- TCU suffered its first home series sweep since the 2019 campaign (Baylor)
- TCU bounced back with a 7-3 win over UTA on Tuesday to remain undefeated in non-conference games
- TCU dropped its first two league series since the 2013 campaign.

FROG HOPS

- TCU's 13-0 start to the season marks the best in program history.
- The 13-game winning streak is tied for the third-longest in program history.
- With four regular season crowns and four tournament trophies, TCU's eight Big 12 championships are the most of any program in the league since TCU joined in 2013.
- The eight total championships are the second most in league history.
- Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- The newest member of the coaching staff, Dave Lawn, comes to TCU with 37 years of coaching under his belt.
- Lawn has made four trips to the College World Series in his career.
- Lawn needs just four games to reach 1,700 games coached in his career.
- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ TCU student assistants Brian Howard and Evan Skoug combined for seven CWS trips in their time as Horned Frogs.
- Howard and Skoug are the latest Frogs to return to the program to complete their degrees, joining Josh Elander (2016), Kyle Winkler (2019) and Matt Purke (2020-21).
- TCU has a trio of sophomores that hail from the same high school in California. Karson Bowen, Gabe Miranda and Louis Rodriguez all played at Orange Lutheran.
- Additionally, TCU has a pair of athletes from Hamilton H.S. in Chandler, Ariz. (Klecker, Wadas) and two from American Fork H.S. in Utah (Ingersoll, Robinson). The group has combined to win eight state champions.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.

COLD SPELL

Since rattling off 13 straight wins to open the season, the Frogs have won just three of their last eight games.

TCU is hitting just .240 during that span and averaging just 5.8 runs per game. Logan Maxwell (.379), Brody Green (.571) and Luke Boyers (.400) are the lone Horned Frogs hitting over .300 in that stretch.

On the mound, the staff has a 5.40 ERA and is allowing opponents to hit .266.

Defensively, the squad has committed five errors which have led to five unearned runs.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

TCU has drawn 109 walks this season and struck out just 147 times. The 147 strikeouts are the fourth-fewest in the Big 12, while the 109 walks are the fourth-most. On eight occasions, the Horned Frogs have drawn more walks than they have struck out in a game. The Frogs have walked five or more times in a game 13 times this season.

COMEBACK FROGS

TCU has eight come-from-beind wins this season. In five of those eight wins, the Horned Frogs have trailed by multiple runs. In four of the wins, TCU has trailed in the eighth or ninth inning.

MAX EFFORT

After dealing with various injuries in his first two seasons, Logan Maxwell has put together a strong start to his junior campaign.

He leads the team with a .403 average. Of his team-leading 27 hits, nine have gone for extra bases. He sits second on the squad with 18 walks and his .539 on-base percentage is 36th nationally

Dating back to last season, Maxwell saw his 19game hitting streak come to an end, but reached-base streak of 21 games remains on-going.

DUCKS ON THE POND

TCU is winning by an average of 1.9 runs per game. That margin could be larger as the Horned Frogs have left a number of runners on base. Through 21 games, TCU has left 185 runners on base, an average of 8.8 per game.

The Frogs are hitting just .289 with runners in scoring position, .308 with runners on base and .650 with a runner on third and less than two outs. TCU has utilized the sacrifice fly, ranking ninth nationally with 16 on the season.

NEW FACES GALORE

In the Sunday win over USC, four Horned Frogs made their TCU debut. A trio of freshmen, Mason Bixby, Micah Kendrick and Zach Wadas made their collegiate debuts. Colt Taylor saw his first action on the mound as a grad transfer. Jax Traeger made his season debut Tuesday.

On the season, six freshmen and nine transfers have seen playing time. Additionally, after red-shirting in 2023, Gabe Miranda has made his collegiate debut.

SPEED FACTOR

The Frogs are one of just seven teams to have stolen at least 1,000 bases over the last 11-plus years. The 1,028 stolen bases rank seventh in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 80% of their attempts over the last nine years (1028-of-1289). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 11 seasons, TCU is 186-of-225 (83%) in stealing third.

THE K-ZONE

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 273 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

The Horned Frogs have tallied double-digit strikeouts in 12 of the 21 games played this season. Twice this season, TCU has fanned 19 batters. TCU is one of three teams (Arkansas, LSU) to register at least 19 Ks in a game twice this season.

TCU ranks 13th nationally in K/9 at 11.3. The Frogs' 237 strikeouts on the season lead the Big 12 and are 10th nationally.

Payton Tolle ranks ninth nationally and leads the Big 12 with 15.3 K/9. His 38 total strikeouts are 31st nationally.

STINGY STAFF

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 246 times in the 666 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 260 times in those contests.

WINS UPON WINS UPON WINS

Since Saarloos arrived on campus, TCU has produced 444 wins and owns a .663 wining percentage. The 444 wins rank seventh nationally and are the most in the state of Texas.

TCU has been victorious in 94 of 141 series played and tallied 46 series sweeps.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 43 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 25-18 mark in those games. TCU is 6-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU has played two extra-inning games this season and is 2-0 in those contests.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
