FROG HOPS

- New Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.
- TCU is 8-5 against top-10 teams under the guidance of head coach Kirk Saarloos.
- TCU has stolen multiple bases in eight of 19 games.
- TCU has homered in 10 of the last 11 games, including a season-high three times in the Sunday's win over San Diego.
- Cole Fontenelle hit TCU's first pinch hit home run since Bobby Goodloe against Texas on May 9, 2021.
- In 19 games this season, TCU has utilized 18 different lineups. The last 17 lineups have been different.

NUMBERS TELL A STORY

TCU's inconsistencies in the offense can be linked to the wins and losses. In wins, TCU is averaging 7.7 runs per game and in losses, just 4.2 runs. The Frogs are hitting .305 as a team in wins and just .217 in losses.

A big part of the success is TCU's production with two outs in wins vs. losses. The Frogs are hitting .293 with 41 two-out RBIs in wins and are hitting just .232 with 11 two-out RBIs in losses.

CLEANING UP ON DEFENSE

TCU has seen an improvement on defense over the last four games. After committing errors in 13 of the first 15 games, TCU has played errorless baseball in three of the last four games.

FRESH FACED IMPACT

The TCU lineup has seen four freshmen make their debuts at the plate this season. The quartet have adjusted well to the collegiate game, combining to hit .284 (29-for-102) with 21 RBIs.

NO RUNNING ALLOWED

The TCU catching duo of Kurtis Byrne and Karson Bowen have been torturous for opponent base stealers. They have allowed just nine stolen bases in 19 attempts.

Byrne has caught three of six base runners, while Bowen has thrown out seven of 10 base stealers. Since allowing two stolen bases in the first four attempts against him, Bowen has thrown out five of the last nine would-be base stealers. Byrne has thrown out two of the last three he's faced.

POWER POTENTIAL

Brayden Taylor has homered in five of the last six games to run his season total to a team-high seven, a mark that co-leads the Big 12.

His home run in the season-opener against Vanderbilt gave him home runs in four straight dating back to last season. It's the second time in his career he has homered in four straight games. As a freshman, he homered in all three games against Oklahoma (4/2-4/21) and followed with a blast against Tarleton (4/6/21).

In his career, Taylor has hit 32 homers. He is

four away from entering the top five all-time in program history.

YOUTHFUL ARMS

TCU has utilized seven freshmen arms this season and they have lived up to the billing. They have contributed 46% of the innings pitched this season. As a group, they have posted a 4.12 ERA, allowing 37 earned runs in 80.2 innings. 11 of the 37 runs have come over 2 2/3 innings in two different games. Minus those innings, the group has a collective 3.00 ERA. They have 70 strikeouts and just 26 walks.

TWO OUT TALLIES

Two out tallies were a huge part of TCU's two wins over No. 10 Vanderbilt and No. 8 Arkansas. Against the Commodores, 10 of TCU's 11 runs came with two outs. In the win over Arkansas, eight of TCU's 18 runs came with two outs. In the win over DBU, two of the four runs scored came with two outs. In the last two weekend series, 16 of 29 runs came have with two outs.

On the sesason, TCU has scored 52 of its 115 runs (45%) with two outs. Ten Frogs have at least one two-out RBI led by nine from Tre Richardson, eight from Brayden Taylor and seven from David Bishop.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation.

The Frogs are one of just 11 teams to have stolen at least 850 bases over the last 10 years. The 888 stolen bases rank 11th in the nation and third among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 79% of their attempts over the last eight years (888-of-1,118). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 10 seasons, TCU is 152-of-187 (81%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

The TCU pitching staff has pitched the eighthmost shutouts (57) nationally over the last eight years

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 238 times in the 596 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 221 times in those contests.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 239 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

The Horned Frogs are off to a blistering start this season, tallying double-digit strikeouts in nine of the first 19 games.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 41 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 23-18 mark in those games. TCU is 4-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU picked up its first extra-inning win of the season in 12 innings at DBU. It's the longest game since a 14-inning win at Texas Tech on May 16.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
