#### **OPENING KICKOFF**

- ► The Dukes advance to the second round of the FCS Playoffs at No. 5 South Dakota State after posting their first FCS Playoff win in program history with a 31-10 victory at No. 16/19 Towson last week.
- ► After falling behind 10-0, Duquesne scored 31 unanswered points en route to the triumph over the Tigers.
- ► A.J. Hines finished with 246 yards from scrimmage with a pair of touchdowns in the victory. The Dukes limited Towson - the top scoring team in the CAA (36.7 ppg) - to a season-low 10 points.
- ► The Dukes are making their second trip to the FCS postseason after also qualifying in 2015. Duquesne earned the Northeast Conference's automatic bid as the Dukes secured their fifth NEC title.
- ► South Dakota State is making its seventh straight appearance in the FCS Playoffs. The Jackrabbits, an at-large selection out of the Missouri Valley Football Conference, earned a seed in the postseason for the third year in a row.

- Ranked second on the team with 59 total tackles including 41 solo stops, 11 tackles for loss in 2017
- Finished the season tied for fifth in the NEC with 11 tackles for loss and 20th in the league with 59 tackles

## **OUICK HITS**

- ▶ The Dukes earned their first win over a ranked opponent with the victory at Towson, improving to 1-5 in those games.
- ▶ Duquesne qualifies for the FCS Playoffs for the second time in program history. Northeast Conference teams are 2-8 all-time in the FCS Playoffs. Wagner earned the other win with a 31-20 victory over Colgate in 2012.
- ► The Dukes are looking to become the first team from the NEC to advance to the FCS quarterfinals. Wagner dropped a 29-19 decision at Eastern Washington in 2012 after defeating Colgate at home
- ▶ The Dukes have enjoyed a great deal of success in NEC play, claiming five conference titles since 2011. Duquesne won a share of the league crown in 2011, 2013, 2016 and 2018 while capturing the outright title in 2015, earning the NEC's automatic bid to the FCS playoffs along with this season.
- ► The Dukes are 19-5 in NEC action since the beginning of the 2015 campaign, including a 10-2 mark at Rooney Field.
- ▶ Duquesne is receiving votes in both the STATS FCS Top 25 & AFCA Coaches' Poll.
- ▶ DU has recorded 59 wins since 2011, at least eight more victories than any other NEC team. In addition, the Dukes' 35 conference wins in that time span are the most in the league.
- ► A.J. Hines picked up his fourth NEC Offensive Player of the Week award in a row after recording 213 yards with a touchdown on the ground in the win over Sacred Heart.
- ► Hines is fourth in the country in rushing yards per game, averaging 136.3 yards per contest.
- ► In the six conference games this season, Hines averaged 165.3 yards on the ground with nine rushing scores.
- ► The Dukes are 7-0 this season when A.J. Hines has at least 100 yards rushing.
- ▶ Nehari Crawford paced the NEC and ranks 20th in the FCS with 1,017 receiving yards on the season. Crawford's 25 receiving touchdowns since the start of last season are the most at the FCS level.
- ▶ Duquesne has won six straight games and is 9-1 against non-FBS opponents.
- ▶ With the Dukes looking for some depth at the running back position a few weeks ago against Robert Morris, defensive back **Daquan Worley** made his debut in the DU backfield, recording seven carries for 96 yards with two touchdowns, including a 52-yard rushing score. He added 89 yards on six carries at Wagner.
- ▶ DU linebacker **Brett Zanotto** is fifth in the NEC with 86 tackles on the season while cornerback **Jonathant Istache** leads the conference with four interceptions. His 18 passes defended also lead the NEC and rank fifth in the FCS.
- ▶ Duquesne is fifth in the FCS in kick return defense (15.4 ypr) and 15th in third down conversion percent (45.9 pct).

- ▶ Duquesne faced a pair of Biletnikoff Award semifinalists this season when taking on its FBS opponents in Andy Isabella (UMass) and John Ursua (Hawaii).
- ► The Dukes had six games at Rooney Field in 2018 (three non-conference matchups, three NEC contests) in addition to the game at Saint Francis U. This comes a year after DU played seven road games in seven different states in 2017.

- ► Duquesne returns 12 starters from last year's team which posted a 7-4 overall mark and a 4-2 ledger in Northeast Conference play.
- ▶ The Dukes have registered at least seven total victories in four straight seasons and six of the last eight years. In a season with two games against FBS teams, DU earned its seventh win with a victory over Sacred Heart.
- ▶ In the Dukes' game against Bryant, Duquesne sported new helmet decals, wearing red jersey numbers on the left side with a transparent "D" logo with blue outline on the right side. The back of the helmet featured a blue Pittsburgh city skyline silhouette.
- ▶ The Dukes are 1-1-2 all-time in December. Saturday is just their second game in December since 1939, as Duquesne fell to Sacred Heart in the 2001 ECAC Classic. The Dukes' lone win in December came at Mississippi State in 1937.

## HISTORY MADE DUKES 31, #16/19 TOWSON 10 NOV. 24, 2018

- ▶ Duquesne scored 31 unanswered points and held No. 16/19 Towson scoreless in the second half, as the Dukes won their first FCS Playoff game in program history.
- ▶ A.J. Hines finished with 246 yards from scrimmage with a pair of touchdowns to lead the Dukes in the triumph.
- ▶ The victory over Towson also marks Duquesne's first over a ranked team in the FCS era.
- ► The Tigers gained a 10-0 first half lead on Tom Flacco's 34-yard touchdown pass to Jabari Allen in the first quarter before a 26-yard field goal by Aidan O'Neill with just over seven minutes to play in the first half.
- ► Towson was on the doorstep again on its next drive, looking to extend its advantage when Brandon Stanback forced and recovered a fumble on the Dukes' one-yard line.
- ► Forcing a punt on the Tigers' next possession, the Dukes gained some momentum into the break, marching 65 yard in nine plays as **Mitch MacZura** connected on a 32-yard field goal as time expired.
- ▶ Duquesne continued that push into the second half, as **Daquan Worley** broke off a 48-yard touchdown run to knot the score at 10-10.
- ▶ The Duquesne defense would force a three-andout before Hines hauled in a screen pass from Parr, taking it 71 yards to pay dirt to give the Dukes their first lead of the contest at 17-10 with just under 10 minutes to play in the third quarter.

THE SERIES

- ▶ Duquesne continued its ground-and-pound approach in to the fourth quarter as a three-yard Parr touchdown run extended the Dukes' advantage to 24-10.
- ▶ After the Dukes forced a Tiger turnover on downs in their own territory later in the quarter, Hines found the end zone for the second time on the day, this time on a three-yard rush to push the Duquesne lead to 31-10 with just over three minutes to play.
- ► The Dukes held Towson scoreless in the final 37:07 of the contest, limiting the Tigers to 33 yards in the third quarter. Outside of the Tigers' final 73-yard drive late in the fourth quarter, Duquesne limited Towson to 36 second-half yards.
- ▶ Hines finished with 28 carries for 175 yards and a rushing touchdown to go with the 71-yard touchdown reception. Worley added eight carries for 78 yards.
- ► The Dukes limited Towson quarterback Tom Flacco who came into the game third in the FCS in total offense at 348.0 yards per game to 127 passing and 38 rushing yards, his lowest total output of the year.
- ▶ Duquesne outgained the Tigers 426-357 in the win, including advantages of 282-230 on the ground and 144-127 through the air.
- ► The Dukes held Towson the top scoring team in the Colonial Athletic Association (36.7 ppg) to its lowest scoring output of the season of 10 points.

## GAME COVERAGE

- ► This is the third meeting between the two schools.
- ► The Dukes and No. 4/6 Jackrabbits met in the 2017 season opener in Brookings, with South Dakota State claiming a 51-13 victory. It was the first of 11 wins last season for **John Stiegelmeier's** Jackrabbits.
- ▶ Duquesne also hosted the Jackrabbits on Nov. 11, 1932 with the Dukes claiming a 34-12 victory at Forbes Field in Pittsburgh. The Dukes went on to finish with a 7-2-1 ledger that season under head coach Elmer Layden.

## NATIONAL EXPOSURE

- ► The Dukes will appear on ESPN3 for the fifth time this season and for the 17th time since the start of the 2016 campaign.
- ► In addition, the matchup with Hawaii was available nationally on the Stadium App via Spectrum Sports while the UMass game was able to be viewed on DirecTV through Eleven Sports.

## **@DUQFB HISTORY**

- ► The Dukes posted a 13-12 victory over Mississippi State in the 1937 Orange Bowl in Miami, Fla.
- ► In 1934, Duquesne topped Miami (Fla.) 33-7 in the Festival of Palms Bowl. The following season, Dukes head coach Elmer Layden accepted the head coaching position at Notre Dame.
- ► Following an 8-0-1 finish in 1939, the Dukes rejected a proposition to appear in the Cotton Bowl against Boston College after bowl administrators failed to meet a DU imposed deadline.
- ▶ Duquesne was named the 2003 I-AA Mid-Major National Champion following its undefeated 5-0 MAAC finish and 12-10 win over Monmouth in the ECAC Classic.
- ► In the Dukes' FCS era, Duquesne has won 16 conference championships (11 MAAC titles, five NEC titles)

### BREAKDOWN BY NCAA AFFILIATION

Football on the Duquesne campus began in the fall of 1891, with detailed results not recorded until 1902. DU has played at the Major College level (1902-50), as a club team (1969-78) and at the NCAA Division III level (1979-92). Duquesne, which competed at the NCAA FCS non-scholarship level from 1993-2007, began offering scholarships at the FCS level prior to the 2008 season.

## **SCOUTING SOUTH DAKOTA STATE**

- ► The Jackrabbits finished the regular season with an 8-2 overall record and a 6-2 ledger in the Missouri Valley Football Conference (MVFC).
- ► South Dakota State's losses came at the hands of top-ranked North Dakota State and Northern Iowa, another FCS Playoff team. SDSU has been ranked as high as No. 2 in the country this season.
- ► The Jackrabbits are making their seventh straight FCS Playoff appearance. Last season they advanced to the semifinals, falling to James Madison 51-16.
- ► SDSU boasts the third-ranked scoring offense in the FCS, averaging 45.4 ppg. The Jackrabbits are fifth in the country in total offense (511.2 ypg) and in turnover margin (1.45).
- ► Signal-caller **Taryn Christion** is a three-time Walter Payton Award finalist. He is third in the nation in pass efficiency (169.5), fifth in touchdowns (28) and in points responsible for per game (19.8).
- ► He holds MVFC career records for touchdown passes (100), passing yards (11,064) and total offense (12,461 yards).
- ▶ Wide receiver Cade Johnson is third in the FCS with 15 receiving touchdowns and seventh in the country averaging 107.2 receiving yards per game.
- ► Running back **Pierre Strong Jr.** was named the MVFC Freshman of the Year after leading the team with 777 rushing yards with eight touchdowns.
- ▶ Linebacker Christian Rozeboom collected first-team all-MVFC honors for the third time. He leads the team with 73 tackles, including 4.5 tackles for loss, to go with two interceptions and a fumble recovery.

## LAST MEETING #4/6 SOUTH DAKOTE STATE 51, DUKES 13 AUG. 31, 2017

- ► South Dakota State scored the game's first 34 points, scoring three touchdowns in the opening quarter followed by two scores in the second stanza en route to a 51-13 victory over the Dukes in the 2017 season opener.
- ► The Jackrabbits, the highest-ranked Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) opponent Duquesne has ever faced, came into the game fourth in the STATS FCS Top 25 and sixth in the FCS Coaches Poll.
- ► The Dukes would answer with their first score when quarterback **Tommy Stuart** connected with junior wide receiver **Nehari Crawford** on a two-yard touchdown pass with 2:22 to play in the first half.
- ▶ After taking the 34-7 advantage into the locker room, SDSU added two more touchdowns to open the second half to push its lead to 48-7.
- ▶ Duquesne responded with another Stuart touchdown pass, this time to junior **Kareem Coles Jr.** over the middle on a 31-yard strike.
- ► The Jackrabbits closed scoring with a 23-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter.

- ▶ Duquesne running back A.J. Hines was named the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) FCS National Player of the Week, the organization announced on Monday.
- ► Hines finished with 246 yards from scrimmage with a pair of touchdowns in Duquesne's 31-10 victory in the FCS Playoffs at No. 16/19 Towson on Saturday afternoon.
- ► The NEC Offensive Player of the Year tallied 175 yards on the ground on 28 carries with a rushing score to go with a 71-yard touchdown reception, helping the Dukes secure their first-ever FCS Playoff win.
- ▶ Averaging 6.3 yards per carry against the Tigers, he rushed for nine first downs in the triumph.
- ► His 71-yard touchdown reception in the third quarter gave the Dukes the lead for good at 17-10. In addition, his three-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter put the game out of reach.

- ► Hines, the 2016 Jerry Rice Award winner, is the third Duquesne player in as many years to be recognized as a finalist for the Payton Award, joining quarterbacks **Dillon Buechel** in 2016 and **Tommy Stuart** last season.
- ► This marks Schmitt's second nod as a finalist for STATS FCS Coach of the Year, as he was also recognized in 2015. He guided the Dukes to their fifth NEC title in eight years this season, as Duquesne posted a 5-1 ledger in conference action.

## PARR EARNS NEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK ACCOLADES

- ► Quarterback **Daniel Parr** was named the NEC Co-Offensive Player of the Week for his performance in the Dukes' NEC title-clinching win at CCSU on Nov. 17.
- ▶ Parr threw for 277 yards and accounted for three total touchdowns in the championship-clinching win over the defending champion Blue Devils.
- ▶ He was responsible for seven third-down conversions in the second half, the last of which lifted the Dukes into the FCS Playoffs. On 3rd-and-8, Parr connected with **Nehari Crawford** across the middle on a 56-yard scoring strike which put Duquesne on top 38-31 with just 24 ticks remaining in the contest.

## HINES IS 4X NEC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ► A.J. Hines earned his fourth Northeast Conference Offensive Player of the Week nod this season following the Sacred Heart game.
- ► Hines registered 213 yards with a touchdown on 31 carries. He went over 200 yards from scrimmage for the fourth consecutive week, helping Duquesne win its fourth consecutive contest to move to 4-1 in NEC play.
- ► This marked Hines' fifth career NEC Player of the Week nod which represents a new Duquesne record.

- ► He passed quarterback **Sean Patterson** (2009-12) for the most in school history.
- ► His also passes running back **Rafiq Douglas** (three in 2015) for the most NEC Offensive Player of the Week awards in a single season in program history.

## HINES CLIMBS RECORD BOOKS; AMONG FCS CAREER LEADERS

- ▶ Running back A.J. Hines (Wilson, N.C./Fike) returns for his junior campaign at Duquesne having compiled 3,828 career rushing yards with 38 touchdowns.
- ► Hines ranks second in school history in career rushing touchdowns and fourth in career rushing yards.
- ► Eclipsing the 1,000-mark for the season in the week 11 win over Sacred Heart, Hines became just the second player in program history to post three straight 1,000-yard rushing seasons. He and Duquesne's all-time leading rusher Larry McCoy (2009-12) are the only two players in school history to do so.
- ► As a sophomore, the former Jerry Rice Award winner finished with 1,038 yards with 10 rushing touchdowns in 10 games played.
- ▶ In his last six games, Hines has rushed for 1,092 yards with nine touchdowns to go with a pair of receiving scores. His six consecutive 100-yard rushing performances are the most for the Dukes in the FCS era. Hines also posted five straight 100-yard games as a freshman in 2016.
- ▶ The Wilson, N.C. has tallied 20 100-yard rushing games in his career, good for third in school history.

- ▶ He turned in a career performance in the Dukes' win over Dayton, tallying 11 catches for 223 yards and a pair of touchdowns. For his showing, he was named the NEC Co-Offensive Player of the Week.
- ► The Fort Pierce, Fla. native has 10 career 100-yard games and nine career games with multiple receiving touchdowns.
- ► He ranks among the program's all-time leaders in several receiving categories.

## NEC FEATURES THREE OF THE TOP SIX RUNNING BACKS IN THE FCS

- ► Three players from the NEC rank in the top six in the country in yards per game this season in Wagner's Ryan Fulse (2nd 162.2 ypg), A.J. Hines (2nd 136.3 ypg) and Sacred Heart's Jordan Meachum (6th 126.9 ypg).
- ► Hines leads the trio with 15 rushing touchdowns, good for fifth in the country, while CCSU sophomore running back **Aaron Dawson** is tied for ninth in the FCS with 13 rushing scores.

## **VETERANS LEAD DUQUESNE O-LINE**

▶ A big part of Duquesne's success running the ball this season is due to the experienced offensive line led by left tackle **Alex Conley** and left guard **Matt Fitzpatrick**. who are each in their third year starting for the Dukes.

- ▶ The pair helped the Dukes pace the NEC in rushing in each of the last two seasons. This season, Duquesne has rushed for over 200 yards five times, three of those coming in conference games in addition to the FCS Playoff win over Towson. DU has allowed two-or-fewer sacks in seven contests on the year.
- ► Conley and Fitzpatrick have blocked for 20 100-yard rushing performances for running back **A.J. Hines**, including a three touchdown, 232-yard performance in the win over Wagner.
- ► Right tackle Nick Jordan and center Gabe Spurlock are in their second season starting for the Dukes, while right guards Collin Wittig and Lyle Petrosky have seen a great deal of playing time for Duquesne up front.
- ► Also playing key roles in the run and pass block game for the Dukes are tight ends Stew Allen, Bill O'Malley and Jake Dixon.

## PARR TAKES OVER UNDER CENTER

- ► For the second straight season, the Dukes entered the year looking to replace their signal-caller from the previous campaign. Head coach Jerry Schmitt and offensive coordinator Anthony Doria looked to Florida Atlantic junior transfer Daniel Parr to fill the void.
- ▶ Parr was 58-of-111 with four touchdowns in two seasons at FAU. He started the first three games of the 2017 season against Navy, Wisconsin and Bethune-Cookman while appearing in eight games total.
- ► In his first season with the Dukes, Parr is 174-of-287 for 2287 yards with 20 touchdowns.
- ► He sits second in the conference and ranks 18th in the nation in pass efficiency (144.3).
- ▶ Parr threw for a career-high 333 yards with three touchdowns, completing 21-of-27 pass attempts in Duquesne's 31-26 victory over Dayton.

## ZANOTTO ANCHORS DUKES DEFENSE

- ▶ Middle linebacker **Brett Zanotto** has paced the Duquesne defense so far this season, as Zanotto has registered a 86 tackles (team-high 53 solo).
- ► Zanotto, a Second Team All-NEC selection this year, is in his second season with the Dukes after transferring from Maryland. He ranked second on the team in 2017 with 59 stops (41 solo).

- ► Zanotto, a Franklin Regional graduate and DU captain was tied for fifth in the NEC in 2017 with 11 tackles for loss. He moved from outside linebacker to the mike position for the 2018 season.
- ► He finished with a career-high 11 tackles (eight solo) at Hawaii following a 10-tackle performance in the win over Dayton.

# DEMEDAL, FITZPATRICK NAMED NAMED TO GOOGLE CLOUD ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT® TEAM

- ▶ Duquesne defensive back **Spencer DeMedal** and offensive lineman **Matt Fitzpatrick** each earned Google Cloud Academic All-District® honors, the organization announced last week.
- ► The 2018 Google Cloud Academic All-District® Football Team, selected by CoSIDA, recognizes the nation's top student-athletes for their combined performances on the field and in the classroom.
- ▶ DeMedal and Fitzpatrick were named to the District 2 Team which encompasses schools from Pennsylvania along with Delaware, Kentucky, Maryland, New Jersey, Washington, D.C. and West Virginia.
- ▶ This marks Fitzpatrick's second-straight Academic All-District honor. The two-time All-NEC selection graduated in May with a 3.79 grade point average as a Finance major and is currently enrolled in Duquesne's graduate program in Biomedical Engineering.
- ▶ DeMedal is just one of three sophomores in District 2 to garner the academic accolade. He has posted a 3.96 GPA in Biology.
- ▶ Both Fitzpatrick and DeMedal will now be included on the national Academic All-America ballot which will be voted on by the College Sports Information Director's of America, with the Google Cloud Academic All-America® Team to be announced on Dec. 10.

## **COMEBACK DUKES**

- ▶ Duquesne has come from behind in six of its nine victories this season, including deficits of 10 against Towson, seven at CCSU, nine at Wagner, 10 at Saint Francis U, seven vs. Robert Morris and seven against Valparaiso early in the season.
- ► After falling behind 10-0, the Dukes scored 31 unanswered in the FCS Playoff triumph at Towson.

- ▶ Duquesne is 5-1 when its opponents score first and 3-1 when the opponent leads after the first quarter.
- ► However, the opponent has led at the half in all three of the Dukes' losses this season.

## @DUQFB BATTLES TOE-TO-TOE WITH FBS HAWAII

- ▶ Duquesne forced three first-quarter Hawaii miscues to jump out to a 14-0 lead over the FBS Rainbow Warriors, but the high-powered Hawaii offense would score 35 unanswered points en route to the 42-21 victory on Saturday night at Aloha Stadium.
- ▶ Playing in front of the homecoming crowd of 26,175, the Dukes immediately gained momentum on the first drive of the game as defensive back **Jonathant Istache** picked off Hawaii quarterback Cole McDonald in the end zone with the Rainbow Warriors threatening early.
- ► Following a Duquesne punt, the Dukes would force another Hawaii turnover when **Leandro DeBrito** forced a fumble by Rainbow Warrior wide receiver Cedric Byrd which was picked up by fellow defensive back **Spencer DeMedal** at the UH 36-yard line.
- ► This set up a six-yard touchdown pass from **Daniel Parr** to **Nehari Crawford**, giving the Dukes the early 7-0 edge.
- ► The ensuing kickoff by **Jacob Gill** would drop in between Rainbow Warrior players near the Duquesne sideline where it was recovered by **Bryan Glover** at the Hawaii 23-yard line.
- ► Three plays later, the Dukes took advantage of the short field as Parr hit **Aidan Cain** on a 20-yard scoring strike for the freshman's first career touchdown reception, giving the Dukes a 14-0 advantage just over seven minutes into the contest.
- ► However, the explosive Rainbow Warriors, who came into the game averaging 495 yards of offense and 41.5 points per game, shook off their early mistakes and responded by outscoring the Dukes 42-7 the rest of the way.

▶ Duquesne has 13 Football Bowl Subdivision players on the roster heading into the 2018 campaign. ## SCHMITT MOVING UP THE DUKES' ALL-TIME WINS LIST

▶ 14th-year head coach Jerry Schmitt enters the 2018 campaign third all-time among the Duquesne football head coach wins list. Since 2005, Schmitt has posted an 92-61 record with five NEC titles and three MAAC championships in addition to leading the program to its first FCS playoff appearance in 2015 and second in 2018.

- ▶ In his 200th career game as a head coach (49 games at Westminster, 151 at Duquesne), he earned his 90th win with the Dukes with a 28-24 victory over Sacred Heart.
- ► Schmitt took over for **Greg Gattuso**, the school's all-time winningest coach who posted 97 wins in 12 seasons from 1993-2004. In his final season at the helm, Gattuso passed **Dan McCann**, who finished with 91 wins in 19 seasons with two stints as head coach, first from 1970-83 and then from 1988-92.
- ► Schmitt passed McCann for second place on the all-time wins list with the victory over Towson.
- ▶ Elmer Layden, who went on to coach at his alma mater Notre Dame, registered 48 wins while at Duquesne from 1927-33. In his final game with the Dukes, he helped DU earn a 33-7 win over the University of Miami in the Festival of Palms Bowl in Miami, Fla.
- ▶ With 120 total wins, Schmitt ranks 20th among active FCS head coaches in career wins, right behind Greg Gattuso in 19th with 121 wins.

## SCHEDULE QUICK FACTS

- ▶ DU faced four first-time opponents in 2018: UMass, Lock Haven, Hawaii and Towson.
- ▶ The Dukes' Aug. 25 matchup at UMass was the earliest game played in program history. This was part of college football's "Week 0" which featured just four Division I games. With a 5:30 PM ET kickoff time, Duquesne and UMass was the first game of the Division I football season. As a result of this, Duquesne had two bye weeks (Sept. 29 & Oct. 27).
- ▶ Duquesne's matchups with UMass and Hawaii were the Dukes' second and third games, respectively, against FBS opponents after taking on the University at Buffalo in the 2014 season opener. In that game, DU led 28-24 with under 10 minutes left before Buffalo, a Mid-American Conference (MAC) team which was coming off an 8-5 season and bowl appearance, scored a pair of late touchdowns to pull out a 38-28 win.
- ▶ The Dukes are also scheduled to travel to Hawaii in 2022. That season, the Rainbow Warriors also host power-five programs Wisconsin and Vanderbilt. Hawaii, a member of the Mountain West Conference, faced seven teams in 2018 who played in a bowl game last season.
- ▶ Duquesne is a combined 95-47 all-time against their 2018 opponents.

## **SIX DEGREES OF STEELERS**

- ► The Duquesne football program has had a long relationship with the Pittsburgh Steelers, with a number of links to the 2018 team.
- ► Steelers founder **Art Rooney**, for whom DU's home field is named, was a quarterback/kicker for the Dukes in 1920. His son, **Dan Rooney**, the Steelers late chairman, graduated from Duquesne. Dan's son, **Art Rooney II**, the current Steelers president, earned a law degree from DU.
- ► Senior receiver **Nehari Crawford** is the cousin of Steelers LB Ryan Shazier. Shazier can regularly be seen at DU games when it fits the Steelers schedule.

- ▶ Wide receivers coach Luke Smith is the nephew of Steelers special teams coordinator Danny Smith. In addition, defensive backs coach Darnel Richardson was selected to attend Steelers training camp last season as part of the 2017 NFL Bill Walsh-Diversity Coaching Fellowship.
- ▶ The Steelers regularly practiced on Rooney Field in the 1990s under a bubble that covered 80 yards of the field during the winter months. The team moved off campus following construction of its South Side practice facility.

## DU TRIO TO PLAY IN ALLIANCE OF AMERICAN FOOTBALL

- ▶ The Alliance of American Football is slated to begin its first season in Feb. 2019. The eight-team league was created by filmmaker Charlie Ebersol and will be overseen by former NFL general manager Bill Polian
- ► Three former Duquesne players are set to play in the AAF including:

Wayne Capers - WR - San Diego Fleet Larson Graham - OL - Birmingham Iron Ben Huss - OL - San Antonio Commanders

► Graham spent the 2017 preseason with the Atlanta Falcons and 2018 with the Pittsburgh Steelers. Huss participated in Jaguars mini-camp in 2018 and was the first Dukes player to play in the NFLPA Collegiate Bowl at the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, Calif. Capers took part in Steelers mini-camp in 2017.

## **DUKES WITH DEGREES**

- ► Six Duquesne players begin the 2018 season having already obtained their bachelor's degrees including: TE Stew Allen, OL Alex Conley, DL Chris Favoroso, OL Matt Fitzpatrick, OL Nick Jordan and LB Kody Nichi.
- ► Four of those players start on the offensive side of the ball for the Dukes - Conley, Fitzpatrick, Jordan and Allen.

## **JERRY SCHMITT**

Five Northeast Conference championships in the past eight seasons and the University's first two trips to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2015 and 2018 highlight the resume of 14th-year Duquesne football coach Jerry Schmitt.

A finalist for the 2015 and 2018 STATS FCS Coach of the Year, Schmitt has seen eight players invited to NFL rookie camps over the past three seasons.

Last season, the Dukes put together a seven-game winning streak, their most wins in a row since the 2002 campaign. Duquesne landed a league-high 12 players on the All-NEC teams including first team honoree and Offensive Player of the Year Tommy Stuart, who became the first Dukes player to garner the award. Stuart was also a finalist for the Walter Payton Award for the top offensive player at the FCS level.

In addition, Ben Huss, a four-year starter and all-conference selection on the offensive line was named an All-American in 2017 by the Associated Press, STATS FCS and HERO Sports while also becoming the first player from Duquesne to play in the NFLPA Collegiate Bowl at the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, Calif.

In 2016, Duquesne, which tied for the NEC title, was one of just four FCS programs with players among the finalists for the three major FCS individual awards. Linebacker Christian Kuntz finished 12th in the voting for the Buck Buchanan Award (top defensive player), quarterback Dillon Buechel was a finalist for the Walter Payton Award (top offensive player) and freshman A.J. Hines was named winner of the Jerry Rice Award (top freshman).

Schmitt, who played an important role in the development of the Duquesne football program as an assistant from 1985-87 and again from 1992-99, returned to the DU campus in 2005 after spending five years as head coach at his alma mater, Westminster College, in New Wilmington, Pa. The Pittsburgh native oversaw the program's move to the Northeast Conference and ensuing adoption of athletics-based aid in February of 2008.

It is a transition that has been an overwhelming success, as over the past eight seasons, Schmitt's Dukes have won more overall games (58) and conference games (40) than any NEC school. In addition, DU - which has five of the past eight NEC titles - is the only league school with five winning conference records in the past eight years.

Schmitt wasted no time putting his mark on the program by leading the Dukes to three consecutive Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championships and earning MAAC Coach of the Year two times in his first three seasons as head coach.

In 2011, Schmitt continued Duquesne's transition as a scholarship-granting associate member of the Northeast Conference by guiding the Dukes to a 9-2 record and NEC co-Championship with a 7-1 record. The 2011 co-title was part of a gradual progression for the Dukes who finished the 2010 season with a 7-4 record and third place league finish with a 5-3 mark.

In 2013, Duquesne once again earned a share of the title - this time tying with Sacred Heart. The 2014 season saw the Dukes finish 6-6 overall. In 2015, Duquesne went 5-1 in conference play, earning its first outright NEC title and the league's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs, Duquesne's first.

Under Schmitt, the Dukes have fashioned a 40-20 record in NEC play over the past eight seasons after posting a 4-11 mark in their first two years while integrating a scholarship model.

In Schmitt's first season, the Dukes posted a 7-3 record (4-0 in the MAAC) - against the most challenging I-AA mid-major schedule a Duquesne team ever faced - and finished with a No. 3 national ranking in The Sports Network I-AA Mid-Major Top 10. The 2005 Dukes finished ranked No. 1 nationally in I-AA total defense, rushing defense and pass efficiency defense.



In year two, Schmitt again led DU to a 7-3 record (3-1 in the MAAC) and eighth consecutive MAAC championship as the Dukes finished ranked sixth in The Sports Network I-AA Mid-Major Top 10. The 2006 Dukes ranked second nationally in passing offense and 15th

In 2007, Duquesne won a share of its ninth consecutive MAAC title in posting a 6-4 overall record. Five years ago the Dukes, in their first season as a scholarship program since the 1950s, went 3-7 in the school's inaugural season in the NEC and followed that with a 3-8 record in

In 2010, with DU's first scholarship class comprising a good portion of the sophomore and junior classes, the Dukes broke through with their third place NEC finish.

Winning titles at Duquesne is nothing new to Schmitt, who helped the Dukes to their first three MAAC championships in 1995, 1996 & 1999 and the school's first Eastern College

Athletic Conference (ECAC) Bowl game in 1996, during his 11 years as an assistant.

Schmitt, who served under three different head coaches in Terry Russell (1985-87), Dan McCann (1992) and Greg Gattuso (1993-99), was the offensive coordinator for his

last seven seasons at DU, during which time the Dukes posted a 53-21 record, won three titles and saw 16 different offensive players named First Team All-MAAC. He was promoted to assistant head coach by Gattuso prior to the 1994 season. Schmitt accepted the head coaching position at Westminster in March of 2000.

While at Westminster, Schmitt posted a 28-21 record in overseeing the Titans' transition from NCAA Division II to the Division III level. He led Westminster to an 8-2 mark including a 5-0 record against teams from the Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) in 2000. After a rebuilding campaign in 2001, Westminster continued to make strides under Schmitt's leadership in 2002, as the Titans finished 6-4 overall (4-1 in league play) and placed second in their first season of eligibility for the PAC title. In 2003, Westminster overcame a challenging non-conference schedule against scholarship teams to contend for the conference title in the final week of the season. In 2004, the Titans rallied from an 0-2 start to post wins in five of their last eight games.

Schmitt's offenses set five single-game records and produced four of the seven 1,000-yard rushers in school history. Forty-four of his players earned All-Conference honors in the three years his players were eligible for post-season recognition.

A 1983 Westminster graduate, Schmitt was a three-year letterman and two-year starter on the offensive line under head coach Joe Fusco, leading the Titans to an undefeated regular season as a senior in 1981. Schmitt, who graduated from Pittsburgh's Keystone Oaks High School in 1978 and his wife, Paula, who earned her master's degree at Duquesne, reside in Pittsburgh with their son Matthew Jake.


