TCU NOTABLES

- TCU is 5-3 on its current 12-game home stand after picking up a series victory over No. 24 Cal State Fullerton last weekend.
- TCU's RPI climbed up to 50 after the series win over the Titans.
- Against Cal State Fullerton, TCU allowed just seven total runs (four earned) and runs in only three of 27 innings pitched.
- TCU ranks fifth in the Big 12 with a .286 average, fifth with a 5.22 ERA and fifth with a .973 fielding percentage.
- TCU ran its season total to 102 stolen bases, which is second in the Big 12 and is tied for 14th nationally.
- TCU reached the 100 stolen base plateau for the third straight season and the ninth time in program history.
- TCU's 62 home runs on the season are sixth in the Big 12.
- Kole Klecker's sevens wins this season leads the Big 12 and ranks tied for 24th nationally.
- Brayden Taylor's hit his 40th career home run to move him into a tie for second all-time in program history. His 15 home runs are tied for third in the league.
- Anthony Silva's .354 batting average ranks 10th in the Big 12.

HOME NOTABLES

- TCU will play 32 home games during the 2022 season.
- TCU is 464-163 all-time at Lupton Stadium.
- TCU is 228-82 at home with Kirk Saarloos on staff.
- TCU has won 61-of-76 home series under Saarloos.
- TCU owns a 103-37 mark in midweek games at home.
- TCU has won 20 or more games in 15 of the 20 seasons Lupton Stadium has been in existence.
- TCU ranks 16th nationally in average attendance (3,994).

BAYLOR NOTABLES

- Baylor has yet to play a weekend series in the month of May due to finals schedule.
- The Bears returned to action Tuesday and Wednesday, dropping contests to Grand Canyon and Lamar.
- Baylor has just one win in its last eight games.
- The Bears have Big 12 series wins over Kansas State and Oklahoma.
- Baylor ranks last in the Big 12 in batting average (.257), ERA (6.73) and fielding percentage (.960).
- Hunter Simmons leads the team with a .331 average, while Kolby Branch paces the squad with 37 RBIs and six stolen bases.
- On the mound, Anderson Needham and Adam Muirhead co-lead the team with 21 appearances.
- Hambleton Oliver owns three of the team's seven saves on the year.

SERIES NOTABLES

- TCU and Baylor will be meeting for the 340th time on Friday night.
- Baylor holds a 172-163-4 lead in the series.
- TCU went 3-1 against Baylor in 2022. The Horned Frogs won 2-of-3 in the regular season and picked up a win in conference tournament.
- TCU is 19-14 against Baylor since Kirk Saarloos arrived on campus in 2013, including 10-5 in Fort Worth.
- TCU is 17-10 all-time against Baylor at Lupton Stadium.
- TCU has won 25 of the last 39 meetings.
- TCU swept Baylor at Lupton Stadium in 2021.
- TCU has won six of nine league series, including four of the five played in Fort Worth.
- The Frogs renewed their series with the Bears in 2000 and have played every year since except 2020.
- Current Baylor Bear Hunter Teplanszky played at TCU in 2022.

FROG HOPS

- New Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.
- TCU is 8-5 against top-10 teams under the guidance of head coach Kirk Saarloos.
- TCU has stolen multiple bases in 27 of 48 games this season. TCU had streak of 50 straight successful stolen base attempts ended at ACU.
- TCU reached the 100 stolen base plateau for the third straight season.
- TCU has homered in 31 of the last 39 games. They have 58 home runs in that stretch.
- TCU scored nine runs in the sixth in the lone win over UNCW. It's the most runs scored in an inning since 2019 when they scored 14 against Oklahoma on May 23.
- Cole Fontenelle hit TCU's first pinch hit home run since Bobby Goodloe against Texas on May 9, 2021.
- In 48 games this season, TCU has utilized 44 different lineups.

RUNNING AMOK

Through the first 20 games of the season, TCU was just 27-of-36 in stolen bases. Over the last 38 games, the Horned Frogs have swiped 75 bases in 79 attempts. The 102 stolen bases are second in the Big 12 and 14th nationally.

Broken down, TCU is 78-of-88 in stealing second, 24-of-26 in stealing third and 0-for-1 stealing home.

LEADING OFF

Elijah Nunez returned to a familiar spot in the lineup, hitting leadoff in seven of the last eight games. He has enjoyed the move to the top, hitting .517 (15-for-29) in that stretch.

He is in the midst of an 11-game hitting streak that has raised his average 62 points from .239 to .301. He is hitting .476 during the streak (20-for-42).

POWER POTENTIAL

With a career-high 15 home runs this season, Brayden Taylor has now hit 40 career homers. He is four home runs shy of tying the school record. His next home run will move him into sole possession of second all-time, passing Chris Connally.

THE NUMBERS TELL A STORY

The stark contrasts in the numbers when TCU wins and losses tell quite the story. In wins, TCU is averaging 9.8 runs per game and in losses, just 5.0 runs. The Frogs are hitting .328 as a team in wins and just .229 in losses.

A big part of the success is TCU's production with runners in scoring position and two out runs. The Frogs are hitting .333 with runners in scoring position and have 108 two-out RBIs in wins and are hitting just .214 with 33 two-out RBIs in losses.

On the mound, the staff boasts a 3.01 ERA while the club owns a .978 fielding percentage in wins. In losses, the staff has an 8.17 ERA and a .961 fielding percentage.

FRESH STARTS

TCU has started a freshman in 10 of the last 11 games. There was a streak of seven straight games with a freshman starter.

Five freshmen have combined to start 26 games this season. That is 54% of the contests played this year.

FRESH FACED IMPACT

The TCU lineup has seen four freshmen make their debuts at the plate this season. The quartet have adjusted well to the collegiate game, combining to hit .331 (103-for-311) with 11 home runs and 73 RBIs. Collectively they have stolen 18-of-20.

HOME COOKING

TCU has won five of eight games so far in its current 12-game homestand. The bats have come to life since returning home. TCU is hitting .331 as a team with a .509 slugging percentage. Elijah Nunez leads the way with a .500 average.

On the mound, the staff boasts a 3.60 ERA and is limiting opponents to a .231 average. The bullpen has a 3.18 ERA in that stretch.

YOUTHFUL ARMS

TCU has utilized seven freshmen arms this season and they have lived up to the billing. They have contributed 49% of the innings pitched this season. As a group, they have posted a 5.35 ERA, allowing 124 earned runs in 208.2 innings. They have 197 strikeouts and just 79 walks.

TWO OUT TALLIES

On the sesason, TCU has scored 138 of its 350 runs (39%) with two outs. Eleven Frogs have at least one two-out RBI led by 19 from Cole Fontenelle, 16 from Brayden Taylor and 14 from Anthony Silva. Tre Richardson has 13.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation.

The Frogs are one of just 11 teams to have stolen at least 900 bases over the last 10 years. The 963 stolen bases rank ninth in the nation and third among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 79% of their attempts over the last eight years (953-of-1,197). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 10 seasons, TCU is 173-of-208 (83%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

The TCU pitching staff has pitched the eighth-most shutouts (59) nationally over the last eight years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 243 times in the 621 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs 240 times in those contests.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 243 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

The Horned Frogs are off to a blistering start this season, tallying double-digit strikeouts in 18 of the 48 games played this season.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 41 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 23-18 mark in those games. TCU is 4-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU picked up its first extra-inning win of the season in 12 innings at DBU. It's the longest game since a 14-inning win at Texas Tech on May 16.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
