NUMBERS TO KNOW

9Chris Pollard needs 9 wins to move into a tie for second all-time in program history for career wins at Duke.

13Senior Alex Stone needs 13 home runs to tie the career program record for home runs hit. He currently sits in seventh all-time with 30.

8Graduate closer Charlie Beilenson needs eight saves to tie the single season saves record by a Duke pitcher. Beilenson would join sophomore James Tallon who recorded 12 in 2023.

LEADING OFF

- The Blue Devils have continued to pounce on opponents like they did throughout the season in 2023. Duke has recorded 46 of its 85 runs so far this season from the fourth to eighth innings. That number accounts for 54.1% of the Blue Devils' run production this season.

- Duke is one of nine programs to make the NCAA tournament five times, appear in three Super Regionals and win a conference championship over the last seven years. The Blue Devils join LSU, ECU, Ole Miss, Vanderbilt, Stanford, North Carolina, Arkansas and Tennessee.

- Following a preseason which included multiple publications worried about the Blue Devils offensive production this season, Duke seemed to silence a lot of those doubters in Conway at the Baseball at the Beach Tournament. In game two of the weekend, Duke pounded George Mason to the tune of 23-5, collecting a new program record 11 home runs in a game. It was also the most by an ACC team since 1985 and was tied for the fourth-most in a since game per NCAA record books.

- Kyle Johnson will make his first start on the mound this weekend against the Zips, earning the nod for Sunday's contest. The two-way star freshman, has appeared in three games on the mound, posting a 2-0 record and a 0.00 ERA. The lefty has worked eight innings, allowing three hits, one unearned run and striking out six batters. Opponents are hitting .115 off Johnson and he has only allowed one extra base hit.

- Current single season appearance program record holder and graduate transfer Charlie Beilenson has started the 2024 season as the work horse out of the bullpen for Duke once again. Beilenson has already appeared in three games this season, earning a save in all three contests. This mark is on pace to break both the appearance record of 39 times from last season and also break sophomore James Tallon's single season saves record of 12, which he accomplished in his freshman campaign. Beilenson has worked six innings, allowing a lone hit and striking out eight this season.

- Graduate transfer Ben Miller has been scorching hot to start the 2024 campaign, collecting hits in the first eight games of the season. Miller has posted a .438 average at the plate, scoring nine runs, 14 hits, three doubles, four home runs and 10 RBI. He also has added two walks and been hit by three pitches. The Durham, N.C., native posts a .906 slugging percentage and .514 on base percentage heading into the third weekend of play.

- Duke is currently tied for second in the country and first in the ACC in home runs hit this season, trailing Georgia (27) and tied with Georgia Tech (23). The Blue Devils added three more home runs against Davidson at Jack Coombs Field, pushing their season total to 23.

THE RETURN OF JOSH ALLEN

646 days later, Josh Allen returned to the diamond to pitch for the Blue Devils on Sunday. Allen was thrust into a bases loaded situation, limiting the Northwestern damage, before Duke was able to score 20-unanswered runs to complete the sweep of Northwestern.

A PERFECT FEBRUARY

Duke is one of three ACC teams, a country best mark, to post a perfect record in the month of February. The 8-0 start to the 2024 season for Duke is the best since 2008, when the Blue Devils began 10-0, before falling to No. 2 North Carolina in the middle game of ACC play.

21 GAMES IN 31 DAYS

The toughest stretch of the season begins on Friday as Duke baseball opens the month of March. Over the next 31 days of play, the Blue Devils take the field 21 times and compete against five ranked opponents, four of which are league series. The Blue Devils travel to Winston-Salem, N.C., for their ACC opener against No. 1 Wake Forest, before hosting No. 10 Clemson at Jack Coombs Field. Duke continues the tough ACC stretch with a three-game set in Raleigh, traveling to take on NC State in a weekend series for the first time since 2022. Duke closes out the month of March with a 2023 Super Regional rematch, welcoming No. 13 Virginia to Durham. Scattered throughout that stretch of ACC play are midweek contests against Appalachian State, Georgetown, Rider, Towson and No. 21 Campbell.

STONE CLIMBS THE HOME RUN RANKS

Senior catcher **Alex Stone** climbed into seventh all-time on the career home run list for Duke, hitting his 30th in a Blue Devils' uniform on Sunday. The home run moved him ahead of **Mike King** (1993-96) who hit 29 during his time in Durham, and Stone now trails **Griffin Conine** (2016-18) by one home run. The career home run record was set by **Nate Freiman** (2006-09) who crushed 43 home runs in a Duke uniform.

KICK THE DOOR DOWN

Rumors swirled immediately following the Blue Devils third Super Regional appearance in program history that head coach **Chris Pollard** was exploring options to leave the program. Thanks to backing from the Duke administration and support of the Blue Devil baseball family, the program is set to begin renovations on Historic Jack Coombs Field beginning at the end of the 2024 season. Renovations will include a new indoor facility with a locker room, batting cages, athletic training room, classrooms, coaches offices and indoor practice facility. Additionally renovations to the dugouts and press area at Jack Coombs Field are in the works. Pollard announced his commitment to Duke with a simple phrase that was coined in his postgame press conference following the exit of the 2023 Charlottesville Super Regional... "Kick the door down" with a GIF. Kick the door down and get to Omaha echos through the program today.

ELECTRIC PITCHING STAFF

A year removed from having one of the best pitching staffs in the country, Duke has remained steady in that department through the first two weeks of play. The Blue Devils post a 2.44 ERA on the mound, marking the 10th best ERA in the country. Graduate Charlie

Beilenson has solidified the closer role this season, tallying four saves through the first eight games of play. Duke posts the best ERA in the ACC and the third most strikeouts in the league.

MILESTONES ON DECK FOR THE SKIPPER

A year removed from one of the greatest bounce back seasons in program history, head coach **Chris Pollard** returns and has his sights set on some major milestones at Duke. The 12th year skipper begins the 2024 season with a career total of 347 wins in a Blue Devils' uniform and now just 9 wins behind **Steve Traylor** (1988-99) for second all-time with 356. Pollard also is 39 wins away from tying legendary head coach **Jack Coombs** (1929-52) for first on the all-time Duke wins list with 381. The longtime Blue Devils coach has already taken the top spot for most ACC wins in program history, entering the 2024 season with 138, and tied the most NCAA Tournament appearances last season with five. The last Duke head coach to make the NCAA Tournament five or more times during their tenure was **Ace Parker** (1953-66).

SCORE FIRST, SCORE OFTEN

The name of the game is scoring first and scoring in bunches for the Blue Devils. Since 2016, Duke has compiled a 178-57 (.757) record when scoring first and a staggering 190-40 (.826) record when scoring three or more runs in an inning.

14TH RATED RECRUITING CLASS

Headlined by two-way star **Kyle Johnson**, the Blue Devils secured the No. 14 class in the country by *D1Baseball*. In addition to the No. 14 class by *D1Baseball*, the Duke produced the No. 20 recruiting class in the country by *Baseball America*, marking the fifth-straight Top-25 class for the Blue Devils under head coach **Chris Pollard**.

STEALS A PLENTY

Through seven games of the season, Duke baseball has accumulated a perfect 9-9 stealing mark on the basepaths. Last season, the Blue Devils finished with a 77-98 tally, as **Alex Mooney** and **Giovanni DiGiacomo** led the team with 21 and 20 swiped bags respectively.

TWO TOP-100 MLB DRAFT PROSPECTS

Duke enters the 2024 season with two players earning national recognition by MLB.com and the MLB Entry Draft. Left-hander **Jonathan Santucci** (29) and right-hander **Fran Oschell III** (77) were both on the list. Both players were invited to the USA Collegiate Baseball National Training Camp, with Oschell III earning a spot on the team during the summer of 2023.

K's FOR KIDS & BASES FOR BABIES

For the last five years, Duke baseball has partnered with the Duke Children's Hospital raising money to support pediatric cancer research. After a record breaking season on the diamond, the Blue Devils raised \$14,263 and presented a check to the Children's Hospital during this years First Pitch Banquet. Over the last five years Duke baseball along with contributions from the Duke community, has raised \$53,524.

Following the 2024 season, Duke will begin renovations on Historic Jack Coombs Field. The new facility will include upgraded dugouts, a new indoor training lab, training room, coaches offices, team room, club house and suites. Along with upgrading all of that, seating will be expanded in the coming years to create what head coach **Chris Pollard** calls “The Cameron Indoor of College Baseball”.

ACC HEADS BACK TO CHARLOTTE

The Atlantic Coast Conference and Charlotte Knights have agreed to bring the ACC Tournament back to Charlotte for the 50th season of ACC baseball. The last time the Blue Devils played in Charlotte was the 2021 season, a year where the program secured its first ACC Championship, defeating NC State, 1-0, to take the crown. The league also announced that the 2026, 28, and 30 championships would take place in Charlotte, while the 25, 27, and 29 championship would be held in Durham at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park.

NEW GEAR WITH A CAUSE

Duke baseball partnered with Wilson Baseball this season as the official equipment sponsor of the Blue Devils. A handful of Duke players are sporting a light blue glove for the 2024 campaign. Wilson has once again teamed up with Autism Speaks to collaborate and create the “Love the Moment” line of bats and gloves to spread the message of inclusion, acceptance and understanding for people on the autism spectrum. The Blue Devils have a history of supporting this cause by helping out with the Miracle League of Durham and hosting the Baseball Bonanza last season in conjunction with the Duke Center for Autism.

DUKE UNIVERSITY TURNS 100

In 2024, Duke celebrates its Centennial, marking one hundred years since Trinity College became Duke University. Duke will use this historic milestone to deepen the understanding of its history, inspire pride and strengthen bonds and partnerships, and prepare for a second century of continued excellence and impactful leadership.

- The Leominster, Mass., native improved to 2-0 on the young season working six innings of scoreless baseball against Northwestern. He punched out a season high 10 strikeouts in his efficient outing, one shy of his career high that he posted against Wake Forest to open ACC play in 2023.
- Santucci returned to the mound for his first start of the 2024 season on Friday afternoon against Indiana at the Baseball at the Beach Tournament. The southpaw didn't skip a beat, working a smooth five innings in his first start back from injury. He allowed four hits and struck out seven to his two adrenaline filled walks early in the ballgame. The Blue Devils' ace looks to build on his season opening gem against Northwestern on Friday.
- Following a freak injury last season which sideline **Jonathan Santucci** for more than half the 2023 campaign, the junior left-hander returns as the Friday night ace for the Blue Devils in 2024. Many scouts and analysts, including *D1Baseball*, have noted that Santucci is back and might be even better then he was before the injury. That high praise and a solid Fall has skyrocketed Santucci's draft stock into the top-25 and some mock drafts have him going as high as No. 20 to the Toronto Blue Jays. *Perfect Game* tabbed Santucci as the No. 25 prospect in the country, while *D1Baseball* put the lefty at No. 36 in their fall reports.
- The Leominster, Mass., native earned his first preseason accolade of the 2024 season, being tabbed a second team preseason All-American by *D1Baseball*. Santucci was one of three pitchers to be named for the Blue Devils, who were one of two programs in the country with three or more pitchers across all three teams. He was also tabbed as a second team preseason All-American by *Baseball America*. In addition to his All-American nods, Santucci was pegged as the 7th-best starting pitcher in college baseball by *D1Baseball* this season.
- In 2022, Santucci was invited to the USA Collegiate National Team Training Camp, in Cary, North Carolina. The lefty ultimately did not make the team, but the lessons learned and experience from performing among some of the best in the country helped guide his journey the past few seasons.
- In his first ACC start of the year, Santucci was lights out against Wake Forest at the DBAP. The lefty worked 4.1 innings on the mound, allowing three hits and punched out a career high 11 Demon Deacons at home.
- The former two-way star begins his junior campaign without a bat in his hands. Santucci has officially made the switch to being a pitcher only this season, allowing him to focus on his craft and future on the mound. "Obviously I know that my future in this sport is on the mound," Santucci said. "It has been a relieving thing to go to practice everyday and be able to focus on one aspect of my game. I have been able to dig deeper into the recovery process and the day-to-day activities that come with being a pitcher at this level."
