OPENING DRIVE

- Columbia will start a two-game road swing in New England when it faces Dartmouth on Friday night.
- Friday will mark the Lions' second of three appearances on ESPNU.
- The Lions are coming off a 35-21 defeat to Penn on Homecoming last weekend.
- Justin Townsend leads the Ivy League in sacks (4.0) and tackles for loss (8.5). He is tied for fifth in FCS in TFLs per game.

A COLUMBIA WIN WOULD...

- Snap a three-game losing streak.
- Be Columbia's first Ivy League win of the season.
- Give the Lions their first win in Hanover since 2021.

TEAM NOTES

PENN LEFTOVERS

- The Lions set a season-high with 21 points, but Penn wideout Jared Richardson erupted for 157 yards and three touchdowns, including two in the second half, to give the Quakers a 35-21 win to spoil Columbia's Homecoming.
- The Lions forced three turnovers in the contest, two interceptions and a fumble.
- Caleb Sanchez threw for a career-high 311 yards, going 27-of-47, and added a pair of touchdowns.
- · Nine different receivers caught a pass in the game.
- Sanchez was named the John Toner Player of the Game, given to Columbia's top player during Homecoming.
- First-year running back Michael Walters and first-year wideout Beckett Robinson scored the first touchdowns of their careers in the win.
- Sophomore Caleb Solomon posted seven tackles, picked up his first interception and forced a fumble.

COLUMBIA/DARTMOUTH CONNECTIONS

- Columbia offensive coordinator Seitu Smith spent the 2018 campaign as an offensive quality control assistant.
- Big Green offensive line coach Keith Clark served in the same role with the Lions from 1991-96, helping Columbia post an 8-2 record in 1996.

SERIES HISTORY

Columbia and Dartmouth will meet for the 95th time in a series that dates back to 1899. The Big Green are 73-20-1 all-time against the Lions, including three straight victories and winning five of the last six meetings.

Columbia's last victory over Dartmouth was a 19-0 shutout in Hanover on October 22, 2021. The Lions' last home victory over the Big Green was a 9-7 decision on October 22, 2016.

DARTMOUTH AT A GLANCE

DARTMOUTH'S STATUS

- Dartmouth is coming off a 30-13 victory over Fordham. The Big Green used a 24-point second half to pull away from the Rams and secure the victory. Grayson Saunier threw for 281 yards and two touchdowns, Grayson O'Bara recorded 104 yards and caught a touchdown pass, and Luke Rives recorded his first collegiate receiving touchdown.
- Sammy McCorkle is in his third season leading the Big Green and his 21st season overall at Dartmouth. Dartmouth finished last season with an 8-2 record, going 5-2 in Ivy League Play. The Big Green earned a share of the Ivy League Championship for their second consecutive title.
- Dartmouth's offense is averaging 422 yards per game. The Big Green's 4.9 yards per carry leads the Ivy League, while D.J. Crowther is second in both rushing touchdowns (7) and yards per game (93.8). Grayson O'Bara is tied for third in receptions (27), and Ky'Dric Fisher leads the Ancient Eight in yards per catch (22.7).
- Dartmouth's defense is allowing over 330 yards per game. Sean Williams is tied for the Ivy League lead in interceptions (3), Zyion Freer-Brown leads the Big Green in total tackles (38), and Thaddeus Gianaris is the Dartmouth leader in tackles-for-loss (5) and sacks (2.5).
- Owen Zalc has been a force for the Big Green's special teams. Zalc has won back-to-back Ivy League Special Teams Player of the week honors after recording three field goals and three extra points in Dartmouth's win at Fordham. Zalc recorded a career-high twelve points against the Rams, following up a spectacular performance against Yale that included a game-winning field goal.

PATRICIA & SHEPARD ALEXANDER HEAD COACH OF FOOTBALL SECOND SEASON WILLIAMS '07

on Poppe was named the 22nd Patricia and Shepard Alexander Head Coach of Football at Columbia University in December 2023 and made an immediate impact in his first season. He led the Lions to a 7-3 overall record—their best since 2017—and a 5-2 lvy League mark to claim a share of the conference title. It was Columbia's first lvy League Championship since 1961.

The seven wins were the most by a first-year head coach at Columbia since 1899, and the five Ivy League victories were a program record for a rookie head coach. Under Poppe's leadership, a school-record 14 Lions earned All-Ivy League honors. Additionally, defensive back Hayden McDonald became the first All-American since 2019, having been selected by five different publications and organizations.

Columbia earned its first win over a ranked opponent since 2015 and its first over a top-15 team since 1995, defeating No. 14/18 Lafayette in the season opener. The Lions received votes in the national top-25 polls for seven weeks and were named the Stats Perform National FCS Team of the Week following the upset of the Leopards.

Poppe's success earned him national recognition as a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, presented to the nation's top FCS head coach. His staff was also named Ivy League Coaching Staff of the Year.

Before returning to Columbia, Poppe served as head coach at Union College in 2023, guiding the Garnet Chargers to a 10-2 record, a Liberty League title, and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament. He coached 15 All-Liberty League honorees, and his team ranked eighth nationally in scoring defense, averaging over 32 points per game offensively.

Poppe has more than a decade of Ivy League coaching experience. He previously served as Columbia's secondary coach and recruiting coordinator from 2015–17, helping the Lions to their best season in decades in 2017 (8-2). During that time, Columbia's defense led the Ivy League in interceptions and pass defense, with seven defensive backs earning All-Ivy honors.

He also spent nine seasons at Harvard (2011–14, 2017–22) coaching the secondary and special teams. Under his guidance, Harvard's defense consistently ranked among the best in FCS. In 2022, the Crimson ranked third nationally in blocked punts and fourth in blocked kicks. Poppe was honored as the FBS/FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the Gridiron Club of Greater Boston in 2021 after leading a Harvard defense that topped the nation in rushing defense and ranked third in interceptions.

Earlier in his career, Poppe coached at Holy Cross, Springfield College, and King's College (Pa.). He is a 2007 graduate of Williams College, where he was a three-year starter in the secondary. As a senior, he earned All-East Region honors and first-team All-NESCAC recognition while helping Williams to a perfect 8-0 season.

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS

Columbia will play four times on Friday nights this season. Only NIU and Ohio (five) have more non-Saturday games than Columbia among NCAA Division I programs in 2025. Following the season opener at Lafayette on September 19, the Lions will be featured three times on ESPNU in conference play (Oct. 3 at Princeton, Oct. 24 at Dartmouth and Nov. 7 vs. Harvard).

LIONS IN PRIMETIME

Columbia is 9-21 all-time when playing night games. On Fridays, Columbia is just 3-11.

COLUMBIA AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

The Lions are 6-66 against teams ranked in the top 25 all-time after falling to No. 7/8 Lehigh on October 11. Columbia went 1-2 against ranked foes last year, including a win over No. 14/18 Lafayette, 31-20, in its season opener.

CHAPMAN SEMIFINALIST FOR WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL TROPHY

Senior offensive lineman Mark Chapman was named one of 177 semifinalists for the William V. Campbell trophy on September 24. It is awarded by the National Football Foundation to the American college football player with the best combination of academics, community service, and on-field performance. It is considered by many to be the "Academic Heisman" and nicknamed as such. Chapman, an Economics major, is a three-year starter at center.

THE CAPTAINS

Upon the conclusion of the last season, senior defensive end Justin Townsend, senior linebacker Jack Smiechowski, senior center Mark Chapman and junior quarterback were named team captains for 2025. The quartet was selected by a team vote. Smiechowski is a second-generation captain. His grandfather, Tom O'Connor, was a running back on Columbia's first Ivy League Championship squad in 1961 and served as captain in 1962.

ANY GIVEN SUNDAY

A pair of 2021 graduates are in their second season on NFL rosters. Defensive back Jordan Colbert is currently with the Miami Dolphins, while running back Dante Miller is with the New York Giants. Miller was on the active roster for two games last season and is currently on New York's practice squad. Colbert earned a spot on Miami's 53-man roster after serving on the practice squad in 2024.

GIL-STRONG

Columbia's beloved Director of Football Sport Performance, Bob Gilmartin, passed away on March 9 after a long battle with illness. He began at Columbia in 2014 and touched the lives of thousands of student-athletes. Gilmartin was also instrumental in the 2024 transformation of the weight room at the Campbell Sports Center, and the head strength coach's office was dedicated in his name during a ceremony this past fall.

Gilmartin joined Columbia after two years as an assistant strength and conditioning coach with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers under Greg Schiano. Gilmartin previously spent 11 years with Schiano at Rutgers University, working as the assistant strength and conditioning coach for the football team and head strength coach for several other varsity programs.

Before Columbia's game against Georgetown, Gilmartin was honored with a moment of silence.

In his honor, The Bob Gilmartin Cancer Foundation was created to carry forward his legacy — a legacy of toughness, compassion, and unyielding resolve. Through WeCancer, it aims to unite families, athletes, and communities in the fight against cancer by funding research, providing patient support, and creating opportunities for awareness and action.

GAME NOTES: OFFENSE

OUARTERBACK CAROUSEL

For the second consecutive season, the Lions have started three different quarterbacks. Junior Chase Goodwin earned the starting job to start the season, but missed the last two games due to injury. Sophomore Caleb Sanchez also missed the Princeton and Lehigh games with an injury, forcing junior Xander Menapace into the lineup against the Mountain Hawks. Sanchez returned last week, making his first start since week 10 against Cornell in 2024.

Additionally, first-year Xander Eschelman has been used primarily in running situations the last three weeks. James McCauley saw his first career action at the end of the Lehigh game.

EVANS STEPPING UP

Junior wideout Titus Evans has registered at least 75 yards over his past three games. At Princeton, he registered eight catches for 93 yards. Against Lehigh, Evans registered six grabs for a career-high 111 yards and a touchdown. He currently ranks No. 5 in the Ancient Eight with 389 receiving yards on the year and ranks No. 25 in FCS, averaging 77.8 yards per game.

THE CROW

Sophomore wideout Hutch Crow has emerged as a redzone threat for the Lions, leading the team with three receiving touchdowns. After not playing as a first-year, he has 15 grabs for 153 yards, including a long of 26 yards.

IF I COULD BE LIKE MIKE

Columbia's ground game is being led by first-year Michael Walters, who has a team-best 172 yards in just three games. He burst onto the scene with a 63-yard performance on 12 carries in the season-opener at Lafayette. After missing two games with an injury, he returned against Penn to rush 11 times for 61 yards and his first career touchdown.

CHASE IS ON THE CASE

Junior quarterback Chase Goodwin will look to build on a solid 2024 season, where he went 4-1 as a starter and led the Ivy League in completion percentage (66.7 percent) before missing the final four games due to injury. He became the first Lion to throw for over 300 yards in a game since 2017 after racking up 334 with a pair of touchdowns at Penn on his way to Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week honors. The native of Houston, Texas, saw action in five games in 2023, serving as the Lions' short-yardage QB.

HOLD THE LINE

Columbia's offensive line is projected to be a strength in 2025. Center Mark Chapman and right tackle Noah Jordan earned All-lvy League honors during their careers. Senior left tackle Ryan Carr and left guard Nik Winzer also saw significant action in 2024. The Lions ranked second in the lvy League in rushing (169.1 yards/game) and posted three 200+ yard rushing games last year.

COLE POSITION

Senior Cole Freeman has moved from quarterback to wide receiver for his final collegiate season. Last year, Freeman started three games, throwing for 755 yards and seven touchdowns and rushing for 207 yards and three scores. Freeman led Columbia to a 13-10 victory over Yale with a game-winning 44-yard touchdown pass with 4:49 left in the fourth quarter.

THE SANCHIZE

Sophomore quarterback Caleb Sanchez led Columbia to two wins to close the season, helping the Lions clinch their Ivy League title. He was the Ancient Eight's Rookie of the Week on Nov. 25 following the 17-9 win over Cornell, where he went 11-of-19 for 221 yards with a passing touchdown and a rushing score. His 12-for-27, 241-yard performance at Brown also kept Columbia in the title hunt in the season's penultimate game.

WHAT'S UP. DOC?

Junior tight end Braden Dougherty is coming off an honorable mention All-Ivy League campaign in 2024. He is the team's second leading returning pass catcher after posting 13 catches for 167 yards and a pair of touchdown grabs.

TERRY-BLE NEWS

Senior running back Malcolm Terry, who took the spring semester off to return to Columbia, suffered a season-ending injury in training camp. Terry averaged 5.2 yards per carry in 2024 and has 815 career rushing yards in three seasons.

CALLING THE PLAYS

Columbia's offensive coordinator, Seitu Smith, is no stranger to the lvy League. After coaching stops at Yale and Dartmouth, he played at Harvard, where he was a wide receiver and kick returner. Smith has won seven lvy League titles as a player or coach.

GAME NOTES: DEFENSE

HANS SOLO-MON

Safety Caleb Solomon has had a breakout season for the Lions, tying for the team lead with 43 tackles, which ranks among the Ivy League leaders. He notched a career-high 15 tackles against Lehigh and had a strong allaround game against Penn, posting seven tackles to go with his first career interception and a forced fumble.

JACK OF ALL TRADES

Senior linebacker Jack Smiechowski has been doing it all for Columbia this season. He is tied for the Ivy League with three interceptions on the season. His 43 tackles are tied for the team lead and are among the Ivy League leaders. In the Lions' win over the Hoyas, he posted a team-high eight tackles to go with a pair of interceptions, the first of his career. At Princeton, Smiechowski posted 15 tackles and another pick. He is the first Lion to post 15 tackles since John Harris '20CC had 15 against Central Connecticut State in 2019. The Upper Saddle River, New Jersey, native has played in 34 of a possible 35 games in his career and is coming off a 2024 campaign in which he was second on the team with 66 tackles

JUSTIFIED

Senior defensive lineman Justin Townsend opted to return to Columbia after suffering a season-ending injury in week three against Princeton in 2024. Townsend has four sacks this season, which leads the Ivy League and is No. 15 in FCS. His career total is up to 18.5, which ranks third in program history. He posted consecutive All-Ivy League campaigns in 2022 and 2023 and led the conference with 7.5 sacks in 2023, which was the fifth-highest single-season total for the program.

POWERFUL POWELL

On the other defensive end, senior Josh Powell has also been a disruptive force and has posted 6.0 tackles for a loss this season, which is third in the Ivy League.

CHARLES IN CHARGE

Junior linebacker Charlie Newton led the defense with 12 tackles against Lafayette, including 1.5 for a loss. It was the second double-figure tackle game of his career and two off his career high set last November at Harvard.

THE THREE AMIGOS

Columbia returns three linebackers who saw significant action in 2024. Senior captain Jack Smiechowski is the team's leading returning tackler after posting 66 takedowns. Juniors Charlie Newton and AJ George filled in after injuries last season and are slated for bigger roles in 2025.

SECONDARY TO NONE

Columbia lost three All-Ivy League members of the secondary due to graduation, including All-American Hayden McDonald. The Lions return cornerback Carter McCray, who earned Ivy League Rookie of the Week honors twice and was honorable mention All-Ivy League. Sophomore Caleb Solomon was a factor early in his rookie season before suffering an injury, and he has 21 tackles at safety. Sophomore Mason Robinson has started the last three games at corner. Sophomore Jeremiah Douglas and senior Jayden Marshall have been patrolling the other safety spot. At the same time, upperclassmen Cobe Crews and Levi Robins have seen ample action throughout their careers and this season.

STO & GO

Since taking over Columbia's defense in 2022, defensive coordinator Justin Stovall has built one of the Ivy League's top units and one of the most respected defenses at the FCS level. Stovall's defense was key to Columbia capturing the 2024 Ivy League title. The Lions allowed just 16.1 points per game – good for No. 2 in FCS and led the Ivy League in four categories (scoring defense, red zone defense, passing defense, passing efficiency defense).

Under his guidance, defensive back Hayden McDonald earned All-America honors from five publications/organizations. McDonald led the conference with five interceptions and was the program's first-ever defensive finalist for the Bushnell Cup, given to the Ivy League's top offensive and defensive player. Additionally, six of Columbia's 11 starters on defense picked up All-Ivy League honors, highlighted by first-team selections for McDonald and defensive lineman Ben Corniello.

GAME NOTES: SPECIAL TEAMS

BE MERRY

In just two-plus seasons, kicker Hugo Merry ranks among Columbia's all-time leaders in field goals made (22 - fourth) and extra points made (48 - sixth). Merry set a program record by making 11 straight field goals, surpassing the old mark of eight, between the 2023 and 2024 seasons. He also converted on 38 consecutive PATs from the end of 2023 until the Georgetown game, a new Columbia record. Merry had the third most makes in the Ivy League (11) in 2024. As a rookie, Merry made eight field goals. Five were between 40 and 49 yards, and he set a long of 45.

TOMMY BOY

Columbia turned to sophomore Tommy Sleeman to take over punting duties from three-time All-Ivy League selection William Hughes. Sleeman has averaged 42.1 yards per kick, has a long of 65 yards and has three kicks over 50 yards on the season. In high school, Sleeman played for national powerhouse Bishop Gorman in Nevada, averaging 50.5 yards per punt as a senior.

CREWS CONTROL

Senior Cobe Crews made a significant impact in the return game against Lafayette, averaging 23.8 yards per kickoff return with a long of 41 yards. Crews had never been used as a returner in his previous three seasons with the Lions. On the season, he has 15 returns and averages 20.9 yards per attempt.

A LOOK BACK... COLUMBIA VS. DARTMOUTH (OCTOBER 26, 2024)

NEW YORK – Dartmouth built an early lead and held off a fourth-quarter surge from Columbia to secure a 24-21 victory Saturday at Robert K. Kraft Field to spoil the Lions' Homecoming game.

The Big Green (6-0, 3-0 lvy League) jumped to a 24-7 advantage early in the second half. Running back Q Jones led the charge with 182 rushing yards on 19 carries, including a 35-yard touchdown run. D.J. Crowther added another rushing touchdown to extend Dartmouth's lead.

"I think we ran into a buzz saw a little bit with how they're coached and how their running backs and offensive line played," said Patricia and Shepard Alexander Head Coach of Football Jon Poppe. "(Q Jones) is talented and we didn't execute the right way or put our guys in the right position to adjust in the second half when some of those big runs took place."


After trailing most of the way, Columbia (4-2, 2-1 lvy League) found momentum late. Quarterback Cole Freeman led the charge with two touchdown passes to senior wide receiver Bryson Canty, who caught eight passes for 90 yards. The Lions' offense pulled within three points after Canty's 7-yard touchdown reception with 34 seconds remaining, capping a 58-yard drive.

Columbia attempted an onside kick, but Dartmouth recovered, allowing the Big Green to run out the clock.

"I thought our guys pressed in the first half," Poppe said. "In the second half, we relaxed and got back to who we are and doing what we do. I'm really proud of how they finished. I couldn't be more proud to represent them and what they ended up almost doing."

Dartmouth's defense recorded three interceptions, but only scored three points off the turnovers. Kicker Owen Zalc contributed with a 35-yard field goal in the second quarter, helping the Big Green stay perfect on the season.

Freeman finished with 173 passing yards, while Canty had eight catches for 90 yards and two scores. Canty's performance earned him John Toner Homecoming Player of the Game honors. The Lions outgained Dartmouth through the air, with 252 passing yards compared to Dartmouth's 70.

BILL CAMPBELL '62CC '64TC

A four-year student-athlete, William "Bill" Campbell '62CC '64TC captained the 1961 lvy League Championship football team, which was inducted into the Columbia Athletics Hall of Fame in 2010, and earned Alllvy League accolades as a senior. In 1963, Bill and a group of football and rugby alumni founded the Old Blue Rugby Club. He returned to Columbia to coach the Columbia Football team for six seasons between 1974 and 1979.

After his coaching stint, Campbell embarked on a legendary career. He was vice president at J. Walter Thompson, an advertising agency based in New York, and then moved on to become general manager of consumer products for Kodak Europe. After Kodak, he joined Apple Computer in 1983, and rose to the level of executive vice president; he went on to found and served as president and CEO of Claris Corporation, a spin-off software developing company created and owned by Apple in 1990. Campbell assumed his role as chairman of Intuit, the maker of Quicken, QuickBooks, and Turbo Tax, in 1998 and served as its CEO until 2000. As an executive, Campbell's marketing and strategic acumen helped build Claris, Apple, and Intuit alike into remarkable Silicon Valley success stories. Later, his advisory roles as a director at Apple, Google, and others established him as the "Coach of Silicon Valley."

He joined the University Trustees in 2003 and was named Chair just two years later. He led the University through one of the most dynamic eras in its history – one that included the planning and groundbreaking of the new Manhattanville campus, the opening of the University's Global Centers, the successful completion of the record-setting Columbia Campaign and The Columbia Campaign for Athletics: Achieving Excellence, the creation of the Columbia Alumni Association and many more initiatives

In 2009, recognizing his influence and love of the game of football, the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame announced that its highest honor, the former Draddy Trophy, sometimes referred to as the "academic Heisman," would be renamed the William V. Campbell Trophy.

Because of his tremendous leadership and passion for Columbia Athletics, the University dedicated the Campbell Sports Center in his honor in October 2013.

In fall 2014, the athletics program retired uniform number 67 – the number Campbell wore as an offensive lineman and linebacker for the 1961 Ivy League Champions – for all 31 of Columbia's varsity teams. At the 2015 Varsity C Celebration, the athletics program introduced a new award, the William V. Campbell Performer of the Year to be presented annually to the top male and female student-athletes of the academic year.
