TCU NOTABLES

- TCU won its fourth Big 12 Championship, going 4-0 en route to the title.
- TCU set a championship record with 48 runs scored and 12.0 runs per game.
- The Frogs are 14-2 in the month of May. TCU is hitting .352, pitching to a 2.99 ERA and fielding .986.
- TCU's RPI finished the regular season with an RPI of 33. It's RPI is up 19 points over the last month.
- TCU ranks fifth in the Big 12 in batting at .295, third in ERA at 4.83 and third with a .977 fielding percentage.
- TCU ran its season total to 129 stolen bases, which leads the Big 12 and is tied for eighth nationally. It is the third-most stolen bases in program history.
- Brayden Taylor became TCU's program record holder with 45 home runs in Thursday's win. His 21 home runs on the year are tied for the third-most in a single season.
- Ben Abeldt, Karson Bowen, Kurtis Byrne, Elijah Nunez and Brayden Taylor were named All-Tournament.

SERIES HISTORY

- TCU and Arizona will be playing for the 10th time in program history. Arizona leads the all-time series 7-2.
- The series dates back to 1956.
- TCU won the last meeting by an 11-5 score in the 2010 NCAA Fort Worth Regional
- TCU is 1-1 against Arizona at a neutral site.
- TCU and Arkansas have played 71 times previously, with Arkansas leading the series 47-24.
- TCU handed Arkansas its first loss of the season, a 18-6 TCU victory in the Higginbotham College Baseball Showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington.
- TCU is 6-0 all-time against Santa Clara.
- All six meeting have taken place at Lupton Stadium.
- TCU swept a three game series in 2015 and 2022.

NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTABLES

- TCU earned its 10th automatic bid in program history, having done so in 2004, 2006, 2007 2008, 2010, 2012, 2014, 2016 and 2021.
- TCU is playing in the Fayetteville Regional for the second time in program history (2019).
- TCU went 2-2 in the 2019 NCAA Fayetteville Regional, advancing to the Regional Championship game as the Region's No. 3 seed.
- TCU is making its 19th NCAA Tournament appearance in program history and eighth since Kirk Saarloos' arrival on campus.
- TCU is one of eight programs nationally to have appeared in 17 of the last 19 NCAA Tournaments.
- The Frogs will be a two seed for the fifth time (2005, 2007, 2012 and 2022).
- TCU has been a one-seed eight times (2009-11, 2014-17 and 2021), a three-seed three times (2004, 2008, 2019) and a four seed once (2006).
- The Frogs have played in a Regional in Tucson, Ariz (1956), Austin, Texas (2004), Waco, Texas (2005), Norman, Okla. (2006), Houston (Rice), Texas (2007), Stillwater, Okla. (1994, 2008), College Station, Texas (2012, 2022) and Fayetteville, Ark. (2019).
- The Frogs are 36-24 all-time in the NCAA Regionals.
- In postseason play, TCU is 58-42 (.580) all-time.
- TCU has won seven NCAA Regionals in program history (2009, '10, '14, '15, '16 and '17 Fort Worth Regional as well as the 2012 College Station Regional.
- TCU is 2-12 in road NCAA Regional games and 13-7 in neutral NCAA Regional games.
- TCU and Arizona are meeting in the postseason for the third time (1956, 0-2 vs. Arizona; 2010, 1-0 vs. Arizona)
- TCU is 0-2 against Arkansas in the postseason.
- TCU and Santa Clara have never met in the postseason.

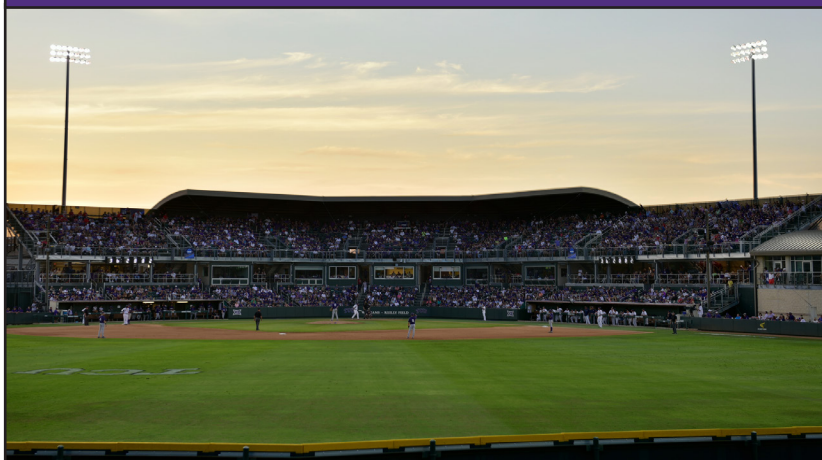

FROG HOPS

- New Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.
- TCU is 8-5 against top-10 teams under the guidance of head coach Kirk Saarloos.
- TCU has stolen multiple bases in 34 of 59 games this season. TCU had streak of 50 straight successful stolen base attempts ended at ACU.
- TCU reached the 100 stolen base plateau for the third straight season.
- TCU has homered in 40 of the last 50 games. They have 71 home runs in that stretch.
- TCU scored nine runs in the sixth in the lone win over UNCW. It's the most runs scored in an inning since 2019 when they scored 14 against Oklahoma on May 23.
- Ben Abeldt has not allowed a run in his last 10 appearances spanning 14.1 innings.
- Cole Fontenelle hit TCU's first pinch hit home run since Bobby Goodloe against Texas on May 9, 2021.
- In 59 games this season, TCU has utilized 52 different lineups.

ELITE COMPANY

With their selection to the field of 64, the Horned Frogs are in elite company. TCU is one of just eight programs nationally to appear in 17 of the last 19 regionals. Also holding that distinction are Arkansas, Florida, Florida State, Miami (Fla.), North Carolina, Vanderbilt and Virginia.

FROGBALL USA - TITLE TOWN

TCU has won a combined eight Big 12 championships since joining the Big 12 in 2013. The Horned Frogs won the regular season title in 2015, 2017, 2021 and 2022. TCU took home tournament crowns in 2014, 2016, 2021 and 2023. That's the most for any Big 12 program since TCU joined the league.

RUNNING AMOK

Through the first 20 games of the season, TCU was just 27-of-36 in stolen bases. Over the last 49 games, the Horned Frogs have swiped 102 bases in 110 attempts. The 129 stolen bases are tops in the Big 12 and tied for eighth nationally.

Broken down, TCU is 98-of-110 in stealing second, 30-of-34 in stealing third and 1-for-2 stealing home. TCU has successfully executed 16 double steal attempts.

A MONTH TO REMEMBER

TCU put together a month to remember, winning 14 of 16 games. TCU outscored its opponents by a 150-52 margin. The Frogs have tallied 10 or more runs seven times.

The Horned Frogs were outstanding in all areas during the month, hitting .352 with a .530 slugging percentage and a .441 on base percentage. The pitching staff has posted a miniscule 2.99 ERA and TCU turned in a .986 fielding percentage. Opponents are hitting just .226 this month.

Kurtis Byrne led the Frogs with a .411 average and tallied 20 RBIs during the month, while Brayden Taylor homered seven times and drove in 22. Luke Savage went 3-0, while Jax Traeger, Kole Klecker and Sam Stoutenborough each tallied two wins.

ALONE AT THE TOP

With a career-high 20 home runs this season, Brayden Taylor has now hit 45 career homers, becoming TCU's all-time home run leader passing Royce Huffman. His 21 home runs on the season are tied for the third-most in a single season and are two shy of tying the single-season record.

FRESH STARTS

TCU has started a freshman in 17 of the last 20 games. There was a streak of seven straight games with a fresh-

man starter.

Five freshmen have combined to start 33 games this season. That is 56% of the contests played this year.

FRESH FACED IMPACT

The TCU lineup has seen four freshmen make their debuts at the plate this season. The quartet have adjusted well to the collegiate game, combining to hit .334 (131-for-392) with 13 home runs and 92 RBIs. Collectively they have stolen 24-of-27.

A RUN FOR THE AGES

TCU tallied two run-rule victories and set a tournament record with 48 runs scored. TCU outscored its two opponents by a 48-15 margin in the four game sweep to the title.

The Horned Frogs are hitting a robust .401 in the tournament with nine doubles, two triples and six home runs.

Five Frogs hit .455 or better. Kurtis Byrne (9-for-16) led the way with a .563 average including two home runs and five RBIs. Brayden Taylor (.500, 3 HR, 11 RBIs), Logan Maxwell (.500, 2 RBIs), Karson Bowen (.471, 3 RBIs) and Cole Fontenelle (.455, 2 RBIs) shined at the plate.

YOUTHFUL ARMS

TCU has utilized seven freshmen arms this season and they have lived up to the billing. They have contributed 49% of the innings pitched this season. As a group, they have posted a 4.89 ERA, allowing 139 earned runs in 255.1 innings. They have 244 strikeouts and just 103 walks.

TWO OUT TALLIES

On the season, TCU has scored 173 of its 461 runs (38%) with two outs. Eleven Frogs have at least one two-out RBI led by 21 each from Kurtis Byrne, Cole Fontenelle and Brayden Taylor. Anthony Silva has 19, while Tre Richardson has 18 and Karson Bowen and Austin Davis each have 16. TCU is hitting .287 as a team with two outs this season.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation.

The Frogs are one of just 11 teams to have stolen at least 950 bases over the last 10 years. The 990 stolen bases rank seventh in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 81% of their attempts over the last eight years (990-of-1,228). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 10 seasons, TCU is 177-of-214 (83%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

The TCU pitching staff has pitched the eighth-most shutouts (59) nationally over the last eight years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 247 times in the 631 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs 242 times in those contests.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 246 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

The Horned Frogs have tallied double-digit strikeouts in 23 of the 59 games played this season.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 41 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 23-18 mark in those games. TCU is 4-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU picked up its first extra-inning win of the season in 12 innings at DBU. It's the longest game since a 14-inning win at Texas Tech on May 16.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.

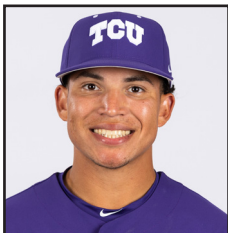
