• Duke went 1-2 in its opening weekend at Purdue's Reamer Club Xtra Special Premier. The Blue Devils fell to No. 16 Purdue (3-1) and Loyola Chicago (3-0) before a 3-2 victory over No. 18 Creighton.

A CLOSER LOOK AT THE SERIES

LOYOLA MARYLAND

Thursday marks the first meeting between Duke and Loyola Maryland.

WEST VIRGINIA

Duke and West Virginia meet for the 10th time in program history and for the first since 2014. The Blue Devils lead the all-time series 8-1 and have won seven consecutive.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

LOYOLA MARYLAND

Loyola Maryland enters Thursday's contest 2-1 in the early fall with wins over Niagara (3-0) and Robert Morris (3-1) over the weekend. Offensively, the Greyhounds are led by Lauren Link with 45 kills and 4.09 kills/set and Kacy Sekunda with 32 and a .343 hitting percentage. The Greyhounds work between two setters -- Bryanne Soares and Sekunda -- while Rose McDermott leads the defensive unit with 45 digs. As a team, Loyola Maryland is hitting .221 percent through three games.

WEST VIRGINIA

West Virginia is 2-1 overall after the College of Charleston Tournament last weekend. The Mountaineers are led by Bailey Miller with 39 kills and a .264 hitting percentage. Setter Lauren DeLo has dished 89 dimes as the team is hitting .274 percent through three matches.

LAST TIME YOU SAW US

• The Duke volleyball team outlasted No. 18 Creighton, 3-2 (17-25, 27-25, 27-25, 24-26, 15-11), to close out the Reamer Club Xtra Special Premier in West Lafayette, Ind.

• Three Blue Devils tallied double-doubles – Gracie Johnson, Kerry Keefe and Emma Worthington – to help spearhead Duke to its first win of 2023.

• Rachel Richardson led the way offensively with a career-high 16 kills as Duke hit .240 percent for the match. Jess Robinson added 10 kills and no errors to play to an impressive .476 clip.

• Setter Worthington dished 52 assists, just two off her career high, and added 16 digs while libero Madison Bryant collected 24 digs. Lizzie Fleming led the blocking contingent with four total blocks, in addition to her nine kills and a .444 hitting percentage, while Johnson recorded three blocks.

SIGHTS ON MILESTONE

- The Duke volleyball program has its sights set on a major milestone. Since its inception in 1971, the Blue Devils have accumulated 999 wins, just one shy of the 1,000-win plateau.
- Duke will be the 43rd program in NCAA history to reach the milestone.

QUARTER OF A CENTURY

- Head coach Jolene Nagel has been at the helm of the Blue Devils since 1999 and is in her 25th season this fall.
- Under Nagel's guidance, she has led the Blue Devils to 13 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11.
- Nagel earned her 600th career victory September 9, 2017 as the Blue Devils downed TCU in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became the 22nd active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 600 career victories.
- As a program, Duke needs just one victory to reach 1,000 program wins - 481 are under the direction of Nagel.

FIRST ACC SETTER OF THE WEEK

- Graduate student setter Emma Worthington was named the ACC Setter of the Week following her performance over the weekend.
- In her Blue Devil debut, Worthington dished 110 assists for 9.17 assists per set and featured an impressive 52 dimes in Duke's five-set win over No. 18 Creighton. She also tallied 32 digs, seven kills and four blocks as a six-rotation player.
- She currently ranks tied for 37th nationally in total assists.
- This is the first ACC Setter of the Week award given by the conference office.

SEEING DOUBLE

- Three Blue Devils -- Gracie Johnson, Kerry Keefe and Emma Worthington -- tallied double-doubles in Duke's five-set marathon win over No. 18 Creighton.
- This is the first time Duke has featured three with double-doubles since Oct. 30, 2022 when Duke defeated Notre Dame in five sets.

RANKED DUB

- Duke's first win of the 2023 season was a ranked one, defeating No. 18 Creighton (3-2) to close out the opening weekend.
- It was Duke's first win over a ranked opponent since Sept. 20, 2019 against No. 14 Oregon.
- Duke was 0-4 against ranked foes a season ago.

GRACIE THE GREAT

- Graduate student Gracie Johnson returns to Duke for her final year of eligibility and is primed for another stellar campaign as a Preseason All-ACC Team selection.
- Johnson was Duke's engine last fall, but that's no surprise with her impressive numbers on both sides of the ball. During her senior campaign, she saw her best offensive output since her arrival in Durham with 462 kills and a .203 hitting percentage. She also collected 53 aces, 217 digs and 43 blocks, proving she's more than just an offensive threat.
- A 2022 first team All-ACC selection, she finished the season ranked in the top-50 of eight national categories and in the top-five of eight statistical categories in the ACC. She led the conference in total aces and was second in total kills and total points.
- Throughout her career, she owns 1,163 kills, 127 aces, 857 digs and 175 total blocks to go along with 20 career double-doubles and 16 games with 20 or more kills. She became the 28th Blue Devil to reach the 1,000-kill plateau in Duke's five-set victory at Notre Dame (10/30).
- This fall, she looks to become the 13th player in program history to register 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs.

RETURN OF THE MACK

- Former Duke standout and 2021 graduate Mackenzie Cole returned to Durham as a member of the Blue Devil coaching staff. She will serve as an assistant coach and the director of operations for the 2023 season.
- Cole had a stellar career as a four-year starting libero for the Blue Devils, which culminated in her earning ACC Defensive Player of the Year, All-East Coast Region and second team All-ACC honors during her final season in 2021.
- After her four years as a Blue Devil, Cole used her final year of eligibility at UCLA as the starting libero for the Bruins in 2022. She finished her career ranked 13th on the NCAA active career leaders list with 2,086 digs.

HELLO, BLUE DEVILS!

- Duke welcomes two graduate transfers to the 2023 squad in Jess Robinson (Michigan) and Emma Worthington (Cornell). Robinson spent the last four seasons as a middle blocker with the Wolverines and looks to continue her impressive year at Michigan a season ago. Following the departure of setter Devon Chang, Worthington looks to jump into the rotation.

MICHIGAN -> DUKE

- Duke welcomes a key addition to the Blue Devil squad this fall in 6-2 middle blocker Jess Robinson. Robinson comes to Durham after spending four years at Michigan.
- During her senior season, she broke the school record career hitting percentage (.341) and the record for a single season Big Ten hitting percentage at Michigan (.388). She captured AVCA All-North Region first team honors and excelled in the classroom, landing on the All-Big Ten academic list, the CSC Academic All-District team and was a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar in 2021.
- Last fall, she held the top spot nationally in hitting percentage for eight of the first nine weeks of the season and finished the year third nationally with a .438 clip on 427 attempts. She recorded 10 or more kills in 12 matches as she appeared and started in all 30 matches, collecting 239 kills, 120 blocks, 46 digs and seven assists.

FROM RED TO BLUE

- In addition to Jess Robinson, head coach Jolene Nagel welcomes Emma Worthington to Duke this fall as a 5-11 setter from Cornell.
- During her senior year, she served as the team captain for the 2022 season and saw action in all 23 contests, leading the team in assists (746) and assists per set (8.99).
- Her assist and assists per set numbers ranked third most in the Ivy League as she posted a career-high 54 assists in a five-set match at Penn. She had seven double-doubles on the year, highlighted by the 54-assists 24 dig performance against the Quakers.

KEEPING UP WITH KERRY

- Freshman outside hitter Kerry Keefe emerged as one of Duke's offensive threats last season and was named to the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- She was sidelined to start the season, but quickly found a starting role on the right side. Keefe tallied 160 kills for 2.39 kills/set and played to a .288 hitting percentage. She also added 44 digs and 42.0 total blocks as a important part of Duke's defense. Last fall, she knocked down a career-high 21 kills versus Clemson, added a career-high seven total blocks against Boston College and saw eight contests with 10 or more kills.

THE CLIMB

- Graduate student middle blocker Lizzie Fleming has posted impressive numbers throughout her Blue Devil career and broke into Duke's all-time blocking list a season ago.
- She owns 370 total blocks (30 solo, 340 assisted) and is currently 13th in Duke history. She finished last fall ranked tied for second on the team in total blocks (70.0) and had 11 games with four-or-more. Over

her career, Fleming has tallied four-or-more blocks in 52 games and owns a career-high of 13 during her freshman season (NC State 11/10/19).

- She was sidelined due to injury for a significant portion of the ACC season last fall over the span of nine matches (9/30-10/28).

THE 2022 SEASON

- The Duke volleyball team went 16-13 overall and 7-11 in conference play during the 2022 season.
- Gracie Johnson was named first team All-ACC and AVCA All-East Coast Region for her efforts while Kerry Keefe was named to the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- Statistically, Johnson led the team with 462 kills, while Devon Chang dished 1,149 assists.
- Taylor Atkinson, Chang, Lizzie Fleming, Johnson, Keefe, Rachel Richardson, Sydney Tomlak, Nikki Underwood, Moorea Wood and Sydney Yap were named to the All-ACC Academic Team for their successes in the classroom.

ACE, ACE & ANOTHER ACE

- Duke has put an emphasis on its serve the last few years and finished fourth in the ACC last season with 183 (1.58 aces/set).
- The Blue Devils are consistent around the lineup with their serve as seven Blue Devils tallied 10 or more, led by Gracie Johnson with an impressive 53. She finished the year ranked tied for 19th nationally in total aces and led the ACC.
- Duke returns Rylie Kadel (28), Nikki Underwood (23), Sydney Yap (23), Rachel Richardson (21) and Taylor Atkinson (10) to the service line this fall.

- She was honored by the ACC with the league's Top Six for Service Award this spring. The accolade is presented annually to six members from each conference institution who demonstrate outstanding dedication to community service and outreach programs.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Graduate students Madison Bryant, Lizzie Fleming and Gracie Johnson, along with senior Sydney Yap will lead the Blue Devils this fall as 2023 captains. Fleming and Johnson served as leaders a season ago.

ACC VOLLEYBALL ON SIRIUSXM

- SiriusXM produced an ACC volleyball preview show, which debuted on Wednesday, Aug. 16 and is available on demand on the SXM App.

Hosted by ESPN's Katie George, a former standout volleyball player at Louisville, the show features interviews with all 15 head coaches and student-athletes.

- Captain Madison Bryant and head coach Jolene Nagel are featured on the show.

ACC UNITY TOUR

- This July, Christina Barrow, Rachel Richardson and Sydney Tomlak were among 10 Duke representatives at the 2023 ACC Unity Tour in Washington, D.C.
- The tour was part of the ACC's commitment to supporting student-athletes through meaningful educational opportunities, including the area of social justice, and is a component of the league's social-justice platform, ACC UNITE.
- 2023 marks the second UNITY Tour. In 2022, Gracie Johnson visited Selma and Montgomery, Alabama, for an immersive journey to one of the centers of the civil rights movement.

Under her guidance, Duke has earned a reputation as one of the elite programs on the East Coast. Nagel has led the Blue Devils to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11. A perennial contender in the ACC, Duke has recorded 20 or more wins in 14 of Nagel's 25 campaigns and consistently finished among the top three in the conference. Nagel earned her 600th career victory September 9, 2017 as the Blue Devils downed TCU in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became the 22nd active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 600 career victories. The winningest Duke volleyball coach on record, she also ranks among the league coaching leaders in overall winning percentage, ACC winning percentage, ACC wins and NCAA Tournament appearances.
