THE SERIES - vs. AKRON

- The Dukes have enjoyed past success against the Zips, winning eight of the nine all-time meetings.
- Duquesne has won the past six meetings by an average margin of 10.6 points, including an 88-63 victory at Akron in the last meeting in 2019.
- The Dukes tied a program-record with 14 three-point field goals in that win.
- Former Duke **Paige Cannon** knocked down five treys and scored a career-high 21 points to go with 11 rebounds to lead the team.
- The Zips have never won at Duquesne in four visits.
- Akron's lone win in the series came in 2006 - a 55-43 setback for the Dukes in the Buckeye State.
- The two teams have met once in the post-season. Duquesne notched a 71-66 win in the opening round of the 2013 WNIT.

SCOUTING AKRON

- The Zips were picked to finish last in the 12-team Mid-American Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll conducted last month.
- Akron has won two of its first three games, including a 60-50 win at Robert Morris.
- Jordyn Dawson** averaged 26.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 4.5 steals per game in the team's two wins.
- She was later named the MAC Player of the Week on Nov. 16 for her efforts.
- Akron will be playing for the first time since a 57-55 loss at Youngstown State on Nov. 15.
- Layne Ferrell** was sent to the free-throw line with 2.8 seconds remaining and a chance to tie the game, but she missed the front-end and the Zips were unable to corral the rebound on the back-end miss.
- Dawson once again led the team with 19 points and 12 rebounds in the setback.

DUQUESNE vs. THE MAC

- The Dukes are 36-24 all-time versus teams from the MAC.
- Duquesne had a stretch of dominance against the MAC from 2010 thru 2018. The Dukes owned a 25-4 record against foes from the league, including a run of 11-straight wins.
- Since the start of the 2018 season, Duquesne has posted a mark of 3-4 against MAC teams, including losses at Kent State and Toledo last season.
- The Dukes have not lost three-straight games to MAC opponents since 1996, when Duquesne dropped contests at Bowling Green (1995), vs. Bowling Green (1996) and against Ball State (1996).

LAST TIME OUT

- A fourth quarter surge lifted Pitt past Duquesne 69-64 in the City Game Saturday night.
- The Dukes led 50-48 at the end of the third quarter, but the Panthers scored the first eight points of the fourth and led by as many as nine points down the stretch.
- The Dukes led for over 21 minutes of game time. Pitt held the lead for just over 12 minutes of the game, which included nine minutes and 48 seconds in the fourth quarter alone.
- Fatou Pouye** finished with 17 points on 7-of-11 shooting and recorded six rebounds off of the bench to lead Duquesne.
- Megan McConnell** posted 14 points, while both **Libby Bazalak** and **Tess Myers** finished with 11 points
- The loss to Pitt was just the third in the past 12 meetings in the City Game.

DUKES UNDER BURT

In eight seasons under Dan Burt, the Dukes have become a perennial contender in the A-10. Duquesne earned bids to the WNIT or NCAA Tournament in 10 of 14 seasons that Burt has been head coach or assistant coach and has led the Dukes to 158 wins since the start of 2013-14.

CONSECUTIVE DOUBLE DOUBLES

- After 12 games without a player registering a double-double, Duquesne teammates **Fatou Pouye** and **Megan McConnell** have each recorded one in consecutive games against Lafayette and Longwood last week.
- McConnell finished with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds in the team's win over Lafayette, while Pouye finished with 25 and 10 in the loss at Longwood.
- It was the first-career double-double for McConnell, who had eight rebounds in the first half alone.
- The double-double was the fourth of Pouye's career and first at Duquesne.
- The last time the Dukes had a player with a double-double in consecutive games was in 2019 when **Libby Bazalak** did so in wins over Cornell (21&13) and Saint Francis U (10&10).

BENCH BOOST

- Fatou Pouye** has provided a spark off of the bench for the Dukes in the past three games.
- After averaging just 5.0 points as a starter versus UCF and Tulsa, Pouye has come off of the bench and averaged 20.0 points in the past three games.
- The Western Kentucky graduate transfer currently leads the team with 14.0 ppg. and is shooting a team-best 54.7 percent from the field (29 of 53) this season.



ONE MILESTONE DOWN

- Libby Bazalak** posted six rebounds in Saturday's loss to Pitt and in the process became the first player since **Paige Cannon** in 2019 to reach 500 career rebounds.
- Bazalak, who currently ranks second all-time in school history with a .383 three-point field goal percentage, is only 118 points away from 1,000 career points.

LIKE FATHER LIKE DAUGHTER

- Tess Myers** is second on the Dukes in scoring through four games with 12.6 points per game.
- Myers has scored in double figures in four of five games, including 16 points in the opener at UCF and 17 at Tulsa.
- Tess's father, Joey starred at Duquesne from 1980-83 playing for two NIT teams. He scored 831 points as a career .455 shooter. The 6-8 forward was one of the top shooting big men in the Atlantic 10 and had the nickname "Sonar Joey Myers" for his range. He played in the pre-3-point era until his senior season, where he moved inside as one of the big men Duquesne had (5-13 3PT). He was drafted by the New Jersey Nets in the eighth round (179th overall).

WELCOME BACK HALLE

- After missing each of the past two seasons, **Halle Bovell** made her season-debut for the Dukes in the City Game vs. Pitt.
- She played over five minutes and recorded a rebound in the game.
- Bovell's last time on the floor in an actual game was on March 9, 2019 in an A-10 Championship Semifinal loss to Fordham at the A.J. Palumbo Center.
- She appeared in 32 games with nine starts for the Dukes in the 2018-19 season.
- Bovell went 987 days between appearances on the floor for the Dukes.

UNCHARTED TERRITORY

- For the first time since the 2004-05 season, the Dukes are 1-4 through the first five games.
- The last time Duquesne started a season 1-5 was 1991-92.

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- After dropping seven in a row at one point last season, the Dukes capped the 2020-21 regular-season with three victories in five games to earn the No. 9 seed in the A-10 Championship.
- Duquesne had 10 different players start at least one game.
- Amanda Kalin** was averaging 17.0 ppg. through the first five games when she was lost for the season due to an injury in the team's sixth game at Dayton.
- Libby Bazalak** - a 2020 Second Team A-10 All-Conference guard - was limited to eight games.
- Precious Johnson** ranked second in the A-10 in field goal percentage, shooting 53.0 percent from the floor (44-of-83) on the season.
- Tess Myers** ranked fifth in the A-10 in three-point field goal percentage, connecting on 39.7 pct. of attempts from long range (25-of-63).

STORY LINES

- This will be Duquesne's first full season at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. The Dukes scored a 71-63 victory on Feb. 18 over Rhode Island in the team's lone game at the newly-renovated facility last season. Duquesne was forced to play off campus the past three seasons and responded by going a combined 13-9 in "home games" at La Roche University, PPG Paints Arena, UPMC Events Center and Oakland Catholic High School.
- Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, **Dan Burt** has led the Dukes to 159 wins. Only Dayton (167) and Fordham (166) have amassed more wins during that span in the Atlantic 10. The Dukes are also one of three A-10 programs to post a winning season in six of the past seven seasons (Dayton, Fordham, & VCU).
- Since 2013-14, the Dukes have led the Atlantic 10 in scoring offense (2x), scoring margin, field goal percentage (2x), free throw percentage and assists per game (2x). Duquesne has ranked at least fourth in the conference in points per game, field goal percentage and assists per game in all but one season since 2014-15.
- Head Coach **Dan Burt's** time on The Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 10 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in 14 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season. In 2015-16, Duquesne earned its first bid to the NCAA Tournament as a No. 9 seed and earned dominant 21-point win over No. 8 Seton Hall.
- Duquesne has posted five 20-win seasons and five trips to the postseason since 2013-14. Burt has coached six of the 11 top scorers in program history and 11 of the 30 1,000-point scorers at Duquesne. Under his tutelage, the Dukes have earned 21 all-conference honors.
- Duquesne's top-eight scorers all return in 2021-22. The Dukes scored 999 points last season and 845 of those points were scored by players returning to the fold this season.
- AMANDA KALIN:** Started each of the first six games, before suffering a season-ending injury ... Expected to return to the team later this season ... Led team with 15.5 points per game and scored in double figures four times ... Finished with 25 points and a season-high seven rebounds at Saint Francis (Pa.) ... Tallied 11 points and a season-best five assists versus Saint Bonaventure ... Dropped a career-high 32 points on 11-of-17 shooting, including a career-best five three-point shots, at Toledo ... Averaged 10.2 points, 4.8 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 0.94 blocks per game in 2019-20 ... Posted fourth triple-double in program history with 15 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists in win over La Salle ... One of 23 players in the nation and only A-10 player to accomplish the feat during the 2019-20 season.
- LIBBY BAZELAK:** Limited to eight games with five starts ... Finished the season second on the team with 8.4 points per game ... Led the team with 3.3 assists per game ... Tallied 18 points and five rebounds at George Mason ... Established a season high with seven assists at La Salle ... Registered a season-high 19 points with five rebounds and four assists in an A10 Championship game versus La Salle ... 2020 A-10 All-Conference Second Team ... Led Duquesne in scoring (13.2 ppg), rebounding (6.5 rpg), assists (3.9 apg), steals (1.3 spg), 3-point field goal percentage (.444) and free throw percentage (.758) in 2019-20.

The Department of Athletics and Change Up engaged partners on campus as well as current and former members of the athletics community throughout the rebranding initiative which spanned nearly 18 months. Focus groups included past and current student-athletes, coaches, Duquesne students, staff and alumni. The process also included feedback from Duquesne's athletics apparel partner, Nike.

The new "Duquesne Dukes" wordmark features a subtle salute to Pittsburgh with a raised first "U" that not only offers a visual cue to the pronunciation of Duquesne, but also acknowledges the city's trademark bridges with the arch created by the letters DUQ. The wordmark was designed in a new "Bluff" custom typeface. The Bluff typeface, which complements the new monogram, features an aggressive appearance with angled terminals, spiked serifs and includes numerals that will appear on game uniforms.

"It was a priority of ours to incorporate key University and Pittsburgh elements into our new visuals," said Harper. "As much as this new look is essential to rebuilding our image, we must combine academic excellence and competitive success along with our new images to truly elevate our brand across the board."

In addition to the traditional red and blue color scheme, a dash of electric blue and silver will be used as accent colors for a more fashion-forward appeal. In a further salute to Duquesne's Pittsburgh roots, hypocycloids – in electric blue only – will also be introduced as a graphic support element.

The new brand identity, which will allow Duquesne's athletics teams to showcase consistent logos, lettering and numerals, is independent of the existing University marks that remain unchanged.

In addition to a new identity system, Duquesne athletics also unveiled a new visual design theme to be featured comprehensively across all print, social, digital and advertising media. The navy-based photography is gritty and moody, to capture the drive and commitment of our athletes. The white-based photography is about creating a dynamic visual that focuses on action and energy. Together, these themes capture the essence of being a student-athlete and serve to elevate DU's visual branding.

This is the first phase of a multi-year process to completely rebrand Duquesne athletics. Additional steps include facility graphics, video and digital elements, in-market merchandising, and reimagining of the Duke mascot.

Dan Burt Head Coach • 9th Season as Duquesne Head Coach • 15th on staff

Dan Burt enters his ninth season at the helm of the Dukes in 2021-22. Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, Burt has led the Dukes to the third most wins in the Atlantic 10 with 158 victories. Among head coaches that were hired since the 2013-14 season, he ranks fifth nationally in wins.

Burt entered the 2021-22 campaign with a career record of 158-89 and 80-43 record in Atlantic 10 play and is just 19 wins shy of becoming Duquesne's all-time winningest head coach.

Burt, the only coach in the history of Duquesne women's basketball to lead the program to the NCAA tournament, was named head coach of the program on April 27, 2013. In his seven seasons leading the Dukes, he has had unprecedented success in both the Atlantic 10 Conference as well as nationally. It took only 149 games for Burt to claim his 100th career victory, the 15th fastest to that feat in NCAA women's basketball history.

He led Duquesne to its first NCAA Tournament in 2016. The ninth-seeded Dukes downed Seton Hall, 97-76, in the first round before falling to undefeated and eventual national champion UConn.

Burt's time on the Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 11 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in the 14 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season.

During his 14 seasons on the Bluff, including seven as the program's top assistant coach, Burt helped the Dukes to 276 victories and ten postseason appearances. He has recruited and coached 16 players who earned all-conference honors a total of 33 times as well as 12 1,000 point scorers. He has also coached five players that received the Atlantic 10 Conference highest postseason awards – Player of the Year (April Robinson in 2016), Defensive Player of the Year (Kristi Little in 2008 & 2009 and Jocelyn Floyd in 2011), Rookie of the Year (Wumi Agunbiade in 2011) and Sixth Woman of the Year (Deva'Nyar Workman in 2016).

A key component in Burt's coaching philosophy is player and career development. In his time at Duquesne, 18 of Burt's players have gone on to play professionally overseas and 100% have earned their degrees.

In June 2013, Burt was selected as one of 30 head coaches across the nation to participate in the Center For Coaching Excellence by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). The event introduces coaches to various aspects of leadership and provide a deeper understanding and appreciation of the importance of ethics and integrity in college women's basketball through a rigorous curriculum presented in a seminar-style environment. The exclusive invitation-only elite leadership program was held at Columbia University in New York City.

Burt has also facilitated roundtable discussions at the WBCA National Coaches Convention. He was one of 15 assistant coaches selected from around the country to lead the discussions in 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2011 and 2013. He also coordinated a roundtable meeting for the entire athletic department at UNC Wilmington during 2003-04 that focused on recruiting for all sports at the school.

In 2002, Burt worked with YES - Youth Education through Sports - Basketball Clinic as part of the Final Four Festivities in San Antonio, Texas. He reprised the role at the 2014 Final Four in Nashville, Tenn. YES is the NCAA's premier outreach to youth across the country, connecting young athletes with collegiate coaches and student-athletes to provide fundamental instruction in sports, conditioning and life skills at select collegiate championships.

Burt graduated from Trinity High School in Washington, Pa. prior to earning a bachelor's degree in physical education from West Liberty State College in 1993. While a Hilltopper, Burt was a scholar-athlete award winner as a member of the men's basketball team.
