The Duquesne University men's basketball team continues a three-game homestand at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse Friday with a 6:00 p.m. tip against Delaware. The Dukes, who have lost five games by seven points or less, including three by five points or less, opened their homestand with a 62-59 setback to Saint Peter's (Dec. 3) to begin the month of December. Tied, 47-47, with 8:12 remaining, the Peacocks used an 8-1 run to open up a 55-48 lead and never relinquished the advantage again. Senior forward Jahsean Corbett scored a game-high 15 points for Duquesne on 5-of-12 shooting from the field, including 2-for-3 from beyond the arc, while going 3-for-4 at the free-throw line. He also added six rebounds, three assists and a steal. Off the bench, junior forward Chabi Barre established a career high in scoring for the second consecutive game, contributing ${\bf 13}$ points while also leading the Dukes with ${\bf eight}$ rebounds. In his ${\bf four}$ games since returning from injury that forced him to miss the first four games of the 2024-25 season, Barre is averaging 8.3 points and 7.0 rebounds and has converted 63.6 percent (14-for-22) of his shots from the floor. Duquesne concludes its three-game homestand Wednesday, Dec. 11, with a 7:00 p.m. tip against Maine at the UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse after hosting the Blue Hens. The Dukes will follow by traveling to Akron, Ohio, for their final game of the regular season at a neutral site Saturday, Dec. 14, with a 6:00 p.m. tip against Towson at Lebron James Arena at St. Vincent-St. Mary High School.

Saint Peter's Leftovers - Duquesne leads the all-time series against SPU, 6-2 (.750) ... The Peacocks shot just 27.3 percent (9-for-33) from the field in the first half and 33.9 percent (20-for-59) overall ... Stephon Roberts and Mouhamed Sow combined for 18 rebounds for Saint Peter's, eight of which came on the offensive glass ... The Dukes used a **16-0** run to turn an 11-8 deficit into their largest lead of the game, 24-11, with 7:39 to go in the first half ... Duquesne owned a **24-22** edge in points in the paint and a **25-24** cushion in bench points ... Saint Peter's outscored the Dukes, 12-10, in second chance points and 9-7 on the break ... In 14 minutes of action senior guard **Cam Crawford** scored **four** points and grabbed **four** rebounds and finished with a plus/minus of +11.

Les Guépards - Duquesne has received a boost in its frontcourt with the return of junior forward Chabi Barre, who missed the first four games of the year due to injury. Barre was a presence in the paint over the course of three games at the Cayman Islands Classic, averaging 6.7 points and 6.7 rebounds in the tournament while also knocking down 64.3 percent (9-of-14) of his attempts from the floor. In a 67-54 win over Old Dominion (Nov. 26), Barre registered his first NCAA Division I double-figure scoring effort with 10 points while also grabbing seven rebounds. He followed that performance by contributing a career-high 13 points and eight rebounds against Saint Peter's as the Dukes opened a three-game homestand at the UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. In his first four games of the season, Barre also set a new personal standard in rebounds with 11 against Hampton (Nov. 25) while also matching a career high with four blocks against the Pirates. Through his first four games of the year, Barre owns 28 rebounds, 16 of which have come on the offensive glass.

Pendulum - The up-and-down nature of college basketball has never been more apparent this season than with Duquesne. Working five new players into the rotation and the Dukes looking to find their groove, the first **eight** games of the 2024-25 season has featured an amazing **32** ties (**4.0** per game) and **50** lead changes (**6.3** per contest). In just the last **four** games alone, contests between Duquesne and its opponent have featured **26** ties and **34** lead changes, including a season-high **nine** ties against South Dakota State (Nov. 24) and **12** lead changes vs. Hampton (Nov. 25).

Defense Wins Championships - The Dukes have seemingly rounded into form defensively, as over the last **four** games opponents are averaging **62.8** points per contest. The four foes have combined to convert just **37.9** percent (**85-for-224**) of its shots from the field, including a **25-for-79** (**31.6%**) performance from beyond the arc. Duquesne has won **29** consecutive games dating back to the 2018-19 campaign when holding opponents to under **60** points thanks to a 67-54 win over Old Dominion to close out the 2024 Cayman Islands Classic. Included in that stretch is a perfect **17-0** mark in three years **Dru Joyce III** has been a member of the coaching staff on the Bluff, including two years as associate head coach from 2022 to 2024.

Cayman Islands Classic Leftovers - Duquesne finished 1-2 as part of the Cayman Islands Classic and finished in seventh place thanks to its win over Old Dominion ... The Dukes established season highs in multiple specialty stats during their three games of the Cayman Islands Classic, including 19 second chance points against South Dakota State and 21 points on the break against Hampton ... The Dukes and Jackrabbits were tied nine times, a season high for Duquesne, while the contest against the Pirates featured a season-high 12 lead changes ... Boston College earned a 63-61 victory over Boise State to claim the title of the 2024 Cayman Islands Classic ... Joshua Beadle drilled a three-pointer with 2.3 seconds remaining to lift the Eagles over the Broncos in the championship game ... In the game for third place, South Dakota State defeated Missouri State, 75-55 ... High Point edged Hampton, 76-73, in the game for fifth place ... Earning MVP honors of the 2024 Cayman Islands Classic was Donald Hand, Jr., of Boston College, who averaged 12.0 points, 6.7 rebounds and 2.0 assists during three games of the tournament ... Hampton guard Noah Farrakhan averaged 21.0 points in three games of the Cayman Islands Classic to lead all scorers in the tournament ... Oscar Cluff of South Dakota State finished with three double-doubles at the 2024 Cayman Islands Classic, averaging 18.7 points and 12.3 rebounds while also registering 11 assists (3.7 pg) and four blocked shots.

Dinkin Donuts - Senior guard **Tre Dinkins III** led Duquesne in scoring over the course of three games at the 2024 Cayman Islands Classic, averaging **11.0** points per contest while also registering a team-high **nine** assists (**3.0** pg), **three** steals and shooting **80** percent (**8-for-10**) at the free-throw line. Dinkins III helped seal the win over Old Dominion by going **7-for-8** at the stripe in the final **4:45** of action and enters Friday's game against Delaware averaing **10.5** points per game. Over his last **six** games, each as a member of the starting lineup, Dinkins III is averaging **10.8** points and **2.2** assists per contest while shooting **77.3** percent (**17-for-22**) at the free-throw line. He is one of two Dukes to score at least **20** points in a game this season, scoring **20** against Milwaukee (Nov. 19).

Little Sun - A number of Dukes are capable of filling the basket on a given night, and that was never more evident than in a 67-54 victory over Old Dominion that helped Duquesne earn its first win of the 2024-25 season in closing out the Cayman Islands Classic. Off the bench, junior forward **Matúš Hronský** paced the Dukes in their win over the Monarchs by matching a career high with **13** points, including a pair of dunks in the closing minutes that contributed to sealing the victory. The only other double-figure scoring effort for Hronský during his time on the Bluff came in his Duquesne debut, a 91-63 win over Montana, Nov. 8, 2022, that opened the 2022-23 season for the Dukes. In that contest, playing as the backup point guard, Hronský scored **13** points on **5-of-6** shooting, including a **2-for-3** performance from downtown. Hronský has opened the 2024-25 season having shot **41.7** percent (**10-for-24**) from beyond the arc, which leads the Dukes.

In the first meeting between the two programs, the Blue Hens earned an 86-81 victory over the Dukes as part of the Binghamton Hoop Fest in Bingamton, N.Y., Nov. 20, 1999 ... The game was the 1999-2000 season opener for both programs ... The contest featured eight ties and five lead changes, with the Blue Hens using a 7-0 run to snap a 72-72 tie and grab a 79-72 edge with 1:40 to play ... Delaware shot 66.7 percent (14-for-21) from the field in the second half and 54.5 percent (30-of-65) overall ... Former forward Wayne Smith (1998-2002) led Duquesne against Delaware with 30 points and six rebounds ... Smith shot 10-of-21 from the floor, including 3-for-8 from beyond the arc, and finished 7-for-10 at the free-throw line ... In his ninth season leading the Blue Hens is Martin Ingelsby, who has amassed a career record of 136-120 (.531) ... Ingelsby led Delaware to the 2022 CAA Tournament title, earning the Blue Hens an automatic bid to the NCAA Championship ... In the 2022 NCAA Tournament, Delaware fell to Villanova, 80-60, in a game played at PPG Paints Arena in Pittsburgh, Pa. ... The Blue Hens feature five players averaging in double figures scoring for a team that averages 79.8 points per contest ... Senior forward John Camden Delaware is scoring at a 17.1 points per game clip while shooting 49.5 percent (45-for-91) from the floor, including 50 percent (22-for-44) from beyond the arc ... Junior guard Cavan Reilly adds 14.9 points per game and has converted 54.3 percent (38-for-70) of his attempts from the field, including a 20-for-46 (.435) performance from deep ... The Blue Hens are 2-0 on the road this season, with wins over Iona, 64-58, and Rider, 72-66.

WORTH NOTING

- The 2024-25 season marks the **109th** year of Duquesne basketball. The Dukes started play in 1913-14 (DU did not field a team in 1944-45-46 due to World War II).
- Duquesne, which has posted back-to-back **20**-win seasons for the first time since 1971 & 1972, is looking to record **three** consecutive 20-win campaigns for the first time since finishing with four straight 20-win seasons from 1952 to 1955. The Dukes are also **13** wins shy of 1,500 as an NCAA program.
- The leading active scorer for the Dukes is senior forward Jahsean Corbett, who owns career totals of 1,372 points and 761 rebounds.
 Corbett amassed totals of 1,303 points and 725 rebounds in three seasons at Chicago State prior to transferring to Duquesne.
- Jahsean Corbett has appeared in 101 career games at the NCAA Division I level, each as a member of the starting lineup. His 100th career start came in a 67-54 win for the Dukes over Old Dominion in the final game of the Cayman Islands Classic.
- The closest member of the Dukes to **1,000** career points is redshirt junior guard **Maximus Edwards**, who enters Friday's game with **783** career points. Named the 2023 Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Year, Edwards scored 722 in two seasons at George Washington before transferring to Duquesne.

Depth Charge - Thanks to the performances from forwards **Matúš Hronský** and **Chabi Barre** in a 67-54 win over Old Dominion that closed out play in the Cayman Islands Classic, a total of **eight** different Dukes have scored in double figures in the first **eight** games of the 2024-25 season. Duquesne has received **20** double-figure scoring efforts so far this season, including four each from guards **Jake DiMichele** and **Maximus Edwards** and forward **Jahsean Corbett**, which leads the Dukes.

FLA - Speaking of forward **Jahsean Corbett**, the transfer from Chicago State paced the Dukes in the opener of a three-game homestand at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse against Saint Peter's (Dec. 3) with **15** points. Corbett, a native of Orlando, Fla., shot **5-for-12** from the field against the Peacocks in becoming the **sixth** different student-athlete for Duquesne in **eight** games this season to lead the team in scoring. Corbett is also proving to be an adept distributor early in the 2024-25 campaign, as he ranks third for the Dukes in assists with **13**, an average of **1.6** per contest.

Paint By Numbers - Duquesne was able to garner its first win of the 2024-25 season with a 67-54 triumph over Old Dominion to close out the Cayman Islands Classic due to its work down low. The Dukes owned a 40-30 edge in points in the paint, establishing a season high in the category. Duquesne has won eight consecutive games dating back to the beginning of the 2022-23 season when scoring at least 40 points in the paint and through eighth games this year is averaging 29.3 points per contest down low.

David On The Block - Junior forward David Dixon ranked seventh in the Atlantic 10 last year with an average of 1.62 blocks per game and also finished the year with 38 of the 83 dunks (45.8%) for Duquesne. Dixon is 20 dunks shy of becoming the second member of the Dukes on record with 100 to his career credit and owns three this season, which trails only forward Chabi Barre, who owns five. The most in program history is Damian Saunders, who rattled the rim 166 times during his career from 2008 to 2011. In addition, Dixon is just six rejections shy of 100 career blocks, owning an average of 1.31 blocks per contest in his 72 career games on the Bluff.

Did You Know? The Dukes finished **12-0** last season when first to reach **70** points against an opponent and have won **31** consecutive games when turning the trick.

Offensive Spark - Each of the three double-figure scorers for the Dukes in their 2024-25 season opener against Lipscomb are newcomers who played their first game in a Duquesne uniform. Guard Tre Dinkins III scored a team-high 16 points off the bench, while guard Maximus Edwards added 14 and forward Jahsean Corbett 12. Combined, the five newcomers that made their debut in a Duquesne uniform against the Bisons produced 69.4 percent (50-of-72) of the offensive output for the Dukes.

What Was Lost ... At the conclusion of the 2023-24 season, the seven players that wrapped up their NCAA Division I career for the Dukes combined for an amazing 346 double-figure scoring games. Included in that was 117 from former guard Dae Dae Grant (56 with the Dukes) and 54 for former guard Jimmy Clark III, all of which came on the Bluff.

... And What Was Gained - In the day and age of the NCAA Transfer Portal, it's reload instead of rebuild. Duquesne welcomed a total of 199 double-figure scoring games from the student-athletes that transferred in as part of the first recruiting class for head coach Dru Joyce III. In addition to the 71 over three seasons from wing Jahsean Corbett at Chicago State, junior guard Maximus Edwards posted 40 double-figure scoring games over two seasons at George Washington and senior guard Tre Dinkins III scored at least 10 points on 33 occasions in two years at Canisius. The trio have combined for 10 double-figure scoring games at Duquesne this season.

At The Heart Of It - The top two returning scorers for points at Duquesne entering the 2024-25 season were juniors David Dixon and Kareem Rozier, who enter Friday's game against Delaware with career totals of 420 and 380 points, respectively. Dixon is Duquesne's active leader for consective starts with 10, while Rozier has appeared in 66 straight games, tops for the Dukes. Rozier owns eight career double-figure scoring efforts at Duquesne, a stretch in which the Dukes have posted a record of 5-3 (.625). Meanwhile, in the 18 games that Dixon has scored at least 10 points in a game Duquesne has amassed a mark of 11-7 (.611).

HEAD COACH DRU JOYCE III

First Season at Duquesne & Overall • Third Season Overall at DU

Dru Joyce III was named the 18th head coach in the 109-year history of Duquesne basketball March 28, 2024. Joyce III, a native of Akron, Ohio, spent two seasons as associate head coach for the Dukes under Keith Dambrot from 2022 to 2024, helping guide Duquesne to an overall record of 45-25 (.643), including a 20-16 (.556) mark in the Atlantic 10, during that span.

The Dukes made an appearance in the 2023 College Basketball Invitational (CBI) before earning the automatic bid for the A-10 in the 2024 NCAA Championship by winning four games in five days en route to the 2024 Atlantic 10 Championship crown in Brooklyn, N.Y., at the Barclays Center. Duquesne, as a No. 11 seed, made its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 1977 and earned its first victory in the championship since 1969 thanks to a 71-67 win over No. 6 seed BYU in Omaha, Neb., at CHI Health Center Arena.

During his first two seasons on the Bluff as associate head coach, Joyce III was instrumental in the development of guards Jimmy Clark III and Dae Dae Grant. Clark III is a two-time Atlantic 10 All-Defensive Team (2023, 2024) honoree, having led the conference in steals each of the last two years, and was also named to the 2024 All-Atlantic 10 Second Team. In two seasons with the Dukes, Grant scored 1,070 points in 67 games, an average of 16.0 points per contest, becoming the 40th player in program history to join the Duquesne 1,000-Point Club. A two-time All-Atlantic 10 Second Team (2023, 2024) selection, Grant established single-season (94.2%) and career (91.4%) records for free-throw percentage while also setting a new program benchmark for consecutive free throws made (46) during the 2023-24 campaign.

QUOTABLE

"I've wanted to be an NCAA Division I head coach since I was 14 years old, so I'm overwhelmed with joy to be named the next head coach at Duquesne University," Joyce III said. "I'd like to thank Duquesne University President Ken Gormley, Director of Athletics Dave Harper and the Board of Trustees for this unbelievable opportunity. I'm looking forward to expanding on the legacy that Keith Dambrot has built the last seven years, and I'm extremely grateful for the opportunity to continue to make an impact with the student-athletes, coaches and staff to make our program one that Duquesne and the surrounding region can be proud of."

PRIOR TO DUQUESNE

Joyce III joined the staff at Duquesne in May of 2022 after spending three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Cleveland State. While on the staff of the Vikings that was led by Dennis Gates, Joyce III helped Cleveland State go from a 10-21 season to a 19-8 (.704) record and NCAA Tournament appearance in the span of two seasons. The Vikings earned an automatic bid to the 2021 NCAA Championship and followed with a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) appearance in 2022 as Cleveland State finished with a record of 20-11 (.645). During the final two seasons Joyce III was on staff at CSU, the Vikings finished 31-10 (.756) in the Horizon League, including a 16-4 (.800) ledger in 2020-21 and a 15-6 (.714) mark in 2021-22.

FAMILY TIES

Joyce III takes over at Duquesne for Keith Dambrot, who finished with an overall record of 116-96 (.547) with the Dukes and announced his retirement March 18, 2024. The ties between Joyce III and Dambrot date back to 1999-00, when Joyce III was the point guard for Dambrot's Akron St. Vincent-St. Mary High School team. Joyce III, who was a teammate of both Lebron James and eventual college teammate Romeo Travis at SVSM, played two seasons under Dambrot, who left to take an assistant coaching position at Akron in 2001.

Following a high school career in which he garnered all-state honors, the Irish went 103-5 (.954) with three state titles during his tenure, Joyce III moved on to Akron, where he established the program career record for assists (503) and earned All-Mid-American Conference (MAC) honors twice (2006, 2007). Joyce III took over as the starting point guard for the Zips as a sophomore when Dambrot was named head coach prior to the 2005-06 season, and during his time Akron won 81 games, including tying the school record for victories with 26 during the 2006-07 season.

Following a standout career with the Zips, Joyce III played professionally in Europe for 12 seasons in Germany, Poland, Russia and France. He ended his pro career as the all-time leader in assists in Germany's Basketball Bundesliga. Joyce III, who concluded his collegiate career with 1,046 points, was inducted into the Akron Varsity "A" Hall of Fame in 2019, the same year as Dambrot.

QUOTABLE

"Dru Joyce III has proven his abundant talent as a coach," Duquesne University President Ken Gormley said. "He's been a key figure in the recent success of the Duquesne men's basketball program, alongside Keith Dambrot, that culminated this year in the exciting Atlantic 10 Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance, re-energizing men's basketball at Duquesne and in Pittsburgh. Dru is already a respected, valued and admired member of the Duquesne family. For that reason, this was an easy decision. Dru will carry forward the great work of Coach Dambrot and continue to usher in an exciting new era of Duquesne basketball that will allow our impressive team of student-athletes to shine on a national stage."
