STORYLINES

- Harvard will make its third trip to the state of New York in a span of 10 days when it faces Siena on Monday night. Tip is slated for 7 p.m. ET with the contest airing on ESPN3.

- The Crimson finds itself on the road at a MAAC school for the second time in the early going. In the second game of the season on Nov. 13, Harvard fell in overtime at unanimous preseason MAAC favorite, Iona, 90-87.

- Harvard is looking to improve to 4-1 for the first time since opening the 2014-15 campaign with a 7-1 record.

- The Crimson is coming off a 98-52 home victory over MIT on Saturday. Harvard buried a program-record-tying 17 three-pointers en route to posting its third game with at least 86 points. Harvard also made 17 treys on Dec. 10, 2002 (vs. Rider) and March 3, 2018 (vs. Columbia).

- As a team, Harvard shot 61.4 percent from the floor vs. the Engineers, including 63 percent from three (17-27), and made 11-of-14 from the charity stripe. The Crimson's field-goal percentage and three-point percentage were both season highs.

- Six Harvard players reached double figures in scoring vs. MIT, something that had not occurred since Dec. 28, 2013. Chris Ledlum and Samuel Silverstein each had 16 points, while Kale Catchings added a season-high 15. Noah Kirkwood chipped in 12, with Luka Sakota and Idan Tretout recording 11 apiece.

- Silverstein, a sophomore guard, enjoyed a perfect shooting day against the Engineers, going 6-for-6 from the field, 2-for-2 from deep and 2-for-2 from the free-throw line. In two games last week (at UAlbany, vs. MIT), he averaged 11.5 points (.900 FG, .750 3FG, 1.000 FT) and 3.0 rebounds in 22.5 minutes.

- Catchings produced his most efficient effort

of the young season vs. MIT, logging 15 points, five rebounds, one blocked shot and one steal in 20 minutes. The senior connected on 5-of-9 from the floor (2-2 3FG), which was better than his combined numbers from his previous three games (13 pts., 3-11 FG, 2-6 3FG).

- Ledlum kept Harvard's streak of having either himself or Kirkwood lead the team in scoring and rebounding with his 16 points and seven rebounds. The junior has led the team in scoring twice, while producing the Crimson's top rebounding figure three times. For the season, he is averaging 18.3 points and a team-high 8.5 rebounds.

- Harvard's victory over MIT improved its home record to 13-1 record over the last two seasons ('19-20, '21-22). The Crimson has won nine straight non-league home games and has not suffered a home loss to a non-conference foe since Nov. 9, 2018.

- Harvard and Siena will be meeting for third time in series history, with both teams splitting the first two games. The combined series score over two games is 123-123.

- The Crimson will be facing the Saints for the third straight season in which it has competed. Harvard dropped a 67-64 decision in Loudonville, New York in 2018-19, before earning a 59-56 home win in 2019-20. The Crimson's 2020-21 campaign was wiped out due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- In the aforementioned 2019-20 get-together with Siena, Ledlum, then a first-year player, came off the bench and contributed 14 points on the strength of a career-best three treys in just 18 minutes. Other current Crimson players to make an appearance that night were Idan Tretout (4 pts., 2 stls.) and Mason Forbes (4 rebs.).

- Dating back to '19-20, Harvard has won 10 of its last 12 (10-2) and is 11-3 in its last 14 outings.

FREE POINTS

The Crimson has made 79-of-99 from the free-throw line, which is good for 79.8 percent. Through games of Nov. 20, Harvard ranks first in the Ivy League in free throws made and attempted, and No. 17 and 39, respectively, in Division I.

LEGALIZED THEFT

Noah Kirkwood has 10 steals on the season and his 2.5 steals per game average ranks first in the Ivy League, through Nov. 20. His season average is buoyed by his career-high seven steals at Iona, which was the most by a Harvard player since Wesley Saunders had seven at Vermont on Dec. 6, 2014. Patrick Harvey owns the record with eight steals (Nov. 25, 2000 vs. Lehigh).

ATOP THE IVY

In addition to the aforementioned categories Harvard leads the Ivy in, it also leads the Ancient Eight in steals per game (10.5) and turnovers forced (18.0), through Nov. 20. Individually, Chris Ledlum and Noah Kirkwood are first in double-doubles (1), with Ledlum also leading the league in rebounds per game (8.5) and total rebounds (34).

NON-CONFERENCE, NO PROBLEM

Harvard is 9-1 in its last nine non-conference games and had won seven in a row before the overtime hiccup at Iona.

WELCOME BACK

Senior Spencer Freedman played 13 minutes off the bench vs. Morehouse and contributed six points, two assists and one steal. The game marked his first action since March 8, 2019, of his freshman season after bouts with injuries (sophomore) and the pandemic (junior). His six points and 13 minutes were his most since logging 11 points in 36 minutes at Vermont on Dec. 8, 2018.

HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE

The Crimson has won 35 of its last 39 games at home (35-4), and 41 of its last 46 (41-5). Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Harvard holds a 43-9 home record against Ivy opponents.

ATOP THE COMMONWEALTH

Harvard is 44-18 overall against its in-state rivals under Tommy Amaker, and owns a 31-10 record against Boston-area schools with Amaker at the helm. Harvard is 7-2 in the program's last two competitive seasons against Bay State programs.

BUILT DIFFERENT

The Crimson is 6-1 in its last seven true non-conference road games. Harvard had won five straight, but had its streak broken at Iona.

HOLDING OUR OWN

Harvard owns 16 victories under Tommy Amaker against schools from the Power-5 Conferences. Since Amaker's first season in 2007-08, the Crimson has posted a 16-16 regular-season record vs. teams from those leagues and is 16-22 overall (regular season, postseason). The 16 overall wins are more than double the next-closest Ivy League team (Yale - 7). The rest of the Ivy: Princeton - 5, Cornell - 2, Penn - 2, Brown - 1, Columbia - 0, Dartmouth - 0.

CANADIAN CRIMSON

Josh Hemmings is the ninth Canadian player to join the Crimson since Tommy Amaker took over in 2007-08. He joins fellow Canadians Noah Kirkwood and Luka Sakota on the current roster, and alums Danilo Djuricic, Chris Egi, Corey Johnson, Agunwa Okolie, Laurent Rivard and Patrick Steeves.

WINNING CULTURE

Harvard has posted a 232-104 overall record since the start of the 2009-10 season. The Crimson, meanwhile, has posted a 123-19 record at Lavietes Pavilion since the start of 2009-10.

DECADE OF DOMINANCE

Harvard enjoyed unprecedented success during the 2010s and was No. 1 in the Ivy League and the state of Massachusetts during the decade (Jan. 1, 2010-Dec. 31, 2019). The Crimson won 209 games, outpacing Princeton (193) and Northeastern (181) for supremacy in the Ivy and state, respectively. Harvard also advanced to eight postseason tournaments and won seven conference titles.

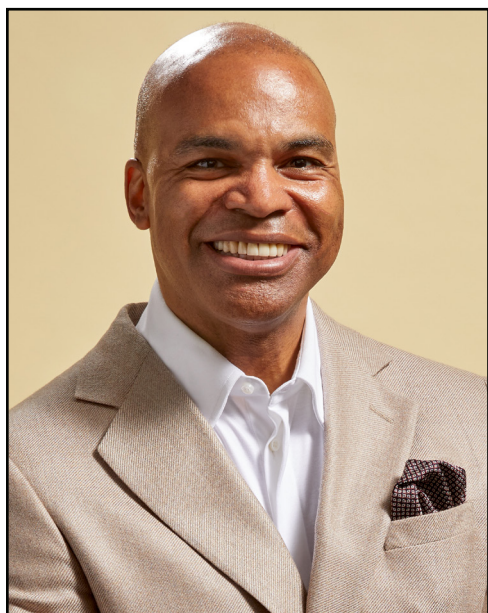

TOMMY AMAKER

The Thomas G. Stemberg '71 Family Endowed Coach for Harvard Men's Basketball
15th season at Harvard
430-279 overall | 254-140 (126-56 Ivy League) at Harvard

In 15 seasons, Tommy Amaker has reinvented the Crimson into an Ivy League power with a national presence. He has directed Harvard to a period of unprecedented prosperity in the form of seven Ivy League championships (2011-15, 2018-19), four NCAA tournament appearances (2012-15) and seven 20-win seasons (2010-15, 2020). Amaker is the all-time winningest coach with the Crimson, surpassing Frank Sullivan with a 74-66 win at Boston College on Dec. 7, 2016.

Amaker was introduced as head coach on April 13, 2007, following six seasons as head coach at Michigan and four at the helm of Seton Hall. He has earned numerous coach-of-the-year awards, including the 2013 Clarence "Big House" Gaines College Basketball Coach of the Year Award, presented to the top minority basketball coach in NCAA Division I. In 2012, he was presented with district coach-of-the-year awards from both the USBWA and NABC, and was a candidate for the AP National Coach of the Year. He has also been named a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award six times (2011-15, 2019), and the Hugh Durham Award three times (2011, 2012, 2015). In June 2020, he was named The James Herscot '58 Coach of Excellence, a title he held in 2020-21, becoming the fifth recipient in Harvard history.

With Amaker at the helm, Harvard has garnered seven All-America honors, 14 All-District distinctions and 35 all-conference accolades. At the Ivy League level, Amaker has helped the Crimson earn 15 first-team all-league selections, four rookies of the year, two defensive players of the year, three players of the year,

Before beginning his head-coaching career, Amaker won two NCAA championships and advanced to five Final Fours as an assistant and associate head coach at Duke, following a successful playing career in Durham, North Carolina.

Prior to arriving at Harvard, Amaker was at Michigan where he inherited a program that was reeling from institutional and NCAA sanctions, but led the Wolverines to the postseason three times, winning the 2004 NIT title and reaching the championship game of the 2006 NIT. The Wolverines were ranked as high as No. 20 in the nation during the 2005-06 season.

At his first head coaching stop, Seton Hall, the Pirates reached the postseason every year during Amaker's tenure. He led Seton Hall to the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2000, and to three appearances in the NIT. He was credited with bringing in the top recruiting class in the country, including the national high school player of the year, for the 2000-01 season.

Amaker has been the head coach of six players who were either drafted, or signed as free agents, by NBA clubs, including two first-round draft picks.

Amaker served nine years as a graduate assistant, assistant coach and associate head coach at Duke, working for legendary head coach Mike Krzyzewski. He was an assistant on two NCAA championship teams with the Blue Devils (1991, '92) and helped Duke to three other Final Fours in eight NCAA tournament appearances. Duke was a combined 230-80 in Amaker's nine years on the Blue Devils coaching staff.

A native of Falls Church, Virginia, Amaker began his career in college basketball with a highly successful playing stint at Duke. He led the Blue Devils to four NCAA tournaments, including the 1986 national championship game, and served as team captain as a senior. A four-year starter, Amaker was the 1987 winner of the Henry Iba Corinthian Award as the nation's top defensive player, and he was enshrined in the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in 2001. In 2013, Amaker was inducted in the Washington Metropolitan Basketball Hall of Fame.

An All-American at Duke, Amaker is also a member of the New England Basketball Hall of Fame, having been inducted in 2013, and the W.T. Woodson H.S. Hall of Fame - Class of 2012 (Fairfax, Va.).

Amaker's playing career also includes a gold medal as part of the U.S. national team at the 1986 World Championships.

A 1987 Duke graduate with a bachelor's degree in economics, Amaker was selected by the Seattle SuperSonics in the 1987 NBA draft. He currently serves on the NABC Board of Directors and co-chairs its Committee on Racial Reconciliation, after having served as a board member of the NABC Foundation. He also joined forces with Kentucky's John Calipari in the summer of 2020, to introduce the McLendon Minority Leadership Initiative and became involved with Black Coaches United. His work with the NABC and with Calipari led to him receiving the NABC Guardians of the Game Award (Inclusion) in 2021. Additionally, Amaker served on the board of USA Basketball where he was a member of the Men's Collegiate and Men's Senior National Committees, helping to select members of the gold-medal-winning 1996 U.S. Olympic team.

Amaker, who was recognized as one of five Champions of Diversity and Inclusion by the NCAA Minority Opportunities and Interests Committee in February 2021, also serves on the Board of Overseers for the Boys & Girls Club of Boston, is an Executive Fellow at Harvard Business School and a Special Assistant to Harvard University President Larry Bacow.
