LEADING OFF

- Duke Baseball recorded 205 of its 310 runs scored so far this season from the fourth to eighth innings. That number accounts for 66.1% of the Blue Devils' runs this season.
- The Blue Devils have recorded 113 two-out RBI this season, accounting for 36.5% of the runs scored this season. Junior **Jay Beshears** leads the team with 14 two-out RBI, followed closely by graduate transfer **Giovanni DiGiacomo** with 13.
- Freshman **Andrew Fischer** set the program record for home runs by a rookie on Friday at No. 11 Boston College, hitting his eighth of the season to right field. He moved ahead of **Biff Bracey** who hit seven in 1963. He added to his total on Tuesday, with a solo shot in the bottom of the first, with his 10th home run of the season.

- Although young, Duke's pitching staff has stepped up to the challenge and continues to prove why they are inside the top-5 nationally in a multitude of categories. The Blue Devils currently have tallied 425 strikeouts on the year, posting a 11.9 K's per nine innings mark to this point. Both those tallies are second in the country and second in the ACC behind only Miami.
- Freshman lefty **James Tallon** continues to slam the door on opponents this season, collecting his eighth save of the campaign on Friday afternoon at No. 11 Boston College. His eight career saves move him into a tie for 15th all-time in program history with **David Putman** and he is on pace to break the single season mark of 11 set by **Kenny Koplove** in 2015.
- The Blue Devils resume heading to the final month of the season continues to grow after picking up a huge road series victory at No. 11 Boston College last weekend. Duke now has six top-15 wins on the season including No. 9 East Carolina, No. 5 Wake Forest, No. 15 North Carolina, No. 14 Campbell and two against No. 11 Boston College. Duke's strength of schedule heading into the Louisville weekend now sits at 25th in the country.
- Louisville sends righty Ryan Hawks to the mound on Friday night to kick off a pivotal ACC series in Durham. Hawks has posted a 5-2 record in nine starts, working 53 innings and scattering 49 hits. He has allowed 24 runs, while walking 14 batters and punching out 55 with a 3.74 ERA. On Saturday, left-hander Riley Phillis toes the rubber, posting a 4-1 record and holding a 4.05 ERA. He has worked 26.2 innings, scattering 23 hits and 12 runs. Phillips has walked 17 batters and struckout 37. In the series finale, righty Carson Liggett takes the bump, posting a 1.66 ERA and an unblemished 7-0 record. He has worked one complete game in his 48.2 innings of work allowing just 10 runs and punching out 43 batters.

TALLON MOVES UP THE LIST

Freshman closer **James Tallon** has been nearly untouchable as the Blue Devils back end arm. On Sunday, the southpaw collected his eighth save of the season, moving into a tie for 9th all-time in a single season and 15th all-time in his career. The program record for a single season was set by **Kenny Koplove** (11) in 2015.

ACC RACE IS TIGHTENING UP

Three games separates first place in the Coastal from fourth place as the race to the finish line heats up. After Pittsburgh knocked off Virginia this past weekend, three games separates the Blue Devils in fourth place from the top spot in the division.

BOMBS AWAY

Duke Baseball has been destroying the cover off the baseballs, crushing 63 home runs this season. That mark is 20th nationally and is on pace to break the single season team record of 90 home runs. The 63 round trippers are the 6th most in a single season for Duke and the third most under head coach **Chris Pollard**.

THE MARGINS AREN'T CLOSE

Duke Baseball has put up video game numbers this season, both on the mound and at the plate. In the 24 games that the Blue Devils have won, they have outscored their opponents by a combined 206 runs. On Tuesday night at Jack Coombs Field, Duke defeated Davidson 19-0 for its 12th double digit scoring outburst of the season. On the flip side, The Blue Devils have lost their 12 contests by a combined run total of 40. Duke had its first margin of victory greater than four runs on Friday night against Pitt, when the Panthers defeated Duke 13-1.

GET THROUGH THE SIXTH WITH THE LEAD

Duke Baseball improved to 21-0, 21-0 and 23-0 respectively when leading after the sixth, seventh and eighth innings this season.

13th MULTI-HIT GAME FOR MOONEY

Sophomore **Alex Mooney** has been on fire to start the 2023 season, leading the team at the plate with a .336 clip. Mooney began the campaign with a 10-game hitting streak, before having it snapped against Princeton. On Sunday, Mooney tallied his 13th multi-hit game of the season, the most by any Blue Devil this year.

RB(eshears)I

Junior **Jay Beshears** continues to prove why he was named as an impact transfer for the 2023 season, tallying his 14th multi-RBI game. The Naples, Fla. product is five clear of **Alex Stone** and **Alex Mooney** who have recorded nine multi-RBI contests this season. His 41 RBI puts him in reach of **Griffin Conine** for 10th all-time in a single season with 56 RBI. The school record was set by **Ed Corey** (76) in 1998.

LAST TEN STAND OUT

Two Blue Devils have shined over the past 10 games, as Duke Baseball is 7-3 during that stretch. Graduate transfer **MJ Metz** (.400) and junior **Alex Stone** (.349) have both posted averages above .340 during that span. Metz is slashing .400/.920/.423 during that span, while Stone is slashing .349/.628/.378.

STONE IS GETTING HOT

Junior backstop **Alex Stone** was named to the 2023 Buster Posey Catcher of the Year Watch List earlier this season by the Wichita Sports Commission and has since heated up down the stretch. After starting the season slow, Stone has posted a .349 average in his last 10 games, crushing three home runs and three doubles, as he is tied for the team lead in RBI during that stretch with 12.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

The Blue Devils schedule continues to get tougher down the stretch, hosting a quality William & Mary club on Tuesday, before welcoming in No. 12 Louisville for a three-game set this weekend. Duke currently posts a strength of schedule ranked 25th in the country, with opponents posting a 694-489 record this season.

STRIKEOUTS ARE SKYROCKETING

Duke Baseball has skyrocketed up the national and league standings in strikeouts the past month, tallying 425 total punchouts. The mark is third nationally and second in the league, behind only Wake Forest in both standings.

A TOP PROSPECT IN DURHAM

Sophomore shortstop **Alex Mooney** moved up in the D1Baseball Top-150 prospects list from No. 29 to No. 27 and is the highest ranked eligible sophomore in this 2023 MLB Draft.

ACC TOURNAMENT RETURNS TO DURHAM

The Atlantic Coast Conference announced that the ACC Tournament is returning to Durham, as the Durham Bulls Athletic Park will be the host site for the 2023 Conference Tournament. The conference also announced that the tournament will alternate sites between Charlotte at Truist Park and the DBAP.

WHITE NEWS & NOTES

FRIDAY NIGHT WHITE: After southpaw **Jonathan Santucci** became unavailable with an arm injury, **Jason White** has moved into the Friday night role. White is no stranger to opening a series for Duke this season, being named the Thursday night starter against North Carolina a few weeks ago. The Concord, N.C., native has been used in multiple ways this season for the Blue Devils and looks to continue to be a strong piece of the bullpen.

WHITE LOOKS TO REBOUND: The righty was on top of the world in his first seven appearances, posting a 0.61 ERA and was virtually untouchable. On Saturday in Clemson, the Tigers were able to touch up White for five runs on five hits. He struck out one Tiger and has his sights set on opening the rivalry weekend on a high note.

WELCOME TO THE ACC: **Jason White** made his Duke and ACC debut in Sunday's finale against the Saint Joseph's Hawks. White worked a clean inning in relief, striking out a pair on 17 pitches.

STRONG ARM FROM DOWN THE ROAD: After a successful career at Belmont Abbey, the righty joins the Blue Devils from down the road. White tallied over 200 innings with the Crusaders, adding 234 strikeouts and boasting an 18-11 record on the mound. White has collected three complete games during his career and has started 31 games before Wednesday.

TOUGH BATTLE FROM THE CONCORD KID: In his first outing on Sunday, White entered the ballgame for Aaron Beasley with a runner on base. The righty was able to get Luca Trigiani to pop out on the first pitch, before battling through two long at bats. White was able to get Ryan Picollo to strike out swining, after a 10-pitch at bat, before recording another punchout on six pitches.

BASEBALL IS IN HIS BLOOD: Baseball has run in the White family for a long time. Jason's father, Jeff, played baseball at Ferum College (1983-84), his brother, Carson, played baseball at UNC-Pembroke (2015), Louisburg College (2016) and Gardner-Webb (2017-18) and his uncle, Robert Trumbo, played for James Madison (1983-1986).

The righty finished his career with a 3.55 ERA and collected 198 strikeouts along the way. His 152.0 innings on the mound were highlighted by 66.2 and 99 strikeouts his senior season in 2022. During that career campaign, Gow recorded a 7-1 record in his 10 starts and opponents batted .223 off him.

TWO-WAY PRODUCT: The two-way star out of California not only held a sub 3.60 ERA at Kenyon, but also produced a career average at the plate of .335. Gow accumulated 424 at bats, driving in 84 total runs and collecting 40 extra-base hits.

Chris Pollard became Duke University's 25th head baseball coach in June 2012, taking the reigns of the Blue Devil program after successful stints at Pfeiffer University and Appalachian State University.

Pollard at Duke Notables:

- In addition to guiding the Blue Devils to six straight 30-win seasons, Pollard led Duke to an at-large bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament, ending the program's 55-year drought without making the postseason event.
- Pollard became the fastest Duke head coach to reach 100 wins with the Blue Devils, recording his 100th victory at Duke on March 15, 2016 against Maryland Eastern Shore.
- In 2021, Pollard became the first coach in Duke history to reach 100 career ACC wins, one of six active coaches to achieve the mark.
- Duke reached the NCAA Super Regional in 2018 and 2019 and NCAA Tournament three consecutive years (2018, 2019 and 2021) for the first time in program history.
- Pollard led the Blue Devils to capture the 2021 ACC Baseball Championship title, the first ACC title in 60 seasons and the first in the current tournament format.
- During Pollard's tenure at Duke he has helped produce 36 Major League Baseball Draft selections, 16 All-ACC picks, four Freshman All-Americans and three All-Americans.
