

**Duke Athletics Accessibility Guide for Guests with Disabilities**  
*Morris Williams Stadium – Track and Field*

**Parking Accommodations**

Accessible parking is located in the Whitford Lot ([GPS Address](#): 110 Whitford Drive). Parking opens (2) hours prior to the start of competition.

An accessible drop-off/pick-up point is available on Whitford Drive outside the Brandaleone Family North Gate of Morris Williams Stadium.

Alternative parking may be required for certain meets. Please check our [website](#) for Parking & Traffic Alerts.

**Entry**

All general public entrances are accessible for guests with disabilities.

- The accessible pedestrian path to the south entrances above Frank Bassett Drive is located at intersection of Frank Bassett Drive and Science Drive, across the street from Science Drive Garage.

**Ticketing & Seating**

All regular season Duke Track & Field meets are free to the public. No tickets are necessary.

Accessible seating for guests with disabilities is available in the front row of the stadium bleachers in the southwest corner at the primary finish line. Accessible ramps are located at both ends of the bleachers.

All stadium sidewalks are accessible and can be used by guests for viewing events around the venue.

**General Accommodations**

*Concessions*

Concessions stand is located in Koskinen Stadium on the north end of Kennedy Tower (closest to Whitford Drive).

*Restrooms & Lactation Room*

Accessible restrooms are located on the south end of the Koskinen Stadium concourse immediately adjacent to the South Gate of Morris Williams Stadium.

For a gender-neutral accessible family restroom or lactation room, please visit the Meet Operations Tent next to Kennedy Tower for assistance.

*Assistive Listening Devices*

Assistive listening devices are available upon request at the Meet Operations Tent next to Kennedy Tower.

- Devices must be returned prior to departure.

*Medical Assistance*

EMS may not be present for the full duration of meets.

- When present, EMS is located alongside Kennedy Tower near the pole vault competition area.
- For assistance, speak to event staff at the Meet Operations Tent next to Kennedy Tower.
- In case of emergency, call Duke Police at 919-684-2444 or call 9-1-1.

*Facility Evacuation*

Event staff will be available to assist guests who request assistance exiting the stadium.

In the event of severe weather, the covered concourse of Koskinen Stadium will be available to guests who disabilities who wish to temporarily shelter in the stadium.

**Sensory Friendly Services**

*Quiet Area*
