SLU POSTPONEMENT

- Due to Saint Louis pausing team activities on Dec. 30, the Duquesne-Saint Louis game on Jan. 1 has been postponed and will be made up at a later date.

THE SERIES

- The Flyers hold a 23-21 in the all-time series, taking a 54-41 win on Jan. 15, 2020 in the most recent matchup. In Dayton, the Flyers have earned 14 wins in 22 games.

LAST TIME OUT

- On Dec. 21, the Dukes comeback bid against Kent State came up just short, falling to the Golden Flashes, 73-66 at the MAC Center. Trailing by as many as 18 points during the first half, Duquesne cut the deficit to just two in the fourth quarter, but Kent State would finish the game strong to earn the victory. Laia Sole led the Dukes with a season and game-high 23 points on 9-of-18 shooting from the floor. Amanda Kalin added 15 points and four assists.

STAT CHECK

- Amanda Kalin (17.0) and Laia Sole (12.6) have paced the offense for the Dukes in five games this season.
- Kalin has made exactly half of her attempts from the field (31-of-62), as made 57 percent of her shots from inside the arc. Precious Johnsons has also been very efficient from the floor, making 17 of her 30 attempts this season (56.7%), which ranks fifth in the A-10.
- Freshman Megan McConnell leads Duquesne with 15 assists on the season. With just three turnovers during her first 110 minutes of collegiate action, she ranks 10th nationally in assist/turnover ratio and leads all first-year players at the Division I level.
- Classmate Tess Myers has excelled from 3-point land, sinking 6-of-14 attempts from 3-point land to start her career.
- Precious Johnson ranks 26th in the country in blocks per game (2.4) and 49th in overall blocks (12).
- As a team, Duquesne has excelled from the charity-stripe this season, ranking 59th in the country in free throw percentage (74.0%). The Dukes shot 69.4 percent from the free-throw line a season ago.

MCCONNELL HONORED

- After scoring nine points and distributing six assists during her Atlantic 10 debut against St. Bonaventure, the A-10 announced on Dec. 14 that Megan McConnell has been selected as the conference's Rookie of the Week. McConnell appeared in 26 minutes off the bench, helping run the Dukes' offense. Her nine points and six assists are season-bests for the Pittsburgh native out of Chartiers Valley High School. She also earned a rebound, a block and took away possession twice from the Bonnies with a pair of steals. Through three games in her career, she is averaging 6.3 points and has just one turnover in 64 minutes of action. She is currently tied for the team-lead with Amanda Kalin with 2.7 assists per game.
- McConnell is the first Duke to win conference rookie of the week since Nina Aho earned the honor on Nov. 11, 2016.
- Megan's brother, T.J., earned rookie of the week from the Atlantic 10 on five occasions during his freshman season at Duquesne in 2010-11. He is currently a member of the Indiana Pacers

SCOUTING DAYTON

- Dayton has also been idle since Dec. 6, when the Flyers fell to the Akron Zips by a score of 77-74. Dayton earned a 71-57 win against Morehead State in its season opener on Nov. 25. The Flyers host St. Bonaventure on Jan. 1 at 5:00 p.m. prior to taking on the Dukes the following Sunday. Erin Whalen has led the Flyers on the scoreboard so far, with a 25-pt performance against Morehead State and a 26-pt effort against the Zips.

DUKES UNDER BURT

In seven seasons under Dan Burt, the Dukes have become a perennial contender in the A-10. Duquesne earned bids to the WNIT or NCAA Tournament in 10 of 13 seasons that Burt has been head coach or assistant coach and has led the Dukes to an A10 best 153 wins since the start of 2013-14.

STORY LINES

- After graduating 5,000+ career points prior to the 2019-20 season, the Dukes return its top three scorers and three-of-five starters from the Atlantic 10 leading offense a season ago. The Dukes return nearly 72 percent of its offense from a season ago. Off the glass, the Dukes return 72.1 percent of its rebounds.
- Duquesne returns a senior-led lineup of Libby Bazalak (13.2 ppg), Amanda Kalin (10.2 ppg) and Laia Sole (11.8 ppg), who accounted for over 50 percent of points, 42.4 percent of rebounds and 59.6 percent of assists from a season ago.
- **PRESEASON LAURELS:** The Dukes were predicted to finish in a tie for fourth place in the Atlantic 10 with Fordham and Davidson in the conference's coaches' poll. Libby Bazalak was selected to the Atlantic 10's All-Conference First Team and All-Defensive Team. Laia Sole was named to the A-10 Second Team.
- **BAZALAK:** Will miss time due to injury... Preseason Atlantic 10 First Team and All-Defensive Team ... A 2019-20 A-10 All-Conference Second Team honoree, led Duquesne in points (13.2 ppg), rebounds (6.5 rpg), assists (3.9) a season ago, becoming the first Duke since 1995 WNBA 4th overall selection Korie Hilde to lead the Dukes in all three categories ... Atlantic 10 All-Academic Team ... Also led Duquesne in steals (1.3 spg), 3-point field goal percentage (.444) and free throw percentage (.758) ... Led the A-10 and ranked 11th in the nation in 3-point efficiency (.444, 2nd highest mark in program history) ... Ranked in the top-10 of eight Atlantic 10 categories: scoring (10th – 13.2 ppg), rebounding (8th – 6.5 rpg), field goal percentage (10th – .448), 3-point field goal percentage (1st – .444), 3-point field goals per game (5th – 2.0), assists per game (5th – 3.9 apg), assist/turnover ratio (9th – 1.4) and minutes per game (3rd – 36.1) ... Nationally, ranked in the top-100 in 3-point field goal percentage (11th – .444), minutes played (30th – 1118:30) and minutes per game (54th – 36.1)
- **KALIN:** Averaged 10.2 points, 4.8 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 0.94 blocks per game ... Among all Dukes, led team in blocks, ranked second in assists, third in scoring, tied for third in rebounding, and ranked second in field goal percentage (.471) ... In the Atlantic 10, finished season ranked eight in field goal percentage (.470), eight in assists (3.7), fourth in assist/turnover ratio (2.0), seventh in blocks and 10th in minutes played (34.0) ... Posted fourth triple-double in program history with 15 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists in win over La Salle ... One of 23 players in the nation and only A-10 player to accomplish the feat during the 2019-20 season
- **SOLE:** Ranked second on the Dukes with 11.8 points per game ... Averaged 4.8 rebounds and 1.7 assists per game ... Led Duquesne and ranked seventh in the A-10 in field goal percentage (.471) ... Scored 20-plus points in four games and posted double-digit points in 17 games ... Recorded 38 of Duquesne's 72 points in an overtime win over Saint Francis, the most points for a Duke in the Dan Burt era and is tied for the sixth most points in a single game and the highest point total for Duquesne in 21 seasons.

A10's Best: Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, Dan Burt has led the Dukes to an Atlantic 10 best 153 wins. The Dukes are the only Atlantic 10 program to post a winning season in each of the past seven seasons and have posted at least a .500 winning percentage in all 13 seasons Burt has been on the Bluff.

SENIORITY: Sole, Kiersten Elliott, Anie-Pier Samson and Halle Bovell have earned their undergraduate degrees, but have two seasons remaining of eligibility due to a redshirt season and injury shortened season. In total, these six experienced players have accounted for 2,388 career points. Along with Samson and Bovell, Sole and Elliott have earned their undergrad degrees from Duquesne and are pursuing master's degrees on the Bluff.

Diamond Bragg, transfer from Wisconsin, has been granted an NCAA waiver to be immediately eligible for competing starting with the upcoming 2020-21 season. Bragg played in 51 games for the Badgers over the last two seasons. As a senior in high school, Bragg averaged 22.7 points, 8.8 rebounds and 6.6 assists per game at Camp Hill. She was a three-time all-state honoree and was recognized as Penn Live's 2017 Female Athlete of the Year. Bragg helped the Lions to consecutive district championships and was a Miss Pennsylvania finalist during her senior season. She finished her high school career with 1,775 points, the second most in Camp Hill history. "I'm beyond excited to have the opportunity to play this season," said Bragg on being granted the waiver. "We have been working extremely hard for months now and it's such a relief to be cleared. I can't wait to be in uniform alongside my incredible teammates this weekend."

MORE THAN A GAME: Bragg created and hosted the "More Than A Game" charity basketball game, which raised more than \$80,000 over two years. The event raises funds for her local Harrisburg, Pa. community to help student-athletes between the ages of 12-16 attend the 'More Than A Game Academy'. The academy is an eight-week program designed to help with SAT preparation, test-taking skills and an increased knowledge of NCAA rules. The funds also helped prospective student-athletes attend campus visits.

POWER 5: The Dukes look to knock off a Power-5 Conference foe for the seventh consecutive season. The Dukes have defeated Pitt five times, and have posted wins over Penn State (2018-19) and Virginia (2017-18) during that span.

- **Libby Bazalak:** *Brother, Connor* is the starting quarterback at Mizzou ... *Sister, Maddy*, played volleyball and graduated from Duquesne in 2019. In 2019-20 she played basketball at Ohio University as a graduate transfer.
- **Amaya Hamilton:** *Father, Brian*, played defensive tackle and was a captain at Notre Dame (1994) under legendary coach Lou Holtz. He signed as a free agent with the Atlanta Falcons after graduation.
- **Precious Johnson:** *Father, Stew*, is the ninth all-time leading scorer in the history of the ABA. He played for seven different franchises (Kentucky Colonels, New Jersey Americans/New York Nets, Houston Mavericks, Pittsburgh Pipers/Condors, Carolina Cougars, San Diego Conquistadors, Memphis Sound, Baltimore Claws, San Diego Sails and San Antonio Spurs). He was a 3x all-star in the ABA. The Clariton, Pa. native went on to play professionally in Iceland and Sweden, where Precious was born and raised.
- **Megan McConnell:** "Pittsburgh's First Family of Hoops" *Brother, TJ*, a Duquesne (2010-12) and Arizona (2013-15) basketball standout is currently a member of the Indiana Pacers. He previously played for the Philadelphia 76ers ... *Brother, Matty*, was an 1,000-pt. scorer at Robert Morris ... *Father, Tim*, is one of the most successful basketball coaches in Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic League (WPIAL) history with eight combined WPIAL championships at Chartiers Valley High School as the boys (1992-2018) and girls (2018-present) coach ... *Aunt, Suzie McConnell-Serio* was an all-american at Penn State, Olympic Gold Medalist, and WNBA standout as a women's basketball Hall of Famer. She posted an 123-68 record as the Duquesne's women's basketball coach before taking the head job at Pitt (2013-18). Before coming to Duquesne, she was the head coach of the WNBA's Minnesota Lynx ... *Aunt, Kathy McConnell-Miller*, went to four NCAA tournaments at Virginia and has been a Division I head coach at Tulsa and Colorado and an assistant coach at Pitt, Rutgers, and Illinois ... *Uncle, Tom*, is the head coach at Division II contender Indiana University of Pennsylvania women's basketball team. He previously served as the head coach of Saint Francis (Pa.) men's team and was an assistant coach for the men's teams at Wake Forest, Marquette, Dayton. He served as an assistant coach for Colorado and Old Dominion's women's teams.
- **Tess Myers:** *Father, Joey*, graduated from Duquesne and played basketball on two NIT Teams in 1980 and 1981, totaling 831 points. He was drafted by the New Jersey Nets in 1983 ... *Sister, Natalie*, was a Class 2A All-State selection at Burrell High School and led IUP in rebounding and ranked third in scoring as a senior on a team that ranked 8th in the nation in DI prior to the COVID-19 pandemic ... *Sister, Taylor*, was an 1,000 pt. scorer at Burrell High School.
- **Aniya Walker:** *Father, Myron*, is Robert Morris' all-time leading scorer (1,965 pts, 1990-94). He is a member of the Northeastern Conference Hall of Fame, RMU's Hall of Fame and Beaver County Sports Hall of Fame ... *Cousin, Shatori Walker-Kimbrough*, played at Maryland and was the sixth overall pick in the 2017 WNBA draft. She earned a spot on the WNBA All-Rookie Team in 2017 and won the WNBA Championship with the Washington Mystics in 2019. She currently plays for the Phoenix Mercury.

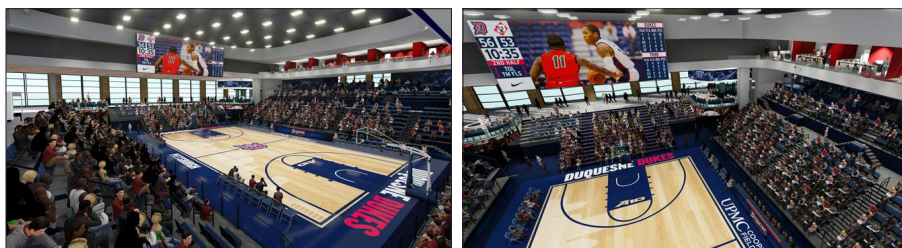

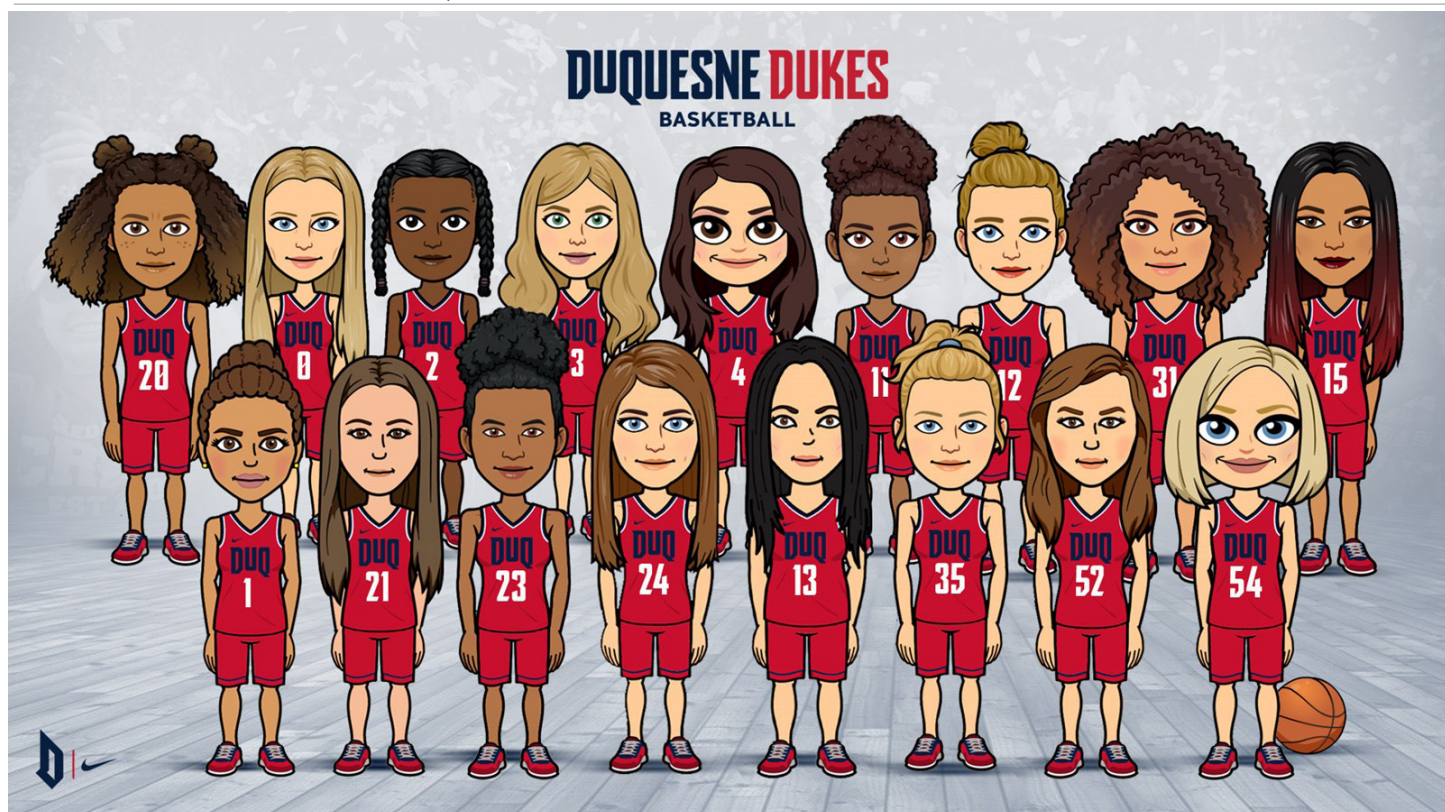

A REVITALIZED VISUAL IDENTITY

Duquesne unveiled a new visual identity for its 17 athletics programs in May. Rooted in the heritage of the University and the city of Pittsburgh, the result is an angular, more aggressive "D" - which takes inspiration from both the Spiritan Congregation flame and the University's iconic Gothic D logo. The modern and dynamic gothic-reimagined D will serve as the primary mark for athletics, while paying homage to Duquesne University's distinction as the only Spiritan institution of higher education in the United States.

"This is the ideal time to reimagine our brand identity," said Duquesne Director of Athletics Dave Harper. "Having a strong and recognizable mark is essential as we continue to elevate the profile of Duquesne athletics."

Duquesne partnered with Change Up (formerly Interbrand Retail) - a leading global branding agency - for the redesign project. Change Up, whose clients include Best Buy, T-Mobile, Buffalo Wild Wings, and Macy's among others, has handled rebranding efforts for sports entities ranging from FC Cincinnati (part of a larger, agency-wide team) to the world-renowned Juventus Football Club. The Department of Athletics and Change Up engaged partners on campus as well as current and former members of the athletics community throughout the rebranding initiative which spanned nearly 18 months. Focus groups included past and current student-athletes, coaches, Duquesne students, staff and alumni. The process also included feedback from Duquesne's athletics apparel partner, Nike.

The new "Duquesne Dukes" wordmark features a subtle salute to Pittsburgh with a raised first "U" that not only offers a visual cue to the pronunciation of Duquesne, but also acknowledges the city's trademark bridges with the arch created by the letters DUQ. The wordmark was designed in a new "Bluff" custom typeface. The Bluff typeface, which complements the new monogram, features an aggressive appearance with angled terminals, spiked serifs and includes numerals that will appear on game uniforms.

"It was a priority of ours to incorporate key University and Pittsburgh elements into our new visuals," said Harper. "As much as this new look is essential to rebuilding our image, we must combine academic excellence and competitive success along with our new images to truly elevate our brand across the board."

In addition to the traditional red and blue color scheme, a dash of electric blue and silver will be used as accent colors for a more fashion-forward appeal. In a further salute to Duquesne's Pittsburgh roots, hypocycloids - in electric blue only - will also be introduced as a graphic support element.

The new brand identity, which will allow Duquesne's athletics teams to showcase consistent logos, lettering and numerals, is independent of the existing University marks that remain unchanged.

In addition to a new identity system, Duquesne athletics also unveiled a new visual design theme to be featured comprehensively across all print, social, digital and advertising media. The navy-based photography is gritty and moody, to capture the drive and commitment of our athletes. The white-based photography is about creating a dynamic visual that focuses on action and energy. Together, these themes capture the essence of being a student-athlete and serve to elevate DU's visual branding.

This is the first phase of a multi-year process to completely rebrand Duquesne athletics. Additional steps include facility graphics, video and digital elements, in-market merchandising, and reimagining of the Duke mascot.



Dan Burt

Head Coach • 8th Season as Duquesne Head Coach • 14th on staff

Dan Burt enters his eighth season at the helm of the Dukes in 2020-21. Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, Burt has led the Dukes to the most wins in the Atlantic 10 with 153 victories. Among head coaches that were hired since the 2013-14 season, he ranks fifth nationally in wins.

Burt enters the 2020-21 campaign with a career record of 153-78 and 76-36 record in Atlantic 10 play and is just 24 wins shy of becoming Duquesne's all-time winningest head coach.

Burt, the only coach in the history of Duquesne women's basketball to lead the program to the NCAA tournament, was named head coach of the program on April 27, 2013. In his seven seasons leading the Dukes, he has had unprecedented success in both the Atlantic 10 Conference as well as nationally. It took only 149 games for Burt to claim his 100th career victory, the 15th fastest to that feat in NCAA women's basketball history.

He led Duquesne to its first NCAA Tournament in 2016. The ninth-seeded Dukes downed Seton Hall, 97-76, in the first round before falling to undefeated and eventual national champion UConn.

Burt's time on the Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 10 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in the 13 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season.

During his 13 seasons on the Bluff, including seven as the program's top assistant coach, Burt helped the Dukes to 276 victories and ten postseason appearances. He has recruited and coached 16 players who earned all-conference honors a total of 33 times as well as 12 1,000 point scorers. He has also coached five players that received the Atlantic 10 Conference highest postseason awards – Player of the Year (April Robinson in 2016), Defensive Player of the Year (Kristi Little in 2008 & 2009 and Jocelyn Floyd in 2011), Rookie of the Year (Wumi Agunbiade in 2011) and Sixth Woman of the Year (Deva'Nyar Workman in 2016).

A key component in Burt's coaching philosophy is player and career development. In his time at Duquesne, 18 of Burt's players have gone on to play professionally overseas and 100% have earned their degrees.

In June 2013, Burt was selected as one of 30 head coaches across the nation to participate in the Center For Coaching Excellence by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). The event introduces coaches to various aspects of leadership and provide a deeper understanding and appreciation of the importance of ethics and integrity in college women's basketball through a rigorous curriculum presented in a seminar-style environment. The exclusive invitation-only elite leadership program was held at Columbia University in New York City.

Burt has also facilitated roundtable discussions at the WBCA National Coaches Convention. He was one of 15 assistant coaches selected from around the country to lead the discussions in 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2011 and 2013. He also coordinated a roundtable meeting for the entire athletic department at UNC Wilmington during 2003-04 that focused on recruiting for all sports at the school.

In 2002, Burt worked with YES - Youth Education through Sports - Basketball Clinic as part of the Final Four Festivities in San Antonio, Texas. He reprised the role at the 2014 Final Four in Nashville, Tenn. YES is the NCAA's premier outreach to youth across the country, connecting young athletes with collegiate coaches and student-athletes to provide fundamental instruction in sports, conditioning and life skills at select collegiate championships.

Burt graduated from Trinity High School in Washington, Pa. prior to earning a bachelor's degree in physical education from West Liberty State College in 1993. While a Hilltopper, Burt was a scholar-athlete award winner as a member of the men's basketball team.

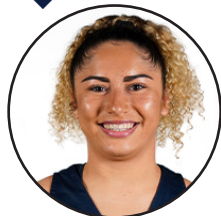
