

FROG HOPS

- With four regular season crowns and four tournament trophies, TCU's eight Big 12 championships are the most of any program in the league since TCU joined in 2013.
- The eight total championships are the second most in league history.
- Associate Head Coach TJ Bruce put together a 171-168 record in seven years as head coach at Nevada (2016-22).
- Bruce was on staff at UCLA when the Bruins won the 2013 National Championship.
- The newest member of the coaching staff, Dave Lawn, comes to TCU with 37 years of coaching under big helt
- Lawn has made four trips to the College World Series in his career.
- Lawn needs just 12 games to reach 1,700 games coached in his career.
- TCU student assistants Brian Howard and Evan Skoug combined for seven CWS trips in their time as Horned Frogs.
- Howard and Skoug are the latest Frogs to return to the program to complete their degrees, joining Josh Elander (2016), Kyle Winkler (2019) and Matt Purke (2020-21).
- TCU has a trio of sophomores that hail from the same high school in California. Karson Bowen, Gabe Miranda and Louis Rodriguez all played at Orange Lutheran.
- Additionally, TCU has a pair of athletes from Hamilton H.S. in Chandler, Ariz. (Klecker, Wadas) and two from American Fork H.S. in Utah (Ingersoll, Robinson). The group has combined to win eight state champions.
- TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.

STREAKING

TCU is off to its best start in program history at 13-0. The 13 game winning streak is TCU's longest since putting together a program-best 14 game winning streak March 21-April 11, 2017.

TCU is one of four squads that remains undefeated three weeks into the season, joining Texas A6M, UC Irvine and Florida State. TCU is one of four school with 13 wins (Nicholls, Tennessee and Texas A6M).

PAC-12 CHAMPS?

TCU just completed a stretch of eight straight games against members of the Pac 12. TCU swept UCLA, won twice against USC and defeated Arizona, Arizona State and Washington State in that stretch.

The Frogs hit .331 and averaged 8.25 runs per game. Kurtis Byrne (.452), Ryder Robinson (.450), Sam Myers (.444) and Logan Maxwell (.423) combined to score 30 runs and drive in 29.

On the mound, the staff turned in a $4.32\,\mathrm{ERA}$ and recorded $102\,$ strikeouts to just $32\,$ walks. Braeden Sloan and Zachary Cawyer registered two wins each.

COMEBACK FROGS

TCU has six come-from-beind wins this season. In four of those six wins, the Horned Frogs have trailed by multiple runs. In four of the wins, TCU has trailed in the eighth or ninth inning.

The eighth inning has been key to the Frogs' comeback success. TCU has outscored its opponent 18-4 and is hitting .404 (19-for-47) in the frame. Kurtis Byrne has been the most productive Frog, hitting .800 with five PBI.

WELCOME TO FORT WORTH

Peyton Chatagnier enjoyed his new stop in the Purple and White. Serving as the lead-off hitter, the Ole Miss transfer is hitting .319 through the first 11 games with a .469 on-base percentage.

In the Saturday game against FGCU and the Sunday tilt against UCLA, he led off the game with a home run. In the FGCU game, he hit another home run for his fourth career multi-home run game.

FRESH CONTRIBUTIONS

TCU has a trio of freshmen producing at an elite level through the first three weeks of the season. Collectively, Sam Myers, Chase Brunson and Ryder Robinson are hitting .376 (41-for-109) with nine doubles, three home runs and 24 RBIs.

Combined, the trio have been responsible for 52 of TCU's 111 runs scored.

A DREAM COME TRUE

Zachary Cawyer played his high school baseball just under eight miles away from Lupton Stadium at Nolan Catholic. After a two year stint at McLennan College, Cawyer is off to a great start at TCU.

The junior leads the team with seven appearances in relief and has a nation-best four wins. In five of the seven appearances he has taken over with at least two runners on. He has allowed just five of 11 to score.

NEW FACES GALORE

In Sunday's win over USC, four Horned Frogs made their TCU debut. A trio of freshmen, Mason Bixby, Micah Kendrick and Zach Wadas made their collegiate debuts. Colt Taylor saw his first action on the mound as a grad transfer. Jax Traeger made his season debut Tuesday.

On the season, six freshmen and nine transfers have seen playing time. Additionally, after red-shirting in 2023, Gabe Miranda has made his collegiate debut.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs led the Big 12 and ranked sixth nationally with a school-record 141 stolen bases in 2023. The 141 stolen bases broke the previous record of 134 set in 1996. Four Horned Frogs reached the 20-steal plateau.

The Frogs are one of just seven teams to have stolen at least 1,000 bases over the last 11-plus years. The 1,019 stolen bases rank seventh in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 80% of their attempts over the last nine years (1019-of-1279). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 11 seasons, TCU is 186-of-225 (83%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 246 times in the 659 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 255 times in those contests.

WINS UPON WINS UPON WINS

Since Saarloos arrived on campus, TCU has produced 441 wins and owns a .670 wining percentage. The 441 wins rank seventh nationally and are the most in the state of Texas.

TCU has been victorious in 94 of 139 series played and tallied 46 series sweeps.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Frogs have enjoyed the home cooking of Lupton Stadium since it opened in 2003. TCU has an all-time record of 479-162 (.747) at Lupton Stadium.

The last nine seasons have seen Lupton Stadium become one of the toughest places to play. TCU has won 52 of the last 66 series played at Lupton Stadium over that time frame.

Since the start of 2014, TCU has posted a 218-71 (.753) record.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 43 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 25-18 mark in those games. TCU is 6-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU has played two extra-inning games this season and is 2-0 in those contests.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
