THE SERIES - vs. GEORGE MASON

- The Dukes and Patriots have met each season since George Mason joined the A-10 for the 2013-14 season, including a first round meeting in the 2017 Atlantic 10 Championship.
- Duquesne has won all nine of those meetings as conference foes. The average margin of victory in those games has been 17.0 points.
- The Patriots have not defeated the Dukes since a 62-55 win in 1999 in non-conference play.
- George Mason has never left Pittsburgh with a win over Duquesne.

LAST MEETING - Feb. 14, 2021

- The Dukes halted a seven-game losing streak with a 55-49 win at George Mason last season.
- Duquesne trailed 47-46 with five minutes left in the game, before out-scoring the Patriots 9-2 down the stretch to secure the win.
- **Libby Bazelak** led the Dukes with 18 points and shot 6-of-11 from the floor including 3-of-6 from 3-point land.
- Duquesne controlled the paint, holding significant advantages in rebounds (43-34), offensive rebounds (18-8), second chance points (16-6) and points in the paint (30-16)
- **Rachel Balzer** led the Patriots with 14 points in the loss.
- The Dukes were playing in just their second game after a 25-day layoff due to COVID-19 protocols

SCOUTING GEORGE MASON

- Mason enters the game on an eight-game losing streak that dates back to Dec. 6.
- The team's last win was a 75-71 victory over Florida that improved the Patriots to 6-3 at the time.
- George Mason is 4-4 this season on the road and 1-7 when playing on its home floor. Its only home win this season came against Florida.
- The Patriots prefer to play close to the rim. Mason leads the A-10 in free throws made (240) and is second in free-throw attempts (330).
- As a team, they shoot 72.7 percent from the charity stripe to slot fifth in the A-10.
- George Mason ranks last in the 14-team league with a 26.8 three-point field goal percentage and 11th with 87 made three pointers.
- Leading scorer **Amaya Scott** ranks second in the league with 18.6 ppg. and seventh with 7.5 rpg.
- She is 72 of 101 at the free-throw line, which ranks first in the A-10 in both makes and attempts.
- Scott is coming off of a career-high 35 points in an 81-74 loss to St. Bonaventure this past Sunday.
- She also added 13 rebounds to pick up her 13th career double-double.
- **Jayla Adams** leads the team and ranks seventh in the A-10 with 3.6 assists per game.
- She also established a career-high with 14 points in the St. Bonaventure loss.
- **Jordan Wakefield** is the team's top-threat from long range. She ranks 10th in the league with 1.82 three-point shots per game.

LAST TIME OUT

- Behind a season-high 11 three pointers, the Dukes collected a 71-62 win at Saint Louis Saturday night.
- Duquesne led 29-27 at the half and had one of its best quarters of the season in the third.
- The Dukes out-scored Saint Louis 22-11 in the period and went on a 13-2 run that spanned over five minutes, before taking a 51-38 lead into the fourth.
- Saint Louis went on a 12-1 run late to make things interesting, but the Dukes knocked down their free throws to put the game away.
- Duquesne was led by four players in double figures, including a career-high 18 points from **Amaya Hamilton**.
- **Libby Bazelak** posted 17 points, seven rebounds, five assists and three steals in the win.
- Both **Tess Myers** and **Megan McConnell** finished with 10 points.
- Myers matched Bazelak's team-high seven rebounds, while McConnell matched Bazelak's game-high five assists.
- The Dukes finished 11 of 30 (37 percent) from three-point range. Duquesne was 25 of 59 (42 percent) from the field. Saint Louis entered the evening allowing teams to convert an A-10 worst 34 percent from beyond-the-arc.
- Duquesne committed a season-low seven turnovers.

ETCHING HER NAME INTO THE RECORD BOOK

- **Libby Bazelak** is only four points away from becoming the 31st 1,000-point scorer in school history.
- The Ohio native would become the first player to eclipse 1,000 career points in a Duquesne uniform since **Julijana Vojinovic** reached the milestone in an 87-71 loss to Syracuse on Dec. 21, 2018.
- Bazelak, who is currently third all-time in school history with a .374 three-point field goal percentage, already reached one milestone this season when she became the first player since **Paige Cannon** in 2019 to reach 500 career rebounds.

DUKES UNDER BURT

In eight seasons under Dan Burt, the Dukes have become a perennial contender in the A-10. Duquesne earned bids to the WNIT or NCAA Tournament in 10 of 14 seasons that Burt has been head coach or assistant coach and has led the Dukes to 158 wins since the start of 2013-14.

TURNOVERS AND TAKEAWAYS

- The Dukes committed a season-low seven turnovers in their recent win over Saint Louis. It marked just the second time this season that Duquesne finished with less than 10 turnovers.
- The Dukes are 6-3 when they win commit the same or less turnovers than their opponent. Duquesne is 1-8 in games when they turn the ball over more.
- Duquesne also totaled 11 steals in its win over the Billikens. It was the fourth time this season and the first time since a 70-61 win over Saint Francis on Dec. 11, 2021 that the Dukes finished with a double-digit steal total.

THREE PARTY

- The Dukes converted a season-high 11 three pointers against Saint Louis.
- It was the third time this season the team finished with more than 10 treys. The Dukes knocked down 10 long range shots versus both Longwood and Pitt.
- Duquesne ranks third in the A-10 with 7.2 three pointers per game.
- The most three pointers made by a **Dan Burt** coached team was 14 at Akron on Dec. 4, 2019.

BORN TO RUN

- The Dukes have gone on a double-digit run in seven different games this season, including five of the past 10 contests.
- Duquesne's 17-0 run versus St. Bonaventure was its largest of the season.
- Prior to the St. Bonaventure game, the season-high was a run of 16-straight points to open the game in the team's win over Lafayette on Nov. 14.

SWAT TEAM

- Precious Johnson** has blocked 10 shots over the past five games.
- She had six blocked shots through the first 12 games of the season and never more than two in a single game.
- Duquesne did not have a player register more than two blocks in a game prior to Johnson's three-block performances against Davidson and St. Bonaventure.

ROUTE 66

- The Dukes have won all six games in which they held their opponent to under 66 points this season.
- Duquesne is winless when it allows 67 or more points.
- The Dukes held VCU to 65 points in regulation, before falling 74-70 in overtime on Jan. 5.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Five of the Dukes seven wins this season have come in the Steel City.
- Duquesne is 6-4 all-time in games at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse, which includes a win last season over Rhode Island in the lone game played inside the newly renovated building.
- Duquesne is 2-7 when playing on the road this season.
- Although the Dukes offensively are averaging more points on the road this season (65.1 ppg.) than at home (61.8 ppg.), they are performing much differently on the defensive end.
- Duquesne is limiting opponents to 58.9 ppg. at the UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse and allowing 70.3 ppg. in games on the road.

DISHING OUT DIMES

- Duquesne has posted double-digit assist totals in each of the past 15 games, including 16 or more in three of its last four contests.
- The Dukes rank fifth in the A-10 with 14.3 assists per game.
- The Dukes finished with 19 assists on 27 made baskets in the loss at Davidson.
- The team distributed a season-high 20 assists in the team's win over Canisius in December.

DIALING UP THE DEEP BALL

- Tess Myers** has scored in double figures in eight of the last nine games, including a career-high 23 points twice in games versus Saint Francis and Davidson.
- She matched a career-high with six three-point field goals at Davidson.
- Myers ranks second on the Dukes in scoring with 12.4 ppg. and has converted at least one three pointer in 16 of the team's 17 games.
- Myers leads the A-10 and ranks 16th in Division I with 2.9 three-point field goals made per game.
- She also slots third in the A-10 with a 40.0 three-point field goal percentage.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE DAUGHTER

- Tess's father, **Joey** starred at Duquesne from 1980-83 playing for two NIT teams. He scored 831 points as a career .455 shooter. The 6-8 forward was one of the top shooting big men in the Atlantic 10 and had the nickname "Sonar Joey Myers" for his range.
- He played in the pre-3-point era until his senior season, where he moved inside as one of the big men Duquesne had (5-13 3PT). He was drafted by the New Jersey Nets in the eighth round (179th overall).

BACK INTO THE STARTING 5

- Leading scorer **Fatou Pouye** was inserted into the starting lineup in each of the past two games. It was her first start since Nov. 11 at Tulsa in the team's last game versus Rhode Island.
- After averaging just 5.0 points as a starter in the first two games of the season at UCF and Tulsa, Pouye had come off of the bench and averaged 15.0 points through 13 games.
- Pouye posted her fourth-career 20-point game when she scored a career-high 31 points in a loss at Kent State on Dec. 8.
- The Western Kentucky graduate transfer currently leads the team and ranks 15th in the A-10 with 12.9 ppg.
- Pouye also ranks second on the team shooting 47.2 percent from the field.

TAKING AWAY THE TOP OPTION

- Duquesne has held the leading scorers for their opponent below their season-average in six of their seven victories this season.
- Notably, Akron leading scorer **Jordyn Dawson** (24.0 ppg.) was limited to just four points on 1-of-11 shooting against the Dukes.
- Canisius leading scorer **Dani Haskell** (16.2 ppg.) finished with 12 points on 5-of-16 shooting, including zero made three-point field goals on seven attempts.
- St. Bonaventure leading scorer and 2021 Third-Team A-10 All-Conference guard **Asianae Johnson** (15.9 ppg.) was limited to six points on 2-of-15 shooting with five turnovers.
- The only player to buck the trend was Saint Louis's three-time A-10 All-Conference guard **Ciaja Harbison** (18.2 ppg.), who finished with 21 points against the Dukes.

**CLOSE ONLY COUNTS IN HORSESHOES**

- The Dukes are winless in the nine games in which they trailed heading into the fourth quarter.
- Duquesne erased second half deficits of 19 points at Longwood and 10 points versus Penn State, but came up short late in each of those games.
- The Dukes trailed by as many as 13 in the third quarter at Kent State, before drawing back to within one with three minutes to play in that game. Kent State held on for a five-point win.
- Duquesne also mounted a second-half rally after trailing by as many as 23 points at Richmond. The Dukes drew within five points of the Spiders in the closing minutes, before eventually losing by six.
- Although it trailed by 10 at one point, Duquesne held a two-point lead heading into the fourth quarter at VCU. The Rams eventually pulled out a four-point overtime win.
- The Dukes faced a 12-point deficit at Davidson with six minutes left in the game, before eventually drawing within one point at 68-67 with 44 seconds left in the game. Davidson went on to close out the contest with a six-point win.

A-10 ANNOUNCES NATIONAL TV TIME FOR DUKES

- Duquesne will be on national airwaves when it travels to Massachusetts on Feb. 13 on CBS Sports Network at noon.
- Every Atlantic 10 team will make at least one television appearance as part of the A-10 Women's Basketball television package.
- There will be 13 regular season games, conference matchups, and three A-10 Women's Basketball Championship broadcasts.
- CBS Sports Network will air eight regular season games and two championship games, and NBCUniversal platforms will carry three regular season games.
- ESPN will have two regular season games and the championship final.
- As previously announced, the 2022 A-10 Championship will be held March 2-6, 2022 with all 14 teams participating in a single-site format. The first round, second round and quarterfinal games will be available live on ESPN+, the Walt Disney Company's industry-leading sports streaming service.

MILESTONE SEASON

- Laia Sole** scored her 1,000th career point in the team's loss at Kent State on Dec. 8.
- In the team's last home game versus Rhode Island, Sole hauled in her 500th career rebound.
- Sole has scored 730 points as a member of the Dukes. Before transferring to Duquesne, she was the 2016-17 America East Sixth Man of the Year as a freshman at Maine.
- She scored 318 points during her lone season with the Bears.

THE BEST ABILITY IS AVAILABILITY

- After missing the first 12 games, **Amanda Kalin** made her first appearance this season and led the team in scoring in their A-10 opener at Richmond on Jan. 1.
- Kalin was held scoreless in limited action at VCU and has not played in any of the team's past three games.
- She started each of the first six games during the 2020-21 season, before suffering a season-ending leg injury at Dayton.
- Kalin led team with 15.5 points per game and scored in double figures four times at the time of her injury.
- Kalin dropped a career-high 32 points on 11-of-17 shooting, including a career-best five three-point shots, at Toledo last season.
- The Pine-Richland grad was one of 23 players in the nation and the only A-10 player during the 2019-20 season to post a triple-double when she finished with 15 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists in a win over La Salle.

GUARDS ON THE GLASS

- Guards **Megan McConnell** and **Libby Bazalak** lead the team in rebounding with 5.9 and 5.8 rpg, respectively.
- McConnell has hauled in at least five rebounds in nine of the last 11 games. She has had three games with 10 or more rebounds this season, including a career-high 13 in the win over Lafayette on Nov. 14.
- Bazalak matched a season-high 10 rebounds in the team's loss at VCU. She has finished with five or more rebounds 11 times this season.
- Bazalak also posted 10 rebounds in the team's win at Siena in November.

A TOUCH OF EVERYTHING

- A Dukes player has notched a double-double three times this season, including two by guard **Megan McConnell**.
- McConnell posted 13 points and 10 rebounds versus Temple on Dec. 5, after registering her first-career double-double with 13 and 13 on Nov. 14 versus Lafayette.
- Fatou Pouye** notched her first double-double with the Dukes and fourth overall when she finished with 25 and 10 at Longwood.
- Duquesne players only had two double doubles during the entire 2020-21 season.

WELCOME BACK HALLE

- After missing each of the past two seasons, **Halle Bovell** made her season-debut for the Dukes vs. Pitt on Nov. 20.
- Prior to the game against Pitt, Bovell's last time on the floor in an actual game was on March 9, 2019 in an A-10 Championship Semifinal loss to Fordham at the A.J. Palumbo Center.
- She appeared in 32 games with nine starts for the Dukes in the 2018-19 season.
- Bovell went 987 days between appearances on the floor for the Dukes.

A-10 ANNOUNCES ADJUSTMENTS TO COVID POLICY

- The league announced late in December a revised COVID-19 policy due to the recent outbreak of cases from the Omicron variant.
- The updated policy allows for postponed games to be rescheduled or declared a "no-contest" in the event that a suitable date cannot be found.
- The Dukes game versus Cornell, which was scheduled for Dec. 21, will not be rescheduled this season.

LOOKING BACK AT 2020-21

- After dropping seven in a row at one point last season, the Dukes capped the 2020-21 regular-season with three victories in five games to earn the No. 9 seed in the A-10 Championship.
- Duquesne had 10 different players start at least one game.
- Amanda Kalin** was averaging 17.0 ppg. through the first five games when she was lost for the season due to an injury in the team's sixth game at Dayton.
- Libby Bazalak** - a 2020 Second Team A-10 All-Conference guard - was limited to eight games.
- Precious Johnson** ranked second in the A-10 in field goal percentage, shooting 53.0 percent from the floor (44-of-83) on the season.

STORY LINES

- Duquesne's top-eight scorers all returned in 2021-22. The Dukes scored 999 points last season and 845 of those points were scored by players returning to the fold this season, including leading scorer **Amanda Kalin** (15.5 ppg.).
- This is Duquesne's first full season at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. The Dukes scored a 71-63 victory on Feb. 18 over Rhode Island in the team's lone game at the newly-renovated facility last season. Duquesne was forced to play off campus the past three seasons and responded by going a combined 13-9 in "home games" at La Roche University, PPG Paints Arena, UPMC Events Center and Oakland Catholic High School.
- Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, **Dan Burt** has led the Dukes to 165 wins. Only Dayton (180) and Fordham (177) have amassed more wins during that span in the Atlantic 10. The Dukes are also one of three A-10 programs to post a winning season in six of the past seven seasons (Dayton, Fordham, & VCU).
- Since 2013-14, the Dukes have led the Atlantic 10 in scoring offense (2x), scoring margin, field goal percentage (2x), free throw percentage and assists per game (2x). Duquesne has ranked at least fourth in the conference in points per game, field goal percentage and assists per game in all but one season since 2014-15.
- Head Coach **Dan Burt's** time on The Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 10 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in 14 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season. In 2015-16, Duquesne earned its first bid to the NCAA Tournament as a No. 9 seed and earned dominant 21-point win over No. 8 Seton Hall.
- Duquesne has posted five 20-win seasons and five trips to the postseason since 2013-14. Burt has coached six of the 11 top scorers in program history and 11 of the 30 1,000-point scorers at Duquesne. Under his tutelage, the Dukes have earned 21 all-conference honors.

Father, Tim, is one of the most successful basketball coaches in Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic League (WPIAL) history with eight combined WPIAL championships at Chartiers Valley High School as the boys (1992-2018) and girls (2018-present) coach ... Aunt, Suzie McConnell-Serio was an All-American at Penn State, Olympic Gold Medalist, WNBA standout and a women's basketball Hall of Famer. Dan Burt

Head Coach • 9th Season as Duquesne Head Coach • 15th on staff

Dan Burt enters his ninth season at the helm of the Dukes in 2021-22. Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, Burt has led the Dukes to the third most wins in the Atlantic 10 with 158 victories. Among head coaches that were hired since the 2013-14 season, he ranks fifth nationally in wins.

Burt entered the 2021-22 campaign with a career record of 158-89 and 80-43 record in Atlantic 10 play and is just 19 wins shy of becoming Duquesne's all-time winningest head coach.

Burt, the only coach in the history of Duquesne women's basketball to lead the program to the NCAA tournament, was named head coach of the program on April 27, 2013. In his seven seasons leading the Dukes, he has had unprecedented success in both the Atlantic 10 Conference as well as nationally. It took only 149 games for Burt to claim his 100th career victory, the 15th fastest to that feat in NCAA women's basketball history.

He led Duquesne to its first NCAA Tournament in 2016. The ninth-seeded Dukes downed Seton Hall, 97-76, in the first round before falling to undefeated and eventual national champion UConn.

Burt's time on the Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 11 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in the 14 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season.

During his 14 seasons on the Bluff, including seven as the program's top assistant coach, Burt helped the Dukes to 276 victories and ten postseason appearances. He has recruited and coached 16 players who earned all-conference honors a total of 33 times as well as 12 1,000 point scorers. He has also coached five players that received the Atlantic 10 Conference highest postseason awards – Player of the Year (April Robinson in 2016), Defensive Player of the Year (Kristi Little in 2008 & 2009 and Jocelyn Floyd in 2011), Rookie of the Year (Wumi Agunbiade in 2011) and Sixth Woman of the Year (Deva'Nyar Workman in 2016).

A key component in Burt's coaching philosophy is player and career development. In his time at Duquesne, 18 of Burt's players have gone on to play professionally overseas and 100% have earned their degrees.

In June 2013, Burt was selected as one of 30 head coaches across the nation to participate in the Center For Coaching Excellence by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). The event introduces coaches to various aspects of leadership and provide a deeper understanding and appreciation of the importance of ethics and integrity in college women's basketball through a rigorous curriculum presented in a seminar-style environment. The exclusive invitation-only elite leadership program was held at Columbia University in New York City.

Burt has also facilitated roundtable discussions at the WBCA National Coaches Convention. He was one of 15 assistant coaches selected from around the country to lead the discussions in 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2011 and 2013. He also coordinated a roundtable meeting for the entire athletic department at UNC Wilmington during 2003-04 that focused on recruiting for all sports at the school.

In 2002, Burt worked with YES - Youth Education through Sports - Basketball Clinic as part of the Final Four Festivities in San Antonio, Texas. He reprised the role at the 2014 Final Four in Nashville, Tenn. YES is the NCAA's premier outreach to youth across the country, connecting young athletes with collegiate coaches and student-athletes to provide fundamental instruction in sports, conditioning and life skills at select collegiate championships.

Burt graduated from Trinity High School in Washington, Pa. prior to earning a bachelor's degree in physical education from West Liberty State College in 1993. While a Hilltopper, Burt was a scholar-athlete award winner as a member of the men's basketball team.
