NUMBERS TO KNOW

10+ The Blue Devils have scored double-digit runs in each of their last three outings, with their only loss in that span coming by one run, 12-11, at Florida State. Duke then defeated the Seminoles, 11-4, in the series finale and then beat Davidson, 14-9

115 Duke leads the ACC, and ranks second nationally, with 115 stolen bases already this season. The Blue Devils have matched the program's single-season record, reaching the 106 mark at Florida State

35 Duke senior Tyler Albright is tied for the national lead for total walks (35) and is tied for eighth in the country for walks per game (1.17). The outfielder was moved to the leadoff spot on March 13, with his on-base abilities making an immediate impact

LEADING OFF

- Duke opens April with its first home ACC series since March 13-15, after spending the last two weekends on the road. The Blue Devils welcome Louisville to Jack Coombs Field for a Thursday-Saturday series, the first meeting between the two teams since a three-game sweep by Duke, all by a single run, during the 2023 season.

- The Blue Devils claimed a 14-9 victory over Davidson in the middle of the week, with Michael DiMartini highlighting Duke's offense, as the outfielder slugged two home runs and added a double for a 3-for-5 day at the plate.

- On the basepaths, Duke set a new program record for stolen bases in a season, with a double steal in the first inning moving the Blue Devils' season total to 108, surpassing the previous record of 106. Duke finished the contest with nine total stole bases, moving its season total to 115 entering the weekend.

- Last weekend, the Blue Devils took one of three on the road at 10th-ranked Florida State winning the Sunday finale, 11-4. The Seminoles took the first two games by just four combined runs, 3-1 and 12-11, before Duke claimed the final game by seven runs. The Blue Devils emerged from their first series against a ranked opponent this season with a victory and impressive performances at the plate and on the mound.

- Friday starter **Aidan Weaver** punched out a career-high 11 across 5.2 innings, while giving up just two runs. **Andy Leon** matched his career high for punchouts in Sunday's affair, as the graduate tallied nine K's in 5.1 innings of three-hit ball.

- **Matthew Strand** finished the month of March as the Blue Devils' leading hitter, slashing .365/.423/.794 across 16 games. All seven of his home runs, and 22 of his 24 RBI, came during March and two of his homers were grand slams against ACC competition. The transfer from Samford is also a perfect 4-for-4 on stolen-base attempts and logged a .985 fielding percentage, with just two errors

- **Brooks Perez** led all Duke batters during the weekend, slashing .600/.615/.900, with two extra-bases knocks and five RBI. The freshman has reached double-digit RBI for the season, with 10, and has demonstrated a high level of patience at the plate as well, with 25 walks already in his rookie campaign.

- Outfielder **Michael DiMartini** also made an impact at the plate against the Seminoles, with three doubles and a home run helping the junior to a 1.100 slugging percentage. His home run, on Saturday, helped Duke keep pace with a dynamic Florida State offense and his 11 total bases across the three games led the Blue Devils. DiMartini continued his power surge, blasting home runs in back-to-back plate appearances against Davidson, with his first one clocking in at just under 450 feet.

- Through 30 games Duke outfielder **Tyler Albright** has already worked 35 walks this season, which is tied for the national lead. The senior is over 75% of the way to his previous season-high of 45, set last year in 62 games. The outfielder moved to leadoff to open the Miami series, with Albright's patience at the plate and base-running ability cited by Duke head coach **Corey Muscara** for the shift in lineup. Albright has also absorbed three hit-by-pitches, and currently holds the best on-base percentage of his career (.481)

- Shortstop **Jake Lambdin** moved down in the order with the lineup change and has grown more comfortable at the plate with the shift. The Xavier transfer is slashing .257/.379/.514, hit his fourth homer of the season at High Point on March 10, leads the team in doubles (13) and is 16-of-17 on the basepaths.

- **Collin Anderson** has taken over at second base, with RJ Hamilton playing more consistently in the outfield. Anderson is slashing .271/.353/.492 this month and hit his third homer of the season at High Point. The freshman has only committed one error, logged back-to-back multi-RBI performances against Miami, and has reached double-digit RBI, with 12 in 18 games.

SCORE FIRST, SCORE OFTEN

The name of the game is scoring first and scoring in bunches for the Blue Devils. Since 2016, Duke has compiled a 233-76 (.754) record when scoring first and a staggering 263-56 (.825) record when scoring three or more runs in an inning.

10+ RUNS = WINS

Since 2023, Duke has collected a record of 65-2 (.970) when scoring 10-plus runs in a contest. In 2023, the Blue Devils posted an impressive 18-0 record on the diamond, while in 2024 they tallied a mark of 18-1. In 2025, the Blue Devils tallied a 20-0 record when scoring 10-plus runs in a contest. So far this season, Duke is 8-1 when reaching the threshold, with the lone loss coming in a one-run defeat, 12-11, at No. 10 Florida State.

WALKING OFF AS WINNERS

Duke has registered three walk-off victories so far this season, with two coming in ACC play. **Kaden Smith** plated the winning run with a single against Notre Dame. **Coach Muscara's** first conference victory of his head coaching tenure. **Brooks Perez** left the yard in the bottom of the seventh against Miami, putting Duke up by 10 runs. Smith once again played the hero against East Carolina, with a three-run shot with one out and the Blue Devils trailing by two.

WINNING BY RUN RULE

Duke run-ruled Miami last Sunday, 20-10, with at least two runs in four of its six trips to the plate. Six different players with at least two RBI, led by **Matthew Strand's** six-RBI day with a grand slam in the first inning and a two-run homer in the third inning. **Kaden Smith** and **Brooks Perez** joined Strand in leaving the yard, with Smith tallying his third homer of his season and Perez ending the game in the bottom of the seventh with a two-run shot. The Blue Devils have tallied four run-rule victories so far this season.

RUNNIN' WILD

A key philosophy under Coach Muscara will be Duke's aggressiveness on the basepaths. Through 31 games, the Blue Devils have demonstrated the willingness to run at any given moment, with 115 stolen bases - a new single-season program record that ranks second nationally and tops the ACC.

CONTINUED COOMBS CONSTRUCTION

Renovations began following the 2024 season, and the 2025 season saw updated dimensions, a new playing surface and MLB quality dugouts. New to Coombs this year is Duke's bullpen behind the left field fence and construction began on the David Koch Jr. Player Performance Center on Feb. 23, with expected completion in mid to late November 2026.

PLAYER PERFORMANCE CENTER 101

The 8,000 square foot facility, designed by EwingCole and built by LeChase Construction Services, will feature a pitching lab, hitting lab, and training lab, with direct access to Jack Coombs Field. Duke student-athletes will be able to utilize several developmental technologies, including Trajekt, iPitch, NewtForce, Trackman and KinaTrax.

Through seven starts this season, **Aidan Weaver** has earned the victory in four appearances, embracing the Friday role. Weaver opened the season with 5.0 innings against Maine, striking out four and allowed two earned runs. The following Friday, Weaver once again went 5.0 innings, with nine K's and another pair of earned runs. Against Princeton, he posted a career-high 7.0 innings and 89 pitches, while striking out another nine batters and walking just one. His best outing of the year so far came in Duke's shutout win over Miami, where Weaver threw the first six innings, allowing just two hits and striking out eight.

The senior punched out double-digit hitters for the first time in his career with 11 K's at Florida State, in 5.2 innings of work, while allowing just two runs on four hits

MORE ON WEAVER

Coach Muscara has praised Weaver in the preseason for embracing multiple changes to his delivery, including a move to the first-base side of the rubber. The shift has allowed Weaver's pitch mix (fast-ball, slider, changeup) to work more effectively for batters on both side of the plate

LEON STEADY AS HE GOES

The Blue Devils' typical Sunday starter, **Andy Leon**, continues to build up his pitch limit after undergoing internal brace surgery last season. The Columbia transfer has not slowed his production, regardless of limits, punching out 32 across 29.0 innings. In his win against Milwaukee, Leon faced one over the minimum after a single HBP and exiting after 4.0 innings and 60 pitches without allowing a hit. At 10th-ranked Florida State, Leon struck out nine and allowed just one run in 5.1 innings to help Duke take the series finale, 11-4.

INNOVATING THE LEADERSHIP MODEL IN COLLEGE BASEBALL

The Blue Devils signaled its intentional investment in its student-athletes with the announcement of **Mike Salvino** as the program's General Manager. Salvino will help ensure Duke competes at the highest level, while positioning each individual for meaningful careers and impact through the "Beyond Baseball" framework. Salvino steps into the role with a goal of building championship teams while also mentoring student-athletes on how to grow their personal brands and prepare for professional careers beyond the game.

TWO PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Michael DiMartini and Cider Canon both earned preseason All-America nods from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA). DiMartini, a transfer from Dayton, earned 1st Team All-America recognition after hitting .403 in 55 games as a sophomore. He logged 11 doubles, seven triples and 14 home runs, while tallying 65 RBI and an 1.150 OPS. Canon, who was recruited out of high school as a catcher, picked up Fourth Team honors following a sophomore campaign highlighted by a .371 average in 48 games, with 16 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs and a 1.193 OPS.
