percent from downtown in the first half, letting opponents score 34.1 points per game while shooting 32.0 percent from beyond the arc.

KORNER COMING ALIVE

First-year Paulina Korner came alive at the ASU Classic last weekend, averaging 9.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists off the bench against Toledo and No. 17/19 Arizona State while finishing the two-day tournament shooting 38.1 percent from the field. The German-native also picked up her first career 3-pointer against Toledo on Friday, Dec. 5, and is averaging 8.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.25 assists per game over her last four games.

RED HOT ROEPER

Devon Roeper came alive against Stony Brook on Nov. 23 as she recorded 23 points while picking up six boards in 25 minutes after shooting 10-of-16 from the floor. In her last six games, she is averaging 14.0 points and 4.2 rebounds while shooting 62.7 percent (37-of-59) from the field.

DYNAMIC DUO

Once again, the Lions are being led offensively by the dynamic scoring duo of Camille Zimmerman and Tori Oliver who enter the weekend averaging 16.8 and 11.0 points per game while shooting 49.6 and 40.9 percent, respectively, from the field this year.

BEST START SINCE 2002-03

For the first time since the 2002-03 season and only the third time ever in program history, the Lions opened the season at 3-0.

CAREER NIGHT FOR ZIMMERMAN

The Nov. 17 win over Vermont marked a career night for sophomore Camille Zimmerman who picked up her fourth career double-double after posting up 31 points and 12 rebounds for the Lions while going 5-of-6 from downtown.

Her career-high 31 points marked the third most in Columbia's single-game history, and second most in a Division I game for a Lion only behind Tori Oliver's 38-point performance against Wagner on Dec. 30, 2014.

TOP RECRUITING CLASS IN THE IVY LEAGUE

Heading into the season, the Lions have the top recruiting class among the Ancient Eight. Ranked No. 57 among all of Division I schools according to the Dan Olson Collegiate Girls Basketball Report, Columbia's Class of 2019 finished just ahead of conference-foe Princeton (58th) while Penn made the Top 100 at No. 70.

LIU Brooklyn heads into Monday's matchup with a 2-5 record after dropping its last two games to NJIT and Colgate as well as a game against then-No. 14 Florida State on Nov. 27. One of its two wins this season came in a 68-66 overtime win over Navy back on Dec. 2.

INTERIM HEAD COACH SHEILA ROUX



Sheila Roux was named the interim head coach in September of 2015 after Stephanie Glance stepped down to become the Executive Director of the Kay Yow Cancer Fund.

Roux joined the Columbia University women's basketball program in April 2013 as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator and was named an Associate Head Coach for the 2014-15 season.

With Roux serving in her first year as the Associate Head Coach, Columbia saw many firsts fall in 2014-15 as it posted the most victories in five seasons with an 8-20 overall record and 2-12 mark against the Ivies. During non-conference action, Columbia not only played in back-to-back overtime contests for the first time, but won both outings versus Rhode Island (Nov. 24) and Bradley (Nov. 26). To close out of league action, the Lions limited NJIT to 38 points, the fewest points allowed since keeping Skidmore at 32 in December 1986. Records fell throughout conference play as well. On Jan. 24, Columbia held Cornell to 46 points, the fewest points allowed in an Ivy League game since March 4, 2011 vs. Yale (W, 46-42). The Lions downed the Harvard Crimson, 59-43, Feb. 13, for the first time under the roof of Levien Gymnasium in program history. For their efforts, the Lions garnered a program-best seven Ivy League weekly awards highlighted by Camille Zimmerman's six Rookie of the Week accolades, which is also a program first.

In her first year on staff with the Lions, Roux helped Glance become the second head coach in program history to win their first game as the floor general when the Lions downed LIU-Brooklyn 62-59 Nov. 9, 2013 to open the 2013-14 season. The win also marked Columbia's first season-opening victory in two seasons when the Lions downed Sacred Heart, 79-55. During that first season on the bench, the Lions went 6-22 overall and 3-11 in Ivy League action.

Prior to heading to the Lions, Roux has combined for over a decade of collegiate basketball experience as a coach and player. In May of 2010, Roux joined the Illinois State University coaching staff where she helped

lead the Redbirds to a record-setting season in her first season as an assistant coach.

Roux played a crucial role in the Redbirds' success during the 2010-11 season, including the first undefeated Illinois State regular season at home in program history and also helped coach the Redbirds to their thirdstraight semifinal appearance in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). The following season, Roux coached the Valley Newcomer of the Year, Jamie Russell, and helped guide ISU to its 11th appearance in the 2011-12 Postseason WNIT with an at-large

Prior to her time at ISU, Roux spent four seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Wisconsin-Milwaukee (2006-10), mentoring five All-Horizon League selections and two-time Horizon League Player of the Year Traci Edwards.

Before heading to Milwaukee, Roux spent a season as the interim head coach at her alma mater Minnesota-Crookston. A four-year letterwinner for the Eagles (1995-2000), she was a volunteer assistant coach during the 2000-01 season. While a player at UMC, Roux was named the school's Female Athlete of the Year in 2000 and graduated as the school's alltime leader in three-pointers (record broken in 2008).

Roux also spent two seasons as an assistant coach at UW-Parkside from 2003-05. In 2005, the Rangers set a school record with 20 wins and made the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history. Roux was a graduate assistant at South Dakota State from 2001-03, the Jackrabbits posted an overall record of 60-11. A member of Division II at the time, the Jackrabbits reached the NCAA Tournament Semifinals in 2002. In 2003, SDSU won the Division II National Championship.

Roux earned undergraduate degrees in sports recreation and management, and information networking management from Crookston and has a master's degree in sports pedagogy with an emphasis in athletic administration from South Dakota State.
