THE SERIES - vs. KENT STATE

- The Dukes and Golden Flashes have met 10 times, with the teams splitting the matchups.
- This is the fifth-straight season the two teams will meet. Kent State has won the last three matchups.
- Prior to the last three, Duquesne won four-straight games from 2011-2018.
- Each of the past four matchups have been decided by seven or less points.

LAST MEETING - Dec. 8, 2021

- Kent State beat Duquesne, 71-66, almost one year ago to the day.
- Fatou Pouye dropped 31 points for the Dukes and Tess Myers scored 14 points while hitting four threes.
- Kent State had three players score 16 or more points.
- Both teams shot over 42 percent from the field.

SCOUTING KENT STATE

- Kent State is 5-2 and coming off a 64-49 win over an A-10 opponent, St. Bonaventure on Sunday.
- After starting 1-2, the Golden Flashes have won four in a row, including a win on the road against Oklahoma State on Nov. 20.
- Lindsey Thall (12.4 ppg) and Katie Shumate (12.3 ppg) lead the team in scoring.
- Hannah Young averages 6.0 rebounds per game to lead the squad.
- Kent State returns six of its top seven scorers from last season.
- Kent State was picked to finish fourth in the MAC this season.
- The Golden Flashes are led by head coach **Todd Starkey**, who is 106-79 in his seven season at Kent State.

LAST TIME OUT

- Duquesne took down Delaware on Sunday night, 66-55.
- The Dukes shot 44.2 percent from the field and 41.7 percent from three to win by double digits in a physical and chippy game.
- Megan McConnell** recorded her second triple-double of the season with 12 points, 15 rebounds and 10 assists.
- Precious Johnson** led Duquesne in scoring once again with 17 points on 8-of-19 shooting.
- Tess Myers** was 4-for-6 from three and had 15 points.
- Duquesne held Delaware to 33.9 percent shooting from the field.

STAT CHECK

- Megan McConnell** is the ONLY player in the NCAA, men's or women's, in any of the three divisions, to have two triple-doubles this year. Her 9.2 defensive rebounds per game is top-3 in the nation and her 10.5 rebounds per game ranks 18th nationally. Her 27 steals are the 14th-most in the country and her 5.8 assists per game leads the A-10.
- Tess Myers** ranks third the A-10 and 24th in the country with 3.00 three-pointers per game this season. Her 24 three-pointers made are the 25th-most in the country. Her 90 total threes last season led the conference and ranked 14th in the nation.
- The Dukes lead the A-10 in rebounds per game (42.9, 41st in nation) and defensive rebounds per game (31.5, 14th in nation). Their scoring defense ranks third in the conference as opponents are scoring 61.0 points per game while their field goal percentage defense (34.9%) ranks first in the conference and 35th nationally.

MRS. TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Megan McConnell** is the ONLY player in the NCAA, men's or women's, in any of the three divisions, to have two triple-doubles this season.
- Her first came on Nov. 11 against Brown. She scored 10 points, grabbed 13 rebounds and dished out 10 assists.
- Her second came against Delaware on Dec. 4 when she had 12 points, 15 rebounds and 10 assists.

DUKES UNDER BURT

In 10 seasons under Dan Burt, the Dukes have become a perennial contender in the A-10. Duquesne earned bids to the WNIT or NCAA Tournament in 11 of 15 seasons that Burt has been head coach or assistant coach and has led the Dukes to 175 wins since the start of 2013-14.

- She is just the second player in A-10 women's basketball history to have multiple triple-doubles in the same season.
- She is the first Duquesne women's basketball player to have multiple triple-doubles in their career - let alone 23 days apart.
- Only one other player has had three triple-doubles in a season in A-10 history - Megan's aunt, Susie McConnell (Penn State, 3, 1988).

A-10 ELITE

- Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, **Dan Burt** has led the Dukes to 175 wins. Only Dayton (192) and Fordham (187) have amassed more wins during that span among A-10 teams.
- The Dukes are also one of four Atlantic 10 programs to post a winning season in at least seven of the past nine seasons (Dayton, Fordham, & VCU).
- Coming into the season, Duquesne was also tied for the third-most A-10 wins (86) since Burt took over as head coach.
- Since 2013-14, the Dukes have led the Atlantic 10 in scoring offense (2x), scoring margin, field goal percentage (2x), free throw percentage and assists per game (3x).
- Duquesne has ranked at least fifth in the conference in points per game, field goal percentage and assists per game in all but one season since 2014-15.

LOCK DOWN D

- Duquesne ranks 35th in the country and first in the conference in field goal percentage defense, with opposing teams shooting just 34.9 percent against the Dukes.
- The Dukes' scoring defense ranks third in the conference as opposing teams have scored just 61.0 points per game.
- The Dukes held opponents to under 50 points five times last season and won eight games by double digits. They have won four games by double-digits already this year.
- Duquesne held an opponent to under 50 points just once during the previous 2020-21 season (George Mason) and did not win any games in 2020-21 by double digits.

BEASTS ON THE BOARDS

- **Megan McConnell** leads the A-10 with 10.5 rebounds per game, which ranks 18th nationally. Her 9.2 defensive rebounds per game rank 3rd in the nation.
- She led the team with 6.4 rebounds per game last season, which ranked 10th in the conference.
- McConnell hauled in at least five rebounds in 22 games last season. She has five or more in all eight games so far this year.
- **Precious Johnson** ranks second on the team and 13th in the conference with 6.9 rebounds per game.
- Duquesne's 31.5 defensive rebounds per game ranks 14th in the country. The Dukes' 42.9 rebounds per game rank 41st in the country.

PLAYING LIKE A MCCONNELL

- In addition to rebounds, **Megan McConnell** leads the A-10 in steals per game (3.4, 16th in nation) and assists per game (5.8, 22nd in nation).
- Last year she led the team in both assists (4.1) and steals (2.6) per game.
- She has 27 steals already, recorded five in the season opener and had six in the Marshall game.
- McConnell recorded a career-high eight steals versus George Washington on Feb. 9, 2022.
- It marked the most steals in a single game by a Dukes player under Head Coach **Dan Burt**.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- Since taking over as head coach in the 2013-14 season, **Dan Burt** has led the Dukes to a 91-39 record in home games.
- Not including the shortened 2020-21 season (only five home games), the Dukes haven't had a losing record at home since 2006-07 and never have under Burt.
- The Dukes went 8-7 at home last season in their first full season at the upgraded UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse.
- Duquesne is 4-1 at home this season.

ALL-TIME WINS RECORD

- **Dan Burt** is one win away from tying and two wins away from breaking the all-time wins record at Duquesne.
- Dan Burkin (1994-2007) has the record with 176 wins.
- Burt currently sits at 175 wins.

50TH ANNIVERSARY

- 2022-23 is Duquesne Women's Basketball's 50th season. 1973-74 was the first season.
- In the past 50 years the program has put together an all-time record of 665-657 (.503), a Division I record of 561-586 (.489) and an Atlantic 10 Record of 254-329 (.436).
- The program has had 10 head coaches since its inception.

- Sophomore **Tess Myers** earned a spot on the 2022 A-10 Preseason All-Conference Third Team, as announced by the league during its media day on Oct. 18.
- Sophomore **Megan McConnell** was selected to the 2022 A-10 Preseason All-Defensive Team after leading the conference with 2.6 steals per game in 2021-22.
- In the coaches poll, Duquesne was picked to finish in ninth-place for the second-straight season.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER

- Through eight games, Duquesne ranks highly in the A-10 in scoring offense (72.1 ppg, 4th) and scoring margin (+11.1, 4th). In the first game of the year, Duquesne put up 94 points and showed off the fast and furious offense that head coach Dan Burt has been talking about.
- The Dukes rank 25th in the nation and 3rd in the A-10 with 8.8 three-pointers per game.
- The Dukes hit 90 points again against Siena, winning 92-73.
- With four of their top six leading scorers from last year back, the Dukes have an offensive core ready to put up points this year.

LET ME ASSIST YOU

- The Dukes have at least 14 assists in seven of eight games this year and rank fourth in the A-10 with an assist/turnover ratio of 1.09.
- Duquesne had 22 assists against Siena on Nov. 22, the most this season and most since the 21-22 season-high of 24 against St. Bonaventure on Feb. 20, 2022.
- Megan McConnell** leads the team with 5.8 assists per game, which leads the conference.
- Duquesne posted double-digit assist totals in each of the last 27 games to end the 2021-22 campaign.
- The Dukes led the A-10 with 14.79 assists per game last season.

RAINING TREYS

- The Dukes rank third in the A-10 and 25th in the country with 8.8 three-pointers per game.
- Tess Myers leads the team with 3.00 threes per game, which ranks 24th in the nation.
- The Dukes have already made 13 threes in a game, shooting 44.8% from long range against Brown on Nov. 11, which was the fourth-highest total in program history.
- Last year's team made 214 three-pointers, which is tied for the fifth-most in Duquesne history.

NEWCOMERS

- Junior forward **Ayanna Townsend** is back home after transferring from Xavier. She was a team captain and averaged 9.1 ppg and 5.5 rpg last season. She has two seasons of eligibility remaining.
- Redshirt freshman center **Selma Kulo** comes to Pittsburgh after two seasons at Western Kentucky. She led the team with 21 blocks and has three years of eligibility remaining.
- Sophomore guard **Naele Bernard** is a transfer from Salt Lake City C.C. with three seasons of eligibility remaining. She led Salt Lake City with 9.0 ppg last season.
- Sophomore forward **Kaitlyn Ammons** appeared in 12 games as a freshman at DePaul last season. She was ranked the No. 1 prospect out of West Virginia and the No. 79 recruit nationally in the class of 2021.
- Freshman guard **Reilly Sunday** is from the local Moon Area High School and earned All-State Honors while leading her team to the PIAA Class 5A quarterfinals last season.
- Freshman guard **Dea Pushkolli** is from Kosovo but spent the last three seasons playing in the U.S.

LOCAL PRODUCTS

- The Dukes have seven student-athletes from the Pittsburgh region, plus another from Wana, W. Va., which is about 70 miles away from Duquesne.
- The seven high schools that the Pennsylvania players are from - Ambridge, Chartiers Valley, Moon, Mars, Bethel Park, North Catholic and Winchester Thurston - are all WPIAL schools.

INTERNATIONAL FOOTPRINT

- On the other end of the spectrum, the Dukes have four international players - Johnson, Kulo, Pushkolli and Bernard.
- Those four players' hometowns are a combined 17,593 miles away from Duquesne.

- **Lauren Wasylyson and Ayanna Townsend** are each in their fifth.
- Nine players on the roster are listed as sophomores or younger.

ETCHING HER NAME INTO THE RECORD BOOK

- **Tess Myers** had one of the greatest three-point shooting single seasons in Duquesne history last year.
- Her 90 three-point field goals were the second-most in the single-season at Duquesne, trailing only the record-holder *Chassidy Omogrosso* (92 - 2018).
- Her 230 attempts were also the second-most in a single season.
- *April Robinson* holds that mark with 247 attempted in 2016.
- She will break into the top-10 in all-time three-pointers made in Duquesne history with 23 this season.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE DAUGHTER

- Tess's father, Joey starred at Duquesne from 1980-83 playing for two NIT teams. He scored 831 points as a career .455 shooter. The 6-8 forward was one of the top shooting big men in the Atlantic 10 and had the nickname "Sonar Joey Myers" for his range.
- He played in the pre-three pointer era until his senior season, where he moved inside as one of the big men Duquesne had (5-13 3PT). He was drafted by the New Jersey Nets in the eighth round (179th overall).

BORN TO RUN

- Just one game into the season, the Dukes already matched their biggest run from last year, which was 17-0. They went on a 17-0 run against Point Park.
- In the game against Brown on Nov. 11, Duquesne went on a 15-0 run in the second half.
- The Dukes went on a double-digit run in 10 different games last season.

CLOSE ONLY COUNTS IN HORSESHOES

- Duquesne was 0-12 last season in games decided by eight points or less, but it is 2-1 this year - a sign that things will be different this season in the clutch moments.
- The Dukes were also winless in the 12 games in which they trailed heading into the fourth quarter, a streak which was also snapped just two games into this season as they trailed 54-53 against Brown on Nov. 11 after three quarters.

BATTLING INJURIES

- Duquesne had nine different players miss time last season due to injury, totaling over 150 games lost.
- The Dukes have played the entire season without guards former Duke Diamond Bragg, Lauren Wasylyson and Olivia Westphal, who suffered injuries in the preseason. Both Wasylyson and Westphal are back this season.
- Wasylyson and Westphal are back in a room of guards that include **Megan McConnell, Tess Myers**, transfer **Naelle Bernard**, freshman **Reilly Sunday** and more.

**Dan Burt****Head Coach • 10th Season as Duquesne Head Coach • 16th on staff**

Dan Burt enters his 10th season at the helm of the Dukes in 2022-23. Since taking over as head coach in 2013-14, Burt has led the Dukes to the third most wins in the Atlantic 10 with 169 victories.

Burt enters the 2022-23 campaign with a career record of 169-107 and 86-53 record in Atlantic 10 play and is just seven wins shy of becoming Duquesne's all-time winningest head coach.

Burt, the only coach in the history of Duquesne women's basketball to lead the program to the NCAA tournament, was named head coach of the program on April 27, 2013. In his 10 seasons leading the Dukes, he has had unprecedented success in both the Atlantic 10 Conference as well as nationally. It took only 149 games for Burt to claim his 100th career victory, the 15th fastest to that feat in NCAA women's basketball history.

He led Duquesne to its first NCAA Tournament in 2016. The ninth-seeded Dukes downed Seton Hall, 97-76, in the first round before falling to undefeated and eventual national champion UConn.

Burt's time on the Bluff has brought unmatched success. The Dukes have earned 11 postseason appearances and 10 20-win seasons in the 15 seasons in the Steel City. Prior to joining the coaching staff in 2007-08, the Dukes had never earned a trip to the postseason or eclipsed 20 wins in a single season.

During his 15 seasons on the Bluff, including seven as the program's top assistant coach, Burt helped the Dukes to 287 victories and ten postseason appearances. He has recruited and coached 16 players who earned all-conference honors a total of 33 times as well as 14 1,000 point scorers. He has also coached five players that received the Atlantic 10 Conference highest postseason awards – Player of the Year (April Robinson in 2016), Defensive Player of the Year (Kristi Little in 2008 & 2009 and Jocelyn Floyd in 2011), Rookie of the Year (Wumi Agunbiade in 2011) and Sixth Woman of the Year (Deva'Nyar Workman in 2016).

A key component in Burt's coaching philosophy is player and career development. In his time at Duquesne, 18 of Burt's players have gone on to play professionally overseas and 100% have earned their degrees.

In June 2013, Burt was selected as one of 30 head coaches across the nation to participate in the Center For Coaching Excellence by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA). The event introduces coaches to various aspects of leadership and provide a deeper understanding and appreciation of the importance of ethics and integrity in college women's basketball through a rigorous curriculum presented in a seminar-style environment. The exclusive invitation-only elite leadership program was held at Columbia University in New York City.

Burt has also facilitated roundtable discussions at the WBCA National Coaches Convention. He was one of 15 assistant coaches selected from around the country to lead the discussions in 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2011 and 2013. He also coordinated a roundtable meeting for the entire athletic department at UNC Wilmington during 2003-04 that focused on recruiting for all sports at the school.

In 2002, Burt worked with YES - Youth Education through Sports - Basketball Clinic as part of the Final Four Festivities in San Antonio, Texas. He reprised the role at the 2014 Final Four in Nashville, Tenn. YES is the NCAA's premier outreach to youth across the country, connecting young athletes with collegiate coaches and student-athletes to provide fundamental instruction in sports, conditioning and life skills at select collegiate championships.

Burt graduated from Trinity High School in Washington, Pa. prior to earning a bachelor's degree in physical education from West Liberty State College in 1993. While a Hilltopper, Burt was a scholar-athlete award winner as a member of the men's basketball team.
