FROG HOPS

- TCU sits 46th in the latest RPI.
- Head coach Kirk Saarloos picked up a win in his first career game.
- Saarloos is the fastest coach to pick up 20 wins, doing so in 29 games.
- TCU has been successful in its last 17 stolen base attempts.
- The Frogs have worked 17 bases-loaded walks this year.
- TCU has outscored its opponents 49-25 in the eighth and ninth.
- TCU is one of 14 Division I schools with two or fewer sac bunts, but is tied for second nationally with 24 sacrifice flies.
- Kurtis Byrne has thrown out five of the last eight stolen base attempts.

WALK THIS WAY

TCU has worked 198 walks this season to rank sixth nationally. About a fifth of the walks drawn (37) have come in the first inning. Six times this season, TCU has drawn over 10 walks in a game.

Brayden Taylor has shown the most patience, drawing 36, a mark that is tie for the national lead. TCU is one of two schools with two players with 30 walks each - Elijah Nunez (32, t-11th) In total, eight Horned Frogs have worked at least 10 walks.

TIMING IS EVERTHING

TCU has hit just 25 home runs in the first 33 games this season. While not a large number, the long ball has played a big part in helping TCU pick up eight wins.

Seven home runs have put the Horned Frogs in front, while another tied the game. Three of Tommy Sacco's five home runs have been goahead runs.

Brayden Taylor hit the go-ahead home run on Saturday against West Virginia. It was his second career go-ahead home run. He added two more home runs in the Texas series to bring his season total to seven.

IN A GROOVE

Tommy Sacco has reached safely in each of his last 10 of his last 13 plate appearances (7 hits, 3 walks) over the last two games. Prior to his current streak, Sacco had been just 1-for-15.

Sacco has tallied a hit in 24 of 33 games this season.

SCUFFLING

TCU has hit a tough stretch that has seen just three wins in the last nine games. In that stretch, the Frogs are hitting just .211 and averaging 4.0 runs per game.

TCU has allowed the game's first run five times and is 1-4 in those contests.

LATE INNING HEROICS

With another comeback victory at Baylor, TCU has now earned five wins when tied or trailing after eight innings this season.

As a team, TCU has outscored its opponent 18-11 in the ninth inning. The Horned Frogs are hitting .292 (21-for-72) with eight doubles and a home run. Additionally they have worked 19 walks and own an .447 on-base percentage.

Luke Boyers leads the team with five ninth inning RBIs and Brayden Taylor has four.

TWO OUT TALLIES

TCU has scored 75 of its 226 runs with two outs this season.

David Bishop leads the team with 18 two out RBIs followed by Tommy Sacco's nine and Brayden Taylor's eight, Elijah Nunez and Gray Rodgers each have seven. Five other Horned Frogs have tallied at least one.

DOWN BUT NEVER OUT

TCU's come-from-behind win over San Diego State in the season opener was a foresight in things to come. It broke a 21 game losing streak when trailing after eight. Four times this season, TCU has rallied to tie or win a game they were trailing in the ninth.

In five of TCUs 12 losses, the Frogs have had the tying run at the plate in the eighth or ninth inning.

The three wins when trailing after eight are the most since three times in 2019.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Since Bill Mosiello's arrival on campus prior to the start of the 2014 season, TCU has scored runs in bunches. The past eight seasons have seen TCU score multiple runs in 791 innings. In 228 innings, TCU has produced four or more runs.

TCU has scored 10 or more runs 109 times over the last eight seasons and tallied 162 wins of 5+ runs. Conversely, the Frogs have lost just 41 games by five or more runs since 2014.

SPEED FACTOR

The Frogs are one of just eight teams to have stolen at least 700 bases over the last eight years. The 770 stolen bases rank eighth in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 79% of their attempts over the last eight years (770-of-978). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last eight seasons, TCU is 131-of-162 (81%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 222 times in the 549 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 200 times in those contests.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 217 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

So far this season, TCU has fanned 10 or more in 13 games.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 38 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 21-17 mark in those games. TCU is 2-0 in extra innings this season.

TCU's five game losing streak in extra-inning games dating back to the 2019 campaign (0-3, 2021; 0-1, 2020 and 1-1, 2019) was snapped with a 6-5 win in 10 innings over Army on March 12.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.


