

FROG HOPS

- New Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.
- Kurtis Byrne stretched his reached base streak to 20 games.
- TCU is 8-5 against top-10 teams under the guidance of head coach Kirk Saarloos.
- TCU was hit by a pitch 16 times in the first eight games, a mark that is third in the Big 12 and tied for 32nd nationally.
- TCU has stolen multiple bases in five of eight games.
- TCU has allowed only four hits in the last two games played.

BASE RUNNERS GALORE

Only 12 times in the first eight games has TCU retired in order.

TCU boasts a .415 on-base percentage, a mark that ranks second in the Big 12.

TCU has scored multiple runs in 17 of 73 innings this season and tallied at least one run in 29 of those innings.

As a team, TCU is hitting .299 with runners on, .318 with runners in scoring position and .607 with a runner on third and less than two out.

A FINE LINE

When the Frogs win this season, they do it by excelling in all three areas of the game, when they've lost, they come up short in all three.

In wins, the Frogs are hitting at a .320 clip and scoring an average of 8.6 runs per game. In losses, the Frogs are hitting .242 and averaging only 5.7 runs per game.

The losses have seen the Frogs allow opponents a .336 average and 9.7 runs per game and conversely, in wins, opponents are hitting just .154 and averaging 3.2 runs per game.

FRESH FACED IMPACT

The TCU lineup has seen four freshmen make their debuts at the plate this season. The quartet have adjusted well to the collegiate game, combining to hit .375 (18-for-48) with 12 RBIs.

Anthony Silva is the lone Horned Frog to have collected a hit in every game this season. He sits second on the team with a .379 average and second with eight RBIs.

Karson Bowen has tallied three straight twohit contests in games he has appeared in.

Fisher Ingersoll and Jake Duer have also made starts as the designated hitter.

POWER POTENTIAL

Brayden Taylor collected his second home run of the season in Saturday's game against Florida State.

His home run in the season-opener against Vanderbilt gave him home runs in four straight dating back to last season. It's the second time in his career he has homered in four straight games. As a freshman, he homered in all three games against Oklahoma (4/2-4/21) and followed with a blast against Tarleton (4/6/21).

In his career, Taylor has hit 27 homers. He is nine away from entering the top five all-time in program history.

YOUTHFUL ARMS

TCU has utilized six freshmen arms this season and they have lived up to the billing. As a group, they have posted a 3.93 ERA, allowing 15 runs in $34\,1/3$ innings. Five of the 15 runs came in one inning against Florida. Minus that frame, the group has a collective 2.70 ERA. The have 35 strikeouts and just nine walks.

TWO OUT TALLIES

Two out tallies were a huge part of TCU's two wins over No. 10 Vanderbilt and No. 8 Arkansas. Against the Commodores, 10 of TCU's 11 runs came with two outs. In the win over Arkansas, eight of TCU's 18 runs came with two outs. In the win over DBU, two of the four runs scored came with two outs.

On the sesason, TCU has scored 27 of its 60 runs (45%) with two outs. The Horned Frogs are hitting .261 (24-for-92) with two outs. Nine Frogs have at least one two-out RBI led by six from David Bishop and five from Elijah Nunez.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation.

The Frogs are one of just 11 teams to have stolen at least 850 bases over the last 10 years. The 875 stolen bases rank 11th in the nation and third among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 79% of their attempts over the last eight years (877-of-1,110). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 10 seasons, TCU is 149-of-184 (81%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

The TCU pitching staff has pitched the ninthmost shutouts (55) nationally over the last eight years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 235 times in the 585 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 216 times in those contests.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 239 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

The Horned Frogs are off to a blistering start this season, tallying double-digit strikeouts in five of the first seven game.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 41 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 23-18 mark in those games. TCU is 4-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU picked up its first extra-inning win of the season in 12 innings at DBU. It's the longest game since a 14-inning win at Texas Tech on May 16.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
