TCU NOTABLES

- TCU went 1-3 in the last homestand which included a series loss to UNC Wilmington.
- Despite the weekend losses, TCU has won 12 of its last 18 games.
- TCU dropped to No. 46 in the RPI after the series loss.
- TCU ranks seventh in the Big 12 with a .277 average, fifth with a 5.21 ERA and fourth with a .974 fielding percentage.
- TCU ran its season total to 88 stolen bases, which is tied for second in the Big 12 alongside Kansas State. It is tied for 12th nationally.
- TCU has a stolen base in 16 of the last 17 games. The Frogs are 61-of-62 during that stretch.
- TCU's 51 home runs on the season are tied for fourth in the Big 12.
- TCU is one of 24 schools with four shutouts this year.
- Kole Klecker picked up his seventh win of the season, a total that ranks tied for third nationally and just one behind the national leaders.
- Brayden Taylor hit three home runs over the weekend to move into fourth all-time in career home runs (38). He needs one more to move into third all-time.
- Anthony Silva's .362 batting average ranks seventh in the Big 12

- TCU will play 17 road games this season.
- TCU has won 28 of 52 road series since Kirk Saarloos' arrival in 2013.
- TCU is 29-14 in road midweek games under Saarloos.
- TCU is 114-90 on the road with Saarloos on staff.
- TCU has been above .500 on the road in six of Saarloos' 10 seasons on staff.
- TCU has won 17 of 37 road conference series since Kirk Saarloos' arrival in 2013.

WEST VIRGINIA NOTABLES

- West Virginia picked up a 2-1 series win at Oklahoma State last weekend and recorded a midweek win against Pittsburgh Wednesday.
- The Mountaineers have won two of the three Big 12 series they've played (win vs. Kansas State, loss to Kansas).
- West Virginia is 6-4 in its last 10 games.
- The Mountaineers sit second in the Big 12 in batting average (.302), second in ERA (4.35) and sixth in fielding percentage (.966).
- WVU's 89 stolen bases on the season are tops in the league and 10th nationally.
- JJ Wetherholt's .451 batting average ranks sixth nationally.
- Wetherholt's 27 stolen bases on the year are also tops in the Big 12.
- Carlson Reed and Noah Short co-lead the squad with 15 appearances out of the bullpen.

SERIES NOTABLES

- TCU and West Virginia began their series in 2013 and will be meeting on the diamond for the 33rd time on Friday night.
- TCU is 24-8 all-time against West Virginia, including a 20-7 mark in the regular season.
- The Horned Frogs have swept the regular season series four of the last eight seasons.
- TCU has won seven of the nine series played.
- West Virginia picked up a 2-1 series victory at Lupton Stadium in 2022.
- TCU is 9-3 against West Virginia in Morgantown.
- TCU has won four of the five series played in West Virginia, recording sweeps in 2016 and 2021.
- Head coach Randy Mazey was an assistant at TCU from 2007-2012.

FROG HOPS

- New Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.
- TCU is 8-5 against top-10 teams under the guidance of head coach Kirk Saarloos.
- TCU has stolen multiple bases in 22 of 37 games this season. TCU streak of 50 straight successful stolen base attempts ended Tuesday at ACU.
- TCU has homered in 25 of the last 29 games. They have 41 home runs in that stretch.
- TCU scored nine runs in the sixth in Saturday's win over UNCW. It's the most runs scored in an inning since 2019 when they scored 14 against Oklahoma on May 23.
- Cole Fontenelle hit TCU's first pinch hit home run since Bobby Goodloe against Texas on May 9, 2021.
- In 37 games this season, TCU has utilized 34 different lineups.

RUNNING AMOK

Through the first 20 games of the season, TCU was jsut 27-of-36 in stolen bases. Over the last 17 games, the Horned Frogs have swiped 61 bases in 62 attempts. The 88 stolen bases are tied for second in the Big 12 and 12th nationally.

Broken down, TCU is 67-of-74 in stealing second, 21-of-23 in stealing third and 0-for-1 stealing home.

CHEF'S COOKING

Since returning from an injury, Anthony Silva has hit his stride offensively. While his 17 game on-base streak ended Tuesday, he has raised his average over 90 points to .362. He is hitting .429 over the last 18 games with nine extra base hits and 22 RBIs. He boasts a .526 on-base percentage.

POWER POTENTIAL

Brayden Taylor has homered in 10 of the last 20 games to run his season total to a team-high 13, a mark that is second in the Big 12.

In his career, Taylor has hit 38 homers. He is six home runs shy of tying the school record. His next home run will move him into a tie for third all-time with Chad Huffman.

A TALE OF TWO TEAMS

TCU's inconsistencies in the offense can be linked to the wins and losses. In wins, TCU is averaging 9.5 runs per game and in losses, just 5.5 runs. The Frogs are hitting .312 as a team in wins and just .226 in losses.

A big part of the success is TCU's production with runners in scoring position and two out runs. The Frogs are hitting .313 with 81 two-out RBIs in wins and are hitting just .214 with 23 two-out RBIs in losses.

On the mound, the staff boasts a 2.98 ERA while the club owns a .982 fielding percentage in wins. In losses, the staff has an 8.59 ERA and a .963 fielding percentage.

CLEANING UP ON DEFENSE

TCU has seen an improvement on defense over the last nine games. After committing errors in 13 of the first 15 games, TCU has played errorless baseball in 13 of the last 22 games. The Frogs boast a .982 fielding percentage during that stretch.

In that stretch, TCU's fielding percentage has climbed from .962 to .974.

FRESH FACED IMPACT

The TCU lineup has seen four freshmen make their debuts at the plate this season. The quartet have adjusted well to the collegiate game, combining to hit .322 (74-for-230) with eight home runs and 55 RBIs. Collectively they have stolen 18-of-20.

NO RUNNING ALLOWED

The catching duo of Kurtis Byrne and Karson Bowen have been torturous for opponent base stealers. They have allowed just 24 stolen bases in 38 attempts. The 23 stolen bases are the third-fewest allowed in the league.

Byrne has caught six of 18 base runners, while Bowen has thrown out eight of 20 base stealers.

YOUTHFUL ARMS

TCU has utilized seven freshmen arms this season and they have lived up to the billing. They have contributed 49% of the innings pitched this season. As a group, they have posted a 5.46 ERA, allowing 98 earned runs in 161.1 innings. They have 145 strikeouts and just 55 walks.

TWO OUT TALLIES

On the sesason, TCU has scored 110 of its 286 runs (38%) with two outs. Eleven Frogs have at least one two-out RBI led by 18 from Cole Fontenelle, 14 each from Brayden Taylor and Anthony Silva. Tre Richardson has 12.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation.

The Frogs are one of just 11 teams to have stolen at least 900 bases over the last 10 years. The 949 stolen bases rank ninth in the nation and third among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 80% of their attempts over the last eight years (949-of-1,180). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 10 seasons, TCU is 170-of-205 (83%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

The TCU pitching staff has pitched the eighth-most shutouts (59) nationally over the last eight years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 241 times in the 610 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs 234 times in those contests.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 240 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

The Horned Frogs are off to a blistering start this season, tallying double-digit strikeouts in 15 of the 36 games played this season.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 41 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 23-18 mark in those games. TCU is 4-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU picked up its first extra-inning win of the season in 12 innings at DBU. It's the longest game since a 14-inning win at Texas Tech on May 16.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
