THE SERIES - vs. RICHMOND

The Dukes and Spiders have met annually since Richmond joined the Atlantic 10 in 2001. Although Richmond leads the all-time series 14-12, the Dukes have held the upper hand

recently, winning eight of the last 10 meetings.

- The Spiders won 12 of the first 16 meetings between the two schools from 2001-12, however Duquesne won each of the next eight games, including a 48-47 victory in the WNIT in 2015.
- Richmond has won each of the past two contests by a combined margin of five points, including a 67-64 overtime win in 2020.

LAST MEETING - Jan. 10, 2021

- Richmond pulled out an 80-78 win last season at La Roche's Kerr Fitness Center.
- Megan McConnell had a chance to tie the game in the closing seconds, but did not convert a contested layup as time expired.

McConnell finished with a career-high 18 points to go along with six rebounds and six assists

- Both Laia Sole (17 points) and Diamond Bragg (15) reached double figures, while Tess Myers added nine points.
- The Spiders were 13 of 26 from long range, with nine different players converting a trey.
- Addie Budnik led Richmond with 18 points and six rebounds in the win.
- The contest featured 14 lead changes.

SCOUTING RICHMOND

- The Spiders enter on a five-game winning-streak, including a convincing 90-50 win over Coppin State this past Wednesday.
- Richmond is leading the A-10 in assists (16.8), threepoint field goals (10.2) and blocked shots per game (6.2), as well as field goal percentage (45.8).
- The Spiders have highest scoring offense in the league (74.9 ppg.) and rank third in the NCAA with 131 three-point field goals and also 82 blocked shots this season.
- Richmond features four players who average double figures, including **Addie Budnik**, who slots 12th in the A-10 with 13.8 ppg. and is shooting 53.9 percent from the field to rank third in the league.
- Budnik also ranks second in the A-10 and ninth in the nation with 3.23 blocks per game.
- **Grace Townsend** leads the league and slots 24th in Division I with 5.6 assists per game.

DUKES UNDER BURT

In eight seasons under Dan Burt, the Dukes have become a perennial contender in the A-10. Duquesne earned bids to the WNIT or NCAA Tournament in 10 of 14 seasons that Burt has been head coach or assistant coach and has led the Dukes to 158 wins since the start of 2013-14.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Dukes are playing for the first time in two weeks after their scheduled contest with Cornell for Dec. 21 was canceled due to Covid-19 concerns within the Big Red program.
- Duquesne was defeated 68-60 by Penn State in its last action on Sat., Dec. 18.
 The Dukes were led by a 21-point effort from **Tess Myers**. She knocked down 7-of-14 from the field, including 5-of-8 from downtown in the setback.
- Fatou Pouye added 12 points, while Megan McConnell led the team on the glass with 11 rebounds to go along with seven points, six assists and three steals.
- The Dukes trailed 59-49 after three quarters, but scored 10-straight points to start the
- fourth quarter to knot the game up.

 Duquesne was held without a field goal for final five minutes of the game, allowing Penn State to out-score the Dukes 9-1 down the stretch to secure the win.
 - Penn State's Makenna Marisa finished with 33 points on 12 of 27 shooting.
- The 33 points matched the most points scored by an individual player against Duquesne during Dan Burt's tenure as head coach. Former UConn All-American Katie Lou Samuelson dropped 33 on the Dukes on Dec. 22, 2017.

COMMON OPPONENT

- The Dukes and Spiders have each made the trip to Farmville, Virginia to take on Longwood this season
- Duquesne erased a 19-point deficit to the Lancers, but came up short 77-76 on Nov. 17.
- Megan McConnell's potential game-winning shot at the buzzer rimmed out to allow Longwood to hold on for the win.
- Richmond led by as many as 24 points in its 83-70 victory over the Lancers on Dec. 15 at Willett Hall.
- Longwood's two-time All-Big South guard Kyla McMakin, who dropped 28 versus the Dukes, was limited to 11 points on a 4-of-20 performance from the field against the Spiders.



RINGING IN THE NEW YEAR

- The Dukes are playing for the fourth time in program history on New Year's Day and the first time since 2017.
- Duquesne is 1-2 in games on Jan. 1 all-time.

 The Dukes rang in 2014 with a 73-65 win over St. Bonaventure, but were defeated by George Washington in 2017 (75-40), and Pitt (62-57) in 2000

CLOSE ONLY COUNTS IN HORSESHOES

- The Dukes are winless in the six games in which they trailed heading into the fourth quarter.
- Duquesne erased second half deficits of 19 points at Longwood and 10 points versus Penn State, but came up short late in each of those
- The Dukes trailed by as many as 13 in the third quarter at Kent State, before drawing back to within one with three minutes to play in that game. Kent State held on for a five-point win.

MAGIC NUMBER

- The Dukes have won all five games in which they held their opponent to under 66 points this season.
- Duquesne is winless when it allows 67 or more points.

A-10 ANNOUNCES POSTPONEMENTS, ADJUSTMENTS

- The A-10 announced Tuesday that the following four games scheduled for the opening day of conference play on Jan. 1 would be postponed: Fordham at Davidson; George Mason at UMass; VCU at La Salle; Dayton at Rhode Island.
- The league also announced a revised COVID-19 policy, which allows for postponed games to rescheduled or declared a "nocontest" in the event that a suitable date cannot be found.



- **Tess Myers** has averaged 19.3 over the team's past three
- games. She scored all of her career-high 23 points in the second half of the team's win over Saint Francis on Dec. 11.
- Myers followed that performance with 21 points in the team's most recent game against Penn State on Dec. 18.
- Her back-to-back 20-point games are the first by a Dukes' player since Chassidy Omogrosso scored 20 or more in threestraight games near the end of the 2019 season.
- She ranks second on the Dukes in scoring with 12.4 ppg. and has knocked down more three-point shots through 12 games this season (36) than she did during the entire 16-game 2020-21 season (25).
- Myers leads the A-10 and ranks 23rd in Division I with 3.0 three-point field goals made per game.
- She also ranks second in the A-10 with a 40.4 three-point field goal percentage.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE DAUGHTER

- Tess's father, Joey starred at Duquesne from 1980-83 playing for two NIT teams. He scored 831 points as a career .455 shooter. The 6-8 forward was one of the top shooting big men in the Atlantic 10 and had the nickname "Sonar Joey Myers" for his range.
- He played in the pre-3-point era until his senior season, where he moved inside as one of the big men Duquesne had (5-13 3PT). He was drafted by the New Jersey Nets in the eighth round (179th overall).

BENCH BOOST

- **Fatou Pouye** has provided a spark off of the bench for the
- After averaging just 5.0 points as a starter in the first two games of the season at UCF and Tulsa, Pouye has come off of the bench and averaged 15.5 points through the team's past 10 games.
- Pouye posted her fourth-career 20-point game when she scored a career-high 31 points in a loss at Kent State on Dec. 8. It was her second 20-point game this season and first game with over 30 points.
- The Western Kentucky graduate transfer currently leads the team and ranks 12th in the A-10 with 13.8 ppg.
- Pouve is shooting a team-best mark of 49.6 percent from the field (63 of 127) and slots second with a 38.7 three-point field goal percentage (12-of-31) this season.

GUARDS ON THE GLASS

- Guards Megan McConnell and Libby Bazelak lead the team in rebounding with 6.1 and 5.7 rpg., respectively.
- McConnell has hauled in at least three rebounds in all 12 games, including a career-high 13 in the win over Lafayette. She has had three games with 10 or more rebounds this season.
- Bazelak posted a season-high 10 rebounds in the team's win over Siena. She has finished with five or more rebounds in eight times this season.

DO IT ALL MCCONNELL

- In addition to rebounds, **Megan McConnell** leads the team in both assists and steals per game and ranks third in scoring.
- She slots fourth in the A-10 with 4.8 assists per game.
- McConnell leads the league and ranks 38th in the nation with 2.7 steals per game.
- The Chartiers Valley product also ranks third on the team with 9.3 ppg.





ROAD WOES

- Duquesne is 1-4 when playing on the road this season.
- After losing by double-digits at UCF and Tulsa to open the season, the Dukes were defeated by one point at Longwood and five points at Kent State in closely contested games.
- Duquesne's lone victory on the road was a 59-49 win at Siena in which it committed a season-high 26 turnovers.

DOUBLE DOUBLES

- A Dukes player has notched a double-double three times this season, including two already by guard Megan McConnell.
- McConnell posted 13 points and 10 rebounds versus Temple on Dec.
 5, after registering her first-career double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds on Nov. 14 versus Lafayette.
- She was just one-point shy of a third double-double when she finished with nine points and a season-high 10 assists versus Canisius on Dec. 1.
- **Fatou Pouye** notched her first double-double with the Dukes and fourth overall when she finished with 25 points and 10 rebounds at Longwood on Nov. 17.
- Duquesne players only had two double doubles during the entire 2020-21 season.

SOLE 1K

- Laia Sole scored her 1,000th career point in the team's loss at Kent State on Dec. 8.
- Sole has scored 695 points as a member of the Dukes. Before transferring to Duquesne, she was the 2016-17 America East Sixth Man of the Year as a freshman at Maine.
- She scored 318 points during her lone season with the Bears.
- Sole is only 16 rebounds away from reached 500 for her career.

WELCOME BACK HALLE

- After missing each of the past two seasons, Halle Bovell made her season-debut for the Dukes vs. Pitt on Nov. 20.
- Prior to the game against Pitt, Bovell's last time on the floor in an actual game was on March 9, 2019 in an A-10 Championship Semifinal loss to Fordham at the A.J. Palumbo Center.
- She appeared in 32 games with nine starts for the Dukes in the 2018-19 season.
- Bovell went 987 days between appearances on the floor for the Dukes

ONE MILESTONE DOWN

- Libby Bazelak became the first player since Paige Cannon in 2019 to reach 500 career rebounds when she pulled in the milestone board in the team's game versus Pitt in November.
- Bazelak, who is currently tied for second all-time in school history with a .382 three-point field goal percentage, is only 62 points away from 1,000 career points.

LOCK DOWN D

- In three of their five wins, the Dukes have held opponents to under 50 points and won by double digits.
- Duquesne held an opponent to under 50 points just once during the 2020-21 season (George Mason) and did not win any games last season by double digits.

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- After dropping seven in a row at one point last season, the Dukes capped the 2020-21 regular-season with three victories in five games to earn the No. 9 seed in the A-10 Championship.
- Duquesne had 10 different players start at least one game.
- Amanda Kalin was averaging 17.0 ppg. through the first five games when she was lost for the season due to an injury in the team's sixth game at Dayton.
- Libby Bazelak a 2020 Second Team A-10 All-Conference guard was limited to eight games.
- Precious Johnson ranked second in the A-10 in field goal percentage, shooting 53.0 percent from the floor (44-of-83) on the season.

STORY LINES

- This is Duquesne's first full season at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. The Dukes scored a 71-63 victory on Feb. 18 over Rhode Island in the team's lone game at the newly-renovated facility last season. Duquesne was forced to play off campus the past three seasons and responded by going a combined 13-9 in "home games" at La Roche University, PPG Paints Arena, UPMC Events Center and Oakland Catholic High School.
- Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, **Dan Burt** has led the Dukes to 163 wins. Only Dayton (174) and Fordham (172) have amassed more wins during that span in the Atlantic 10. The Dukes are also one of three A-10 programs to post a winning season in six of the past seven seasons (Dayton, Fordham, & VCU).
- Since 2013-14, the Dukes have led the Atlantic 10 in scoring offense (2x), scoring margin, field goal percentage (2x), free throw percentage and assists per game (2x). Duquesne has ranked at least fourth in the conference in points per game, field goal percentage and assists per game in all but one season since 2014-
- Head Coach **Dan Burt's** time on The Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 10 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in 14 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season. In 2015-16, Duquesne earned its first bid to the NCAA Tournament as a No. 9 seed and earned dominant 21-point win over No. 8 Seton Hall.
- Duquesne has posted five 20-win seasons and five trips to the postseason since 2013-14. Burt has coached six of the 11 top scorers in program history and 11 of the 30 1,000-point scorers at Duquesne. Under his tutelage, the Dukes have earned 21 allconference honors.
- Duquesne's top-eight scorers all return in 2021-22. The Dukes scored 999 points last season and 845 of those points were scored by players returning to the fold this season, including Amanda Kalin.
- **AMANDA KALIN:** Started each of the first six games, before suffering a season-ending injury ... Expected to return to the team later this season ... Led team with 15.5 points per game and scored in double figures four times ... Finished with 25 points and a season-high seven rebounds at Saint Francis (Pa.) ... Tallied 11 points and a season-best five assists versus Saint Bonaventure ... Dropped a career-high 32 points on 11-of-17 shooting, including a career-best five three-point shots, at Toledo ... Averaged 10.2 points, 4.8 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 0.94 blocks per game in 2019-20 ... Posted fourth triple-double in program history with 15 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists in win over La Salle ... One of 23 players in the nation and only A-10 player to accomplish the feat during the 2019-20 season.

Father, Tim, is one of the most successful basketball coaches in Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic League (WPIAL) history with eight combined WPIAL championships at Chartiers Valley High School as the boys (1992-2018) and girls (2018-present) coach ... Aunt, Suzie McConnell-Serio was an All-American at Penn State, Olympic Gold Medalist, WNBA standout and a women's basketball Hall of Famer. She posted an 123-68 record as the Duquesne's women's basketball head coach, before taking the head job at Pitt (2013-18). Before coming to Duquesne, she was the head coach of the WNBA's Minnesota Lynx ... A REVITALIZED VISUAL IDENTITY

Duquesne unveiled a new visual identity for its 17 athletics programs in 2019. Rooted in the heritage of the University and the city of Pittsburgh, the result is an angular, more aggressive "D" – which takes inspiration from both the Spiritan Congregation flame and the University's iconic Gothic D logo. The modern and dynamic gothic-reimagined D will serve as the primary mark for athletics, while paying homage to Duquesne University's distinction as the only Spiritan institution of higher education in the United States.

"This is the ideal time to reimagine our brand identity," said Duquesne Director of Athletics Dave Harper. "Having a strong and recognizable mark is essential as we continue to elevate the profile of Duquesne athletics."

Duquesne partnered with Change Up (formerly Interbrand Retail) - a leading global branding agency - for the redesign project. Change Up, whose clients include Best Buy, T-Mobile, Buffalo Wild Wings, and Macy's among others, has handled rebranding efforts for sports entities ranging from FC Cincinnati (part of a larger, agency-wide team) to the world-renowned Juventus Football Club. The Department of Athletics and Change Up engaged partners on campus as well as current and former members of the athletics community throughout the rebranding initiative which spanned nearly 18 months. Focus groups included past and current student-athletes, coaches, Duquesne students, staff and alumni. The process also included feedback from Duquesne's athletics apparel partner, Nike.

The new "Duquesne Dukes" wordmark features a subtle salute to Pittsburgh with a raised first "U" that not only offers a visual cue to the pronunciation of Duquesne, but also acknowledges the city's trademark bridges with the arch created by the letters DUQ. The wordmark was designed in a new "Bluff" custom typeface. The Bluff typeface, which complements the new monogram, features an aggressive appearance with angled terminals, spiked serifs and includes numerals that will appear on game uniforms.

"It was a priority of ours to incorporate key University and Pittsburgh elements into our new visuals," said Harper.
"As much as this new look is essential to rebuilding our image, we must combine academic excellence and competitive success along with our new images to truly elevate our brand across the board."

In addition to the traditional red and blue color scheme, a dash of electric blue and silver will be used as accent colors for a more fashion-forward appeal. In a further salute to Duquesne's Pittsburgh roots, hypocycloids - in electric blue only - will also be introduced as a graphic support element.

The new brand identity, which will allow Duquesne's athletics teams to showcase consistent logos, lettering and numerals, is independent of the existing University marks that remain unchanged.

In addition to a new identity system, Duquesne athletics also unveiled a new visual design theme to be featured comprehensively across all print, social, digital and advertising media. The navy-based photography is gritty and moody, to capture the drive and commitment of our athletes. The white-based photography is about creating a dynamic visual that focuses on action and energy. Together, these themes capture the essence of being a student-athlete and serve to elevate DU's visual branding.

This is the first phase of a multi-year process to completely rebrand Duquesne athletics. Additional steps include facility graphics, video and digital elements, in-market merchandising, and reimagining of the Duke mascot.



Dan Burt Head Coach • 9th Season as Duquesne Head Coach • 15th on staff

Dan Burt enters his ninth season at the helm of the Dukes in 2021-22. Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, Burt has led the Dukes to the third most wins in the Atlantic 10 with 158 victories. Among head coaches that were hired since the 2013-14 season, he ranks fifth nationally in wins.

Burt entered the 2021-22 campaign with a career record of 158-89 and 80-43 record in Atlantic 10 play and is just 19 wins shy of becoming Duquesne's all-time winningest head coach.

Burt, the only coach in the history of Duquesne women's basketball to lead the program to the NCAA tournament, was named head coach of the program on April 27, 2013. In his seven seasons leading the Dukes, he has had unprecedented success in both the Atlantic 10 Conference as well as nationally. It took only 149 games for Burt to claim his 100th career victory, the 15th fastest to that feat in NCAA women's basketball history.

He led Duquesne to its first NCAA Tournament in 2016. The ninth-seeded Dukes downed Seton Hall, 97-76, in the first round before falling to undefeated and eventual national champion UConn.

Burt's time on the Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 11 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in the 14 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season.

During his 14 seasons on the Bluff, including seven as the program's top assistant coach, Burt helped the Dukes to 276 victories and ten postseason appearances. He has recruited and coached 16 players who earned all-conference honors a total of 33 times as well as 12 1,000 point scorers. He has also coached five players that received the Atlantic 10 Conference highest postseason awards – Player of the Year (April Robinson in 2016), Defensive Player of the Year (Kristi Little in 2008 & 2009 and Jocelyn Floyd in 2011), Rookie of the Year (Wumi Agunbiade in 2011) and Sixth Woman of the Year (Deva'Nyar Workman in 2016).

A key component in Burt's coaching philosophy is player and career development. In his time at Duquesne, 18 of Burt's players have gone on to play professionally overseas and 100% have earned their dearees.

In June 2013, Burt was selected as one of 30 head coaches across the nation to participate in the Center For Coaching Excellence by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). The event introduces coaches to various aspects of leadership and provide a deeper understanding and appreciation of the importance of ethics and integrity in college women's basketball through a rigorous curriculum presented in a seminar-style environment. The exclusive invitation-only elite leadership program was held at Columbia University in New York City.

Burt has also facilitated roundtable discussions at the WBCA National Coaches Convention. He was one of 15 assistant coaches selected from around the country to lead the discussions in 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2011 and 2013. He also coordinated a roundtable meeting for the entire athletic department at UNC Wilmington during 2003-04 that focused on recruiting for all sports at the school.

In 2002, Burt worked with YES - Youth Education through Sports - Basketball Clinic as part of the Final Four Festivities in San Antonio, Texas. He reprised the role at the 2014 Final Four in Nashville, Tenn. YES is the NCAA's premier outreach to youth across the country, connecting young athletes with collegiate coaches and student-athletes to provide fundamental instruction in sports, conditioning and life skills at select collegiate championships.

Burt graduated from Trinity High School in Washington, Pa. prior to earning a bachelor's degree in physical education from West Liberty State College in 1993. While a Hilltopper, Burt was a scholarathlete award winner as a member of the men's basketball team.
