NOTES

■ TCU continues non-conference play with its first-ever meeting with Winthrop Wednesday at 7 p.m.

■ The Frogs' two losses this season have come by a combined four points, 62-60 to Clemson in overtime and 80-78 to USC.

■ TCU leads the Big 12 with 9.4 3-pointers made per game. TCU ranks 20th nationally in turnover margin (5.1) and 27th in turnovers forced (17.9).

■ Since the 2014-15 season, the Frogs have gone 61-10 in November and December combined. Under Jamie Dixon (since 2016-17), TCU has gone 40-6 in November and December combined. Also, under Dixon, TCU has gone 52-11 in nonconference games.

■ TCU has two returning starters from last season, senior Desmond Bane and sophomore Kevin Samuel. Bane has scored over 20 points in four of TCU's eight games and ranks fourth in the Big 12 with a scoring average of 18.0 points per game. Samuel ranks fourth in the Big 12 with 8.8 rebounds per game and fifth in the nation by shooting 70.3 percent from the field. Samuel's five double-doubles this season leads the Big 12 and ranks 11th in the nation.

■ Bane has earned multiple preseason honors. He was named to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team, was one of 20 players nationally named to the watch list for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year award, the Oscar Robertson Trophy and was named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 which is given to the best player in the nation.

■ At 1,397 career points, Bane is 11th on TCU's all-time scoring list. He is 29 points shy of Gary Turner (1,426, 1964-66) for 10th.

LAST TIME OUT

TCU was unable to complete a second half comeback as it fell, 80-78, to USC Friday night in the inaugural basketball game played at Fort Worth's new Dickies Arena. Down by as many as 18 points early in the second half, the Horned Frogs fought back to eventually tie the game, 78-78, on a layup by Kevin Samuel with eight seconds to play. Samuel, who finished with 17 points and 11 rebounds, missed the ensuing free throw, which set up the game-winning tip-in by USC's Nick Rakocevic with 0.2 seconds remaining. The Trojans outshot the Frogs 52.6 percent to 43.3 percent.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

Winthrop is 4-5 this season following a 92-88 loss to Coastal Carolina Saturday. Earlier this season, the Eagles pulled off one of the biggest upsets in program history when they beat No. 18 Saint Mary's in their second game in as many days. It was Winthrop's third win over a ranked team in program history and the first against a ranked team in a true road game. This season, Winthrop is led by senior forward Josh Ferguson's 13.7 points and 6.1 rebounds per game. As a team, Winthrop's 16.9 assists per game ranks 15th in the nation thanks in large part to Chandler Vaudrin, who ranks 15th nationally with 6.4 assists per game.

SERIES HISTORY

It's the first meeting between TCU and Winthrop. The Frogs are 4-1 against current members of the Big South Conference.

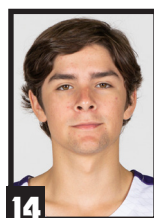

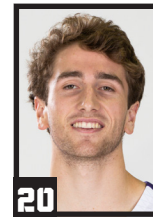

BANE NAMED TO WATCH LIST FOR ROBERTSON TROPHY

Desmond Bane continues to garner attention on award watch lists as he was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy list Thursday. The trophy is given annually to the outstanding men's college basketball player by the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA). The trophy is considered to be the oldest of its kind and has been given out since 1959.

BANE AND 20 POINTS

Desmond Bane had four games of 20 or more points through TCU's first seven games. That was the most 20-point performances by a TCU player since Corey Santee did so four times in in the 2001-02 season. Santee is currently the player development coordinator for the Horned Frogs.

400 FOR DIXON

TCU's 59-58 win over UC Irvine on Nov. 18 was career win No. 400 for Jamie Dixon. He became the 48th active NCAA Division I coach with 400 career wins and joined exclusive company and be the 11th head coach to reach 400 career wins in 17 seasons.

At 396 (total after last season), Dixon has the fourth-most wins ever by a head coach after 16 seasons. Only Mark Few (438 at Gonzaga), Roy Williams (437 at Kansas, North Carolina) and Thad Matta (422 at Butler, Xavier, Ohio State) have more wins after 16 seasons.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES TO START

Kevin Samuel is the first TCU player in 25 years to record three double-doubles in each of the first three games of the season. Samuel had 17 points and 12 rebounds on Nov. 7 against Southwestern, 12 points and 12 rebounds on Nov. 12 against Louisiana and 19 points and 11 rebounds on Nov. 18 against Air Force.

The last TCU player to record three double-doubles to start a season was Kurt Thomas when he had seven to begin the 1994-95 season.

18 THREES

On Nov. 12, TCU broke the school record for most 3-pointers in a game with 18. The old record was 17, which occurred twice. TCU had 17 against Grambling State on Dec. 30, 1999 and again at UNLV on March 13, 2008.

TCU's 18th 3-pointer came on the last shot attempt of the game, from Edric Dennis with 45 seconds to play. The Frogs made 12 3-pointers in the first half, which tied for the most-ever by a Big 12 Conference team in a half. It was the

sixth time that a team hit 12 in the first half. It last occurred on March 3, 2012, when Missouri made 12 3-pointers in the second half at Texas Tech.

The Frogs finished 18-of-38 (47.4 percent). The 48 attempts were the second-most ever by a TCU team. The most remains 39, which came against Houston on Feb. 1, 2003.

NUMEROUS NEWBIES

At 11, TCU is tied with Navy and Utah for the most freshmen of any NCAA Division I team. Of TCU's 11 freshmen, five are on scholarship.

At 13, TCU has the most newcomers of any NCAA Division I team. That number includes six walk-ons, which also includes. The Frogs return just five players who saw minutes last season (Owen Aschieris, Desmond Bane, Russell Barlow, Kevin Samuel and RJ Nemphard are the others). Nine of TCU's 13 newcomers are on scholarship.

FROGS SIGN TWO FOUR-STAR BIGS

TCU signed Terren Frank and Eddie Lampkin, two four-star big men for the incoming class of 2020 on Nov. 12.

Frank is a 6-7, 210-pound forward from Chatsworth, Calif. He is ranked 78th nationally in the ESPN 100 and is a consensus four-star player. Frank has played on two of the best teams in the state of California in Sierra Canyon High School and Team WhyNot. He led Sierra Canyon to two state championships and helped Team WhyNot reach the championship game of the Elite Youth Basketball League. On the EYBL circuit, Frank averaged 12 points and six rebounds.

Lampkin is a 6-10, 290-pound center from Katy, Texas. He's the No. 5 overall player in Texas according to TexasHoops.com and has a four-star rating by ESPN.com. Lampkin averaged 14 points, 10 rebounds and 2.4 assists last season as a junior at Morton Ranch High School. Heading into this season, Morton Ranch is the No. 3 ranked team in Class 6A and the top-ranked team in Houston according to TexasHoops.com. This past summer, Lampkin went to the Steph Curry Select Camp and earned MVP of the Steph Curry Under Armour game.

TEAMMATES THERE, TEAMMATES HERE

Freshmen guards PJ Fuller and Taryn Todd are playing together for the second-straight season. The two were teammates last season at Findlay Prep in Henderson, Nev. Fuller signed with the Frogs in November, while Todd was a late signee, officially joining TCU in late May. Findlay Prep went 18-6 with the duo. Fuller, a native of Seattle, Wash., averaged 18.7 points, 5.8 rebounds and 4.7 assists while Todd, from Ontario, Canada, averaged 12.7 points, 3.7 rebounds and 2.8 assists.

TODAY IN TCU BASKETBALL HISTORY

DECEMBER 11, 1992

TCU's defense held Tennessee-Martin scoreless over the final 4:33 of the game in a 75-67 win in two overtimes. Jentry Moore became the first TCU freshman since 1983 to score at least 20 points, and two different Horned Frogs pulled down 14 rebounds in the contest.

DESMOND BANE'S SUMMER

Desmond Bane had a busy and productive summer. The Big 12's top returning scorer declared for the NBA Draft and went through the draft process, working out in front of NBA personnel, before withdrawing his name. In August, Bane was one of 24 collegiate players to compete in the prestigious Nike Skills Academy, held at the Mamba Sports Academy in Thousand Oaks, Calif. There, Bane participated in on-court workouts led by elite instructors in front of scouts from nearly every NBA team.

PROJECTING DESMOND BANE

Desmond Bane returning for his senior season allows the Richmond, Ind., native to go up the charts in the TCU record book. Prior to the start of the season, Bane was 633 points away from matching the school record, held by Darrell Browder (1979-83). Only seven times has a TCU player scored at least 633 points in a season. If Bane were to score his point total last season of 563, it would put him at No. 3 on TCU's all-time scoring list. If Bane were to match last season's stats, he would rank top five all-time in points, field goals, 3-pointers, games started and minutes played.

Bane was close having a 50/40/90 season as a junior. Last season, he shot 50.2% from the field, 42.5% from 3-point range and 86.7% from the free throw line. No TCU player has ever had a 50/40/90 season.

FALL COMES, FROGS RISE

Since the 2014-15 season, the Frogs have gone 36-4 in the month of November and 60-10 in November and December combined. Under Jamie Dixon (since 2016-17), TCU has gone 39-6 in November and December combined.

THREE YEARS OF WINNING

TCU accumulated 68 wins over the first three seasons under Jamie Dixon, just two shy of the school record. TCU had 24 wins during its NIT championship run in 2016-17,

21 wins and an NCAA Tournament bid during the 2017-18 season and 23 wins and a return to the NIT semifinals last season.

TCU has won at least 20 games for three consecutive seasons for the second time in school history. The only other time TCU had three-straight 20 wins seasons came during the 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99 seasons. TCU has never won 20 or more games in four-straight seasons.

Jamie Dixon recorded 20 wins for the 15th time in his 16 seasons as a head coach last season. He is one of four active coaches who have had 20+ wins in 15 of their first 16 seasons as a head coach; Mark Few (all 16), Jim Boeheim (15 of 16), Jamie Dixon (15 of 16) and Bruce Pearl (15 of 16). Having 20 or more wins in 15 of 16 seasons as a head coach is pretty good. Below is the current list of highest percentage of seasons with 20+ wins among DI active head coaches.

BETTER IN THE BIG 12

After totaling just six Big 12 wins in its first three seasons in the conference, TCU has 21 Big 12 wins in the three seasons that Jamie Dixon is the head coach. Dixon is 22-32 in the Big 12, improving the 6-48 record TCU had in the Big 12 in the first three years after TCU left the Mountain West Conference in 2013.

FOREIGN FLARE

TCU's roster has five student-athletes on its roster from a foreign country, which ties for the seventh-most among NCAA DI programs. Furthermore, TCU's five foreign countries represented ranks tied for second nationally for the most. Only Davidson and Loyola Marymount have a more variety with six foreign countries represented. Countries outside of the United States that are represented are Argentina (Francisco Farabello), Canada (Taryn Todd), Barbuda (Kevin Samuel), New Zealand (Harrison Young) and Serbia (Nikola Vasiljevic).

NEW STAFF

TCU gained experience and success in its staff over the offseason with the hiring of Tony Benford and Duane Broussard.

Benford was hired as an assistant head coach after spending the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at LSU. He assumed the role of interim head coach during postseason play and led the Tigers to the Sweet 16. LSU went 28-10 during the 2018-19 season, the most wins by the program since 2000.

Broussard was hired as an assistant coach at TCU after six seasons at UCLA where he helped lead the Bruins to four NCAA Tournament appearances.

SHARING THE ROCK

TCU has led the Big 12 in assists per game in each of the first three seasons that Jamie Dixon has served as head coach.

WINNING AT HOME UNDER DIXON

TCU has won 15 home games in all three seasons of the Jamie Dixon era. The school record is 16 set during the 1997-98 season.

■ TCU has won 50 home games in the first four years under Jamie Dixon. The record for most home wins in a four year period is 57 from 1996-1999. TCU won 45 home games in the first three years under Dixon, the most in school history over a 3-year period. It beat the old TCU record of 44 home wins during the span of 1996-99.

■ TCU has won 11 of its last 16 Big 12 home games. The Frogs had won eight straight Big 12 home games until a loss to No. 14 Kansas on Feb. 11, 2019, which was the most for TCU in a conference since the 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99 seasons when the Frogs won nine straight in the Western Athletic Conference.

■ TCU in Schollmaier Arena is 50-14 overall and 15-12 in Big 12 games under Jamie Dixon.

■ TCU is 52-11 in nonconference games (including play in the Big 12 tournament and postseason). TCU is 49-7 against teams that aren't members of the Big 12 Conference.

■ The Frogs are 35-2 against nonconference opponents at Schollmaier Arena under Dixon. The two losses were to Lipscomb on Nov. 20, 2019 and Auburn on Jan. 28, 2017.

TCU AT DICKIES ARENA

TCU played USC on Dec. 6 in the first basketball game held at Fort Worth's new Dickies Arena. The Trojans defeated the Horned Frogs, 80-78. Dickies Arena, which seats 12,782 for basketball, is located adjacent to the Will Rogers Memorial Center campus, a 3-mile drive from TCU. The arena is scheduled to host the American Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Championship (2020-2022) and the first-and-second round games of the NCAA men's basketball tournament in 2022, of which TCU will serve as the host school.

WHY IS FORT WORTH CALLED COWTOWN?

Established in 1849 and named to honor General William Jenkins Worth, Camp Worth began as an Army outpost on the north-facing bluff overlooking the Clear Fork of the Trinity River. It was one of eight forts built and assigned to protect Texas settlers from Native American attacks along Texas's western frontier.

From the 1860s into the late 1870s, Fort Worth was the king of the cattle industry and earned its nickname – Cowtown. Hell's Half Acre, located where downtown Fort Worth is today, became the place to be for cowboys looking for entertainment. A cowboy could hang his hat, take off his boots, and settle in for a night of gambling, partying, and trouble in civilization's last stop on the Chisholm Trail before the long cattle drive north to Kansas City. Now it is the scene of vibrant restaurants, live music, and less bawdy entertainments.

All practices are generally closed unless otherwise specified. TV crews and photographers are only permitted to shoot practice after receiving permission from the Media Relations Office.

All media passes available for pickup on game day will be left at media will call, located in the main tunnel of Ed and Rae Schollmaier Arena.

MEDIA CREDENTIAL REQUESTS

All credential requests for home TCU basketball games will only be accepted through an online system (SportsSystems.com/TCU). Please visit the site for complete instructions on submitting the application form. All credential requests for an outlet must be made at one time, and only those applications submitted by an outlet's sports editor or sports director will be considered. Requests should be received no later than noon, two days prior to the game.

GAME DAY SERVICES

The TCU Athletics Communications Office will provide rosters of both teams, game notes, statistics and media guides to accredited media members for each home contest inside the media room on the lower level of Ed and Rae Schollmaier Arena. Complete statistics and game books will be available following each game. Media wishing to file stories after the game may do so in the press conference/media room, while food and drinks will be available for working media members prior to each home game in the same location.

RADIO BROADCASTS

Four (4) courtesy telephone lines, as well as two (2) ISDN SPIDS, are available courtside on press row for the visiting team's official radio station. The visitor's radio location is at the end of press row. The TCU/IMG Sports Network is located on the opposite end of press row. TCU Director of Broadcasting Brian Estridge serves as the local contact when placing phone line orders. He can be contacted at (817) 257-5462 or via email at b.estridge@tcu.edu. Also, for ease of operation, all outgoing calls should be placed with either a calling card or by collect.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

As prescribed in NCAA and Big 12 Conference guidelines, working photographers will be limited to the court baseline areas for game-time shooting. No photographers will be allowed to shoot courtside from in front of either the officials or press row tables. Additionally, tripods will not be allowed at courtside or along the end lines. #1. Chauncey Collins (6'0"-F-95, graduated '16, plays pro in Lithuania) led Dzukija to a victory over the league outsider Nevezis (3-9) 74-70 in the Lithuanian LKL in Saturday night's game. He was MVP of the game. Collins recorded 33 points (!!!) in 30 minutes. Dzukija Alytus (3-8) is placed second from the bottom (#9) in the LKL. It was his team's first victory after three consecutive losses. But this is still an early stage of the season and everything may happen. Collins has relatively good stats this year 12.0ppg, 1.6rpg and 1.7apg in seven games he played so far.

#2. JD Miller (6'8"-F-96, graduated '19, plays in Ukraine) contributed to an easy victory against the seventh-ranked Mykolaiv (3-7) 92-73 in the Ukrainian Superleague last Saturday. Miller scored 14 points and grabbed 7 rebounds; quite an impressive performance considering it's only his first season in pro basketball. SC Prometey Kamianske (8-1) is placed first in the Superleague. But the season just started, so everything may happen. It's Miller's first year with the team. Miller has relatively good stats this season 10.2ppg, 7.7rpg, 1.3apg and 1.3bpg.

#3. Kenrich Williams (6'7"-G-94, graduated '18, currently in the NBA), who plays in the NBA could not help the New Orleans Pelicans (6-14) in their last game. Despite Williams' good performance the New Orleans Pelicans (6-14) lost 114-110 on the road to the Los Angeles Lakers. He recorded 11 points and grabbed 7 rebounds in 33 minutes. It was Pelicans' third consecutive loss in a row. But the season is still in its first stage and everything can happen. This year Williams averages 5.6ppg, 5.9rpg and 1.8apg in 19 games.

#4. Experienced Kevin Langford (6'8"-F/C-85, graduated '09, plays pro in Finland) was the major contributor in a KTP Basket's surprising victory against the league leader Seagulls (14-3) 101-85 in the Finnish Korisliiga in Saturday night's game. He scored 22 points. KTP Basket Kotka (8-7) is placed seventh in the Korisliiga. But the season is still in its first stage and everything can happen. Langford has relatively good stats this season 10.7ppg, 5.5rpg and 2.5apg.

#5. Trey Zeigler (6'5"-G-91, graduated '15, plays in Finland) was not able to help Korihait (3-13) in their last game. Despite Zeigler's very good performance the bottom-ranked Korihait lost 84-69 at home to the higher-ranked (#8) Kataja. He had a double-double by scoring 19 points and getting 15 rebounds in 37 minutes. It was Korihait's first loss after three consecutive victories. Zeigler has individually a very good year with high stats. He averages 18.9ppg, 9.0rpg and 1.3apg in eight games.

#6. Brandon Parrish (6'6"-G-94, graduated '17, currently in Portugal) contributed to an easy victory against the league outsider Terceira crushing them 98-74 in the Portuguese LPB on Sunday night. He recorded 18 points, 7 rebounds and 4 assists. This season Parrish averages 9.4ppg, 5.3rpg and 1.4apg.

#7. Nikola Gacesa (6'9"-F-87, graduated '11, plays pro in Slovakia) was not able to secure a victory for Prievidza (6-5) in their last game. Despite Gacesa's very good performance Prievidza lost 79-74 on their home court in Prievidza to the lower-ranked (#7) Handlova. He was the second best scorer with 15 points. Gacesa also added 6 rebounds in 36 minutes. Gacesa has relatively good stats this year 13.6ppg, 5.5rpg and 2.1apg in 11 games.

#8. Kouat Noi (6'7"-F-97, graduated '19, plays in Australia) managed to help Cairns Taipans to win against the third-ranked United 93-86 in the Australian NBL last Friday. He recorded 5 points, 12 rebounds and 5 assists. Noi has relatively good stats this season 11.9ppg, 7.1rpg and 1.3apg. He has also Australian citizenship.

#9. Jarvis Ray (6'6"-G-90, graduated '14, currently in Austria), who plays in the Austrian BSL couldn't help BC Raiffeisen Flyers Wels (15-3) in their last game. Despite Ray's very good performance BC Raiffeisen Flyers Wels were crushed 106-72 in Gmunden by the lower-ranked (#3) Swans. He was the top scorer with 17 points. Ray also added 4 rebounds in 28 minutes. Ray has relatively good stats this year 12.3ppg, 2.6rpg, 1.5apg and 1.3spg in eight games.

#10. Vladimir Brodziansky (6'11"-F-94, graduated '18, plays pro in Spain) couldn't help one of league's weakest teams Rio Natura Monbus Obradoiro CAB in their game against Valencia Basket in the Spanish Liga Endesa. Brodziansky scored 6 points. His team was defeated 86-76. This season Brodziansky averages 9.3ppg and 3.6rpg.
