FROG HOPS

- Head coach Kirk Saarloos picked up a win in his first career game.
- TCU has stolen multiple bases in five of 11 games this season.
- TCU has successfully stolen its last six bases.
- Brayden Taylor is 3-for-3 with 4 RBIs in the ninth inning this season.
- TCU is hitting .429 in the ninth inning, a key factor in two wins this season when tied or trailing after the eighth.
- The Frogs have worked six bases-loaded walks this year.

LEADING OFF

Elijah Nunez epitomizes what it means to be a lead-off hitter. Over the weekend, the sophomore hit .692 and was on base in 10 of 14 plate appearances for a .714 on-base percentage.

Over the last six games, Nunez has been on fire, hitting .583 (14-for-29) with three walks. His average has rised 195 from .267 up to .462.

As the lineup's lead-off hitter, Nunez has reached safely in five games, tallying two hits and three walks for a .500 on-base percentage. He has racked up five first inning runs.

His prowess extends to the base paths as he leads the league and ranks 13th nationally with nine stolen bases.

FAST START

TCU has scored a first inning run in nine of 11 games this season, outscoring their opponents 22-8.

The Horned Frogs are hitting .341 (15-for-44) in the first inning and have drawn 20 walks amounting to a .536 on-base percentage. TCU has seen the lead-off batter reach in seven of the 11 games and scored six times.

MAKING A SPLASH

David Bishop has had a banner start to his collegiate career. The freshman ranks fourth on the team with a .375 batting average and is tied for the league lead with 17 RBIs. His RBI total is tied for third nationally among freshmen.

He has reached safely in all 11 games and tallied a hit in nine contests. In seven games, Bishop has driven in at least one run.

TWO OUT TALLIES

TCU scored 31 of its 81 runs with two outs this season. The Horned Frogs have proven to be a tough out in any situation, but even more so with two outs. The Frogs are hitting .286 (34-for-119) with two outs this season.

David Bishop leads the team with nine two out RBIs followed by Reed Spenrath's and Tommy Sacco's four. Four other Horned Frogs have at least two two-out RBIs.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Since Bill Mosiello's arrival on campus prior to the start of the 2014 season, TCU has scored runs in bunches. The past eight seasons have seen TCU score multiple runs in 754 innings.

In 218 innings, TCU has produced four or more

TCU has scored 10 or more runs 103 times over the last eight seasons and tallied 157 wins of 5+ runs. Conversely, the Frogs have lost just 41 games by five or more runs since 2014.

DEFENSIVE PROWESS

TCU has committed just six errors on the season and ranks 24th nationally with its .984 fielding percentage. The five errors are tied for the fewest in the Big 12. After committing two errors in the first game, TCU put together a streak of five straight without committing a miscue. TCU has allowed just four unearned runs this year.

SPEED FACTOR

The Frogs are one of just eight teams to have stolen at least 700 bases over the last eight years. The 740 stolen bases rank eighth in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 78% of their attempts over the last eight years (740-of-944). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last eight seasons, TCU is 122-of-152 (80%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 218 times in the 527 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 187 times in those contests.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 215 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

So far this season, TCU has fanned 10 or more in eight games. TCU ranks 24th nationally with 11.3 K/9.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE

TCU's win after trailing heading to the ninth was its first since scoring five in the ninth to rally from a 4-2 deficit against Kansas on May 11, 2019. It broke a 21 game losing streak when trailing after eight.

TCU was 0-13 in games it trailed after eight in 2021. It was 0-2 in a shortened 2020 campaign. It lost its last six in 2019.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 36 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 19-17 mark in those games.

TCU has dropped five straight extra-inning games dating back to the 2019 campaign (0-3, 2021; 0-1, 2020 and 1-1, 2019). TCU's last extra inning win was a 3-114-inning victory at Texas Tech (May 16, 2019).

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.




