### LEADING OFF

Duke hits the road for a three-game ACC series at Jim Patterson Stadium in Louisville. Duke and Louisville meet for just the 11th time in the two programs' histories with the first meeting coming in 2015. Louisville leads the series with a 8-2 record, including a 2-1 record at home. Duke is looking to bounce back after a six-game skid in the series. Most recently, Louisville swept a series in Durham in 2019. Head coach **Chris Pollard** holds a 2-8 record against the Cardinals, with all meetings coming while at Duke. All three games will be broadcast on ACC Network Extra with the first pitch scheduled for 6 p.m. on Friday and 1 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Chris Edwards will also broadcast the contest via radio on TuneIn or GoDuke.com.

### BY THE NUMBERS

**1** Duke junior **Jack Carey** and sophomore **Marcus Johnson** combined to pitch nine innings of one-hit baseball on Sunday, March 21 at Notre Dame.

**4** Duke's four home runs at North Carolina April 12 and vs. Wake Forest April 18 were the most in a single game this season. It was the first time the Blue Devils have recorded four or more home runs in a game since May 2019 at Georgia Tech.

**6** Graduate student third baseman **Erikson Nichols** recorded a career-high six RBIs in his season debut against Coastal Carolina. Nichols blasted a three-run homer on the first pitch he saw this season. His six RBIs in a single game were the most since former Blue Devil **Kennie Taylor** did so against against Penn State in 2019.

**7** Graduate student **Chase Cheek**, redshirt senior **Chris Dutra** and senior **Joey Loperfido** will serve as captains for the 2021 season. In addition, senior **Chris Crabtree**, junior **Rudy Maxwell**, sophomore **Marcus Johnson** and freshman **Luke Fox** will join the trio to make up the team's leadership council.

**18** Duke has recorded 18 strikeouts in two games this season, the most in a single game under head coach **Chris Pollard**.

**44** Duke's 44 home runs this season, including 24 in the last 10 games and 12 in the previous four games, rank eighth all-time in program history for a single season. In addition, the 44 home runs are the second-most in a single season under head coach **Chris Pollard**.

**78** The Blue Devils rank second in the ACC in doubles per game (2.11). Senior **Michael Rothenberg** ties for ninth in the ACC this season with 11. Senior **Joey Loperfido** and junior **Ethan Murray** boast 10 each.

**100+** Senior **Chris Crabtree** recorded his 100th career hit against Virginia on April 25. Crabtree is one of eight Blue Devils on the current roster to boast triple-digit career hits.

**104** Duke head coach **Chris Pollard** currently holds 105 career wins in ACC play. He is the first Duke head coach to reach 100 career wins in conference action.

**SERIES HISTORY**

Duke and Louisville meet for the 11th time in the two programs' histories, dating back to 2015. Louisville leads the all-time series, 8-2, including a 2-1 mark in Louisville. Most recently, Louisville and Duke met in a top-25 ACC series in March of 2019, with the Cardinals taking all three games at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park. Duke is seeking its first win over Louisville since April of 2017, when it won the first game of a three game series in Louisville. Head coach **Chris Pollard** is 2-8 against Louisville all-time, with all meetings coming during his tenure at Duke.

**SCOUTING THE CARDINALS**

One of the most dangerous teams in the ACC, the Cardinals have been a mainstay in the Top-15 rankings across all publications. Louisville is coming off a bounceback win over Vanderbilt after being swept at Clemson, for just its second ACC series loss so far this season. Louisville is among conference leaders in nearly every offensive category, ranking in the Top-5 in batting average, runs scored, hits, triples, RBIs and stolen bases. Individually, Louisville is led by Henry Davis at the plate, batting .403 to lead the ACC. Davis also leads the team in runs (38), hits (56) and walks (29). On the bump, Michael Kirian leads the team with 50.1 innings pitched and 58 punchouts.

**FAMILIAR FACE, NEW NAME**

This season, senior **Joey Loperfido** will go by "Mario", his given first name, in the ballpark over the public address and on the scoreboard. Although he has never gone by Mario before, it is his first name. Loperfido made the decision to go by Mario to honor his late grandfather who passed away last spring.

**DUKE RENEWS K'S 4 KIDS' CANCER INITIATIVE**

Duke baseball announced the renewal of the K's 4 Kids' Cancer campaign, which is now in its third season with the team. ### DETAILS

On October 2, 2015, Duke renewed its agreement with the Durham Bulls to play home games at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park (DBAP), home of the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays. Beginning in 2016, the contract renewal is a seven-year agreement that allows Duke to play up to 36 exhibition and home games at the DBAP each year. The agreement also called for a limited number of Duke practices at the DBAP as well as a new permanent Duke locker room and clubhouse at the facility. Duke and the Durham Bulls began their partnership prior to the Blue Devils' 2010 season. The 2021 campaign marks the 13th consecutive season in which Duke will play home games at the DBAP. Under the new agreement, the Blue Devils will play the vast majority of their home schedule at the minor league venue.

## TRIPLING INTO THE RECORD BOOK

Junior **Ethan Murray** tripled twice in the fourth inning against Campbell on April 13. Murray's pair of triples in a single inning was just the ninth time that has happened in Division I NCAA history, and the first time since 2008.

## UTILIZING THE LONG BALL

The Duke offense has erupted over the past 10 games, hitting 24 home runs in the span. In the last 10 games, the Blue Devils have scored 75 runs, with 40 of those runs coming from home runs. Graduate student Peter Matt and junior RJ Schreck have led the way, hitting six and five home runs, respectively, over the past 10 games. Duke's 44 home runs on the season rank eighth all-time in a single season in Duke history and are the second most in a single season under head coach **Chris Pollard**.

## JOHNSON, FOX STELLAR IN APRIL

Sophomore **Marcus Johnson** and freshman **Luke Fox** were stellar on the bump for the Blue Devils in the month of April. Johnson (1.15) and Fox (1.20) ranked first and second in the ACC in ERA for the month, both holding opposing batters to a sub-.200 batting average. The duo combined to allow just four earned runs on 16 hits and five walks while striking out 41 batters in 30.2 innings of work in the month of April.

## ROTHENBERG APPROACHING RECORD BOOKS

Senior **Michael Rothenberg** is currently tied for 14th in program history in home runs with 21. He is also nearing the top-25 charts in school history in walks and RBIs. The Boca Raton, Fla., native has 80 career walks, nearing Luis Duarte's 86 from 1992-95 that ranks 25th. His 111 career RBIs are approaching JD Alleva (1998-01) and Jeff Piscorik (1992-95) who tie for 25th in school history with 122.

## GET BACK, JACK

Senior **Michael Rothenberg** is tied for the lead the ACC in runners picked off, as he has nabbed three runners this season. In addition, he has caught 10 runners stealing bases, ranking sixth in the ACC.

## JOHNSON CLOSING FOR DUKE

Sophomore **Marcus Johnson** has emerged as Duke's go-to closer during the 2021 season. The Fontana, Calif., native has shown excellent control and pounded the strike zone, totaling 38 strikeouts to just six walks in 36 innings pitched for a team-leading strikeout-to-walk ratio of 6.33. In his last five outings, Johnson has picked up two wins while allowing just four hits and two walks while fanning 17 batters in 11 scoreless innings pitched. In addition, he has held batters to a .111 batting average.

## STRIKING THEM OUT IN BUNCHES

Duke has recorded 18 strikeouts in two games this year to set the record for most strikeouts in a single game under head coach **Chris Pollard**. The Blue Devils first accomplished the feat on March 6 as sophomore **Henry Williams** recorded 11 while sophomore **Jimmy Loper** added seven more to lead the Blue Devils to a 8-1 win over Pittsburgh. Duke also struck out 18 in a predetermined staff day against NC Central on April 6. Freshman **Luke Fox** led the way with a career-high six strikeouts in two innings of work.

## 'WEARING' IT PROUD

Seniors **Joey Loperfido** and **Michael Rothenberg** have a knack for getting hit by pitches throughout their careers. The roommates both hold a spot in the all-time career records at Duke in the category as Rothenberg is tied for seventh all-time (32) and Loperfido (27) ranks tied for 14th.

## CIRCLING THE PILLOWS IN STYLE AT VIRGINIA

Duke hit eight home runs in the three-game series at Virginia, the most in a single three-game series under head coach **Chris Pollard**. In addition, senior **Michael Rothenberg** hit long balls in back-to-back at bats during Friday's game to become the first Blue Devil to do so in a single game since Kennie Taylor accomplished the task at Georgia Tech on May 17, 2018. Just two games after Rothenberg accomplished the feat, teammate graduate student **Peter Matt** also hit home runs in back-to-back at bats on Sunday at Virginia.

## DOCKMAN LIGHTS OUT IN FIVE-GAME SPAN

Senior **Matt Dockman** has been a bright spot out of the Duke bullpen, and strung together five consecutive scoreless appearances in relief from March 26- April 11. During that stretch, the Hilliard, Ohio, native allowed no runs on just four hits and three walks while striking out 14 in 11 innings of work. Over those five games, opponents have hit a .105 batting average against him.

## MATT, LOPERFIDO RECORD CAREER HIT NO. 150

Senior **Joey Loperfido** registered his 150th career hit with a double against NC Central on April 6. Graduate **Peter Matt** recorded his 150th career hit at Notre Dame on March 19. His 180 career hits current rank in the top 120 career leaders while Loperfido's 167 hits rank in the top 180 in the category in Division I. Prior to Duke, Matt played four seasons at Penn.

## GRAND SLAMMIN

Senior **Joey Loperfido** recorded the first grand slam of his career at Miami on April 3, 2021 and Duke's first since classmate **Michael Rothenberg**'s grand slam last season against Campbell (March 4, 2020). Loperfido finished the game with five RBIs, matching his career high previously set against Bucknell in 2018.

## SCHRECK WITH A HOT START

Junior **RJ Schreck** started the season hot, batting .434 with 23 hits and 18 RBIs through Duke's opening 15 games. His .400+ batting average through the opening 15 games is the highest during head coach **Chris Pollard**'s tenure. Coming into the season, Schreck had a career batting average of .172 (15-for-87). Currently, he leads the team with six home runs this season, the first of his career. Schreck ranks second on the team with 10 multi-hit games and ties to lead the team with five multi-RBIs games. In addition, Schreck totals 22 RBIs, including eight from the Boston College series.

## CAREY, JOHNSON COMBINE FOR GEM AT NOTRE DAME

Junior **Jack Carey** and sophomore **Marcus Johnson** combined for a pitching gem in a shutout win at No. 17 Notre Dame on March 21. Carey made his fifth start of the season, allowing just one hit and one walk in 6.0 innings of work. Johnson worked a perfect three-inning save, retiring all nine batters faced. Duke gave up just one hit for the first time of the season and the first time since a win against Florida State in the final series of 2020.

## CONFERENCE WIN NO. 100

Duke head coach **Chris Pollard** recorded his 100th win in ACC play with Duke's win over Notre Dame on March 21. Pollard became the first Duke baseball coach to reach the 100 ACC win mark in school history. In addition, he is one of six active coaches in the conference to hold 100 victories.

## DOUBLE-DIGIT HITS

Duke recorded 50 hits, including 10-plus hits in each game, in the series against Boston College and the midweek matchup with Davidson on March 2. It was the first time the Blue Devils have tallied 10-plus hits in four consecutive games since April 2019.

## ROTHENBERG NAMED TO BUSTER POSEY AWARD WATCH LIST

Senior **Michael Rothenberg**, out of Boca Raton, Fla., earned recognition on the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award Watch List for the second consecutive season. In the shortened 2020 season, Rothenberg batted .349 with an ACC-leading .551 on-base percentage. He also topped the team with 17 RBIs, 15 walks and eight HBP.

## NICHOLS LEADS TO OPEN CONFERENCE PLAY

Graduate student **Erikson Nichols** led the Blue Devils offensively in the series against Boston College to open league action. Nichols went 6-for-9 over that weekend for a batting average of .667, ranking second in the ACC after opening weekend. His on base percentage of .700 also ranked second in conference play.

## TRANSFERS PLAY KEY ROLE

In Duke's season-opening series win over Coastal Carolina the Blue Devils found success from new names in addition to familiar faces. The grad transfer trio of outfielders **Peter Matt** and **Chris Davis** and pitcher **Richard Brereton** all made their Duke debuts and contributed to Duke's two wins over the Chanticleers. Matt started two games for the Blue Devils in Conway, S.C., batting .300 with a double and a two-run blast for two RBIs. In addition to his offensive power, Matt recorded four putouts including three in a single inning. Davis saw valuable time in game two of the series, pinch-hitting in the ninth inning. Davis finished the weekend 1-for-3 with two runs scored and an RBI. Brereton was the first called out of the Duke bullpen, coming in to relieve starter **Cooper Stinson** on Saturday. Brereton allowed just one run while striking out four in 2.0 innings of work.

## ROTHENBERG RECOGNIZED FOR ACC POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Senior **Michael Rothenberg** was named an honorary selection for the Weaver-James-Corrigan Scholarship Award, a \$6,000 award given to select student-athletes each year to help with the cost of graduate education. A native Boca Raton, Fla., Rothenberg was one of four Blue Devils honored with the scholarship which focuses on distinction both in the classroom and their respective sport and while demonstrating exemplary conduct in the community.

## BLUE DEVILS PICKED TO FINISH FOURTH IN ACC COASTAL

Duke was picked to finish fourth in the 2021 ACC Coastal Division as voted by the conference's 14 head coaches. Seven coaches picked Miami to win the Coastal Division, while Virginia and Georgia Tech received five and two votes, respectively. The Hurricanes tallied 89 points, ahead of both Virginia and Georgia Tech, who tallied 85 points and 71 points, respectively. Duke placed fourth with 59 points, while North Carolina (40), Virginia Tech (31) and Pittsburgh (17) rounded out the teams in the division. On the other side of the conference, Louisville was picked to take the ACC Atlantic Division with 11 of the 14 potential first-place votes. The Cardinals were also picked as the conference's overall champion.

## ALL-AMERICA HONORS FOR DUKE DUO

Senior catcher **Michael Rothenberg** and junior right-handed pitcher **Cooper Stinson** both earned preseason All-America honors heading into the 2021 season. Rothenberg, Duke's mainstay behind the plate, was named to *D1Baseball's* Preseason All-America third team after leading the ACC in on-base percentage (.551) last season. He currently owns a reached-base streak of 24 consecutive games, dating back to 2019. Rothenberg batted .349 throughout the 2020 campaign, tying for 18th in the conference, while compiling 17 RBIs to lead the Blue Devils. Stinson was named a third team preseason All-American by the NCBWA. Stinson put together a 3-0 record as Duke's Saturday starter in the shortened 2020 season. He carried a 0.42 ERA through the year, ranking first in the league and 15th nationally. Stinson opened the 2020 campaign with 19.2 consecutive innings pitched of scoreless baseball. In addition, Stinson ranked eighth in the ACC in WHIP (0.92) and ninth in walks allowed per nine innings (1.66).

Chris Pollard became Duke University's 25th head baseball coach in June 2012, taking the reigns of the Blue Devil program after successful stints at Pfeiffer University and Appalachian State University. In addition to guiding the Blue Devils to six straight 30-win seasons, Pollard led Duke to an at-large bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament, ending the program's 55-year drought without making the postseason event. Pollard became the fastest Duke head coach to reach 100 wins with the Blue Devils, recording his 100th victory at Duke on March 15, 2016 against Maryland Eastern Shore. During Pollard's tenure, 25 Blue Devils have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.
