WINNIPEG BECKONS IN WEEK 7

CALGARY – Bye week is in the rear-view mirror, and the stretch drive begins in earnest for the University of Calgary Dinos football team as they head east to Winnipeg.

Saturday's contest against the Manitoba Bisons goes at 2 p.m. CT (1 p.m. MT) at IG Field, with CanadaWest.tv presented by Co-op providing exclusive live streaming coverage.

The Dinos (5-1) and Bisons (3-3) each control their own destiny when it comes to playoff positioning, and there's a significant chance this could be a first-round playoff preview with the Dinos currently in top spot and the Bisons fourth. A win Saturday in Winnipeg would all but clinch a home playoff game for the Dinos – for the 12th consecutive year – while the Bisons need one more win to officially lock up the fourth and final playoff spot in the conference.

The Dinos and Bisons are two of the three highest-scoring teams in Canada West so far this season, averaging 30.2 and 27.3 points per game, respectively. While the Dinos have the top passing attack in CW, the Bisons are one of just two teams that has picked up 1000 yards along the ground through the first six games – with tailbacks Michael Ritchott and Victor St. Pierre-Lavolette roughly splitting the duties.

HEADLINES

- Calgary won 24-10 in the teams' previous meeting this season Sept. 6 in Calgary
- Overall, the Dinos are riding an eight-game win streak over the Bisons, dating back to the 2014 Hardy Cup. Three of those wins have come in Winnipeg, including a 76-17 blowout the last time the two teams met at IG Field back in 2017
- After dropping all the way to No. 8 in the national Top 10 following their lone loss of the season to Saskatchewan, the Dinos have moved back to the No. 4 ranking they have had for most of the year after their win over Alberta and upsets across the country during the Canada West bye last week.
- The Bisons own the tiebreaker with UBC, so Regina is the only team that can catch them for the fourth playoff spot. A Rams loss to Alberta would end their chances and clinch the playoffs for the Bisons regardless of the outcome in Winnipeg Saturday, but a Manitoba loss and a Regina win would set up a big game to end the season next week at Mosiac Stadium.

No. 4 CALGARY DINOS (5-1)

Last week: defeated Alberta 34-16

Next week: host UBC

- The Dinos are slowly getting players back from the sick bay after a rash of injuries left several players sidelined earlier in the season. Receiver Hunter Karl made his return to the lineup against Alberta before the bye, recording seven catches for 86 yards, and with Dallas Boath back for two games now the Calgary receiving corps is leaning back to health at an important time of year.
- Karl enters the final two games of the season 12 catches and less than 200 yards away from the Dinos' all-time lead in both categories. The versatile receiver also took on the Dinos' punting duties last week, averaging 40 yards per boot.
- Josiah Joseph started for the Dinos against Alberta after Adam Sinagra was knocked out of the Saskatchewan game Sept. 27 and performed well, earning conference offensive player-of-the-week honours.

LAST DINOS-BISONS MEETING – September 6, 2019 @ McMahon Stadium

CALGARY – In front of just over six thousand people for KICKOFF XIV, the No. 4 University of Calgary Dinos put on a defensive clinic to take a 24-10 win against the sixth-ranked Manitoba Bisons Friday night at McMahon Stadium.

Not every win is going to be pretty, and this was the definition of a grind-it-out victory for the Dinos. Calgary head coach Wayne Harris knows that his team still has a long way to go in terms of execution, but he is still very pleased with his team's effort through the first two weeks of the season.

"We had some big plays, but we also had some missed opportunities. I am pleased with the fact that we battled for the full game."

While those hoping for a high-scoring offensive affair were sorely disappointed, the Dinos defense was spectacular, giving up just one field goal all night. Calgary confused Bisons quarterback Des Catellier throughout the contest, causing the local Calgary product to throw three interceptions on the evening.

Manitoba's opening drive was arguably their most impressive, however, it would be snuffed out by Week 1 hero Deane Leonard, as he was able to jump in front of the Catellier deep out for his second interception of the season, and the first of Catellier's three.

After missing the opener against Alberta, reigning U SPORTS Rookie of the Year Tyson Philpot would get off to a hot start in his second season. A beautifully designed route combination would allow Sinagra to find Philpot all alone down the sideline for the first touchdown of the game, putting the Dinos ahead 7-2 late in the first quarter.

Calgary's best drive of the game would come early in the second quarter, as a 41-yard Jeshrun Antwi rumble would set the Dinos up deep in Bisons territory. **-UC--UC-**

Dallas Boath would then put himself in early consideration for catch of the year, with a diving snag in the back corner of the end zone. Boath would add his second major of the game just minutes later, and give the Dinos a comfortable 24-7 lead heading into halftime.

While the first half had some offensive excitement, the second half was all defence with just three points scored. Calgary gave up a third safety of the night, and Manitoba added a single point off a missed field goal, leading to the final score of 24-10.

Boath, who celebrated his 23rd birthday with two touchdowns, knows that these tight games to start the season will only end up helping his team in the end.

"We faced some adversity early on here, that we haven't faced in awhile, and now we just have to keep moving forward, and get some more wins hopefully," said the fifth-year receiver.

Catellier finished 23-for-46 for 271 yards and three interceptions on the night, and was also the Bisons' leading rusher with 65 yards. His top target was Trysten Dyce, who hauled in eight catches for 114 yards.

Adam Sinagra completed 18 of 29 passes for 207 yards and three touchdowns on the night, with Tyson Philpot accounting for 71 of those yards. Jeshrun Antwi's 76 yards paced the Dinos run game. Defensively, Charlie Moore and Stefan Conway led the Dinos and Bisons, respectively, with identical stat lines: six tackles, one tackle for loss.

Calgary will head out west next weekend to take on the UBC Thunderbirds on Saturday night, while Manitoba will be back in wild rose country to take on the Alberta Golden Bears next Friday night.

For more than 40 years, Wayne Harris has been involved with the Dinos as a player, alumnus, assistant coach, and most recently defensive coordinator – and he was named the sixth head coach in Dinos Football history on February 12, 2015.

In his first season with the Dinos, Harris captured CIS coach-of-the-year honours after leading the program to an undefeated season and the No. 1 national ranking for eight consecutive weeks.

The son of Calgary Stampeders legend Wayne Harris, Sr., Harris starred as a two-sport athlete for the Dinos from 1977-81 in both football and wrestling. He was a three-time Canada West all-star at linebacker and added a conference wrestling title in 1980. He spent four seasons in the Canadian Football League with the Stampeders, B.C. Lions, and Toronto Argonauts before retiring in 1984, when he joined the Calgary Board of Education.

Over the course of his coaching career with the Dinos, Harris has been part of seven Hardy Cup championship teams and participated in four Vanier Cups, including the 1995 championship season under former head coach Peter Connellan. In 2006, Harris received the Gino Fracas Award recognizing the top volunteer coach in CIS football, and in 2014 he received the Distinguished Alumni Award from the Dinos Fifth Quarter Association in recognition of nearly four decades of involvement with the program.

He was involved as an assistant coach with the Dinos in three separate stints between 1989 and 2014 and was defensive coordinator from 2011-14. Harris was head coach of the Calgary Colts from 1991-93, and he also spent 25 years as a coach in Calgary high school football at Sir Winston Churchill, Henry Wise Wood, and William Aberhart. His son, James, played as a linebacker for the Dinos in the mid-2000s.

- After winning two straight against Regina and UBC, the Bisons faltered in Saskatoon their last time out as the Huskies avenged their season-opening loss to the Herd with a 49-21 victory of their own.
- The Huskies had success limiting the Manitoba ground game to just 159 yards, 67 of which came from starting QB Des Catellier. A Calgary native, Catellier threw for 271 yards in the defeat, and he sits third in CW with 240 yards per game through the air.
- The Bisons are strong up front defensively, with Derek Dufault leading the conference with six sacks on the season. Manitoba has also allowed fewer passing yards than any other team this season, with just 232.2 yards per game against through the first six contests.
