

## **Duke Athletics Accessibility Quick Sheet**

### *Ambler Tennis Stadium – Outdoor Tennis*

Prior to game day, please feel free to reach out to the Duke Disability Management Office at 919-668-1267.

#### **Parking Accommodations**

General Public Parking for guests with disabilities is located in the Card Lot located on Towerview Road ([GPS Address](#): 320 Towerview Road). Parking opens (2) hours prior to the start of the match.

An accessible drop-off/pick-up location for guests with disabilities is available in the Card Lot immediately outside Ambler Tennis Stadium.

Alternative parking may be required for certain matches. Please check our [website](#) for Parking & Traffic Alerts.

#### **Entry**

An accessible entrance to Ambler Tennis Stadium is available under the trees alongside Court #5. An accessible ramp leads from the sidewalk to the seating area.

#### **Ticketing & Seating**

All Duke Tennis regular season tennis events at Ambler Tennis Stadium are free to the public. No tickets are necessary. Tickets are required for NCAA Championship Events. Please check event-specific information for championship ticket requirements.

If tickets are required for an event, tickets may be purchased by visiting [goduke.com/tickets](http://goduke.com/tickets) or by calling the Duke Ticket Office at 1-877-375-3853 or 919-681-2583. Ticket fraud includes, but is not limited to, the misrepresentation of a disability.

Accessible seating and companion seating is located under the trees alongside Court #5. Signage will be posted marking this area.

#### **General Accommodations**

##### *Mobility Assistance*

Wheelchairs and other assistive devices are permitted in Ambler Tennis Stadium. Assistive devices may be stored in the designated accessible seating areas.

##### *Concessions*

There is no concession stand at Ambler Tennis Stadium.

##### *Restrooms*

All stadium restrooms are gender neutral and accessible for guests with disabilities. Stadium restrooms are located underneath the grandstands of Ambler Tennis Stadium.

##### *Medical Assistance*

EMS may not be present for these events. For assistance, please locate the nearest staff member. In case of emergency, please call Duke Police at 919-684-2444 or call 9-1-1.

##### *Facility Evacuation*




If an emergency or severe weather evacuation were activated, stadium event staff will be available to assist guests with disabilities who request assistance in exiting the stadium or seeking safe shelter.
