Parking Accommodations

Parking for guests with disabilities is located in the Whitford Lot ([GPS Address](#): 110 Whitford Drive). Parking opens (2) hours prior to the start of the event.

An accessible drop-off/pick-up location for guests with disabilities is located along the Whitford Drive traffic circle at 110 Whitford Drive.

Entry

The Brandeone Family North Gate and Southwest Gate near the Bassett Drive Ticket Booth are accessible for guests with disabilities. Stadium gates open (1) hour prior to the start of the event.

Ticketing & Seating

Tickets may be purchased prior to game day by visiting goduke.com/tickets or by calling the ticket office at 1-877-375-3853 or 919-681-2583. Game day ticket sales are available at the Koskinen Stadium ticket booths located on Whitford Drive and above Bassett Drive beginning (60) minutes prior to kick-off.

Accessible seating and companion seating for guests with disabilities is available on a first come, first-serve basis on the first row of the seating area.

General Accommodations

Mobility Assistance

Wheelchairs and other assistive devices are permitted in Koskinen Stadium. Assistive devices may be stored in the designated accessible seating areas or under the bleachers.

Listening Assistance

Assistive listening devices are available upon request from the ticket booth. Post-game, guests should return the device to the nearest Event Staff member.

Concessions

An accessible concessions stand is located on the north end of the Kennedy Tower bleachers, just inside the Brandeone Family North Gate.

Restrooms

All stadium restrooms are accessible for guests with disabilities.

- Stadium restrooms are located in the southwest corner of the stadium.
- For a gender-neutral accessible family restroom, please ask the nearest event staff member for assistance.

Medical Assistance

For first aid and emergency medical services, please visit the first aid station near the stadium restrooms in the southwest corner. In case of emergency, please call Duke Police at 919-684-2444 or call 9-1-1.

Facility Evacuation





If an emergency or severe weather evacuation were activated, stadium event staff will be available to assist guests with disabilities who request assistance in exiting the stadium or seeking safe shelter.
