The game will be carried live on ESPN+ with Alex Mikos (PXP) and Christine Szabo (Color) calling the action. It will also be carried live on the Blue Devil Sports Network via WDNC AM 620, the Varsity Network app and www.GoDuke.com with Chris Edwards (PXP) on the air beginning at 6:45 p.m. (ET).

What is Next?...

Duke will return home to host UNC Wilmington on Sunday, Nov. 14 at 2 p.m., in Cameron Indoor Stadium.

A Look at Dayton...

In the season opener, Dayton totaled a 73-52 victory over Alabama A&M on Tuesday. Dayton won its sixth regular season title last season and went 14-5 overall, 12-1 in Atlantic 10 play. The Flyers were undefeated on the road, going 8-0, and 5-3 at UD Arena.

Head coach Shauna Green is in her sixth season in charge of the Flyers and was named Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year 2020, her second time at UD. She earned her 100th win at Dayton in the regular season

Dayton is led by graduate students Erin Whalen and Jenna Giacone. Whalen led the team last season with 13.6 points per game, while Giacone was second with 12.4 points per game. Both players were picked A-10 preseason Second Team and First Team respectively.

The Series with Dayton...

Duke and Dayton will face off for the second time in program history, with the Flyers leading the series, 1-0.

In the last meeting, Dayton won 99-78 on Jan. 3, 1981 in Dayton, Ohio.

Duke Versus the Atlantic 10 Conference...

Duke owns a 27-6 record against opponents in the Atlantic 10 Conference -- Davidson (4-1), Dayton (0-1), Duquesne (1-0), George Mason (4-0), La Salle (0-1), Massachusetts (1-0), Rhode Island (1-0), Richmond (6-1), Saint Joseph's (4-1), Virginia Commonwealth (6-1). The Blue Devil's have won 12 consecutive contests against the Atlantic 10 Conference.

Storylines/Other Blue Devil Notes...

- Duke senior **Elizabeth Balogun** has faced Dayton one time in her career, which came on Dec. 21, 2018 as Georgia Tech played against Dayton in the West Palm Invitational. Balogun collected 13 points, seven rebounds and two blocks in 33 minutes.

- Duke scored 95 points in the season opener against Winthrop, which is the most points by a Blue Devil squad under the direction of head coach **Kara Lawson**.

- The Blue Devils will play in the state of Ohio for only the fifth time in school history and the first time since 2012. Duke has collected a 2-3 ledger in those contests -- Cincinnati (L, 64-86 on Jan. 2, 1981), Dayton (L, 78-99 on Jan. 3, 1981), Xavier (W, 74-46 on Jan. 5, 1981), Toledo (L, 65-71 on Nov. 18, 2001) and Xavier (W, 82-59 on Nov. 25, 2012).

- Duke's nine 3-pointers made against Winthrop in the season opener is the most by a Blue Devil team in an opener since Duke hit 12 against East Carolina on Nov. 22, 2002. **Lexi Gordon's** five treys matched Rebecca Greenwell for the most in a season opener by a Duke student-athlete. Greenwell had five 3-pointers in the 2017-18 opener at Grand Canyon.

- The Blue Devils will play five of their first seven contests at home in Cameron Indoor Stadium in 2021-22.

- In the class rankings from wbbasketballblog.com, **Imani Lewis** was No. 32 for the seniors and **Celeste Taylor** was No. 27 for the junior class.

- Four Blue Devils will return to their home state of Texas on Nov. 21 for the Alabama contest in the Maggie Dixon Classic, which will be played in Fort Worth, Texas at TCU. **Jordyn Oliver** (Prosper, Texas), **Jade Williams** (The Colony, Texas), **Nyah Green** (Allen, Texas) and **Lexi Gordon** (Fort Worth, Texas) are all from the Longhorn State.

- **Elizabeth Balogun** steps on the court in 2021-22 with Duke marking the third different ACC squad she has played for. She will be the first women's basketball player in ACC history to play for three different teams

- **Imani Lewis'** 30 career double-doubles currently ranks tied for 23rd nationally in the NCAA for active career leaders.

- Blue Devil senior **Elizabeth Balogun** represented her home country of Nigeria in the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo. She appeared in all three contests for the Nigerians and played with former Duke standout **Oderah Chidom** with Nigeria.

- Duke features three graduate students in 2021-22 that are all attending the Duke Fuqua School of Business -- **Amaya Finklea-Guity**, **Jade Williams** and **Lexi Gordon**.

- **Kara Lawson's** playing career has her in elite company as she is one of only three NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches to play in a NCAA Final Four, win an Olympic Gold Medal and win a WNBA Championship (Lindsay Whalen of Minnesota and Cynthia Cooper-Dyke of Texas Southern).

- Junior transfer **Jordyn Oliver** will miss the 2021-22 season, after suffering an achilles injury over the summer.

On the Road...

The Blue Devils have collected a 29-20 record all-time in road openers, including wins in 13 of the last 14 contests.

A win against Dayton would be the first time Duke has won a road opener since 2017-18, when the Blue Devils won at Grand Canyon 74-61.

Duke has not dropped three straight road openers since 1996-98 (counting only true road games) -- 1996:

lost at Virginia; 1997: lost at Clemson and 1998: lost at Notre Dame.

Dating back to the 2000-01 campaign, Duke owns a 110-18 record in the month of November, including six straight wins.

Duke Opens with Win Over Winthrop...

Duke opened the 2021-22 campaign in strong fashion, posting a 95-39 victory over the Winthrop Eagles Tuesday evening at Cameron Indoor Stadium.

The Blue Devils finished the game with five players in double figures, led by graduate transfer **Lexi Gordon's** 17 points and senior **Imani Lewis' 16** second half points in their Duke debuts. Junior **Celeste Taylor** and sophomore **Nyah Green** each added 11 points, with **Miela Goodchild** chipping in 10. **Vanessa de Jesus** tallied a team-high eight assists, while Taylor led the way on the boards with eight.

After a slow start to the game, Duke found its footing and flipped the switch. Leading by three at the first media timeout, the Blue Devils went on a 35-10 run to take a 44-16 lead into the locker room at the break. Duke hit 42.1 percent from the floor, including a 60-percent clip through the second quarter. The stingy Duke defense forced 14 turnovers through the first 20 minutes and held Winthrop to just 22-percent shooting.

Gordon knocked down four triples and paced the Blue Devils with 14 first half points. Green added six points off the bench, while Taylor and de Jesus chipped in five points apiece, the latter adding five assists and six boards as well. In all, Duke featured eight first half scorers in the first stanza, as **Jade Williams, Elizabeth Balogun** and Goodchild tallied four points as well.

Duke maintained the offensive efficiency out of the break and got most of its point production from the paint. The Blue Devils scored 16 of their 24 third quarter points from the inside, nearly matching their first half total of 18. Taylor tallied six points and pulled down four boards in the period and Lewis added six points of her own to go with two offensive rebounds in five minutes on the floor. At the end of three, the Blue Devils held a 40-point lead, 68-28.

Lewis continued to fill the stat sheet in the fourth, as the senior forward added 10 more points to her total making her the third Blue Devil to reach double figures. Duke would put the finishing touches on the game, coasting to a 95-39 win.

A total of 12 Duke student-athletes scored on the evening and five notched blocked shots. Overall, the Blue Devils produced 42 points off 32 Winthrop turnovers, tallied 46 points in the paint and outscored the Eagles 47-10 off the bench.

Lawson in Second Season with Blue Devils...

After a decorated playing career, time as a college basketball analyst and a stint as an assistant coach with the Boston Celtics, **Kara Lawson** is in her second season as Duke's head coach.

Last year, Lawson and the Blue Devils totaled a 3-1 record before COVID-19 shut down the season in late December.

Just a few highlights of Lawson's career -- Celtics first female coach in the franchise's 73-year history, named one of the 100 most influential people in women's

college basketball as announced by Silver Waves Media in the summer of 2020, on January 12, 2007, she became the first female analyst for a nationally-televised NBA game, helped USA Basketball 3x3 teams to six gold medals since 2017, played 13 WNBA seasons and helped lead the Sacramento Monarchs to the 2005 WNBA title, WNBA All-Star in 2007, four-time All-SEC selection and two-time All-America choice at Tennessee, 2008 USA Basketball gold medal winning squad in Beijing, China and leading the 2020 USA Basketball 3x3 squad to a Gold Medal in its inaugural Olympics in Tokyo. The list could go on and on...

New Look for the Blue Devils in 2021-22...

Head coach **Kara Lawson** and her staff brought in seven transfers ahead of the 2021-22 campaign with the addition of **Elizabeth Balogun** (Louisville), **Lexi Gordon** (Texas Tech), **Amaya Finklea-Guity** (Syracuse), **Imani Lewis** (Wisconsin), **Jordyn Oliver** (Baylor), **Celeste Taylor** (Texas) and **Nyah Green** (Louisville). All seven student-athletes were top-41 recruits, including No. 6 (Taylor), No. 9 (Balogun), No. 11 (Gordon), and No. 12 (Oliver & Green), respectively.

The group of transfers have combined to play in 477 career games with 352 starts and totaled 10,714 minutes played. They have scored 4,223 points, grabbed 2,273 rebounds, dished 519 assists, and blocked 331 shots. The trio of Gordon (15.7), Lewis (15.0), and Taylor (12.3) are coming off averaging double-digit points per game with their respective teams last year.

To go along with the transfers, Lawson added two incoming freshmen -- **Lee Volker** (Purcellville, Va. - St. Paul VI Catholic) and **Shayeann Day-Wilson** (Toronto, Ont., Canada - Crestwood Prep). The Blue Devils return five student-athletes from the 2020-21 campaign -- **Onome Akinbode-James, Vanessa de Jesus, Miela Goodchild, Jiselle Havas** and **Jade Williams**. They combined to score 61.4 percent of Duke's points last year.

2021-22 Roster Features Impressive Resumes...

With the addition of the transfers to the returning student-athletes from the 2020-21 campaign, Duke's 2021-22 roster features players with a wealth of honors and accolades.

• Five players were McDonald's All-Americans in high school (**Jade Williams, Elizabeth Balogun, Nyah Green, Jordyn Oliver** and **Celeste Taylor**).

• Six student-athletes were Jordan Brand All-Americans as prep players (**Lexi Gordon, Jade Williams, Elizabeth Balogun, Nyah Green, Jordyn Oliver** and **Celeste Taylor**).

• Seven players represented their respective countries' as members of junior and senior national teams in FIBA tournaments: **Celeste Taylor, Jordyn Oliver** and **Jade Williams** (USA Basketball); **Elizabeth Balogun** and **Onome Akinbode-James** (Nigeria); **Miela Goodchild** (Australia) and **Shayeann Day-Wilson** (Canada).

Duke junior **Celeste Taylor** was one of five selections on the ACC Newcomer Watch List as voted by the league head coaches.

A native of Valley Stream, N.Y., Taylor is coming off starting 52-of-58 contests over the last two seasons at Texas. She helped lead the Longhorns to an appearance in the NCAA Elite Eight a year ago. As a sophomore, Taylor averaged 12.3 points, 4.9 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 2.1 steals as she earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention accolades. She ranked second in the Big 12 in steals and 21st in scoring. She collected 20 or more points on four different occasions and scored double-digits in 20 contests. The trio boasts a combined 49 years of collegiate coaching experience including one NCAA Championship, 17 NCAA Tournament selections and six NCAA Final Four appearances.

Former Duke National Player of the Year and WNBA Champion **Alana Beard** has partnered with the African American Sports and Entertainment Group (AASEG) in pursuit of bringing a WNBA franchise to Oakland, Calif.

A 15-year veteran of the WNBA and 4-time WNBA All-Star, Beard will lead the Oakland WNBA ownership process. Attorney Jade Smith-Williams, a local Oakland women's basketball legend and former professional player, will advise the group on its ownership pursuit.

Beard, a back-to-back WNBA Defensive Player of the Year selection, along with Smith-Williams will be working closely with Oakland natives, Shonda Scott and Samantha Wise, and members of the AASEG. Beard and the AASEG are also in discussions with several other prominent African American women to join the process soon.

The AASEG is positioned to not only bring a WNBA team to Oakland, but also to bring resources to girls and women throughout the Bay Area.

Beard, a 2004 Duke graduate, was the first Blue Devil women's basketball standout to have her jersey retired. She is Duke's all-time leading scorer with 2,687 points, a 2003 and 2004 National Player of the Year, a three-time ACC Player of the Year, three-time Kodak All-American and three-time Associated Press All-American. She led the Blue Devils to the 2002 and 2003 NCAA Final Four and helped win four straight ACC titles.

Gray Added to ACC Network Studio Crew...

Four-time WNBA All-Star, Olympic gold medalist and former Duke women's basketball standout **Chelsea Gray** has signed a deal to join ACC Network (ACCN) as a college basketball studio analyst. Gray will appear weekly as part of ACCN's "Ladies Night" coverage. Gray will make her network debut on Tuesday, Nov. 2 as part of the Nothing But Net: Women's Season Preview special.

Gray, the 11th pick in the 2014 WNBA Draft by Connecticut, played one season with the Sun before five with Los Angeles where she helped the Sparks to the 2016 WNBA title. Gray signed with the Las Vegas Aces prior to the 2021 season as an unrestricted free agent. She started in all 32 games and averaged 11.2 points and 5.9 assists per games last season while helping to lead the Aces to the WNBA Playoffs Semifinals. Gray was named to the WNBA All-Star Team in 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021, earned first team All-WNBA honors in 2019 and second team honors in 2017. She owns career averages of 11.6 points, 4.5 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game.

At Duke, Gray was a highly decorated player whose college career was cut short due to injury. Prior to injury, Gray earned All-America honors her sophomore and junior seasons, and was named the ACC Co-Player of the Year for the 2012-13 season. She helped guide Duke to three ACC regular season titles (2011, 2012, 2013) and two ACC Tournament Championships (2011 and 2013). Gray finished her career as a Blue Devil ranked second on Duke's all-time career assists list and third on its all-time steals list.
