FAST BREAKS

- TCU (6-6,1-6) returns home to the friendly confines of Schollmaier Arena this Saturday, Jan. 23, to take on the Texas Tech Lady Raiders. Tip-off is set for 1 p.m. and the contest will be televised live on the Big 12 Now on ESPN+.
- TCU's previous home victory was an overtime win over Kansas last Sunday in Fort Worth. It marked the first overtime game for TCU since Jan. 13, 2018, when the Frogs went into extra frames at West Virginia. It was just the third overtime game played under head coach Raegan Pebley, and it also marked TCU's first overtime game at home since going into an extra period against SMU back on Nov. 17, 2010.
- The Horned Frogs are coming off a 71-54 road loss to the Texas Longhorns this past Wednesday in Austin. Michelle Berry led the Frogs with 14 points and seven rebounds, while draining a career-high four three-pointers in the contest.
- TCU totaled a season-high 22 assists in its win over Kansas last Sunday, bettering its previous high of 20 assists totaled against Central Arkansas back on Nov. 28. The Horned Frogs continue to rank among the top-50 teams, coming in at No. 46 overall with 15.8 assists per game.
- TCU and Texas Tech close out the season series on Saturday. Tech won the initial meeting, 78-72, in Lubbock back on Dec. 19.

THE MATCH-UP

- The Horned Frogs and Lady Raiders wrap-up the season series when the teams face-off against each other for the 58th time overall in a series that dates back to Feb. 2, 1980.
- Texas Tech has won three straight and leads the all-time series 45-12.
- TCU has won 11 of 19 meetings since becoming a member of the Big 12, which includes a 6-2 mark in games played in Fort Worth. TCU is 6-17 all-time against the Lady Raiders at home.
- The past six games between TCU and Texas Tech have been decided by eight points or less. In its last three wins over Tech, TCU's margin of victory is 7.6 points, while Texas Tech's last three wins are by a margin of victory of 4.6.

SCOUTING THE LADY RAIDERS

- Texas Tech is 4-4 since downing TCU in Lubbock back on Dec. 19. The Lady Raiders had dropped four straight, but bring in a two-game winning streak on Saturday.
- The Lady Raiders picked up a home win over then ranked No. 21 Texas last Sunday and are most recently coming off a 75-65 road win at Kansas this past Wednesday.
- Texas Tech is just 1-3 on the road, with its lone win coming against the Jayhawks. Other road losses include defeats to Baylor, Oklahoma State, and West Virginia.
- Texas Tech is among the league and nation's best in free throw attempts and free throws made. The Lady Raiders lead the conference and rank No. 5 in the nation with 294 free throw attempts, while ranking No. 1 in the Big 12 and No. 2 in the nation with 223 free throws made.
- Only Arkansas' 287 free throws made rank higher than Texas Tech's total.
- Vivian Gray, a former standout at Oklahoma State, transferred to Texas Tech as a grad-transfer this previous offseason and she lead the Lady Raiders in multiple statistical categories, including: scoring (19.6), rebounding (8.2), steals (15) and blocked shots (19).
- Bryn Gerlich has dished out a team-best 43 assists on the season.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE FROGS

- TCU dropped a Big 12 Conference road game at Texas this past Wednesday, falling 71-54, to the Longhorns.
- The Horned Frogs managed to keep pace with the Longhorns in the first, third and fourth quarters, but Texas outscored the Frogs 22-10 a second quarter that put the game out of reach.
- Michelle Berry set a new single-game career-high with four three-pointers made and led the team with 14 points and seven boards.

BIG 12 CONFERENCE THIS-AND-THAT

- TCU is 54-61 all-time in Big 12 games, since moving to the league in 2012-13.
- Since becoming a member, TCU has tallied its most league wins against Kansas (12). The Frogs have registered 10 wins against both Iowa State and Texas Tech.

• The Horned Frogs registered a program-best 13-5 record in Big 12 play last season, which led to TCU's highest finish in the Big 12 standings, coming in second-place. The Frogs were picked to finish eighth in Big 12 play last season.

HOME SWEET SCHOLLMAIER ARENA

- TCU is 35-2 overall in non-conference games played inside Schollmaier Arena.
- In addition to the team's 28 consecutive win streak over non-conference opponents at home, TCU has compiled an overall record of 36-9 inside the complex over the past three seasons.
- The Horned Frogs are now 68-25 all-time inside Schollmaier Arena since opening back on Dec. 20, 2015.

WELCOME TO THE BLOCK PARTY

- TCU totaled 11 blocked shots in its non-conference finale against Oral Roberts on Dec. 22, registering double-digit blocks in a game for the first time since collecting 10 blocked shots against Montana State back on Dec. 8, 2018.
- It marks the most blocked shots in a game since notching 11 blocks against SMU back on Nov. 18, 2018
- Junior Yummy Morris totaled a season-best and tied a career-high with four blocked shots in the game. She has a team-leading 11 blocked shots on the year, which ranks seventh in the Big 12 and 61st in the nation.
- TCU's total of 35 blocked shots on the season ranks among the nation's top-55, coming in at No. 53 overall.

DON'T EVEN THINK OF 60

- TCU has limited an opponent to under 60 points four times this season and are 4-0 in those games.
- Under head coach Raegan Pebley, the Horned Frogs are 55-3 (.948) all-time when limiting the opposing team to score 60 points or less.
- The Horned Frogs have won 13 straight games when limiting opposing teams to under 60 points.
- The last time a TCU team was defeated, limiting an opponent to under 60 points, came back on April 3, 2019, against Arizona in the WNIT Semifinals. Arizona won the game 59-53.

THRICE AS NICE

- Senior Lauren Heard was named the Big 12 Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 14.
- Heard earned Big 12 Player of the Week honors for the third time in her career, after collecting a pair of POW selections last season.
- She is the first TCU player to be named Big
 12 Player of the Week three times in a career, surpassing Zahna Medley as the only other twotime Big 12 POW recipient. Medley was also tabbed a Big 12 Freshman of the Week four times.
- Heard became the first TCU player to be named the conference player of the week at least three times in a career since Helena Sverrisdottir (nine-time MWC Player of the Week honors).

- The Denton, Texas, native now ranks No. 13 all-time in school history with 1,275 points scored in her career. She also ranks No. 3 overall in free throw attempts (545) and No. 5 overall in free throws made (390).
- She is among the school's top-10 players in both steals and assists. She currently ranks No. 9 in steals (187) and No. 7 in assists (349).
- A complete list of career-record marks for Heard can be found in these notes on page five.

FASTEST TO 100

- Lauren Heard, who scored 125 points through the first six games of the season, became the fifth different TCU player to pour in at least 100 points through her first six games of a season over the past 15 years.
- Zahna Medley is the last player to score 100+ points in six games, having done it in both 2015-16 and 2013-14. She scored 102 points in six games back in 2015-16 and notched 116 points in six games during the 2013-14 campaign.
- Heard joined the likes of Emily Carter (136, 2010-11),
 TK Lafleur (102, 2008-09) and Adrianne Ross (101, 2006-07) as the only other players to score 100+ points in six games in the past 15 seasons.

A-LISTED!

- Lauren Heard was named to both the Lieberman Award and Naismith Trophy preseason watch lists.
- An All-Big 12 First Team selection a year ago, and a Preseason All-Big 12 honoree, Heard is the only returning Big 12 player to rank among the top-10 in the league in scoring, assists and steals.
- She ranked fourth overall in the Big 12 in points scored (18.4), sixth in assists (4.0) and was second in steals (2.1).
- She led the league and was the only player in the conference to average at least 20 points (20.1) in Big 12 only games last season.
- In five games against top-25 ranked teams, she averaged 16.4 points, tallied 2.4 steals and dished out 3.2 assists per contest.

JACKSON FIVE-FOR-FIVE

- Graduate transfer Aahliyah Jackson registered a 5-of-5 effort from the field in a win over Central Arkansas back on Nov. 28.
- Jackson became the first TCU player to shoot
 1.000 from the field with at least five attempts since
 Jordan Moore was 8-of-8 against West Virginia back on Feb. 16, 2019.
- In her first season with the Horned Frogs, Jackson has notched new single-game career-highs in minutes (29), points (13, twice), field goals (5) and steals (3).

THE COMEBACK TRAIL

- TCU erased an 11-point deficit in its win over Middle Tennessee back on Dec. 13
- It marked the first come-from-behind win this season following a deficit of at least 10 points and the third time to do so in the past two seasons.
- The Horned Frogs wiped out a 10-point deficit to lowa State and a 12-pint deficit to Kans State last

season. Both wins came on the road.

• TCU has trailed by at least one point in all six of its wins during the 2020-21 season - which included a seven-point deficit to Kansas this past Sunday.

YOU STOLE IT!

- TCU tallied 21 steals in its season-opening win against Incarnate Word.
- The Horned Frogs totaled 20+ steals in a game for the first time in more than 16 seasons. It was the first 20-steal game since collecting 20 steals against Cornell back on Jan. 2, 2006.
- The 21 steals are tied for the fourth-most in a single game by a TCU team.
- The all-time record is 24 steals, which happened twice overall, but the last time coming against Southern Miss back in 2005.

NON-CONFERENCE CHALK TALK

- TCU wrapped up non-conference play having now won 28 straight home games over non-conference opponents - a streak that dates back to the 2017-18 season.
- The win streak includes WNIT home victories over the previous two seasons, as well.
- The Horned Frogs' last home loss to a nonconference opponent came back on Nov. 21, 2017, in a defeat to Yale.
- TCU is 49-4 overall against non-conference teams played at home in the regular-season under head coach Raegan Pebley. TCU has gone undefeated in non-conference home games over the past three seasons.
- TCU is 69-23 at home against all non-conference opponents under coach Pebley, which includes home wins over WNIT postseason opponents.

Previously known as the Daniel-Meyer Coliseum, the facility underwent a \$72 million renovation that was completed during the 2015-16 season. The Schollmaiers provided the lead gift of \$10 million. The Daniel-Meyer name is still prominent as the entire area is known as the Daniel-Meyer Athletic Complex.

The TCU men's and women's basketball programs received new locker rooms and team meeting rooms as well as an expanded sports medicine center. There is also locker rooms for visiting teams and a new video board.

The new building facade for the Ed and Rae Schollmaier Arena architecturally complements Amon G. Carter Stadium and the TCU campus. The interior has a lower playing surface to increase courtside seating and provide a more intimate atmosphere. Wider concourses and multiple public entries have helped ease congestion. The fan experience is further enhanced by new concession stands, a food court and restrooms as well as increased points of sale. A new courtside club lounge is also located on floor level. The facility also includes offices for the athletics administrative staff as well as coaches in various sports, allowing the Ed and Rae Schollmaier Arena to be the hub of TCU Athletics.

Additional features of the Ed and Rae Schollmaier Arena are the Jane & John Justin TCU Athletics Hall of Fame on the concourse level, offices for Olympic sports and administration and a larger main ticket office to support the arena and Amon G. Carter Stadium.

ED AND RAE SCHOLLMAIER HISTORY

Ed Schollmaier is the retired CEO of Alcon Laboratories, Inc., while the late Rae Schollmaier was a dedicated civic volunteer. Through the Schollmaier Foundation, they are longtime philanthropic leaders in Fort Worth.

A TCU Trustee since 1996, Ed Schollmaier chaired the Building and Grounds Committee and served on the Executive, Fiscal Affairs and Intercollegiate Athletics committees, as well as the Committee on Trusteeship.

Ed Schollmaier was a member of the Neeley School International Board of Visitors and the recipient of Neeley's Ike Harrison Award. He has been recognized as an Honorary Alumnus and an Honorary TCU Letterman. Rae Schollmaier served on the College of Fine Arts International Board of Visitors, the Fine Arts Task Force of The Commission on the Future of TCU and the KinderFrogs School Advisory Board. For their service and generous support, the Schollmaiers were honored with TCU's Horizon Award and the Royal Purple Award.

The Schollmaiers have also supported TCU Athletics through the Ed and Rae Schollmaier Basketball Complex, which opened in 2004.







HEAD COACH | RAEGAN PEBLEY | 7TH SEASON



Raegan Pebley is in her seventh season as TCU women's basketball head coach in 2020-21. Pebley led the Horned Frogs to four postseason appearances in her first five seasons, including WNIT Semifinals appearances in both 2017-18 and 2018-19. The 2019-20 squad was on the way to making a postseason

appearance prior to the NCAA Tournament being canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pebley (pronounced Pee-blee) has had the Frogs on an upward trend over the past three seasons, as their 69 total wins during that stretch are ranked third among all Big 12 teams while its 32 conference victories also rank third.

The 2019-20 campaign saw the Frogs register a 22-7 overall record and a 13-5 mark in Big 12 play. It marked Pebley's third-consecutive 20-win season, while the 13 Big 12 wins rank most in school history. It also matches the most conference wins for TCU in any league (2000-01, WAC; 2007-08 and 2010-11, MWC). TCU would go onto finish second-place in the Big 12 standings - the highest finish for the Frogs since joining the league in 2012-13.

The Frogs have been on an upward trend over the past three seasons. TCU notched a 24-11 record in 2018-19, coming up just one-win shy of the school's record 25 victories (2000-01, 2003-04). In addition, TCU also set program records with 17 home victories in 2018-19 and the 13 Big 12 Conference wins this past season. The Horned Frogs also managed to register its most road wins in the Pebley era, notching nine victories on the road in 2019-20.

TCU collected its first national ranking in 10 years during the 2017-18 campaign, as well, coming in as high as No. 22. The Frogs then made its way back into the WBCA Top-25 rankings during the 2019-20 season, coming in at No. 25, the week of Feb. 25.

TCU ranked among the Big 12's top teams this past season, ranking first in free throw attempts (621), third in free throws made (417), second in steals (274), first in steals per game (9.4), second in opponent three-point percentage (.273), and first in forced turnovers (18.62). Three different Horned Frogs would go onto earn All-Big 12 honors, giving TCU at least two players on the All-Big 12 team in four of its six seasons as a member of the Big 12 Conference.

Lauren Heard became just the third Horned Frog in program history to be named to the All-Big 12 First Team, joining Zahna Medley (2014, 2015, 2016) and Jordan Moore(2019). Kianna Ray would earn second team honors and Jayde Woods was named honorable mention. A total of 14 players have earned All-Big 12 honors under Pebley.

The 2019-20 campaign also saw Pebley record her 100th victory on the sidelines at TCU. She is just the second coach in school history to boast at least 100 victories at the helm of the Horned Frogs basketball program.

The Frogs went on a tear in the postseason for a second-consecutive year in 2018-19, winning four games in the WNIT before falling on the road to eventual champion Arizona in the semifinals. Pebley's squad dominated the early rounds of the tournament, winning its first four games by an average of 17 points, including three victories at home and an impressive road win at Arkansas.

TCU finished among the top-three teams in the Big 12 in several statistical categories in 2018-19, including scoring defense, blocked shots, assists, turnover margin and steals. The Frogs finished eighth in the NCAA in both total blocked shots (189) and blocked shots per game (5.4) and led the Big 12 in total steals (331), steals per game (9.5) and turnovers forced per game (17.34).

The 2018-19 season was a continuation of a successful

climb for TCU under Pebley. The Frogs won 18 games in each of her first two seasons with a WNIT Second Round appearance in 2014-15 followed by appearances in the WNIT Third Round and Semifinals in 2015-16 and 2017-18, respectively. TCU's WNIT victory in 2015 was its first postseason win in seven years.

During the 2017-18 campaign, the Frogs earned their first national ranking since 2010, claiming a spot in the top-25 for three weeks. The ranking came in the midst of a sevengame Big 12 winning streak, the Frogs' best conference winning streak since 2008. During the streak, the Frogs beat No. 7 Texas then knocked off No. 15 West Virginia on the road, marking just the second time in program history TCU won back-to-back games against ranked teams.

The Frogs went on to finish 9-9 in the Big 12 in 2017-18, capping the regular season with a win over Oklahoma in the Big 12 Championship quarterfinal and advancing to the first semifinal since the Frogs joined the Big 12.

TCU then played in its third WNIT under Pebley and made a deep run in the tournament, advancing to the semifinal where the Frogs fell on the road to eventual champion Indiana. Along the way, TCU won four games in the tournament, including a pair of road wins, pushing TCU's total to 10 wins away from home in 2017-18, the program's most since 2004-05.

In 2017-18, TCU was the only Big 12 team to finish in the Big 12's top three in field goal, 3-point and free throw percentage. The Frogs averaged 74.8 points and 16.5 assists per game, both the second best in program history, and posted a program-best 1.1 assist-turnover ratio.

Individually, numerous players have flourished in Pebley's system, perhaps none more than TCU's all-time leading scorer, Medley who earned three All-Big 12 First Team honors in her career - two under Pebley - and was the first three-time all-conference first team selection in program history.

Medley finished her career with TCU bests of 1,975 career points, a 15.6 points per game scoring average and 316 made 3-pointers. She finished second in TCU history with 633 made field goals and 510 assists.

Moore's progression throughout her TCU career is indicative of Pebley's teaching ability. The Round Rock, Texas, native finished her career as TCU's all-time leader in field goal percentage, shooting 54.7 percent in her four years in Fort Worth, as well as the single-season leader after shooting 59.0 percent in her senior campaign. She also finished seventh in the TCU record book with 1,514 points, second with 892 rebounds and third with 243 blocks.

Additionally, the Frogs have won both of their Big 12 individual awards under Pebley, most recently with Okonkwo earning the Sixth Man Award in 2017-18. Chelsea Prince was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year in 2014-15, marking the fourth-straight such selection under Peblev

Off the court, the Frogs have seen incredible success under Pebley. In her six seasons, TCU student-athletes have earned 27 Academic All-Big 12 honors, that after earning just four in the two years prior to Pebley's arrival.

Included in the 27 selections is a record four first-team selections in 2019-20. Jada Butts was one of the 2016-17 first team selections and became the first Frog to earn Academic All-Big 12 honors in four straight years, while Ray followed in her footsteps, taking home all-academic honors from 2016-20.

Pebley has not only served TCU, but also the women's basketball community as a whole. She is a member of the Kay Yow Cancer Fund Board of Directors, helping guide the Fund's mission to extend and improve the lives of all women battling cancer by raising money for research and assisting the underserved.

She is also a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Board of Directors, helping the Association's mission to improve and advance the game of women's basketball.

TCU officially announced the hiring of Pebley as the program's seventh head coach on April 1, 2014.

Pebley arrived at TCU after spending the previous two seasons at Fresno State where she led the Bulldogs to Mountain West tournament titles and berths into the NCAA Tournament in each of her two seasons. Fresno State compiled a 46-20 (.697) overall record under the direction of Pebley, including a 26-8 (.765) mark in league play, while four Bulldogs earned All-Mountain West honors, including back-to-back Defensive Player of the Year selections.

Pebley's Fresno State squads featured one of the top defensive units in the country, as the 2012-13 Bulldogs ranked third in the NCAA in steals with 12.9 per game, doing so while only fouling 12.1 times per game to rank No. 7 nationally for the fewest fouls committed per game. The Bulldogs allowed a paltry 62.4 points per contest in the two seasons under Pebley.

The Orem, Utah, native faced a tall task in her first head coaching position, starting the Utah State women's basketball program after its reinstatement in 2003 following a 25-year hiatus. Pebley led the Aggies for nine seasons, building the program from scratch into back-to-back WNIT berths, marking the first postseason appearances in school history.

Pebley garnered WAC Coach of the Year accolades for the 2010-11 season after the Aggies advanced to their first WNIT, where they toppled Arizona, and was a WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist in 2012 after Utah State registered its first-ever 20-win season and returned to the WNIT.

In her nine seasons at Utah State, 12 Aggies earned all-conference honors, including Ashlee Brown, who was named the WAC Defensive Player of the Year in 2012, the first of four straight student-athletes to earn the league's top defensive awards under Pebley. Before taking over the Utah State program, Pebley served as an assistant coach at George Mason from 1997-99 under Jim Lewis and Debbie Taneyhill and at Colorado State from 1999-01 under Tom Collen.

At CSU, the Rams went 48-17 in her two seasons with the team reaching the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2001 and the semifinals of the WNIT in 2000.

A standout at the University of Colorado, Pebley was selected with the 21st overall pick of the inaugural WNBA Draft in 1997, where she played two seasons with the Cleveland Rockers and Utah Starzz. She has since returned to a role within the league as she regularly serves as the color analyst on television broadcasts for the Dallas Wings.

During her collegiate career at Colorado, Pebley helped lead the Buffs to a 106-24 overall record and four conference championships, including winning the inaugural Big 12 tournament title in 1997. In her career, Pebley earned all-conference accolades twice, including a second team All-Big 12 selection in 1997. She is the first former All-Big 12 selection to return to coach in the league.

CU made two Sweet 16 appearances during her career, including a trip to the Elite Eight during her sophomore season, as the Buffs won a school-record 30 games (30-3 overall). Colorado won 25-straight games that season and finished the year ranked No. 2 in the final AP poll.

Pebley, whose maiden name is Scott, was one of nine players in CU history to score over 1,000 career points (1,045) and collect over 700 rebounds (701). Pebley played under legendary head coach Ceal Barry who was a 2018 inductee into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame.

Pebley and her husband, Keith, have one son, Joseph, and one daughter, Harper.




