

FROG TIDBITS

TCU has played 33 players this season. Dalton Brown was the latest Frog to make his season debut, doing so on Saturday.

TCU allowed its first stolen base in Game 11. Opponents are 1-for-6 this season.

The group of eight seniors have a combined 34 years of collegiate baseball experience.

Five Frogs (Dalton Brown, Austin Henry, Conner Shepherd, Hunter Wolfe and Gene Wood) are in their sixth year of eligibility.

Elijah Nunez has two outfield assists this season

Brayden Taylor's three triples on the season are tied for the most in the NCAA.

Nunez's 14 walks on are fourth nationally, just two behind the national leader.

TCU's in-game substitutions are hitting .357 (5-for-14) with 4 RBIs.

THE 700 CLUB

With Friday's win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, head coach Jim Schlossnagle joined an exclusive club of 20 active head coaches to have tallied 700 wins at his current institution.

His career winning percentage of .674 is fourth among active coaches in NCAA Division I.

LEADING OFF

In game 2 of a doubleheader against Liberty on Feb. 27, the freshmen trio of Elijah Nunez, Luke Boyers and Brayden Taylor have been at the top of the order. TCU is 4-1 in those games.

They are hitting a combined .357 (20-for-56) with a .520 on-base percentage. The trio has scored 20 runs, tallied eight extra base hits and driven in 14.

GRABBING HOLD

Phillip Sikes made his first start of the in the win over Texas State. He has started every game since, leading TCU to a 7-1 record in those games.

He leads the team with a .419 average. Of his 15 hits, he has six doubles and one inside the park grand slam. His 15 RBIs are tops on the squad and second in the Big 12.

The junior has tallied a hit in six of the eight games and driven in a run in six. He has an RBI in five straight games.

THE RUSS BUS

Russell Smith missed the 2019 campaign after having Tommy John surgery. He has made seven starts since returning from the injury and is 3-0 in those games.

In 35 1/3 innings pitched, he has allowed just 10 runs (eight earned) with 6 walks and 52 strikeouts.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

In three of the last five years, TCU has ranked in top 50 in scoring. This season, TCU is averaging 8.3 runs per game to rank 32nd nationally.

Over the last five years, TCU has scored multiple runs in 632 innings. In 180 innings, TCU has produced four or more runs.

TCU has scored 10 or more runs 85 times over the last seven seasons and tallied 127 wins of 5+ runs. Conversely, the Frogs have lost just 36 games by five or more runs since 2014.

SPEED FACTOR

The Frogs are one of just nine teams to have stolen at least 600 bases over the last eight years. The 614 stolen bases rank eighth in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 77% of their attempts over the last six years (614-of-801).

TWO OUT TALLIES

TCU has scored 38 of its 91 runs this season with two outs. In the first three games of the season, TCU managed just five two out runs.

Over the last seven games, TCU has scored 33 of its 84 runs with two outs.

Seven of Brayden Taylor's 11 RBIs on the season have come with two outs. That mark leads the team. All told, the freshman trio of Taylor, Luke Boyers (4) and Elijah Nunez (5) have produced 16 of the team's 34 two-out RBIs.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 189 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017. TCU has fanned at least 10 batters in eight of the first 11 games this season.

STINGY STAFF

The TCU pitching staff has tossed the fourthmost shutouts (47) nationally over the last seven years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 179 times over the last 409 games played. and has surrendered 5+ runs just 142 times.

NATIONWIDE

The United States is well-represented on the Horned Frogs rosters. The 42 athletes hail from 14 states spanning the continental USA.

There are 28 players from the state of Texas. Utah has two representatives (Hill and Taylor), while 12 other have one representative - Arizona (Sacco), California (Shepherd), Colorado (Cornelio), Illinois (Ray), Iowa (Krob), Michigan (Henry), Mississippi (Wood), Missouri (Byrne), Oklahoma (Thompson), Tennessee (Wolfe), Virginia (Williams) and Wisconsin (Mihlbauer).

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 66 extra inning games since 2004 and holds a 41-25 mark in those games.

TCU went to extra innings for the first time in 2021 on March 7 against Sam Houston State, dropping a 6-5 decision in 10 innings.

TCU owns a 9-5 record in extra innings dating back to the 2015 campaign.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.

TCU's longest regular-season extra inning game was 15 innings against Texas A&M on March 4, 2017.


