The Duquesne University men's basketball team continues a **three-game** homestand to open its 2025-26 season Friday with the first of three games in the Villanova Challenge with a 7:00 p.m. tip against Sacred Heart at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. The Dukes opened their **110th** season of NCAA basketball with an 83-63 victory over Niagara (Nov. 3), picking up program victory **No. 1,500** in the process. Senior guard **Tarence Guinyard** led Duquesne in the win over the Purple Eagles with **19** points and tied a career-high with **five** assists, while junior guard **Jimmie Williams** contributed **15** points, **four** assists and **three** steals. Graduate student **John Hugley IV**, in his first game for the Dukes, finished with **seven** points, a game-high **eight** rebounds and a block in the triumph, shooting **3-for-6** from the field, including **1-for-1** from deep. Duquesne concludes its **three-game** homestand to open the year after hosting the Pioneers by continuing play in the Villanova Challenge Tuesday, Nov. 11, with an 8:00 p.m. tip against Queens.

DUKES WELCOME EIGHT NEWCOMERS

• Duquesne University head men's basketball coach **Dru Joyce III** added eight newcomers for the 2025-26 campaign to complement the 10 returning players for the Dukes, including four transfers and four freshmen.

• The latest Duquesne recruiting class includes four guards, three forwards and a center. Joining the Dukes via the NCAA Transfer Portal are guards **Tarence Guinyard** (UTM) and **Jimmie Williams** (South Florida) as well as forward **John Hugley IV** (Xavier) and **Stef van Bussel** (Charleston). Joining as freshmen are guards **Dom Aekins** and **Arness Lawson**, each of whom hail from Columbus, Ohio, and a pair of international recruits in **Frederik Jellum** (Copenhagen, Denmark) and **Lazar Milošević** (Bileća, Republika Srpska).

• The four NCAA Division I transfers that will compete for Duquesne in 2025-26 own combined career totals of **1,650** points, **750** rebounds, **218** assists and **117** steals entering the 2025-26 season. Hugley IV compiled career totals of 871 points and 469 rebounds over the last five years, which has included stops at Pittsburgh, Oklahoma and Xavier. An All-Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) Honorable Mention selection after his sophomore season with the Panthers in 2022, Hugley IV needs 122 points to reach 1,000 as well as just 23 boards for 500 in his NCAA career.

• Guinyard joins the Dukes after spending the 2024-25 season at the University of Tennessee at Martin (UTM), where he led the Skyhawks in scoring at **16.3** points per game while also averaging **4.7** rebounds and **2.3** assists per contest. Owning an uncanny ability to get to the free-throw line, Guinyard averaged almost **six** trips to the stripe per game last year, converting **74.3** percent (**142-for-191**) of his opportunities in 32 games. Guinyard ranked **fourth** in the Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) in scoring and **ninth** in free-throw percentage en route to being named to the 2025 All-OVC First Team. His penchant for getting to the stripe last year followed a junior college career where in two seasons at Florida State College at Jacksonville (FSCJ), Guinyard finished 338-for-486 (69.5 percent) at the free-throw line. In two seasons with the Blue Wave, Guinyard scored 1,302 points in 63 games, an average of 20.7 points per contest.

• Another newcomer with a decorated junior college career is Jimmie Williams, who spent the 2023-24 campaign at Wallace State Community College. In 35 games, Williams helped guide the Lions to an overall record of 26-9 (.743) by averaging 22.5 points per game along with 8.3 rebounds and 5.0 assists per contest. He posted 14 double-doubles that season, including a pair of triple-doubles, and in the quarterfinals of the Alabama Community College Conference (ACCC) Tournament dropped a Wallace State single-game record 48 points. Named a 2024 National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All-American, Williams spent last year at South Florida, where he appeared in 30 games and averaged **7.5** points, **2.6** rebounds and **1.2** assists per contest.

• In addition to the four transfers for the Dukes in 2025-26, four fresh faces join the program, including a pair that hail from Columbus, Ohio, and two international players. Aekins originally signed with the Dukes in November of 2023 before spending a year at prep school, while Lawson is the all-time leading scorer at Pickerington North High School. Jellum and Milošević join the Dukes from Denmark and Republika Srpska, respectively. The international pair join Nečas and van Bussel as international players for Duquesne. Last year, van Bussel earned a medical redshirt while at the College of Charleston after appearing in 21 games as a true freshman during the 2023-24 season at fellow Atlantic 10 foe Saint Louis. In an average of 7.8 minutes per game with the Billikens, van Bussel averaged 1.6 points and 2.6 rebounds, including six points and a career-high 10 rebounds in a career-high 26 minutes against Rhode Island.

• Meanwhile, among the returners for Duquesne in 2025-26 are a pair of student-athletes that missed last season due to injury, while another played seven games for the Dukes before missing the rest of the year. Both guard **Brandon Hall** and forward **Alex Williams** will see their first action on the Bluff in 2025-26, while guard **Jake DiMichele** looks for a healthy season after averaging **10.9** points and shooting **50** percent (**29-of-58**) from the floor in the first seven games of the 2024-25 campaign, each coming off the bench. Included among his performances early last season was a career-high **21** points, including **19** in the second half, against Milwaukee.

• As a rookie in 2023-24, DiMichele started **21** games, with the Dukes **15-6 (.714)** in those contests. Overall he appeared in **30** games, producing averages of **6.4** points and **2.5** rebounds while converting **46** percent (**75-for-163**) of his shots from the floor. Reaching double figures in scoring **eight** times, he paced the Dukes in a 68-59 win over Fordham with **15** points and then matched that season high in scoring with **15** points against Davidson. A key piece of a rotation that helped guide Duquesne to the 2024 Atlantic 10 Championship, in the semifinals, a 70-60 victory over St. Bonaventure, DiMichele scored **12** points. In the 2024 NCAA Tournament, he contributed **eight** points in a 71-67 victory over No. 6 seed BYU as the Dukes collected their first win in the NCAA Championship since 1969.

• Hall spent his first two years in the junior college ranks, averaging **10.3** points in **31** games at Moberly Area Community College in 2022-23 and **16.4** points at Howard College in 2023-24 in **18** contests. Alex Williams appeared in **68** career games, including **17** starts, at Furman from 2021 to 2024, compiling career totals of **562** points, **209** rebounds and **27** double-figure scoring games.

Duquesne won the only meeting between the two programs, a 74-63 victory as part of the San Juan Shootout in Caguas, Puerto Rico, Dec. 20, 2002 ... In that victory the Dukes opened the second half on a 15-5 run to open up a 52-41 lead after Duquesne owned a one-point advantage, 37-36, at halftime ... The win over the Pioneers marked the first game out of the United States for the Dukes as a program ... Former guards Bryant McAllister (2002-06) and Kevin Forney (1999-2003) each scored 16 points to lead Duquesne in the win, while center Simplice Njoya (2001-03) registered a double-double with 13 points and 15 rebounds ... Former guard Jimmy Tricco (2002-04) contributed 10 points and three assists in the victory ... Sacred Heart is led by **Anthony Latina (Brandeis '95)**, who is in his 13th season as head coach ... The Pioneers were members of the Northeast Conference (NEC) but joined the MAAC prior to the 2024-25 season ... The Pioneers opened their 2025-26 season with a 103-46 victory over the United States Merchant Marine Academy (Nov. 4) ... Former Duquesne head coach Danny Nee served as head coach at Merchant Marine from 2010 to 2014 ... Redshirt senior forward Anquan Hill finished with a double-double in Sacred Heart's 2025-26 season opener thanks to 21 points and 12 rebounds ... Hill, who spent the 2022-23 season at St. Bonaventure, was named to the 2025 All-MAAC Third Team after averaging 12.8 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last season ... Hill began his career at Fairleigh Dickinson (FDU), averaging 7.7 points for the Knights during the 2021-22 campaign ... Six players scored in double figures for SHU in the win over Merchant Marine, including 18 points from Dashon Gittens (8-for-9 FG), a transfer from FIU.

FOUR SCORE AND ...

- In today's day and age of college basketball with the NCAA Transfer Portal, Duquesne offers senior forward **David Dixon**, who will play his final season with the Dukes in 2025-26 and has spent his entire career on the Bluff.
- Dixon, 6'9" and 230 pounds, owns career totals of **575** points and **426** rebounds and last season became just the **second** player in program history to eclipse career totals of both **100** blocks and **100** dunks.
- A career **55.4** percent (**224-for-404**) from the field in **97** games, including **24** starts, Dixon ranks fifth in the Duquesne record book for blocks (**129**) while sitting second in dunks (**105**). Dixon is the program's active leader in both points and rebounds and is **74** caroms shy of **500** for his career.
- Dixon is one of just **four** players in the Atlantic 10 this season that has spent their entire career with one program, joining 6'10" forward Sean Logan of Davidson, 6'10" forward Christian Fermin of VCU and 6'11" center Mike Walz of Richmond. Ironically, each of the four student-athletes to have played their entire career at one institution are post players.
- Dixon also has shown a flair for the dramatic, as he buried a three-pointer with **4.8** seconds left in overtime to snap an 80-80 deadlock and help propel Duquesne to an 85-81 victory over Saint Joseph's (1/8/25) at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse.

Niagara Leftovers - Duquesne improved to **14-7 (.667)** all-time against the Purple Eagles in the first meeting between the two programs since 2007 ... The Dukes also improved to **91-19 (.827)** all-time in season openers, including **86-5 (.945)** when opening the year at home ... The **26-point** lead for Duquesne in the second half eclipsed its largest lead at any point during the 2024-25 campaign against an NCAA Division I opponent ... Guards **Tarence Guinyard** and **Jimmie Williams** combined to shoot **12-of-18 (.667)** from the floor, including **7-for-12 (.583)** from beyond the arc ... Off the bench, redshirt senior guard **Maximus Edwards** scored four points, grabbed three boards and tied a career-high with **five** assists without a turnover ... In a combined 15 minutes of action, redshirt sophomore **Stef van Bussel (4)** and freshman **Lazar Milošević (7)** combined for **11** points and **three** rebounds, shooting **3-for-3** from the floor and **5-for-7** at the free-throw line ... Junior guard **Lucas Prolla** celebrated his 21st birthday against Niagara by playing final 2:28 of action, registering a steal ... The Dukes owned a **32-25** edge in rebounding and finished with **18** assists ... Duquesne's **900th** program win also came against Niagara Dec. 5, 1978, with an 82-69 victory in the third game of the 1978-79 season as the Dukes improved to 3-0 in their first season under head coach Mike Rice ... Jersey Swap - A number of returning Dukes are donning new uniform numbers this season, including both of Duquesne's returning starters. Redshirt senior guard **Cam Crawford** switches to wearing **No. 5** after sporting No. 1 last season, while junior forward **Jakub Nečas** wears **No. 9** this season after using the No. 7 for his jersey his first two years with the program. Senior guard **Maximus Edwards**, meanwhile, switches to **No. 22** after sporting No. 8 a year ago. In addition, two international players will wear jersey numbers never before worn in the 110-year history of Duquesne basketball. Redshirt sophomore **Stef van Bussel** will don **No. 18**, while freshman forward **Lazar Milošević** will wear **No. 27**. Nečas is also the first student-athlete for the Dukes to wear No. 9 since Chuck Horne sported the digit from 1950-51.

Defense Wins Championships - Duquesne gave up 80 or more points just **four** times during the 2024-25 season in the first year under head coach **Dru Joyce III** and finished the year ranked **fourth** in the Atlantic 10 in scoring defense (**67.3** ppg). Duquesne, which held **nine** consecutive opponents under **70** points during the course of last year, the longest streak by the program in over **60** years, owns a record of **13-6 (.684)** under Joyce III when holding opponents to under **70** points, including a perfect **6-0** when yielding less than **60** points in a contest.

Closing Out - A total of **62.5** percent (**20-of-32**) of Duquesne's games during the 2024-25 season, the first for **Dru Joyce III** as head coach, were decided by **nine** points or less. Of those **20** games, the outcome of **12** was decided by **five** points or fewer. In **nine** Atlantic 10 road games last season, Duquesne was outscored by a total of **14** points, with the seven losses by a combined **27** points (**3.86** average margin of defeat).

100/100 - Forward **David Dixon** joined an exclusive group in an 85-68 victory over George Mason (March 1) last season as part of the Chuck Cooper Classic at UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. His first dunk of the contest, which came at the 11:02 mark of the first half, helped Dixon become just the **second** player in program history to reach career totals of both **100** dunks and **100** blocks. Former forward Damian Saunders (2008-11) owns career records in both categories with 166 jams and 300 rejections. Dixon contributed **14** points off the bench in the win against the Patriots as Duquesne improved to **16-7 (.696)** since the beginning of the 2022-23 campaign when he scores in double figures.

Did You Know? The Dukes have won **35** consecutive games dating back to the 2018-19 campaign when holding opponents to under **60** points thanks to a **69-56** victory over Loyola Chicago (Feb. 8) last year at the UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. Included in that stretch is a perfect **23-0** mark in four years **Dru Joyce III** has been a member of the coaching staff on the Bluff, including two years as associate head coach from 2022 to 2024.

HEAD COACH DRU JOYCE III

Second Season at Duquesne & Overall • Fourth Season Overall at DU

Dru Joyce III was named the 18th head coach in the 110-year history of Duquesne basketball March 28, 2024. Joyce III, a native of Akron, Ohio, spent two seasons as associate head coach for the Dukes under Keith Dambrot from 2022 to 2024, helping guide Duquesne to an overall record of 45-25 (.643), including a 20-16 (.556) mark in the Atlantic 10, during that span.

In his first season leading the Dukes, Joyce III helped Duquesne erase an 0-6 start to the season by winning nine of 12 games to even its overall record at 9-9 (.500), including a 4-1 (.800) start in the Atlantic 10. A focus on the defensive end, the Dukes concluded their first year under Joyce III yielding an average of 67.3 points per game, which ranked fourth in the Atlantic 10. Joyce III was also instrumental in the development of guard Cam Crawford, who led the Atlantic 10 in three-point field goal percent accuracy on the year at 43.1 percent (44-for-102).

The Dukes made an appearance in the 2023 College Basketball Invitational (CBI) before earning the automatic bid for the A-10 in the 2024 NCAA Championship by winning four games in five days en route to the 2024 Atlantic 10 Championship crown in Brooklyn, N.Y., at the Barclays Center. Duquesne, as a No. 11 seed, made its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 1977 and earned its first victory in the championship since 1969 thanks to a 71-67 win over No. 6 seed BYU in Omaha, Neb., at CHI Health Center Arena.

QUOTABLE

"I've wanted to be an NCAA Division I head coach since I was 14 years old, so I'm overwhelmed with joy to be named the next head coach at Duquesne University," Joyce III said. "I'd like to thank Duquesne University President Ken Gormley, Director of Athletics Dave Harper and the Board of Trustees for this unbelievable opportunity. I'm looking forward to expanding on the legacy that Keith Dambrot has built the last seven years, and I'm extremely grateful for the opportunity to continue to make an impact with the student-athletes, coaches and staff to make our program one that Duquesne and the surrounding region can be proud of."

PRIOR TO DUQUESNE

Joyce III joined the staff at Duquesne in May of 2022 after spending three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Cleveland State. While on the staff of the Vikings that was led by Dennis Gates, Joyce III helped Cleveland State go from a 10-21 season to a 19-8 (.704) record and NCAA Tournament appearance in the span of two seasons. The Vikings earned an automatic bid to the 2021 NCAA Championship and followed with a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) appearance in 2022 as Cleveland State finished with a record of 20-11 (.645). During the final two seasons Joyce III was on staff at CSU, the Vikings finished 31-10 (.756) in the Horizon League, including a 16-4 (.800) ledger in 2020-21 and a 15-6 (.714) mark in 2021-22.

FAMILY TIES

Joyce III takes over at Duquesne for Keith Dambrot, who finished with an overall record of 116-96 (.547) with the Dukes and announced his retirement March 18, 2024. The ties between Joyce III and Dambrot date back to 1999-00, when Joyce III was the point guard for Dambrot's Akron St. Vincent-St. Mary High School team. Joyce III, who was a teammate of both LeBron James and eventual college teammate Romeo Travis at SVSM, played two seasons under Dambrot, who left to take an assistant coaching position at Akron in 2001.

Following a high school career in which he garnered all-state honors, the Irish went 103-5 (.954) with three state titles during his tenure. Joyce III moved on to Akron, where he established the program career record for assists (503) and earned All-Mid-American Conference (MAC) honors twice (2006, 2007). Joyce III took over as the starting point guard for the Zips as a sophomore when Dambrot was named head coach prior to the 2005-06 season, and during his time Akron won 81 games, including tying the school record for victories with 26 during the 2006-07 season.

Following a standout career with the Zips, Joyce III played professionally in Europe for 12 seasons in Germany, Poland, Russia and France. He ended his pro career as the all-time leader in assists in Germany's Basketball Bundesliga. Joyce III, who concluded his collegiate career with 1,046 points, was inducted into the Akron Varsity "A" Hall of Fame in 2019, the same year as Dambrot.

QUOTABLE

"Dru Joyce III has proven his abundant talent as a coach," Duquesne University President Ken Gormley said. "He's been a key figure in the recent success of the Duquesne men's basketball program, alongside Keith Dambrot, that culminated this year in the exciting Atlantic 10 Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance, re-energizing men's basketball at Duquesne and in Pittsburgh. Dru is already a respected, valued and admired member of the Duquesne family. For that reason, this was an easy decision. Dru will carry forward the great work of Coach Dambrot and continue to usher in an exciting new era of Duquesne basketball that will allow our impressive team of student-athletes to shine on a national stage."

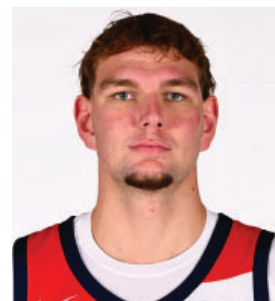

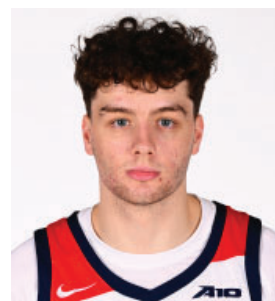
