Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium – Field Hockey

Parking Accommodations

General Public Parking for guests with disabilities is located in the Bivins Lot (GPS Address: 4 Brodie Gym Drive) above the Duke Softball Stadium. The parking lot is located on the right after turning onto Brodie Gym Drive. A visible ADA placard is required for entry into this lot. Parking opens (2) hours prior to game start.

Additional parking for guests with disabilities is located in the 705 Broad Street parking lot, across the street from Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium.

An accessible drop-off and pick up point for guests with disabilities is available in the Bivins Lot.

Alternative parking may be required for certain games. Please check our <u>website</u> for Parking & Traffic Alerts.

Entry

An accessible entrance for guests with disabilities is available via the north gate to Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium, located next to the stadium restrooms and across from Duke Softball Stadium.

Please note that the southwest gate is not an accessible entrance as it requires the usage of stairs.

Ticketing & Seating

All regular season Duke Field Hockey home events at Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium are free to the public. No tickets are necessary. Tickets are required for ACC and NCAA Championship Events. Please check event-specific information for championship ticket requirements.

If tickets are required for an event, tickets may be purchased by visiting goduke.com/tickets or by calling the Duke Ticket Office at 1-877-375-3853 or 919-681-2583. Ticket fraud includes, but is not limited to, the misrepresentation of a disability.

Accessible seating for guests with disabilities is available in the front row of the stadium bleachers. Accessible ramps are located on both ends of the bleachers.

General Accommodations

Concessions

Concessions are sold at Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium on the south end of the bleachers right next to the accessible ramps.

Mobility Assistance

Wheelchairs and other assistive devices are permitted in Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium. Assistive devices may be stored in the designated accessible seating areas or under the Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium bleachers.

Restrooms

Accessible restrooms are located at the north end of the stadium.

For a gender-neutral accessible family restroom, please visit the marketing table located alongside the bleachers for assistance.

Medical Assistance

EMS may not be present for these events. For assistance, please locate the nearest staff member. In case of emergency, please call Duke Police at 919-684-2444 or call 9-1-1.

Facility Evacuation

If an emergency or severe weather evacuation were activated, stadium event staff will be available to assist guests with disabilities who request assistance in exiting the stadium or seeking safe shelter.
