QUICK STORYLINES

- The Crimson 2024-25 season was comprised of a 12-game non-conference slate and its annual 14-game Ivy schedule. Following its 26-game regular season, Harvard has tied a program record with a record of 22-4, matched only by the 1997-98 team.
- In non-conference play, the Crimson went 11-1 and defeated three power conference opponents (No. 25 Indiana, Boston College, Northwestern) for the first time in program history. Additionally, the Crimson's win over Indiana marked its second AP Top 25 win in the last 25 years.
- Harvard wrapped up its regular season last weekend with a dominant 74-40 victory at Dartmouth.
- With the victory over the Big Green, the Crimson has recorded its most overall (22) and Ivy (11) wins since the 2013-14 season.
- The Crimson holds a record of 1-5 in the Ivy Madness semifinals since its inception in 2016-17. The Crimson has made all seven Ivy League Tournaments, receiving the three seed six times. Last season, Harvard was eliminated by Columbia, 63-61.
- Harmoni Turner and Elena Rodriguez received nods in the Ivy League end-of-year honors following impressive senior campaigns. Turner headlined the major awards by being named the Ivy League Player of the Year and receiving a unanimous First-Team All-Ivy selection. Rodriguez followed by being named Second-Team All-Ivy.
- Along with a slew of other national honors this season, Harmoni Turner and Carrie Moore were recently both named as World Exposure Report Mid-Major Finalists for Player of the Year and Coach of the Year, respectively. Additionally, Turner and Moore were named finalists for the 2025 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year award and the 2025 Kathy Delaney-Smith Mid-Major Coach of the Year award, respectively.
- Moore has continued to lead the Crimson back into the national spotlight and build her legacy at the helm of the program. With a victory over Penn on January 20, Moore became the fastest coach to 50 wins in program history.
- After its first 26 contests, the Crimson ranks fourth in turnover margin (8.5), 13th in three point percentage defense (26.6%), 15th in scoring margin (18.0), 21st in turnovers forced per game (20.8), 25th in steals per game (11.0), and 30th field goal percentage defense (37.0%), nationally. As a whole, the Crimson ranks as the top scoring defense in the country, holding opponents to an average of 51.2 points per game.
- In the first NET Rankings of the season Harvard checked in at No. 36. The ranking marked the highest in the Ivy League and the highest in program history, topping its previous best of 58 from last season. Since then, the Crimson has continued to move up, ranking as high as No. 32. Harvard has not ranked outside the top 40 and has led the Ivy League in the NET for the entirety of the season.
- Following a historic victory over No. 25 Indiana, the Crimson received votes in week two of the AP Top 25 poll. Throughout the season, the Crimson were receiving votes for 14 straight weeks and 15 total times.
- Harvard currently ranks No. 4 in the College Inside Mid-Major Top 25, trailing Columbia at No. 3 and leading Princeton at No. 8.
- The Crimson was picked to finish third in the Ivy League Preseason Poll, receiving 101 points, including one first-place vote. Harvard trailed only Princeton (122) and Columbia (110).

HOW WE'VE FARED IN THE MADNESS

- The Crimson has appeared in all six Ivy Madness tournaments since its inception in 2017.
- Harvard has been the three seed each year besides being the four seed in 2022.
- Last season, the Crimson faced the host Columbia Lions in the semifinals. A late-game surge from Harvard was cut short, ultimately falling, 63-61.
- The Crimson is 1-5 in semifinal games with its one victory coming in Carrie Moore's first year at the helm in 2023. Harvard recorded the first upset in tournament history, dropping Columbia, 72-65, in overtime to advance to the championship game.

ALL-IVY

- The Crimson duo of Harmoni Turner and Elena Rodriguez received All-Ivy honors after impressive senior campaigns.
- Turner headlined the major awards, being named the player of the year. Throughout the season, the guard led the league in points (21.6) and steals (2.8), while also ranking sixth in assists (3.4) and 11th in rebounding (5.5). The Mansfield, Texas native was also a unanimous First-Team All-Ivy selection. It is the third first-team honor of her career, but the first unanimous selection.
- Turner is the first Harvard women's basketball student athlete to be named player of the year in 20 years. Additionally, the Crimson star is the 17th player in Ivy League history to earn a major award following being named rookie of the year.
- Rodriguez rounded out the Crimson on All-Ivy teams, being named Second-Team All-Ivy. The Spain native averaged 12.2 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 1.6 steals in her senior season. Rodriguez, who ranks first in program history for field goal percentage, has the fourth-best shooting percentage at 55.7%. For players with over 200 field attempts, Rodriguez's percentage ranks as the best in the conference.
- It is the second All-Ivy honor for Rodriguez, earning Honorable Mention All-Ivy in her sophomore season.

DEFENSIVE DIFFERENTIAL

- The Crimson has found a new defensive identity in the 2024-25 season. By providing relentless pressure across the 94 feet, Harvard ranks as the top defense in the league and in the nation.
- Harvard has a scoring differential of 18.0 in 2024-25 as opposed to 5.5 in 2023-24 by holding its opponents to an average of 12.2 fewer points per game.
- Additionally, the Crimson is holding opponents to nearly 3.0% dropoff in both field goal and three-point shooting percentages.
- By putting constant pressure on its opponents, Harvard has raised its opponent's turnover average by 5.6 per game and its steal average by 3.9 per game.
- Harvard's average of 51.2 points per game allowed ranks as the top scoring defense in the country.

HARVARD HISTORY

- The Crimson has reached new heights in 2024-25, catapulting back into the national spotlight.
- Harvard finished 11-1 in non-conference play with three wins coming against power conference opponents. It is the first time in program history that the Crimson has dropped three Power Four foes.
- One of those three wins came against No. 25 Indiana, marking the team's second AP Top 25 win in 25 years.
- With its resume boosting wins, the Crimson began to be recognized in the AP Top 25 poll. Throughout the season Harvard was receiving votes in 15 different weekly polls, including 14 straight.
- While continuing to rank inside the top 40 of the NET for the entirety of the season, the

Crimson reached a program-best NET ranking at No. 32.

- At the conclusion of conference play, the Crimson has tied its program's best regular season record at 22-4. The 84.6% winning percentage has only been matched by the historic 1997-98 team. Additionally, its 22 total and 11 conference wins are the team's best since the 2013-14 season.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Crimson closed out the regular season with a dominant 74-40 victory over the Dartmouth Big Green in Hanover, N.H.
- Harmoni Turner surpassed 30 points for the fourth time this season, tallying 33 points on 15-of-22 shooting. The senior contributed to 21 of the Crimson's 31 made field goals by also dishing out six assists.
- Elena Rodriguez reached double figures in the contest, adding 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting while also grabbing a team-high seven boards.
- Saniyah Glenn-Bello was a strong defensive presence for the Crimson, collecting a career-high four steals against the Big Green.
- Katie Krupa had a solid shooting day, adding eight points by connecting on three of her four field goal attempts. The junior captain also recorded two blocks in the contest.
- Harvard's five turnovers marked its lowest turnover total since December 2, 2017, when the Crimson tallied four miscues in a loss to Temple.
- In opposition, Harvard turned the Big Green over 21 times and totaled 18 points off the miscues. The Crimson surpassed double-digit steals for the 16th time this season and the third straight game.

WEEKLY HONORS

- Following a historic two-game stretch, Harmoni Turner took home her first Ivy League weekly honor of the season on November 18.
- On a national level, Turner took home a slew of individual honors being named one of the USBWA National Players of the Week, an Honorable Mention AP National Player of the Week, the NCAA March Madness Player of the Week, the NCAA March Madness Starting Lineup, and the Mid-Major Madness Player of the Week.
- In week two, Turner averaged 39.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, and 3.0 steals across two Harvard wins. Her nearly 40-point average came as she shot 55.3% from the field and 52.6% from the three-point line.
- After the Crimson's 3-0 record in week three of play, Lydia Chatira received her first career weekly honor. The first-year averaged 6.0 points on 42.9% shooting, 4.0 rebounds, 3.3 assists, and a steal across wins over Northeastern, Northwestern, and Illinois State.
- Turner took home her second weekly honor of the season following her performance in the Crimson's 86-26 victory over Boston University. The senior led all scorers with 20 points on 8-of-15 shooting while also grabbing five boards, dishing out three assists, and tying a season-high with six steals.
- Turner added another weekly honor to her resume following a strong weekend in the team's contests versus Brown and Penn. The senior average 26.0 points on 56.7% shooting, 6.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 2.0 steals across two 29+ point wins for the Crimson. Against Brown, Turner registered her third 30+ point performance of the season, contributing 33 points on 11-of-17 shooting from the field and 6-of-12 from distance.
- Turner recorded her fourth Ivy League weekly honor and second USBWA national weekly honor of the season on February 17 and 18, respectively. Across two wins, the senior averaged 21.5 points on 50.0% shooting (64.3% 3-PT), 5.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 2.5 steals.
- The Crimson star recorded her final weekly honor of the season on March 10 to lead the league with five weekly nods. Turner received the award following her fourth 30+ point performance of the season when she dropped 33 points on 15-of-22 shooting against Dartmouth. She contributed to 21 of 31 made field goals against the Big Green as she dished out six assists.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Following a strong opening week, including the first AP Top 25 victory of the Carrie Moore era, the Crimson received votes for the first time in program history.
- Entering this season, Harvard had never received votes or been ranked inside the AP Top 25.
- Harvard was back in national eye following week three, receiving votes in the AP Top 25 poll for the second time this season and the second time in program history.
- The Crimson received its most votes of the season with 10, following week 10 and its 12-1 start to the season.
- Throughout the season, Harvard was recognized in the AP Top 25 receiving votes category for 14 straight weeks and 15 total times.

NOT SO "MID"-MAJOR

- Throughout the season, the Crimson has climbed the ranks in the College Insider Women's Mid-Major Top 25.
- On December 24, the Crimson moved into first place in the poll for the first time in program history and held the spot for three straight weeks.
- The Crimson remained in the top-two for several weeks, but after falling to Columbia, dipped in the poll.
- More recently, the Crimson checks in at No. 4 in the Mid-Major Top 25. Harvard trails Columbia, which ranks No. 3 and leads Princeton, which rounds out the Ivy League in the Top 25 at No. 8.

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

- Harvard's dominant defense through the first 26 contests ranks fourth in turnover margin (8.5), 13th in three point percentage defense (26.6%), 15th in scoring margin (18.0), 21st in turnovers forced per game (20.8), 25th in steals per game (11.0), and 30th field goal percentage defense (37.0%). As a whole, the Crimson ranks as the top scoring defense in the country, holding opponents to an average of 51.2 points per game.
- Harmoni Turner has had a dominant senior campaign and currently ranks near the top of several statistical categories. On the offensive end, Turner ranks 12th in points per game, averaging 21.6.
- At the defensive end, the senior ranks 15th in steals per game by averaging 2.8 per game and 38th in steals with 74 total.

Within the league, Harvard ranks first in scoring defense (51.6), scoring margin (17.4), opponent field goal percentage (37.3%), opponent three-point percentage (26.6%), turnover margin (8.2), and steals (11.0). Additionally, it ranks second in scoring (69.0), three-point percentage (34.6%), and offensive rebounds (12.9).

- Harmoni Turner earned the Ivy League Player-of-the-Year honor by ranking first in scoring (21.6), points (561), field goals made (204), and steals (2.8), second in three-pointers per game (2.3), third in three-point percentage (34.5%), fourth in assist to turnover ratio (1.6), sixth in assists (3.4), and 11th in rebounds (5.5).
- Gabby Anderson is a constant presence on the defensive end of the ball, ranking third in the league in steals with 1.8 per game and 15th in rebounds with 4.5 per game.
- Elena Rodriguez rounds out the three Crimson players in the top five of steals, contributing 1.7 per game. The senior, who ranks first all-time in field goal percentage in program history, currently ranks third in the Ivy League by shooting 55.7% through the first 26 games. Of players who have attempted more than 200 field goals, Rodriguez's percentage ranks as the best. Rodriguez also ranks 12th in scoring averaging 12.2 points per game.

ALL-TIME LISTS TO WATCH

HARMONI TURNER

- Throughout last season, Harmoni Turner cemented herself into several program top-10 lists and will continue to climb as her career inches toward the finish line.
- With 1,940 career points, Turner ranks third all-time. Against Brown, the senior passed Reka Cserny '04 and she is now 202 points away from passing Hana Peljto '04 and continuing her ascent.
- Turner's average of 18.0 points across her four years in the program ranks as the third best scoring average in program history. Additionally, her average of 21.6 points per game this season would rank third in Harvard women's basketball history.
- The Mansfield, Texas native currently ranks seventh all-time in career assists with 395. Her current career average of 3.7 per game checks in at eighth all-time.
- With six steals against Yale, Harmoni Turner moved into second all-time in program history for steals, passing Reka Cserny '04 (234). Turner now only trails Allison Feaster '98 (290). Her 2.5 steals per game career average checks in at third all-time.
- Having accumulated 726 field goals in 107 contests, Turner ranks second in program history in career field goals made.
- With seven made three-pointers against Boston College, Turner broke into the top-10 of career field goals made, totaling 176 and counting.
- While scoring 41 points against Boston College on November 14, Turner broke the program record for points in a single game. The record of 39 was previously held by Allison Feaster '98 and Hana Peljto '04.

ELENA RODRIGUEZ

- Rodriguez entered her senior season 347 points away from becoming the 24th player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points. Through 26 contests, Rodriguez now sits with 970 career points.
- The senior's career field goal percentage of .558 (387-693) currently ranks as the best ever in Harvard women's basketball history.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

- While exploding for 41 points against Boston College, Harmoni Turner rewrote the 27-year-old record for single-game scoring.
- The previous record of 39 points was first set by all-time great, Allison Feaster '98 and matched by Hana Peljto '04.

NATIONAL NOTICE

- Harmoni Turner has been recognized for several national awards throughout the course of her final season in Cambridge.
- The senior has been recognized in each step of the 2025 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year award process, being named to the preseason and midseason watch list, as a semifinalist and most recently as a finalist.
- Also earning recognition as one of the top mid-major, Turner has been a semifinalist and finalist for the World Exposure Report Mid-Major Player of the Year award.
- The Mansfield, Texas native was named to the 2025 John R. Wooden Award Top 25 Midseason Watch List, which is awarded to the nation's top player each season.
- Additionally, as a part of the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame awards, Turner was named to the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Top Ten Watch List. She was also added the 2025 Jersey Mike's Naismith Women's Player of the Year Midseason Team.
- The senior's lengthy resume is rounded out by being named to the USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Year Midseason Watch List.
- Carrie Moore is also being recognized for her role in leading the Crimson to one of its best seasons in program history. She has recently been named as a finalist for both the World Exposure Report Mid-Major Coach of the Year award and the 2025 Kathy Delaney-Smith Mid-Major Coach of the Year award.

CARRIE’S CRIMSON

- In the first two years with Carrie Moore at the helm of Harvard women’s basketball, the Crimson have registered 36 victories. The win total marks the most in program history through any coaches’ first two years.
- This season, Moore became the fastest coach to 50 wins in program history following a 73-44 victory over Penn.

FOR THE FOES

- The Princeton Tigers are 21-6 on the year and 12-2 in Ivy League play to round out another impressive season.
- The Tigers closed out the regular season last weekend with a 67-53 victory over Penn at The Palestra.
- Despite a strong year, Princeton failed to claim a share of the regular season title for the first time since the 2016-17 season.
- The Tigers have historically dominated the Ivy League Tournament winning each year since its inception outside of the inaugural 2017 tournament.

SO WE MEET AGAIN

- The Crimson have fallen in both match-ups with the Tigers this season.
- On Saturday, January 11, Princeton snapped the Crimson’s 10-game win streak as it connect-ed on a buzzer beater to steal the first contest, 52-50.
- The Tigers then bested the Crimson on its home court, 70-58, in the second meeting.

The Kathy Delaney-Smith Friends of Harvard Women's Basketball Head Coach

Third season at Harvard

58-28 Overall | 29-13 Ivy League

Carrie Moore was named The Kathy Delaney-Smith Head Coach For Harvard Women's Basketball, Erin McDermott, The John D. Nichols '53 Family Director of Athletics, announced on Wednesday, April 6, 2022. Moore, the fourth head coach in program history, arrives in Cambridge from Michigan where she helped the Wolverines to the Elite 8 round of the 2022 NCAA tournament.

In year two under Moore, the Crimson finished 16-12 overall and 9-5 in conference play. Harvard once again earned a spot in the Ivy League Tournament as the three-seed before falling to Columbia on the Lions home court, 63-61. Moore helped lead three players to All-Ivy honors including Harmoni Turner who earned First-Team All-Ivy for the second straight season and Lola Mullaney and Katie Krupa who both received Honorable Mention All-Ivy. Moore's 36 total wins throughout her first two seasons marks the most in program history through any coaches' opening two years.

In her first season at the helm in Cambridge, Moore led the Crimson to historic heights. The team compiled a record of 20-12 overall, a win total that was a program best for a first-year head coach. Following a third-place finish in the Ivy League regular season, the Crimson defeated two-seed Columbia, 72-65, to advance to the Ivy League Tournament Championship game. Despite falling in league play, the Crimson went on to the WNIT where it would go on a historic run to the fourth round, the Great 8. In 2023, Moore coached three players to All-Ivy accolades including Harmoni Turner who earned First-Team All-Ivy, Lola Mullaney (Second-Team All-Ivy), and Elena Rodriguez (Honorable Mention All-Ivy).

In her one season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator in Ann Arbor, Moore guided Michigan to a 25-7 record (13-4 Big Ten) and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA tournament. The Wolverines entered the postseason ranked 12th in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll, marking the program's highest regular-season-ending ranking in school history.

At the individual level, Moore helped Naz Hillmon become Michigan's first player to garner AP All-America First-Team honors, while coaching five All-Big Ten selections in 2021-22.

Prior to returning to her home state of Michigan, Moore spent two seasons at North Carolina, serving as the program's assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. During her time in Chapel Hill, she guided the Tar Heels to the 2021 NCAA tournament and signed a pair of highly regarded recruiting classes. Her 2019 class was considered the 10th-best nationally, while the 2020 group was ranked third as it featured three McDonald's All-Americans.

Along her path to Harvard included two different stints at Ivy League member Princeton. Before heading to UNC, Moore was an assistant coach for the Tigers, coaching Princeton to back-to-back Ivy regular-season and tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19) en route to a pair of NCAA appearances, and a berth in the 2017 WNIT. She also served as the Tigers' director of operations for two seasons (2008-09, 2009-10), with the 2009-10 team capturing the Ivy championship and reaching the NCAA tournament.

In between her stints at Princeton was a five-year run at Creighton. As an assistant from 2010-15, Moore helped the Bluejays reach the postseason each year, including consecutive trips to the NCAA tournament in 2012 and 2013, a feat that had never been accomplished in program history.

Before embarking on a successful coaching career, Moore was a standout player at Western Michigan, where she scored a school-record 2,216 points. As a senior in 2006-07, she was named the Mid-American Conference Player of the Year after leading the nation in scoring at 25.4 points per game, marking the first time a MAC player won the Division I scoring title. In addition to her efforts on the court, which included her setting nine school records and four league records, Moore was a star in the classroom, collecting Academic All-America Second-Team accolades and landing on the nominee list for the Senior CLASS Award. She graduated magna cum laude from WMU in 2007, with a degree in journalism.

Once her time as a Division I player was up, Moore signed WNBA free agent contracts with the Phoenix Mercury and Chicago Sky, and then played professionally for one season in Poland.
