- ▶ Duke looks to pick up ACC win No. 2 and win No. 10 overall this Saturday at Notre Dame.
- ▶ The Blue Devils are 9-2 and ranked fifth after outlasting the Tar Heels last Friday.
- ▶ Notre Dame is 5-3 overall and 1-1 in the ACC. The Fighting Irish are coming off a 10-6 loss to Syracuse.

THE SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ Duke and Notre Dame are meeting for the 22nd time overall with the Blue Devils holding a 13-8 lead. The two teams have met 15 times since 2010 and Duke is 8-7 in that span.
- ▶ This is the 13th top 10 matchup since 2010 between these teams and both squads have six wins apiece in that span.

LOOKING AT DUKE

► Fifth-ranked Duke hits the road after a thrilling 11-10 win over rival North Carolina. The Blue Devils are 9-2 and looking for win No. 10 for the 12th straight season and for the 23rd time in program history.

► Senior attackman Justin Guterding, who recently joined the 300-point club, headlines one of the nation's top offenses with 37 goals and 29 assists for 66 points. Rookie Joe Robertson complements him on attack with 32 points. In the midfield, junior Brad Smith has 37 points and graduate student Peter Conley has chipped in 27.

► Defensively, Duke has been outstanding in holding opponents to just 8.09 goals and only 28.9 shots per game. The Blue Devils have held opponents without a goal for 15-plus minutes 14 times this season. Cade Van Raaphorst and JT Giles-Harris anchor the close defense with 13 and 15 caused turnovers, respectively. In goal, Danny Fowler sports a 8.28 goals against average and a .553 save percentage.

► Joe Stein is the main draw man, sporting a .581 win percentage (75-of-129). Brian Smyth also has taken over 100 draws and is 53-of-126 (.421). They have 32 and 23 ground balls, respectively.

LAST TIME WE MET

► Notre Dame scored a pair of goals in 24 seconds in the fourth quarter to hold off a last-minute charge from Duke in the ACC semifinals in Durham last April. The Blue Devils failed to score in the first half as the Fighting Irish built a 3-0 lead at the break.

► Duke tied the game 5-5 midway through the fourth quarter, but could never get over the hump for the lead. Justin Guterding led all scorers with four points, while Ryder Garnsey had three for Notre Dame. Danny Fowler made seven saves for Duke.

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME

► Notre Dame returns home with a 5-3 record after losing to Syracuse 10-6 in the Carrier Dome. The Irish are ranked 10th and are 1-1 in league action.

► Ryder Garnsey is the top scorer for an offense averaging 9.75 goals per game with 20 points. Bryan Costabile and Brendan Gleason have 19 points apiece.

► Defensively, Notre Dame is allowing 9.12 goals per game and have allowed 10-plus goals in all three setbacks. John Sexton anchors the defense with 10 caused turnovers and 33 ground balls. Matt Schmidt mans the crease with a 8.79 goals against average and a .475 save percentage.

► At the faceoff X, John Travisano sports a .585 win percentage (86-of-147) record and has picked up 32 ground balls.

► Notre Dame has struggled on extra man, scoring on just 24 percent of its chances, ranking 61st of 71 teams nationally.

DUKE IN TOP 10 MATCHUPS

► The Blue Devils will be playing in their 82nd top 10 game since 2007 Saturday. Duke is 49-32 overall in top 10 matchups under head coach John Danowski.

► This will be the 19th top-10 matchup for the Duke seniors. They are 9-9 overall and 3-1 when ranked higher.

► Saturday's game will be the 13th time since 2010 Duke and Notre Dame will face off as USILA top 10 foes. Duke is 6-6 in those games and 4-4 when ranked higher overall.

FORCING THE ISSUE ON DEFENSE

► Duke's defense has been stifling this season, allowing just 8.09 goals per game to lead the ACC and rank sixth nationally. The Blue Devils are forcing the issue and lead the conference and rank eighth in Division I in caused turnovers per game with an 8.82 average.

► Last season, in which Duke posted one of its best defensive campaigns, the Blue Devils were fourth in the ACC and 46th among Division I teams with only 6.17 caused turnovers per game.

SPECIAL TEAMS REMAIN SPECIAL

► The Blue Devils' man-down defense and man-up offense have been crucial to Duke's success this season. Duke leads the ACC in both categories and is 10th and third nationally, respectively.

► The Blue Devils are scoring on 60 percent of their extra-man opportunities and killing off 77 percent of their man-down situations. They are one of seven programs to have percentages above .500 in both.

DUKE IN THE MONTH OF APRIL

► Duke is 183-178 (.507) all-time in the month of April. Since 2007, Duke is 43-12 (.782) and was 4-1 last season. The Blue Devils won 18 straight games in April from 2007-2010, ultimately losing in the ACC Semifinals in 2010. Duke last went undefeated in April in 2009, winning the ACC title.

► Guterding averaged 2.56 assists per game in 2017, more than a one assist per game improvement of his 1.4 in 2016. He continues to trend slightly upward in 2018, averaging 2.64 assists per game.

► His 46 total in 2017 ranked sixth in Duke single-season history. Only Jordan Wolf, Matt Danowski and Ned Crotty have more assists in a season than Guterding.

► Guterding has 121 career helpers to rank third on the career charts. Danowski and Crotty sit atop the list with 183 and 147, respectively.

70, 71, 72 AND COUNTING FOR GUTERDING

► With four points at Marquette in 2017 Justin Guterding became the first Blue Devil to record at least 70 points in each of his first three seasons, going for 70, 71 and 97 in his respective seasons. He also is the fastest Blue Devil to 100 career points and is tied for the fastest player to 200 points. He needs four points to reach 70 this season.

► Guterding registered 97 points in 2017 to become the fourth different Blue Devil in program history to score 90 points in a season. His total is tied with current assistant coach Matt Danowski for second on the Duke single-season list.

► Only Jordan Wolf has scored 100 points in a season for Duke and just 15 different Division I players have reached the century mark in NCAA history 17 times - Lyle Thompson of Albany did so three times.

► Guterding is one of four Blue Devils to rank in the top 10 in school history in career points (304), goals (183) and assists (121).

Cemented as one of the top coaches in college lacrosse, John Danowski has led the Duke men's lacrosse team to unprecedented success and himself to the top over the Division I men's lacrosse wins list. Danowski was introduced as Duke's eighth head men's lacrosse coach on July 21, 2006 and quickly led the Blue Devils to some of the most successful lacrosse seasons in school history, to three NCAA Championships in five seasons.

In Danowski's 11 years at the helm of the Blue Devils lacrosse program, he has compiled an impressive 173-53 record in leading Duke to seven ACC regular season titles and four ACC tournament titles, eight straight appearances in the national semifinals from 2007-14, four in the NCAA title match and ultimately to the 2010, 2013 and 2014 national titles. The 2014 NCAA crown put Danowski, a winner of 391 career games, among a small group of nine coaches to win three national titles and among eight to capture consecutive crowns. Meanwhile, Duke's run of eight straight NCAA semifinals rank as the second most of any program since 2000 with Syracuse. Most recently, Danowski passed Dom Starsia as the winningest Division I lacrosse history, garnering his 376th win with a 13-6 victory over Jacksonville.

A winner of nearly 80 percent of his games at Duke, the individual awards Blue Devil players have garnered is equally impressive. In 11 seasons, Danowski mentored 64 All-America selections, 36 All-ACC choices, two Tewaaraton Trophy winners, a pair of USILA Attackman of the Year honorees, a USILA Defenseman of the Year, three USILA Midfielder of the Year award recipients and 21 USILA Scholar All-America picks.

While the success on the field is unsurpassed in Duke lacrosse history, the student-athletes excellence in the classroom also is unrivaled. The Blue Devils consistently lead the ACC in All-ACC Academic picks as well as players on the ACC Academic Honor Roll.
