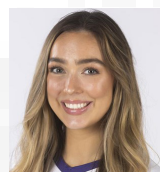
Tournament Quick Hits

- TCU and Alabama are squaring off for the third time on the volleyball court. The Horned Frogs own a 2-0 advantage in the all-time series, having defeated the Crimson Tide in a pair of neutral site contests in 2011 and 2012.
- Saturday's matinee vs. the Wildcats provides the Horned Frogs to extend its all-time series lead vs. ACU to 3-0. The teams are meeting in Fort Worth for the third time in eight years.
- TCU and Texas State are no strangers to one another. Saturday marks the 10th all-time meeting between the programs. The Bobcats boast a 6-3 edge over the Horned Frogs, though TCU claimed the teams' most recent meeting, a four-set victory on March 18, 2021 in San Marcos.
- The Horned Frogs are 6-4 all-time vs. SEC opponents, own a 16-11 edge against current WAC schools and sport a 13-8 all-time mark against present Sun Belt Conference members. Texas State is the lone Sun Belt foe TCU does not possess a winning record against.
- With the debut of the Horned Frog Invitational, TCU is hosting three nonconference tournaments for the second time in the last decade.

Frog Focus

- A tournament sweep is at the forefront of head coach Jason Williams' goals for the weekend. Should the Horned Frogs claim all three matches, they will enter Big 12 play with a winning record for the fourth time in the last five years.
- TCU claimed a share of the NC State Classic tournament title following its neutral site victories over Western Carolina and Indiana on Sept. 8-9.
- The Horned Frogs blocking progression fueled both triumphs. TCU registered a season-high 13 blocks vs. WCU, then followed up with a 12-block effort against the Hoosiers. Freshman Sarah Sylvester racked up five rejections against NC State - the most in a match by any Horned Frog this season.
- The two victories were engineered by a pair of standout individual efforts. Against the Catamounts, MyKayla Myers landed 10 kills on .714 hitting, the highest mark among all Big 12 players in four-set matches. The following day, Audrey Nalls delivered her best performance in purple and white. The four-year senior finished with 28 points and 25 kills - both of which were career-highs - along with 13 digs vs. Indiana. Nalls' 25 kills are the most in a match by any Big 12 player three weeks into the 2022 campaign.
- The win over Indiana featured a handful of situational firsts. It was the first five-set match of the fall for TCU, marked the first time the Horned Frogs built a 2-0 lead and was the team's first nonconference victory over a Power Five program since a five-set triumph over Auburn on Sept. 15, 2019.
- Starting setter Callie Williams is likely to achieve a significant career milestone before the first media timeout vs. Alabama. She is currently five assists shy of reaching 2,000 assists for her career, which includes stops at Tennessee (2017-2018) and Baylor (2019-2021). Williams will join senior McKenzie Nichols (2,592 assists) in the 2,000-assist club among members of the Horned Frogs' 2022 roster.
- A small army of Frogs are scattered across the Big 12 statistical leaderboard. Julia Adams ranks fourth in kills per set (3.66) and fifth in points per set (4.00). Williams' 8.27 assist-per-set average slots her seventh among her conference peers. Sylvester and libero Keagan Polk lead all freshmen, respectively, in hitting percentage and digs per set. Sylvester is connecting at a .339 clip while Polk is digging out 2.73 attacks per set.
- Adams ranks 103rd nationally in kills per set while Sylvester's hitting percentage is tied for 130th among all DI players.

MILESTONE WATCH

Familiar faces for Frog fans and newcomers alike are nearing significant individual career landmarks.

Setter McKenzie Nichols has already etched her name among the all-time greats at her position in program history and is nearing another milestone. Nichols is just 402 assists shy of reaching 3,000 career assists. She ranks in the top-five in career assists in TCU's program record book (2,598) two matches into of her senior year. Her next double-double will be the 25th of her TCU career. Nichols is also one 30-plus assist match away from having 50 such performances in her four-year run in Fort Worth.

Julia Adams has racked up 872 kills over her three-year run in Fort Worth, putting her just 167 shy of joining the 1,000-kill club. She will become just the 11th player in program history and the first since 2016 to accomplish the feat should she reach the mark. The 6-3 middle blocker landed a career-best 285 kills in 2021 and has led TCU in the category the last two seasons.

Speaking of assists, Callie Williams is closing in on dishing out 2,000 dimes for her career. Williams, who arrived in Fort Worth this summer from Baylor as a graduate student, has amassed 1,995 assists between stops at Tennessee (2017-2018), Baylor (2019-2021) and now TCU. She eclipsed 500 assists in her first three full seasons.

A MESSAGE FROM THE BETTER BLOCKING BUREAU

The talent is there for TCU to possess perhaps one of the stiffest defensive middle blocks in the Big 12 in the form of Madilyn Cole and Mykayla Myers.

Cole and Myers rank second and sixth, respectively, among all returners in the Big 12 in blocks per set from 2021. The 6-4 Cole averaged 1.19 blocks per set last fall while Myers sent back 1.11 attacks per set.

Both players enjoyed breakthrough 2021 campaigns. Cole's 81 blocks were the fifth-most among all debut Division I players. She also ranked 64th nationally in blocks per set. Myers projects as one of the most versatile at the position among her conference peers. The Washington State transfer led TCU in blocks (105) and hitting percentage (.308) last fall to become the first Horned Frog to reach triple digits in blocks since 2017 and hit over .300 in consecutive seasons since 2016. She ranks fifth among all returners in the Big 12 in 2021 hitting percentage.

NEW BUT NOT LACKING IN POWER FIVE EXPERIENCE

Exactly half of the Horned Frogs' squad are entering their first fall in Fort Worth, as 10-of-20 players are newcomers. Five of the new faces, however, are Division I conference transfers, four of whom boast Power Five conference credentials. Callie Williams and Sustala, paired with Nichols, provide the Horned Frogs with a combined career 4,567 assists and 869 digs. Williams also added 5-11 outside hitter Lyric Stewart out of Georgia, where she spread 58 kills across 12 matches as a freshman in 2021. Second-year freshman Keagan Polk (Baylor), who is also a member of the TCU beach volleyball program, slides over to the Horned Frogs back row. Rounding out the transfers is setter Ashlynn Bourland, who spent the 2021 campaign 40 miles down the road at North Texas.

CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREES COME TO COWTOWN

A trio of freshmen in Williams' inaugural recruiting class cemented their legacies as being among the indisputable best to ever suit up for their high schools by guiding their teams to state titles in 2021.

- San Antonio natives Jalyn Gibson and Carlee Pharris memorably led Brandeis High School to its first-ever TX UIL 6A Volleyball State Championship in November. With the tandem leading the way, the Broncos concluded the fall with a 47-2 overall record and finished No. 3 overall in the PrepVolleyball.com National HS Rankings. Both players were the epitome of stat sheet stuffers. Gibson concluded her senior campaign with 737 digs, 641 kills, 64 blocks and 44 aces. Pharris' swan song in the Alamo City was every bit as impressive, as she totaled 1,261 assists, 361 digs, 73 aces and 63 blocks.

- Up north, 6-1 middle blocker Sarah Sylvester steered Marian High School to Michigan High School Activities Association Volleyball State Championships from 2020-2021 and the No. 2 overall mark in the PrepVolleyball.com National HS Rankings.

DON'T MESS WITH TEXAS

The Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex and state of Texas at large is arguably the most fertile volleyball recruiting ground in the country, and first-year head coach Jason Williams has made retaining the region's top prep prospects a priority since day one. The Horned Frogs' 2022 roster composition and returning production reflects the imperative.

- 84 percent of the roster (16-19) calls the Lone Star State home
- Of the 16 Horned Frogs referenced above, nine hail from the DFW area
- Eight of the 10 members of Williams' inaugural recruiting class prepped at a TX UIL high school
- Three of TCU's top-four returners in career kills — Julia Adams, Audrey Nalls, Afedo Manyang and MyKayla Myers — are DFW residents.
- The quartet accounted for exactly two-thirds of TCU's total kills (803-1,191) in 2021
- TCU's returning leaders in kills (Adams — Plano, TX), hitting percentage and blocks (Myers — Coppell, TX), assists and aces (McKenzie Nichols — Southlake, TX), and digs (Cecily Bramschreiber — Lucas, TX) are all from the Metroplex
- Among the newcomers, second-year freshman and libero Keagan Polk joins Nichols as one-of-two Southlake Carroll HS Dragons-turned-TCU Horned Frogs

A NEW ERA AND VISION FOR TCU VOLLEYBALL

TCU Director for Intercollegiate Athletics Jeremiah Donati tabbed Jason Williams as the fourth head coach in TCU volleyball history on Dec. 20, 2021. Williams arrived in Fort Worth following a seven-year run at Big 12 rival Baylor. The Plano, Texas native climbed the ranks from volunteer assistant in 2015 to full-time assistant in 2016 and then associate head coach in 2020.

"Jason is a perfect fit for TCU and Fort Worth," Donati said during Williams' introductory press conference.

Williams' credentials certainly support the sentiment.

- His last six years in Waco saw the Lady Bears post six consecutive 20-win seasons
- Baylor made three straight Sweet 16 appearances in the NCAA Tournament, including a memorable run to the Final Four in 2019, in Williams' final three years as an assistant coach
- He was instrumental in helping Baylor enjoy by far its best season in school history in 2019. With Williams serving as associate head coach, the Lady Bears posted a 29-2 overall record, held the top spot in the AVCA Poll for six weeks and earned the No. 1 overall seed in the Big Dance for the first time in school history.
- The veteran coach knows a thing or two about developing the top amateur volleyball talent in the country. While at Baylor, Williams coached six players at Baylor to All-America honors, including 2019 AVCA National Player of the Year and five-time All-American Yossiana Pressley. He has also been an assistant coach and scout for the USA National Team Development Program.
- Williams feels right at home in Fort Worth. Before making the move to the collegiate coaching ranks, he was among the most successful club volleyball coaches in the Lone Star State and nationally. In the 10 years prior to his time in Waco, Williams led his club teams to annual top-20 national rankings with eight of those squads in the top 10. In 2014, Williams' 16s team won the AAU National Championship and the JVA World Challenge. He led three teams to the finals of the USA Junior National Championships in the open division and five top-five finishes. Williams also had four teams finish in the top 10 of the final year-end national rankings on PrepVolleyball.com.

ACROSS THE 2022 AWARDS AND ACCOLADES SPECTRUM

The Horned Frogs have cleaned up their fair share of individual accolades two weeks into the 2022 campaign.

- Julia Adams earned back-to-back sets of All-Tournament honors at the Big 10/Big 12 Challenge and "Fight in the Fort." Adams led TCU with 19 kills vs. the Aggies and averaged 14 per match during "Fight in the Fort". She led all players with 17 in the Horned Frogs' win over the Chanticleers. Facing two top-five programs in Minnesota and Wisconsin, Adams amassed a combined 22 kills over the two-day Big 10/Big 12 Challenge. She led all players with 13 kills vs. No. 3 Wisconsin on Friday and landed a team-high nine vs. the Golden Gophers.
- Bramschreiber picked up her first career set of All-Tournament recognition following "Fight in the Fort." She nearly recorded her first double-double vs. Texas A&M with a nine-kill, nine-dig effort and amassed 40 kills over the three-match affair.
- Polk's All-Tournament honor from "Fight in the Fort" was well-deserved. The second-year freshman posted consecutive double-digit dig performances for the first time in her career vs. Coastal Carolina and Memphis.

LOCKING DOWN LIBERO

TCU wasted little time identifying a replacement for Dani Dennison, the program's school record holder for digs (1,611), at libero.

- The second-year freshman has started all nine matches, including an exhibition vs. College of Charleston on Aug. 19, for the Horned Frogs at the position, one month into the season.
- Polk, 5-8, tallied 15 digs vs. two top-five foes in Wisconsin and Minnesota in her first collegiate matches on Aug. 26-27.
- She then notched consecutive double-digit dig performances vs. Coastal Carolina and Memphis on Sept. 2-3, finishing with 15 and 24 digs, respectively, in the twin bill.
- Ahead of the Horned Frog Invitational, Polk ranks 10th in the Big 12 and leads all conference freshman in digs per set (2.73). Her 82 digs are tops on the squad

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

Five of TCU's 10 returning letter winners have made 40-or-more career starts for the Horned Frogs; McKenzie Nichols (72), MyKayla Myers (52), Julia Adams (48), Audrey Nalls (48) and Afedo Manyang (41).

Nichols and Myers earned the starting nod at setter and middle blocker, respectively, in all 26 matches for TCU in 2021.

ANTHEM FOR THE UNDERDOG

Fourth-year junior Madi Cole has overcome multiple scoliosis and other health challenges since she was age-13 to become one of the top defensive middle blockers in the Big 12.

She was featured in an "Inspired Underdogs" video story by Clearcover in June. TCU Athletic Communications also authored a 500-word feature on Cole's recovery in September. Check out the full Inspired Underdogs interview at Clearcover.com and visit GoFrogs.com to more about Cole's story.

THE GIRLS ARE BACK IN TOWN

The Horned Frogs return 10 letter winners and nearly all of their key contributors from 2021. TCU retained 98 percent of its total kills (1,170), 90 percent of its total assists (1,001) and 68 percent of its total digs (863) from last season.

STARTING OFF A NEW ERA IN STYLE

The Horned Frogs could not have scripted their unofficial 2022 debut - and the start of the Jason Williams era - any better.

- TCU swept C of C in an exhibition match at TD Arena on Aug. 19 in set scores of 25-18, 25-22 and 25-11
- The Horned Frogs led by as many as 14 points in the contest while never trailing
- All 18 players who dressed entered the contest
- The Horned Frogs utilized a 5-1 formation to statistical success, as they led the match in nearly every statistical category, including kills, blocks, assists, digs and service aces
- The victory pushed TCU's all-time mark - including exhibition affairs - vs. Colonial Athletic Association squads to 8-1 and increased its all-time edge vs. C of C to 2-0

SAY HELLO TO SYLVESTER

With TCU trailing 1-0 vs. Memphis on Sept. 3, head coach Jason Williams pivoted to middle blocker Sarah Sylvester in search of a spark at the net. He inserted the 6-3 freshman into TCU's starting six, and it's safe to say the Livonia, Michigan native maximized the opportunity.

- Sylvester landed a kill and back-to-back blocks to stake TCU to a 6-1 lead in set two vs. the Tigers in her first appearance in purple and white
- She finished the match with six kills and five blocks
- Following the contest, Williams rode with Sylvester in full, starting her at middle blocker opposite MyKayla Myers later that evening vs. Texas A&M. She tallied six more kills on a team-high .455 hitting clip to pair with three blocks.
- Subsequently, Sylvester has earned the starting nod in four straight matches
- Sylvester leads TCU in total blocks (17) despite not appearing in TCU's first three contests
- She currently ranks ninth and leads all Big 12 freshman in hitting percentage (.339)
- The Michigan native matched her season high in blocks (five) against NC State on Sept. 9

NEWCOMERS LEAD THE "FIGHT"

Sylvester was not the lone new face to maximize extended playing time during TCU's "Fight in the Fort" nonconference tournament on Sept. 2-3.

- Fellow freshman Riley Weigelt reached double figures in digs for the first time vs. Memphis, as she tallied 10 while appearing in all four sets
- Texas A&M transfer Sabrina Sustala showed out vs. her former squad, as the defensive specialist landed two service aces vs. the Aggies. Sustala also posted a TCU career-high in digs (nine) in the Horned Frogs victory over Coastal Carolina
- Williams amassed 124 digs over three matches
- Polk tallied 41 digs en route to All-Tournament honors

THE SIGHTS AND SOUNDS FROM A HISTORIC NIGHT IN SCHOLLMAYER

TCU head coach Jason Williams glanced around Schollmaier Arena on Friday, eventually breaking into a grin following the Horned Frogs' 3-1 win over Coastal Carolina in the "Fight in the Fort" nonconference tournament. The head man was soon met with a series of greetings following his first victory at the helm of TCU volleyball.

First came a series of hugs and back slaps from assistant coaches and support staff members. The celebration then turned to the handshake line with his players, who blitzed the Chanticleers to the tune of a season-high 58 assists and 55 kills.

Confetti poppers soon awaited Williams following an extended walk to the locker room chock full of high fives.

"As a lord, I've won a lot," Williams joked in addressing the team. "But it is special. It's special that my first head coaching win overall is with this group right here."

FROGS EARN SHARE OF NC STATE CLASSIC TOURNAMENT TITLE

TCU claimed its first team accolade of the fall in the Tar Heel State after posting a 2-1 mark at the NC State Classic on Sept. 8-9.

- The Horned Frogs earned a share of the tournament title, splitting the honor with the host Wolfpack
- The result signified the first tournament victory in the Jason Williams era
- TCU set a number of early-season statistical highs in its 3-1 victory over Western Carolina to begin the tournament. The Horned Frogs registered a season-high 13 blocks to pair with season-bests in kills (62) and hitting percentage (.307). It marked the first time this fall the Horned Frogs averaged more than three blocks per set, eclipsed 60 kills and hit over .300.
- Match two vs. Indiana saw the Horned Frogs' mettle tested in full. TCU appeared poised to sweep the Hoosiers back to Bloomington after claiming the first two sets in scores of 26-24 and 25-20. The Hoosiers then rallied to extend the match to a decisive fifth set, claiming the third and fourth frames 27-25 and 25-118.
- TCU scored six of the final eight points to claim set five 15-13 against Indiana after trailing by three points as late as 12-9 in the frame.
- The win vs. the Hoosiers was TCU's first victory over a Big Ten opponent in 11 years. It was also TCU's first nonconference triumph over a Power Five foe since a five-set victory over Auburn on Sept. 15, 2019.

NALLS KNUCKLES DOWN IN NORTH CAROLINA

Without question, the Horned Frogs success at the NC State Classic does not materialize without one of the program's best offensive performances in the Big 12 era by Audrey Nalls against Indiana.

- The four-year senior finished with 28 points and 25 kills - both of which were career-highs - along with 13 digs vs. Indiana. Nalls' 25 kills are the most in a match by any Big 12 player three weeks into the 2022 campaign.
- Her 25 kills are tied for second in single-match history in TCU's Big 12 era
- She also racked up 13 digs vs. the Hoosiers to record her first double-double of the fall and sixth of her career
- For the weekend, Nalls tallied 49 kills and 33 digs

SUSTALA STEPS UP IN THE TAR HEEL STATE

Perhaps the most underrated individual effort in the NC State Classic came from Sabrina Sustala.

- Playing as TCU's primary three-row defender vs. Indiana, Sustala notched a TCU career-high 18 digs while passing at a .263 clip.
- One day prior, she earned her first career start in purple and white against Western Carolina. She rewarded the coaching staff's confidence by leading TCU in digs for the first time in her career with 14.

A WELCOME HOME PARTY IN WACO

TCU's Big 12 opener at No. 15 Baylor will feature a homecoming of sorts for a trio of Horned Frogs

- It marks Jason Williams' first return trip to Waco as the Horned Frogs' head coach
- Williams is not the only member of the program with green and gold in their roots. Graduate student Callie Williams played three seasons for the Lady Bears from 2017-2019. Libero Keagan Polk began her collegiate career in Waco last fall before transferring to TCU during the spring 2022 semester to pursue a beach volleyball opportunity

It has not taken long for the Frog faithful to embrace a move over to Ed and Rae Schollmaier Arena. Three of TCU's last seven home contests inside 'Scholl, which underwent a \$72 million renovation in 2015-2016, have drawn three of the top-five largest crowds in the history of the program.

The Horned Frogs set an attendance record when 4,012 spectators packed the 'Scholl for a five-set thriller vs. Baylor on Nov. 13, 2021. TCU's 2022 season-opener saw 2,431 fans support the Horned Frogs as they battled reigning NCAA Volleyball Champion Wisconsin on Aug. 26. TCU's match vs. No. 5 Minnesota on Aug. 27 was the fifth highest-attended match in school history (2,427 fans).

FAREWELL TO RICKEL GYM

TCU Volleyball officially outgrew its former home inside the University Recreation Center after 24 seasons of competition. The Horned Frogs sold out the stadium in every regular season home match in 2019, leading to the move over to Schollmaier Arena during the 2020-2021 season.

The Rickel held an official capacity of 1,250, yet TCU packed over 2,000 fans into the arena 17 times from 2011-2019. By contrast, Schollmaier Arena seats 6,800.

In its final season at the Rickel, TCU set an attendance record with four Big 12 matches eclipsing 2,000 fans, setting an overall attendance record with 26,672.
