

FROG HOPS

- With four regular season crowns and four tournament trophies, TCU's eight Big 12 championships are the most of any program in the league since TCU joined in 2013.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$. The eight total championships are the second most in league history.
- Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- The newest member of the coaching staff, Dave Lawn, comes to TCU with 37 years of coaching under his belt.
- Lawn has made four trips to the College World Series in his career.
- ${\boldsymbol \cdot}$ Lawn needs just 18 games to reach 1,700 games coached in his career.
- TCU student assistants Brian Howard and Evan Skoug combined for seven CWS trips in their time as Horned Frogs.
- Howard and Skoug are the latest Frogs to return to the program to complete their degrees, joining Josh Elander (2016), Kyle Winkler (2019) and Matt Purke (2020-21).
- TCU has a trio of sophomores that hail from the same high school in California. Karson Bowen, Gabe Miranda and Louis Rodriguez all played at Orange Lutheran.
- Additionally, TCU has a pair of athletes from Hamilton H.S. in Chandler, Ariz. (Klecker, Wadas) and two from American Fork H.S. in Utah (Ingersoll, Robinson). The group has combined to win eight state champions.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.

STRONG START

TCU is off to its best start to a campaign since 1994. It's the fifth time since the 1967 season the Frogs have opened 7-0. TCU opened 8-0 in 1967, 1975 and 9-0 in 1994. The 1985 squad owns the best-ever start at 11-0.

TCU is one of 16 squads that remains undefeated two weeks into the season. Only 12 of the 16 teams have at least seven wins.

SETTLING IN

After posting a 7.96 ERA in the opening weekend, the pitching staff has found their rhythm. Over the last four games, the staff has lowered its ERA by 2.5 runs down to 5.40.

In the last four games, the staff boasts a 3.44 ERA, allowing 13 runs in 34 innings. Against UCLA, the staff had a 3.24 ERA.

Down too were the walks. Opening weekend, the staff issued 20 walks. In the last four games alone, they have issued just 11 walks.

DON'T SLEEP ON THE FROGS

Come early and stay late is the motto of the early season for the Frogs. TCU has had to rally back to win three of four games this season.

TCU is hitting .507 (35-for-69) in the first two innings of contests with 21 runs scored and .337 (29-for-86) in the innings 6-through-8. The middle frames have been tough as TCU is just 18-for-78 (.231) in innings 3-through-5.

SUNDAY'S ARE FOR KARSON

Karson Bowen is hitting .321 on the season, but the bulk of his production has come on Sunday. He leads the squad with 12 RBIs, 10 of which have come on Sunday's.

The sophomore is hitting .750 (6-for-8) with two home runs on Sunday and just .150 (3-for-20) in the other five games.

WELCOME TO FORT WORTH

Peyton Chatagnier enjoyed his new stop in the Purple and White. Serving as the lead-off hitter, the Ole Miss transfer is hitting .360 through the first seven games with a .500 on-base percentage.

In the Saturday game against FGCU and the Sunday tilt against UCLA, he led off the game with a home run. In the FGCU game, he hit another home run for his fourth career multi-home run game.

OPPORTUNISTIC FROGS

Brody Green was inserted as a defensive replacement in the series finale against FGCU. He has done nothing but hit since entering the linuep. He leads the team with a .529 (9-for-17) average and boasts three multi-hit games over that stretch.

Jack Basseer joined the lineup as the designated hitter on Saturday and hit .500 (3-for-6) with two runs scored in those two games.

A DREAM COME TRUE

Zachary Cawyer played his high school baseball just under eight miles away from Lupton Stadium at Nolan Catholic. After a two year stint at McLennan College, Cawyer is off to a great start at TCU.

The junior leads the team with four appearances in relief and has two wins. In all four appearances he has taken over with at least two runners on. He has allowed just three of nine to score.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs led the Big 12 and ranked sixth nationally with a school-record 141 stolen bases in 2023. The 141 stolen bases broke the previous record of 134 set in 1996. Four Horned Frogs reached the 20-steal plateau.

The Frogs are one of just seven teams to have stolen at least 1,000 bases over the last 11-plus years. The 1,011 stolen bases rank seventh in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 80% of their attempts over the last nine years (1011-of-1268). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 11 seasons, TCU is 184-of-223 (83%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 244 times in the 652 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 251 times in those contests.

WINS UPON WINS UPON WINS

Since Saarloos arrived on campus, TCU has produced 436 wins and owns a .667 wining percentage. The 432 wins rank seventh nationally and are the most in the state of Texas.

TCU has been victorious in 94 of 139 series played and tallied 46 series sweeps.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Frogs have enjoyed the home cooking of Lupton Stadium since it opened in 2003. TCU has an all-time record of 476-162 (.746) at Lupton Stadium.

The last nine seasons have seen Lupton Stadium become one of the toughest places to play. TCU has won 52 of the last 66 series played at Lupton Stadium over that time frame.

Since the start of 2014, TCU has posted a 215-71 (.752) record.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 41 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 23-18 mark in those games. TCU is 4-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU picked up its first extra-inning win of the season in 12 innings at DBU. It's the longest game since a 14-inning win at Texas Tech on May 16.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.




