SETTING THE SCENE

- Elon opens the 2024 regular season Friday night at Duke for a game televised on the ACC Network. Elon enters the season with high expectations and is just one spot outside of the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 media poll entering the contest.
- Friday night's game kicks off at 7:30 p.m. inside Wallace Wade Stadium. Duke is 7-0-1 all-time against Elon with seven of those meetings taking place at Duke. The Blue Devils won the most recent meeting by a score of 52-13 in 2014.
- Elon Head Coach Tony Trisciani begins his sixth season leading the Phoenix and is the longest tenured coach in the program since Al Seagraves was atop the program for eight seasons from 1996-03. Duke will debut a new head coach in Manny Diaz, who led Miami (Fla.) from 2019-21.
- Elon is opening a season on the road against a Power Four opponent for the third consecutive season. The Phoenix lost at Wake Forest in 2023, 37-17, and at Vanderbilt in 2022, 42-31. Elon outscored both opponents in the second half by a combined score of 38-27.
- Saturday's game will be broadcast nationally on the ACC Network with Clay Matvick, Steve Addazio and Justin Walters on the call. Taylor Durham and Dr. Khirey Walker will provide the audio broadcast via The Varsity Network app on your computer or smart device, or by clicking on Live Audio on the football schedule page at ElonPhoenix.com.

AN ELON WIN WOULD...

- be the program's first over an FBS program in school history
- be the program's first over Duke in 10 meetings all-time
- move Tony Trisciani's career record to 27-25
- be the program's first season opening win since the 2020 (spring 2021) season
- be the team's first win in a season opener on the road since 2006 (26-23 win at Coastal Carolina)

2024 ELON FOOTBALL

ELON BEGINS YEAR SIX OF TONY TRISCIANI ERA

- On Dec. 17, 2018, Tony Trisciani was named the 23rd head football coach in Elon history. He has led the Phoenix to three consecutive winning seasons for the first time since 2007-10, which included a return to the FCS playoffs in 2022.
- While it is his sixth season as head coach, Trisciani is in his ninth year overall with the Phoenix, serving as the defensive coordinator in 2017 and 2018 before his elevation to the lead chair. In 2006, he coached the defensive backs and ran the special teams for Elon.
- Trisciani has been a member of the Phoenix staff the last three times Elon has made the playoffs -- as head coach in 2022 and as defensive coordinator in 2018 and 2017.
- Elon has won at least five games and four league contests in all four fall campaigns in which Trisciani has been the head coach. The 2020 season was competed during a shortened spring campaign due to COVID-19.
- Under Trisciani, Elon won 17 conference games from 2021-23 and is the only program to finish conference play above .500 in each of those seasons. Those results came after being picked to finish 12th, sixth and fifth, respectively, in the league's preseason coaches poll.
- The 2024 season is Trisciani's 29th year as a football coach and his 19th at a CAA Football institution. Since his return to Elon in 2017, he has helped the program defeat 15 FCS Top 25 programs. As head coach, he has notched nine wins over ranked teams, with at least two wins against ranked teams in each of his fall campaigns as a head coach. In 2023, Elon twice beat a top five opponent, a feat the Phoenix had only done once in the program's FCS history previously (10/6/18 at No. 2 James Madison).

STABILITY AMONG THE STAFF

- Head Coach Tony Trisciani was able to keep together the majority of his coaching staff for the 2024 season.
- Defensive Line Coach Seth Payne was the only departure following the 2023 season but Joe Perri, who had served as a defensive line assistant for two years, filled the vacant role.
- Offensive Coordinator Drew Folmar has been at Elon since 2017, while Defensive Coordinator Dovonte Edwards is in his fourth season at Elon and in his third in his current role.
- Special Teams Coordinator/Outside Linebackers Coach Milo Austin, Inside Linebackers Coach/Defensive Run Game Coordinator Casey Vance and Running Backs

Coach Nate Harris all joined Elon in time for the 2022 season and begin year three with the Phoenix.

- Offensive Line Coach Alex Stadler, Wide Receivers Coach/Recruiting Coordinator Kyle Perkins, Tight Ends Coach Matt Ford and Cornerbacks Coach/Defensive Pass Game Coordinator Dominique Battle are all in their second year with the Phoenix.
- Special Teams Assistant Mike Nall rejoined the program prior to the 2019 season. Nall also coached at Elon from 2005-08.
- Elon has added two new faces to the staff. Akeem Dent is an assistant defensive line coach and Chris Schultz is an assistant offensive coach. Both also have roles within the special teams units.

SCOUTING DUKE

- Duke went 8-5 a year ago, including a 4-4 record in the ACC, which included a 42-7 win over last year's FCS opponent, Lafayette. The Blue Devils beat Troy, 17-10, in the Birmingham Bowl.
- Head Coach Mike Elko left after the season for Texas A&M and Manny Diaz replaced him. Diaz most recently was the defensive coordinator at Penn State and was the head coach at Miami (Fla.) from 2019-21, going 21-15.
- Duke was among the stingiest teams in the nation a year ago, allowing just 19.0 points per game. The Blue Devils did that with a stalwart effort on red zone defense and a net punting average that ranked second in the country. Duke also blocked three kicks on the season.

SPECIALISTS U.

- Under the tutelage of Mike Nall, Elon has become a destination location for kickers and punters at the FCS level.
- At punter, Kyle Romenick ranked 25th in the nation in punting average in 2023 at 42.1 yards per punt and Elon ranked 23rd in the country in net punting average. In 2022, Jeff Yurk was fifth nationally at 44.1 yards per punt and the team was 10th in net punting at the FCS level.
- At kicker, true freshman Jack Berkowitz was one of 13 players in the country to make at least 1.2 field goals per game with a percentage of 80 percent or higher. That came just one season after All-American Skyler Davis made 82 percent of his field goals with 1.5 per game. Davis, in fact, made seven 50+ yard field goals, tying the FCS record for a single-season. Elon kickers have made at least 75 percent of their field goal attempts in every season since 2020-21.

LOOKING FOR RESPECT

- Elon was picked to finish sixth in the CAA by the coaches in the 2024 preseason poll despite returning 14 starters (second-most in the league) after a fourth place finish a year ago. Elon has exceeded preseason expectations in each of the last three years.
- In 2023, Elon Football finished 6-2 in CAA play and tied for fourth in the league standings, just one game out of a three-way tie atop the conference. The Phoenix were picked to finish fifth in the preseason.
- In 2022, Elon was predicted to end sixth in

2024 ELON FOOTBALL

CAA Football but finished third in the conference standings, earned an at-large bid to the FCS playoffs and ended the year ranked No. 17 in the country.

- In 2021, Elon was picked to finish last in the 12-team league but ended in sole possession of third place.

- Elon is the only program to finish in the top three of the final CAA Football standings in each of the past three seasons (2021-23).

- Since the start of the 2021 season, Elon is 17-7 in conference play, tied with Richmond for the second-best record in the CAA. Villanova is just one game better at 18-6.

YEAR NUMBER SEVEN FOR DOWNING

- Graduate quarterback Matthew Downing begins his seventh season of college football in 2024 and brings stability to a position where Elon has seen plenty of turnover.

- Downing is set to become the first quarterback to start the opening game of a season in back-to-back seasons since Davis Cheek did so from 2017-19.

- A year ago, Downing started nine games and ranked No. 4 nationally in yards per completion (15.3), No. 8 in yards per attempt (8.9), No. 9 in passing efficiency (157.7) and No. 25 in passing touchdowns (19).

- Downing missed the Villanova game with an injury but returned for the final four games and played at a level he had not previously. He averaged 294.0 passing yards with 12 touchdowns and zero interceptions during that season-ending stretch. Downing averaged 19.6 yards per completion in those four contests.

- So, how does Downing have seven years of eligibility? He began his career at Georgia, playing in four games and redshirting in 2018, getting that season back to eligibility. After transferring to TCU, he played in seven games over three years from 2019-21, but the 2020 COVID season was a free year for all student-athletes. He earned his first collegiate start in the 2020 season opener against Iowa State, going 11-of-21 for 158 yards and a touchdown.

- Following his time at TCU, Downing transferred to Louisiana Tech, playing in four games in 2022, going 33-of-62 with three touchdowns and 356 yards passing. He suffered a season-ending knee injury with the Bulldogs and received a medical redshirt.

- To recap, Downing played counting seasons in 2019, 2021 and 2023 with redshirt seasons in 2018, 2020 and 2022.

CHAN THE MAN

- Chandler Brayboy has proven to be one of the most explosive players in CAA Football and was recognized as the fourth-most explosive in FCS Football by Stats Perform/The Analyst prior to the season.

- Brayboy averaged 19.6 yards per reception, 8.4 yards per rush and 26.9 yards per kick return in 2023. He had four touchdowns receptions of at least 55 yards, in which Elon won four CAA games.

- Brayboy was listed at No. 82 among 101 college football players (across all levels) on Bruce Feldman's annual Freaks List on The Athletic.

- The redshirt senior was named preseason all-conference at THREE different positions by Phil Steele (all-purpose specialist, wide receiver, kick returner) and at TWO different positions by the CAA coaches (wide receiver, kick returner).

- He had a 65-yard touchdown reception a week ago in the win over Delaware, part of a career-best 269 all-purpose yards. Brayboy finished with a career-best 121 yards receiving to go with 137 yards on four kick returns (34.3 per return) and 11 rushing yards.

- Brayboy had a 65-yard touchdown reception in a win over then-No. 5 Delaware, part of a career-best 269 all-purpose yards. In the season finale against Hampton, he had a 60-yard touchdown reception and a 56-yard kick return.

- Brayboy also had touchdown receptions of at least 55 yards in wins over then-No. 5 William & Mary and Monmouth.

- One of six players in Elon's FCS history with at least 1,000 kickoff return yards, Brayboy is extremely dangerous on special teams.

- Brayboy is one of three players in the program's FCS history with both 1,000 career receiving yards and 1,000 career kickoff return yards. He joins Kierre Brown (1,977 receiving and 2,479 kickoff from 2010-14) and Michael Mayers (2,872 receiving and 1,582 kickoff from 2004-07) among that elite list.

TAKING CARE OF THE FOOTBALL

- Since 2021, Elon has thrown just 15 interceptions as a team. That includes five in 2021, four in 2022 and six in 2023.

- Over that time span, just one FCS program has thrown fewer interceptions. Kennesaw State, now transitioning to FBS Football, has thrown 14 interceptions over the past three seasons.

- By comparison, Elon threw 1,010 passes from 2021-23, while Kennesaw State attempted just 514 passes during that span.

- After Elon with 15 interceptions, Montana State has thrown 16 interceptions in the past three seasons. North Dakota State, North Dakota, South Dakota State and Dartmouth each have 17 interceptions, while Texas Southern has 18. Columbia and Princeton have 19 each to round out the group of schools with fewer than 20 interceptions.

A BAKER'S DOZEN

- Ok, maybe it's not 12 (or 13) transfers, but Elon did bring in two impact transfers with identical last names of Baker.

- Redshirt senior safety Khalil Baker gives Elon two former All-Americans in the secondary (along with Caleb Curtain). Baker played at North Carolina Central from 2019-23 and was named a 2022 AFCA All-American and Associated Press First Team All-American. He also earned the 2022 Aeneas Williams Award, given to the nation's best defensive back in HBCU Division I college football. He was limited a year ago due to injury but has played 37 career games and has five career interceptions.

- Senior Rushawn Baker is expected to contribute to the running game after playing in 30 games over three seasons at Bucknell. He rushed for 1,359 career yards and 15

touchdowns for the Bison, adding 26 career receptions.

WINNING IN THE TRENCHES

- Under Head Coach Tony Trisciani, Elon has been nearly unbeatable when winning in the trenches on at least one side of the ball.
- Elon is 8-0 when rushing for at least 200 yards in a game under Trisciani and 12-1 when holding opponents to fewer than 100 yards rushing. Elon's only loss in that scenario came in week one of the 2023 season against Wake Forest, as the Demon Deacons had just 98 yards on 2.8 yards per carry.
- Elon has reached both milestones in a game three times under Trisciani, two of which came in 2023.
- Against Gardner-Webb in 2022, Elon ran for 205 and held the Runnin' Bulldogs to 43. Against North Carolina A&T in 2023, Elon rushed for 260 and held the Aggies to 81 yards. The next week at Campbell, Elon ran for 242 yards and held the Camels to just 35 yards.

CURTAIN CALL

- Redshirt junior safety Caleb Curtain enters the 2024 season as one of the most decorated players in program history.
- Following a breakout season in 2023, Curtain was named a second team All-American by Stats Perform, the AFCA, the Associate Press and Phil Steele.
- Curtain led Elon with 80 tackles, including 54 solo. He had 6.5 for loss and 4.5 sacks. Curtain also led the CAA with four interceptions, had two fumbles recovered and six pass break-ups.
- Curtain got 2023 started in a big way with four tackles, a sack, and most importantly, a 50-yard interception return for a touchdown at Wake Forest in the season opener.
- Heading into 2024, Curtain earned even more recognition. He has been projected as the conference Defensive Player of the Year by the CAA and Phil Steele. He's also earned preseason First Team All-American status by Stats Perform and Phil Steele. Curtain is also a nominee for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team and is one of 30 on the watch list for the Buck Buchanan Award, given to the best defensive player in FCS Football.

EXPERIENCE ON THE OLINE

- Elon returns four starters on the offensive line and the Phoenix are extremely experienced up front, including three with more than 30 career starts under their belt.
- Zane Gilbert has started 37 consecutive games for the Phoenix on the offensive line and Jabril Williams adds 36 career starts. Kevin Burkett has 32 career starts, all consecutively as well. Add Jack Cutler's 13 career starts and the offensive line has 118 total starts.
- Gilbert and Williams were both named preseason all-conference by Phil Steele.

LINEBACKERS BRINGING IT

- Elon has strength at linebacker behind Freshmen All-Americans Marco Patierno and Brandon Tyson, combined with the return of redshirt junior Nic Veloz.

- Patierno was named a Freshman All-American last year by Stats Perform, FCS Football Central and Phil Steele, along with being one of 22 players recognized midseason as a candidate for the Jerry Rice Award, the FCS Freshman of the Year. He finished 2023 with 68 tackles and added a 23-yard fumble return for a touchdown against Hampton.
- Tyson was a second team Freshman All-American by Phil Steele after starting all 11 games and ending third on the team with 73 tackles, adding 9.0 tackles for loss. He closed 2023 with 11 tackles and a forced fumble against Hampton, earning CAA Defensive Player of the Week honors.
- Veloz has been limited to four games played in each of the last two seasons due to injury. His return, though, bolsters the linebacker unit as he has 78 career tackles in 24 career games, forcing three fumbles and recovering two.

THE BALL IS THE PROGRAM

- Under Head Coach Tony Trisciani, the Elon football program has been one of the best in the country in turnover margin.
- Elon has not had a negative turnover margin in Trisciani's tenure and has ranked in the top 25 in the country in each of the four fall seasons (2019, 2021-23) in which he has been the head coach. A year ago, Elon ranked 12th in FCS with a +0.64 turnover margin per game.
- Elon won the turnover battle seven times in 11 games in 2023 and has an active string of 20 games without committing more than two turnovers in any contest.
- Only four FCS programs have been +7 or better on turnover margin in each of the last three seasons. Elon joins North Dakota State, South Dakota State and Montana State in that elite group.

2024 ELON FOOTBALL

SACK MASTERS

- Elon ranked 21st in all of FCS Football in quarterback sacks a year ago, averaging 2.55 per game. The Phoenix had at least one sack in 10-of-11 games, peaking with seven in a win over Campbell.
- Fifteen different players were credited with at least 0.5 sack a year ago and the top returners include Caleb Curtain (4.5), Cazeem Moore (3.0), Jesse Powell II (2.0) and Josh Johnson (2.0).
- Elon is 11-1 in the tenure of Head Coach Tony Trisciani when recording four or more sacks in a game. The only loss in that time frame came when the team had 4.0 sacks a year ago in the season-opening loss to Wake Forest.
- Elon has ranked among the top 25 in the country in sacks in each of the last two years, finishing 13th with 2.83 sacks per game in 2022.

HIGH FIVE

- Discounting the abbreviated 2021 spring campaign, Elon has recorded at least five overall wins and four conference wins in five consecutive fall seasons.
- With five straight fall seasons of at least five overall wins and four conference wins, it is the longest streak of sustained success that Elon has seen since moving to FCS in 2000.

ABOUT THE PHOENIX

- In 1921, Elon's sports teams were first called the Fightin' Christians. As the department transitioned to NCAA Division I athletics in the late 1990s, a new nickname was sought out.
- A 15-member task force was selected to choose the new identity.
- In 2000, Elon officially changed its mascot to the Phoenix. The choice refers to a 1923 fire that consumed school records, classrooms, the library and the chapel. Trustees immediately voted to rebuild and Alamance County residents rallied to help raise funds. A new building opened in 1923, with four more buildings added between 1924 and 1925.
- The Phoenix's plumage matches the school's maroon and gold colors. Once every 500 years, when it felt its death approaching, the Phoenix would build a nest in an oak tree -- a link to the college name, Elon, which is Hebrew for oak.
- After being consumed in the nest by its own flames, the Phoenix would rise again to fly to the temple of the sun. The bird is a symbol of light, knowledge and everlasting vigor.
- **As there can only be one Phoenix at any time, please refer to the Phoenix in the singular.**

- Elon University has no connection to Elon Musk and the word Elon, in fact, is the Hebrew word for oak, as the school was founded in a grove of oak trees. Students receive an acorn during New Student Convocation and an oak sappling during Commencement Week to symbolize growth.
- Spike Lee filmed part of "He Got Game" on campus in 1997. Elon represented "Tech University" in the film, one of the schools that Ray Allen's character was invited to visit. Six Elon students landed speaking roles and four communications students had the opportunity to shadow the film's producer for the day.
- The CW's "The Flash" got his start at Elon. Actor Grant Gustin attended the University before he got his big break in television.
- Elon has been named one of the most beautiful campuses in the nation on multiple occasions and it is designated as a botanical garden. Elon's 690-acre campus includes the 56-acre Elon University Forest, and the Elon Environmental Center at Loy Farm. Elon's arborists maintain over 5,800 trees across 323 acres of the main campus, including 78 different genera of trees and 184 different species.
- Seattle Mariners pitcher George Kirby is an Elon alumnus. He holds the MLB record for throwing the most consecutive strikes to start a game (24 vs. the Washington Nationals on Aug. 24, 2022). 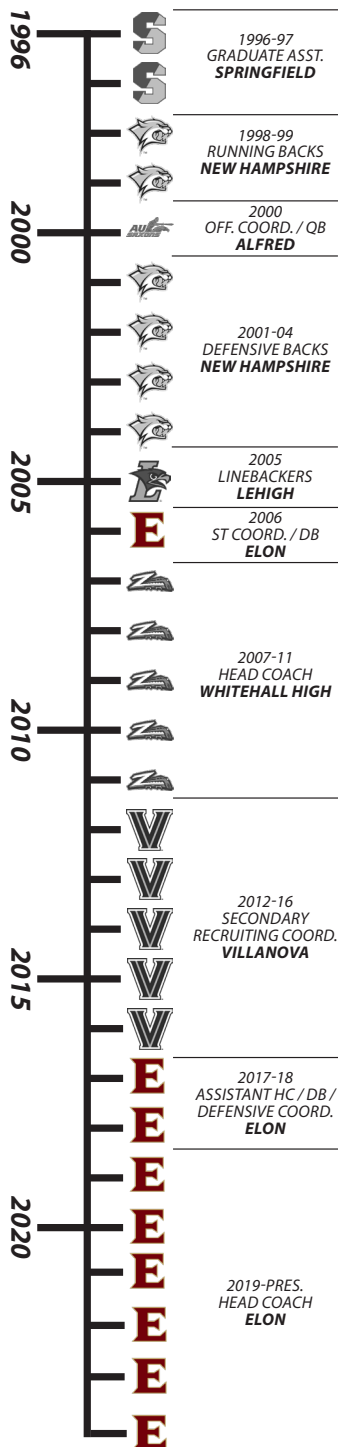
