### NOTES

- TCU hosts Kansas State at Schollmaier Arena on Saturday at 3 p.m. on CBSSN.
- Jamie Dixon is five wins away from 500 as a head coach. His 167 wins at TCU rank second all-time.
- Under Dixon in Schollmaier Arena, TCU is 109-38 overall and 39-32 in Big 12 games.
- TCU is 7-0 at home this season with an average scoring margin of +19.6.
- Sophomore guard RJ Jones played in 28 games for KSU last season. He is redshirting for TCU this year.
- Ernest Udeh Jr., who is averaging 9.2 points, 8.6 rebounds and 1.5 blocks, is TCU's only returning scholarship player.
- Udeh's rebounding average of 8.6 ranks fourth in the Big 12. He had a season-high 14 at Arizona on Monday.
- Udeh is one of four players in the Big 12 averaging at least 9.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.
- Udeh has won the opening tip in nine of 10 games played this season and 34 of 39 career games.
- TCU's newcomers includes six transfers and four freshmen. Two additional players are redshirt freshmen.
- Senior guard Frankie Collins was ruled out for the season on Dec. 13, with a broken left foot.
- Leading TCU in scoring is Vasean Allette at 10.7 points per game and had 18 at Arizona on Monday.
- Trazarien White arrived at TCU with over 1,000 career points. Noah Reynolds is one point from 1,000 for his career.
- Reynolds leads TCU with 3.9 assists and has an assist to turnover ratio of 2.53, which ranks seventh in the Big 12.
- Brendan Wenzel is TCU's top 3-point threat at 45.7 percent. He missed the last three games with a high ankle sprain.
- Freshman David Punch is one of six freshmen in the Big 12 averaging at least 560 (6.1) points and 4.5 (4.8) rebounds.
- Freshman Micah Robinson along with White, has made a 3-pointer in each of the last six games.
- TCU is 40-of-47 (85.1%) from the free throw line over the last two games.
- TCU, which led the nation in fastbreak scoring the past two seasons, ranks third in the Big 12 and 30th nationally in with 15.5 per game.
- TCU ranks second in the Big 12 and 20th nationally in 3-point defense, allowing 28.3 percent from three.
- Opponents are shooting 26.0 percent from three in Schollmaier Arena this season.
- TCU ranks seventh in the Big 12 in turnovers forced per game at 14.1.
- TCU ranks sixth in the Big 12 and 57th nationally in turnover margin at 2.9.
- TCU ranks 28th in defensive efficiency at 96.6 according to KenPom. TCU finished 44th last season.
- Last season, TCU finished the season in the NCAA Tournament for a program-best, third-straight season.
- Dixon is one of just nine active head coaches who have made at least 15 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.
- Only 21 active DI coaches have more wins than Dixon's 495.
- TCU has 17 seasons of 20 or more wins in its history and six have come in the last eight seasons.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Kansas State leads the all-time series 21-13, but TCU has won the past two meetings.
- TCU has won three of the past five meetings and eight of the last 12.
- Last year's only meeting was a 75-72 win by TCU in Manhattan on a step-back 3-pointer by Jameer Nelson Jr. with 1.1 seconds remaining.

### LAST TIME OUT

- TCU dropped its Big 12 opener at Arizona on Monday, 90-81.
- Noah Reynolds led TCU with a season-high 23 points on 9-of-16 shooting, including 3-of-6 from three.
- The Frogs had just eight turnovers, their second fewest of the season.
- TCU shot 14-of-18 (77.8 percent) from the free throw line, its best effort away from Schollmaier Arena this season.

### UP NEXT

- TCU will play at No. 14 Houston for the first time since 2011 on Monday at 8 p.m. on ESPN2.

### ABOUT THE OPPONENT

- Kansas State is 7-5 on the season and 1-0 in Big 12 Conference play following its 70-67 win over No. 16 Cincinnati on Monday.
- Fifth-year senior David N'Guessan leads the Wildcats with 13.6 points per game. His 66.7 percent shooting from the field is second in the Big 12 and ninth nationally.
- Coleman Hawkins, who is coming off 20 points and 10 rebounds against the Bearcats, leads the team in rebounding with 10.1 per game.

### DIXON KEEPS CLIMBING

Jamie Dixon stands in second place for most wins by a TCU head coach.

- Dixon is five wins away from 500 for his career. Only 21 active DI head coaches have 500 career wins. Of that number, only six have won 500 games as the head coach of a major conference team. That group is Rick Barnes, Leonard Hamilton, Tom Izzo, Rick Pitino, Kelvin Sampson and Bill Self.
- Dixon is one of just nine active head coaches who have made at least 15 appearances in the NCAA Tournament. The other eight coaches are Dana Altman, John Calipari, Mark Few, Tom Izzo, Matt Painter, Rick Pitino, Kelvin Sampson and Bill Self.
- TCU's win percentage during Dixon's first eight seasons was .593, the best by a TCU coach in 20 years.
- TCU has made four NCAA Tournament appearance in the last six seasons that a postseason was held. TCU had been to one NCAA Tournament in the 30 years prior to Dixon's first appearance in 2018.

### FROG BREAK

TCU ranks third in the Big 12 and 30th nationally in fastbreak scoring with 15.5 per game.

- TCU led the nation in each of the past two seasons in fastbreak scoring. The Horned Frogs averaged 17.8 fastbreak points per game last season and 17.5 per game in the 2022-23 season.
- The most fastbreak points by a TCU team under Jamie Dixon is 43 against Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 17.

### OUTREBOUNDING LEADS TO WINS

- Always a focus for a Jamie Dixon coached team is rebounding. Here is a breakdown of win/loss records when TCU and/or Jamie Dixon-led teams outrebound their opponent.
- TCU has been outrebounded in six games this year and have lost five of them.

### COLLINS OUT FOR THE SEASON

It was announced on Dec. 13 that starting guard Frankie Collins will miss the remainder of the season with a broken left foot. The injury occurred during the first half of TCU's game against Vanderbilt on Dec. 8 at Dickies Arena. He was the Horned Frogs' top scorer at 11.2 points per game and leader in assists (4.4) and steals (1.9).

### TURNOVERS FORCED

TCU ranks seventh in the Big 12 and 84th nationally with 14.8 turnovers forced per game.

- TCU forced Michigan into 21 turnovers on Nov. 15 in Ann Arbor. It was the most the Frogs have forced on the road in regulation since Bradley turned it over 21 times on Dec. 23, 2015.
- Against a power conference opponent on the road in regulation, 21 turnovers hadn't been forced by a TCU team since Jan. 9, 2013 when Oklahoma State turned it over 24 times.

### REUNITED

Newcomers Noah Reynolds and Brendan Wenzel are teammates for the second time. The two were at Wyoming for the 2021-22 season where the Cowboys went 25-9 overall and fell in the First Four to Indiana. They were also on the 2022-23 Wyoming team.

### FALL SIGNING CLASS

TCU signed Xavier Edmonds and Kayden Edwards for the 2025-26 season.

- Edmonds is a 6-8 forward and three-star recruit out of Bishop Montgomery in Torrance, Calif. He played at Salt Lake Community College last season where he averaged 14.0 points and 7.4 rebounds per game.
- Edwards is a four-star recruit out of Duncanville High School in Texas. The 6-2 guard, nicknamed "Bugg," is the 61st ranked player in the Class of 2025, the sixth-ranked player from Texas and the third-best recruit in program history according to 247Sports. He is No. 59 in ESPN's top 100. Last season, Edwards averaged 23.9 points on 37.6 percent shooting from 3-point range while adding 3.4 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game.

### FRESHMAN CLASS

TCU's roster is made up of three of the top recruits the Frogs have ever had.

- This season's freshman class ranks 17th nationally by ESPN and is highlighted by Micah Robinson at No. 64 and David Punch at No. 96.

- November signee Kayden Edwards is ranked No. 3 on that list. He'll be a freshman next season.

### KEY NOTES FROM GAME 1

TCU put up impressive numbers in its season-opening 105-59 win over Florida A&M

- The 46-point margin of victory was TCU's largest since a 46-point win over Central Arkansas on Dec. 28, 2022 (103-57).
- TCU led by as many as 48 points. It tied for the largest lead in a game under Dixon. TCU also had a 48-point lead in its Dec. 18, 2022 game with Mississippi Valley State.
- TCU's 105 points tied for the third-most scored under Jamie Dixon.
- TCU led 59-22 at halftime. The 37-point margin was the largest halftime lead in program history. The Frogs have scored more in a 20-minute period. In 1997, TCU outscored UT Pan American by 39 points (80-41) in the second half in a 153-87 win.
- The Frogs' 29 assists tied for the second-most under Dixon and the most since 29 assists were recorded against Central Michigan on Nov. 30, 2018.
- TCU's five turnovers were the fewest it's had since March 17, 2023 when it had five against Arizona State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- TCU was 14-of-30 from 3-point range including 11-of-16 in the first half. The 14 made 3-pointers were the Frogs most since Feb. 15, 2020 when they made 15 against Kansas State. It was also tied for the fifth most by TCU under Dixon.
- It was TCU's 300-straight game with a made three.

### EXHIBITION WIN OVER NO. 16 ARKANSAS

A game-winning 3-pointer by Brendan Wenzel led the Frogs to a 66-65 win over No. 16 Arkansas in a charity exhibition on Nov. 1 at Dickies Arena. Ernest Udeh Jr. led TCU with 13 points, on 6-of-7 shooting, and eight rebounds.

### WHAT WAS LOST

The Horned Frogs lost nine scholarship players from last year's team, including their top seven scorers.

- TCU returned just 4.7% of its scoring from last season, the fewest in the Big 12 and 10th fewest in the nation.
- TCU's 14.2% of returning rebounding ranks as the second fewest in the Big 12 and 21st fewest in the nation.
- TCU returns 7.5% of its minutes played from last season, which are the fewest in the Big 12 and 12th in the country.
- Top departures from last year's team included all-conference players Emanuel Miller and Jameer Nelson Jr.
- All six players who ran out of eligibility last season signed

- The freshman class ranks 17th by ESPN and highlighted by Micah Robinson (64) and David Punch (96).

### TCU 75 - KANSAS STATE 72 // FEB. 17, 2024

MANHATTAN, Kan. - Jameer Nelson Jr. made a step-back 3-pointer with 1.1 seconds remaining to break a tie and give TCU a 75-72 win at Kansas State Saturday afternoon in Bramlage Coliseum.

Nelson's 3-pointer came after the Horned Frogs (18-7, 7-5) held their largest lead of the game, 61-51, with 7:14 to play. The 10-point margin came at the heels of a 20-2 scoring run when Micah Peavy had all three of his blocked shots and scored eight of his career-high 26 points.

TCU led 70-65 with 41 seconds to play after a free throw by Peavy. The Wildcats (15-10, 5-7) ultimately tied the game without making another field goal. KSU went 7-for-7 in the final 41 seconds, including three makes by Arthur Kaluma, who was fouled on a 3-point attempt.

With TCU leading 74-70 and 26 seconds to play, KSU's Tylor Perry, who was 12-of-12 from the line, made both attempts. With a two-point game and 15.6 remaining, Peavy threw the ball away on the ensuing inbounds play.

Nelson was whistled for a foul on the KSU inbounds play, sending Cam Carter to the line to make two free throws and tie the game, 72-72, with 15.6 seconds to play. Nelson's game-winner came with a heavily guarded effort by Carter.

After shooting 29.6 percent in the first half, TCU shot 55.2 percent in the second half, including a 5-of-8 effort from three.

It was TCU's sixth win of the season when trailing by 10 or more points. The Horned Frogs trailed by 10 with 12:05 to play in the first half and trailed by four, 28-24, at halftime.

With the win, TCU head coach Jamie Dixon passed Billy Tubbs for second on the school's all-time wins list with 157.

The Horned Frogs will return to action on Tuesday when they play at Texas Tech at 8 p.m. on either ESPN or ESPN2.

## ABOUT THE UNIFORMS

TCU men's basketball debuted its uniforms in the 2022-23 season.

- The design on the side of the uniforms are "SPINES" which represent the anatomical spines on the Horned Frog.
- From an frontal and rear view, the "SPINES" are represented to imitate the spines on the top and bottom of the Frog. The view can be seen when a player is at the free-throw line and seeing just hints of the tips of the spines.
- The red line in the middle has multiple meanings - the bloodline that shoots from the eyes of the Horned Frog when threatened. It also a represents the 'Blood is Thicker Than Water' mentality that a close family has in their bloodline
- The Design originates from the myth/origin of the horned lizard itself. The "ZIG ZAG" motif is often found in Texas Native America culture as a representation of lightning striking the earth and the red representing the horned lizard fighting back to a much bigger foe.
- The origin of the horned lizard is a fight between the lizard and lightning. Lightning states it can defeat anything on earth and challenged the lizard to four strikes (hence the four combined ZIG ZAGS on the sides of the uniform). Lightning missed the quick lizard and the Horned Frog "SPINED" the lightning from above. As payment, lightning now sends SPINES of light throughout the sky as homage to the tiny, yet mighty, Horned Frog.

#1. Desmond Bane (6'6"-G-1998, played in 2016-20, plays pro in the NBA) led Memphis Grizzlies to a victory over the Atlanta Hawks (16-15) 128-112 in the NBA last Saturday. He was MVP of the game. Bane scored 23 points, grabbed 5 boards, dished 8 assists and stole 4 balls in 27 minutes. The Memphis Grizzlies have a solid 21-10 record this season. It's Bane's fourth year with the team. He has individually a very good year with high stats. Bane averages 15.3ppg, 5.9rpg, 4.7apg and 1.1spg in 23 games he played so far.

#2. Kouat Noi (6'7"-F-1997, played in 2016-16, plays in Australia) could not help Sydney Kings (11-8) in their last game on Wednesday. Despite his very good performance Sydney Kings were edged 111-108 on the road by the leading Hawks. Noi was the second best scorer with 24 points. He also added 9 rebounds (was perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line). It's Noi's first season with the team. Noi has relatively good stats this year 12.1ppg and 2.4rpg. He has also Australian nationality.

#3. Kyan Anderson (5'11"-PG-1992, played in 2011-15, currently in Hungary) was the main contributor in DEAC's victory against the tenth-ranked OSE Lions (4-9) crushing them 89-67 in the Hungarian A Division in Sunday night's game. Anderson was MVP of the game. He recorded 31 points (!!!) and added 6 assists in 32 minutes. Debreceeni Egyetem (19-7) is placed second in the A Division. Anderson has very impressive stats this year 15.3ppg, 2.3rpg, 4.5apg and 1.9spg in 12 games.

#4. Vladimir Brodziansky (6'11"-C/F-1994, played in 2015-18, plays pro in Spain) was not able to help Universidad Catolica de Murcia CB (0-3) in their last game on Saturday. Despite Brodziansky's good performance Universidad Catolica de Murcia CB was defeated 82-74 on the opponent's court by the lower-ranked Tenerife (#9). He scored 10 points and grabbed 6 rebounds. It's Brodziansky's first season with the team. This year Brodziansky averages 8.3ppg and 3.1rpg.

#5. Damion Baugh (6'4"-G-2000, played in 2024-24, plays in the NBA G League) was the major contributor in a Westchester Knicks' victory against the Valley Suns (8-6) 127-119 in the NBA G League on Thursday night. He had a double-double by scoring 22 points and getting 11 rebounds. Baugh also added 7 assists in 35 minutes; quite an impressive performance considering it's only his first season in pro basketball. The Westchester Knicks have a very good 13-4 record this season. It was his team's ninth consecutive victory in a row. But this is still an early stage of the season and everything may happen. It's Baugh's first year with the team. Baugh has relatively good stats this season 13.1ppg, 5.2rpg, 6.5apg and 1.1spg in 17 games.

#6. Kenrich Williams (6'6"-G/F-1994, played in 2014-18, plays pro in the NBA) contributed to an easy victory against the Washington Wizards 123-105 in the NBA last Monday. He recorded 7 points and grabbed 8 rebounds in just 14 minutes. This year Williams averages 5.9ppg and 3.2rpg in 20 games.

#7. Chuck O'Bannon Jr. (6'6"-F-1999, played in 2020-24, plays in Slovakia) was not able to secure a victory for Blue Wings (11-7) in their last game on Saturday. Despite his very good performance Blue Wings was defeated 90-80 at home by the lower-ranked Prievidza (#6). O'Bannon Jr. was the top scorer with 20 points. He also added 4 rebounds and made 2 blocks. This season O'Bannon Jr. has very high stats. He averages 18.5ppg, 4.2rpg, 1.2apg and 1.4spg.

#8. Jameer Nelson Jr. (6'1"-PG-2000, played in 2023-24, currently in the NBA G League) contributed to an easy victory against the Cleveland Charge crushing them 126-106 in the NBA G League in Sunday night's game. He scored 16 points and grabbed 4 rebounds in a mere 18 minutes. This year Nelson Jr. averages 8.1ppg, 2.3rpg, 1.5apg and 1.3spg in 12 games.

#9. Xavier Cork (6'9"-F-2001, played in 2021-24, plays pro in Holland) couldn't help Den Bosch (6-9) in their last game on Sunday. Despite his good performance Den Bosch was defeated 89-78 on their home court in Den Bosch by the leading Oostende. Cork was the second best scorer with 11 points. This season he averages 6.0ppg and 3.7rpg.

#10. Experienced Garlon Green (6'7"-F-1991, played in 2009-13, plays in France) contributed to an easy victory against the 12th-ranked C'Chartres 85-69 in the French ProB (second division) on Friday night. He scored 9 points in 28 minutes. Green has relatively good stats this year 12.6ppg, 4.6rpg and 2.0apg in 17 games.
