

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Chris Pollard needs one win to become Duke's all-time winningest coach surpassing legendary head coach Jack Coombs with 381.

The number of new faces, both graduate and freshman, who made their Duke debut during Opening Weekend.

Junior Tyler Albright is ranked 21st in the country in home runs through the first three games of 2025.

LEADING OFF

- Duke continues a trend of scoring throughout the middle innings of games once again this season, scored 11 of their 22 (50.0%) runs this past weekend from the fourth to sixth inning.
- After already leading the program to its first three Super Regional appearances and a record six NCAA Tournament appearances, head coach Chris Pollard eyes one of the most coveted prizes on campus. Pollard enters the 2025 season two wins behind legendary head coach **Jack Coombs** for the most in program history. Additionally, Pollard is nearing his 800th career victory, beginning the season with 765 wins across 26 years of coaching.
- Historic Jack Coombs Field opens the 2025 season once again for the Blue Devils after undergoing the ground breaking of a newly renovated facilty. New to 2025, The Jack offers expanded sight lines, renovated and larger dugouts, new playing dimensions, updated fence design, and new playing surface. Phase two of the project will feature a new indoor hitting and pitching facility, before phase three encompasses the clubhouse and player areas.
- Two-way star, **Kyle Johnson**, has been a force at the plate since starting the 2025 season, posting a .250 average at the plate and hitting home runs in the past two games he has appeared in the field. On the mound, Johnson worked four innings on Opening Day, his first appearance on Opening Day in his career.
- Duke baseball continues to grow as a unit, as they downed UNCW on Tuesday at Jack Coombs Field. The Blue Devils played tight the first four innings of the contest, trailing 2-1 entering the sixth inning. Sophomore **Kyle Johnson** gave Duke a spark, hitting a two-run home run to left center field, before **Ben Miller** added a pair with his own two-run home run in the sixth. Former UNCW Seahawk right-handed pitcher **Ryan Calvert** earned the win in relief, working two innings and striking out one.
- Cornell opens the 2025 season this weekend in Durham, after a 17-21 record in 2024. The Big Red made a push in the Ivy League Tournament, defeating Princeton and Penn to advance to the Championship game against Penn. In game one, Cornell fell 11-9 to Penn, before Penn was able to pull away in game two, 12-6. Carson Mayfield takes the ball in game one, after posting a 8.55 ERA and a 2-2 record last season. On Saturday, Noah Keller takes the ball for Cornell, posting a 1-6 record and 6.55 ERA. On Sunday, Chris Ellison, who posted a 4-0 record and a 5.70 ERA on the season, will toe the rubber for the Big Red. Led by senior John Quinlan at the plate, he posted a .378 average in 33 starts, scoring 35 runs and leading the team with 56 hits. He collected nine doubles, two triples, and five home runs, adding 10 stolen bases.

GOLDEN DUO BEGIN YEAR TWO

The dynamic duo of **AJ Gracia** and **Kyle Johnson** begin either sophomore campaigns as two of the most highly recognized players at their position. Regarded by most as two of the top 15 best players in the 2026 MLB Draft, Gracia and Johnson were honored during the preseason as 2025 Preseason Golden Spikes Watch List members, joining 53 other collegiate baseball players across the country. The two had breakout seasons in year one with the Blue Devils, earning them a spot on the USA Collegiate National Team Summer Ball roster.

ALBRIGHT SHINES IN OPENING WEEKEND

A year removed from being shifted into a platoon role for the Blue Devils, junior **Tyler Albright** reminded people why he was one of the most successful freshman on Duke's 2023 roster. The outfielder has since transitioned from left field to center, and posted a .455 weekend at the plate against Cincinnati. Albright scored four runs, collected five hits, one double, a triple and two home runs. He drove in four RBI and walked two times, securing a slugging percentage over opening weekend of 1.273.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES ON DECK

Duke begins the season with rankings inside the top 12 in all five of the major publications, including the officially tally of No. 11 in the DIBaseball poll. Alongside of those honors, the Blue Devils stacked the preseason accolades led by sophomores **AJ Gracia** and **Kyle Johnson**. The duo was selected to Perfect Game's Preseason All-American teams, as well as earned Golden Spikes Watch List honors. Additionally, nine Blue Devils were named to DIBaseball's top position rankings and pitching rankings as **Macon Winslow** (37), **Jake Hyde** (11), **Ben Miller** (3), **Wallace Clark** (22), Gracia (10), **Ben Rounds** (50), Johnson (44), **Andrew Healy** (64) and **James Tallon** (112) all appeared on their respective position lists.

ACC TOURNAMENT MAKES A CHANGE

The Atlantic Coast Conference made a change to the ACC Tournament for the 2025 season alongside the addition of new conference mates Cal and Stanford, two squads the Blue Devils will face in the first two weekends of ACC play. New for the 2025 season, the Atlantic and Coastal divisions are no more. With that, the conference tournament held at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park at the end of May, expands to 16 teams. The entire league will participate in the conference tournament, eliminating pool play and moving to a single elimination tournament. The top four teams at the end of the regular season will earn spots in the quarterfinals played on Thursday or Friday, while the next four seeds earn spots in Wednesday's second round action. The final eight teams will begin tournament action on Tuesday, forcing the bottom half of the league to win five games to claim the automatic qualifier for the NCAA Tournament

MILESTONES ON DECK FOR THE SKIPPER

Head coach *Chris Pollard* returns and has his sights set on some major milestones at Duke. The 13th year skipper passed **Steve Traylor** (1988-99) for second all-time with 357 on Tuesday at Jack Coombs Field against Campbell. Pollard also is two wins away from passing legendary head coach **Jack Coombs** (1929-52) for first on the all-time Duke wins list with 382. The longtime Blue Devils coach has already taken the top spot for most ACC wins in

program history, entering the 2025 season with 154, and holds the most NCAA Tournament appearances with six. The last Duke head coach to make the NCAA Tournament five or more times during their tenure was **Ace Parker** (1953-66). In 2024, Pollard secured the second 40-plus win season in program history, behind the 2018 crew who tallied 45, the most in program lore.

SCORE FIRST, SCORE OFTEN

The name of the game is scoring first and scoring in bunches for the Blue Devils. Since 2016, Duke has compiled a 197-66 (.749) record when scoring first and a staggering 217-47 (.822) record when scoring three or more runs in an inning.

IVY PIPELINE RETURNS

Duke's Ivy League pipeline returns for the 2025 season, as **Ben Miller** (Penn) returns and **Ben Rounds** (Harvard), **Jake Berger** (Harvard), **Nick DiPietrantonio** (Princeton), and **Reid Easterly** (Yale) all joined the club.

10+ RUNS = WINS

Over the past two seasons, Duke has collected a record of 36-1 when scoring 10-plus runs in a contest. In 2023, the Blue Devils posted an impressive 18-0 record on the diamond, while in 2024 they tallied a mark of 18-1.

CAPTAIN CLARK IS BACK

Senior **Wallace Clark** returns for his senior season at Duke, following an impressive and dominate first year in Durham at shortstop. Born in London, Clark was a member of the 2024 British National Team in the Baseball World Cup in Shaoxing, China, where he started all eight games at shortstop. Clark tallied 24 hit by pitches during his first season at Duke, tallying the second most in a single season. The Tulsa, Okla., native posted a .451 on base percentage, adding 37 walks to his hit by pitch tally.

DURHAM SOUTH?

Following a trade just before the calendar switched to 2025, the Miami Marlins acquired their fourth active Blue Devil to the roster in the form of **Matt Mervis**. Mervis, who made his MLB Debut on May 5, 2023, against the Marlins in Wrigley Field, joins former Duke standouts **Jay Beshears, Graham Pauley**, and former collegiate teammate **Griffin Conine** in the organization. Throughout the 2024 MLB season, three additional Blue Devils joined Jarvis and Mervis in the past two seasons to make their MLB Debut. Conine, Pauley and **Joey Loperfido**, rounded out the five former players that became big leaguers.

DUKE TO THE PROS

Since 2014, the Blue Devils have had 46 players selected in the MLB Draft and an additional four free agent signings. Out of those 46 selected players, 31 have been pitchers and the five selected in 2024 were fourth in the country behind LSU (8), Mississippi State (8) and Oklahoma State (6). The Blue Devils welcomed three additional MLB Alumni during the 2024 MLB season, bringing the total number the past two years to five debuts.

the Blue Devils staff this season, after the departure of Ty **Blankmeyer** heading to Vanderbilt. Simmons joined the Blue Devils' staff after a five-year stint at Indiana and will coordinate all developmental aspects for the infielders and lead training protocols for baserunning. The 13-year coaching veteran has thrived on the recruiting front in previous stops, securing a pair of top 25 classes to go along with four other top classes. In 2023, the Hoosiers class was tabbed as the 17th best class in the country, the highest in Indiana program history.

NEW LOOK COOMBS

Following the 2024 season, Duke began renovations on Historic Jack Coombs Field. The new facility includes upgraded dugouts, a new indoor training lab, training room, coaches offices, team room, club house and suites. Along with upgrading all of that, seating will be expanded in the coming years to create what head coach *Chris Pollard* calls "The Cameron Indoor of College Baseball". Construction began on August 12, 2024, as Coombs was treated to updated dimensons, a new playing surface, and MLB quality dugouts.

KICK THE DOOR DOWN

Duke baseball has been knocking on the door of Omaha since head coach *Chris Pollard* arrivied in Durham, but has yet to get past the threshold. Following the 2023 Super Regional appearance in Charlottesville, Pollard coined a phrase that has resonated through the program, "Kick the Door Down".

FRIDAY NIGHT ACE

- For the first time in his career, sophomore **Kyle Johnson** will toe the rubber on Opening Day, earning the start after an impressive freshman campaign and eye raising preseason.
- Johnson finished his first season with the Blue Devils becoming the first Freshman All-American Utility player since Marcus Stroman in 2010. He completed his rookie season with a 4-1 record on the mound, posting a 4.38 ERA in 10 starts. In his 49.1 innings of work, He allowed 44 hits and held a 2.79 strikeout to walk ratio.

LIGHTS OUT THURSDAY NIGHT

• In his first "Friday Night Ace" start during his freshman campaign, Johnson pitched his best game of his young career against North Carolina at Jack Coombs Field. The lefty posted a career-high six innings and eight strikeouts, setting the tone for a series opening win over the Tar Heels.

TEAM USA SUMMER

• Both halves of the Blue Devils dynamic duo earned invitations to the 2024 USA Collegiate National Training Camp this past summer, as Johnson and **AJ Gracia** were selected to the summer ball roster. The Leesburg, Va., product began the summer with the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod League, before joining the US Collegiate National Team Camp in Cary. With USA Baseball, Johnson posted a 1-0 record on the mound, striking out four batters in two innings of work.

2026 DRAFT PROSPECT ON THE HORIZON

• After being tabbed as the 15th-ranked sophomore in his class by Perfect Game and the 44th-ranked Starting Pitcher by D1Baseball, Johnson has been tabbed as one of the most highly rated collegiate prospects. The lefty is one of two Blue Devils in the top 20 of the 2026 Perfect Game draft boards, being rated as the 16th-best prospect and listed as a twoway player.

• One of the most electric arms in the Blue Devils bullpen begins the 2025 season in a new role, making just his second career start on Sunday afternoon at Jack Coombs Field. **James Tallon** has appeared in 47 games for the Blue Devils over his first two seasons, making his first career start on Championship Sunday against Florida State in the ACC Tournament. Tallon has now transitioned into a full-time starter to begin the 2025 campaign and looks to take another huge leap forward in his development.

THE FORMER CLOSER STARTS ACC CHAMPIONSHIP

• In his first career start, and pitching on short rest, Tallon did exactly what he needed to guide Duke to its second ACC Tournament Championship and a perfect 8-0 combined record in Charlotte during ACC play. The lefty was selected as a Freshman All-American in his first season at Duke, as well as earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors and All-ACC Second Team recognition.
- The Arlington, Va., product was tabbed as a finalist for the Stopper of the Year award in his first campaign, as he and Beilenson were back-to-back finalists in consecutive seasons, before appearing on the Stopper of the Year Watch List to start the 2024 season.


