Noting Lebanon Valley

Lebanon Valley hosts the 20th edition of the Rinso Marquette Tournament as the defending champion, winning its first title since 2004-05 last season ... LVC is coming off a superb 23-7 campaign that saw them go to the Commonwealth Conference title game and win the ECAC South title ... They will be led by preseason all-American **Joe Meehan**, a first-team all-CC point guard last year who averaged 18.4 ppg and 6.1 apg ... Senior guard **Jordan Stewart** led the CC in defensive boards, pulling in 7.0 per game while also scoring 6.9 ppg ... Junior center **Danny Brooks** had a much-improved sophomore year and is poised for even more in 2011-12, coming off a 10.7 ppg/5.6 rpg season ... LVC has two starting roles to fill at 2-guard and forward, with **Cameron Prince**, **Sam Diaz**, **Logan Walters**, and **Matt O'Brien** returning with guard experience and **Joey Giangioffe** and **David Cobin** back at forward ... Coach **Brad McAlester** brings in six newcomers for this year.

Gallaudet went 17-11 overall and 12-6 in the North Eastern Athletic Conference in 2010-11 ... The Bison will make their Rinso Marquette tournament debut this season, squaring off against tournament host LVC in the first round ... Gallaudet returns an experienced squad of players, led by senior forward **Layton Seeber** and senior guard **Tony Tatum** ... Seeber averaged 14.6 ppg and 5.2 apg in 2010-11 ... He also pulled down 6.7 rpg and shot over 90 percent from the free-throw line ... His co-captain Tatum enjoyed paired him with 12.8 ppg while snatching 5.8 rpg ... Senior guard **Brandon McMillan** will also serve as a cornerstone after he averaged 9.3 ppg in 2010-11 ... Senior forward **Daniel Fava** is also poised to make big contributions this season, after playing in all 28 games last season ... Junior guard **Jocus Houston** will also add depth to the roster.

Rowan University compiled a 12-14 record last season ... The Profs started last season off winning the Widener Tip-Off Classic ... This will be Rowan's third tournament appearance, winning their two previous appearances in 1995-96 and 2007-08 ... Leading the returners is junior guard and team captain

Kendall White ... White started 24 of 26 games for the Profs last year, averaging 10.8 ppg ... He averaged 5.1 rebounds per game, and as a freshman earned NJAC Rookie of the Week honors four times ... Senior forward **Steve Secula** is back after a successful 2010-11 season which saw him average 9.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game ... In 2009-10, he ranked third in field goal percentage in the conference (.547) ... Sophomore guard **Jason Rosenberg** returns after playing in all 26 games last season and starting 24 of them ... Rosenberg averaged 4.5 ppg and brought down 2.2 rpg last season.

Wesley went 18-11 overall and 12-4 in the Capital Athletic Conference, reaching the CAC championship game last season ... Wesley will make their first Rinso Marquette tournament appearance, though they met Lebanon Valley here in the ECAC semis last year, which LVC won in a close contest...

Returning starters for Wesley include junior forward **Paul Reynolds**, who raked in All-CAC first team and D3hoops All-Mid-Atlantic Region honors ... Reynolds led the team in scoring (averaging 15.9 ppg), steals (57), and rebounds (6.9 per game) ... Senior guard **Chris Douglas** averaged 12.4 ppg with five 20+ point games ... Senior forward **Sean McAndrew** will also be a contributing factor, averaging 6.8 ppg last season ... The team will miss senior guard and All-CAC second-teamer **Darrel Johnson** this season due to injury, but pick up freshmen **Quincy Pettiford**, **Destin Johnson**, and 6-8 center **Matt Swistak**, all of whom are expected to be big contributors.

Noting Pitt-Bradford

Pitt-Bradford will make their first appearance in the Marquette tournament, after going 15-11 overall and 12-6 in the Allegheny Mountain Collegiate Conference in 2010-11 ... The Panthers bring back a solid core of talent from last season with four starters back, led by guard **Maria Costanza** ... Costanza earned second-team All-AMCC honors after starting all 26 games and leading the team in scoring with 12.4 points per game ... She also shot 41 percent from beyond the arc ... Senior guard **Danielle Zeamer** also earned second-team All-AMCC honors after averaging 10.3 ppg ... Senior guard **Ashley Seidenstricker** will also be a big contributing factor as she averaged 9.2 ppg last season, the third-best on the team ... Forwards **Hollie Rapp** and **Caitlin Jordan** return in the frontcourt ... Dr. George “Rinso” Marquette



Dr. George “Rinso” Marquette was an inspirational administrator and legendary coach at the Valley for 38 years, and was a mentor to thousands of young men and women during his career and in retirement until his passing in November 2008.

Marquette came to Lebanon Valley as a freshman in 1942 with plans to become a music teacher after graduation. After serving in the Air Force for three years, Marquette received his degree from LVC in 1948 and embarked on a career as a high school history teacher. He also played minor league baseball in the Canadian-American League.

In 1951, Marquette earned a master’s degree from Columbia University. A year later, he returned to Lebanon Valley College as chair of the physical education department and head baseball and men’s basketball coach. In his very first season as head coach of men’s basketball, he led his

squad to the “Sweet 16” of the NCAA Tournament, along with high-powered programs such as Kansas, Indiana, and Louisiana State. To this day, Lebanon Valley is the smallest school to ever advance that far in the NCAA Tournament.

Marquette was named dean of men in 1956 and earned his doctorate from Temple University in 1967. In 1984, he was named vice president for student affairs and remained in that position until his retirement in 1990.

On Oct. 16, 1999, LVC honored Marquette and his wife, Rufina '51, by dedicating a residence hall in their honor.

Since the establishment of the tournament in 1992, Lebanon Valley’s men’s team has won 10 of the 17 Rinso Marquette Tournaments and has appeared in the championship game 14 times. In 2004-05, LVC defeated New Jersey City in the championship for its fourth-straight tournament title. The Valley also won the tournament three straight years from 1997-99 and 1993-95.

In 2003-04, for the first time, a women’s tournament was held in addition to the men’s tournament. Lebanon Valley captured the inaugural women’s tournament and have twice more since then, and have advanced to the final every time.
