GRIZZLIES LOOK TO KEEP THINGS ROLLING

MONTANA VS. EASTERN WASHINGTON / THURSDAY, OCT. 11 / 7 P.M. / MISSOULA, MONT.

MONTANA VS. IDAHO / SATURDAY, OCT. 13 / 2 P.M. / MISSOULA, MONT.

Montana returns home after a weekend split at Southern Utah and Northern Arizona. The Grizzlies were once again resilient, coming from behind in a five-set victory over the Thunderbirds that saw Mykaela Hammer record 21 kills and Sarina Moreno tally 32 digs. Two nights later at Northern Arizona, Montana played well for two sets against the preseason No. 2 team before falling in three sets.

In years past, Montana would have celebrated a 1-1 road split. There was still plenty to be excited about, but the Grizzlies, having tasted success after a 3-0 start to Big Sky Conference play, now want more.

"It's fun to be where we are and to say, 'Here are our new problems. Let's go tackle these, because we're done with those old problems,'" second-year head coach Allison Lawrence said. "We continue to – and we have to if we want to reach our goals – push our boundaries."

The Grizzlies will have the opportunity to continue to do that this week at home, where they are riding a four-match home winning streak.

First up is Eastern Washington, a team that is winless in Big Sky play thus far but held the league's best record during non-conference play, beating two teams – Akron and UC Riverside – that Montana lost to.

"Eastern is winless in conference, but they're very dangerous," Lawrence said. "They did really well in preseason and beat some teams that some other Big Sky teams couldn't beat. It's going to be a battle, and I'm excited for it."

Montana has played and beaten Eastern Washington more than any other opponent aside from Montana State, but one of the most memorable wins was the most recent.

In the 2017 season finale, Montana beat Eastern Washington in three tight sets, playing what Lawrence said at the time was the team's best volleyball of the season. Without any seniors on roster, in many ways, that victory helped propel the team into the 2018 season, where Montana is off to its best conference start in nearly a decade.

ABOUT MONTANA

- Montana has already surpassed last year's conference win total, jumping out to its first 4-2 start since 2010. Three of the victories came against teams ranked ahead of UM in the preseason poll.
- Montana has won four consecutive home matches dating back to Sept. 1.
- The Grizzlies have played in seven five-set matches, going 5-2 and winning four in a row.
- Senior OH Mykaela Hammer was named the Big Sky Conference Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 24. During conference play, she ranks fifth in the league with 3.71 kills per set.
- MB Olivia Bradley ranks 10th in the Big Sky with a .272 hitting percentage, best among all freshmen.
- Junior setter Ashley Watkins has nearly 2,100 career assists. She currently ranks ninth in UM history.
- Montana has used three liberos, but freshman Sarina Moreno has started each of the past 14 matches, averaging 4.23 digs per set.
- Three of Montana's losses have come to top-30 teams nationally.
- UM made great strides during its first season under Allison Lawrence, seeing a three-win improvement from the 2016 campaign.
- UM improved in every statistical category from 2016 to 2017, including a 40-percent increase in blocking (132-spot improvement nationally).
- The Grizzlies return every player who earned a start in 2017, in addition to 99.9% of their kills, 99.5% of their blocks, 95.7% of their assists, 83.6% of their service aces and 81.6% of their digs.

ABOUT EASTERN WASHINGTON

- Eastern Washington led all Big Sky schools with an 8-4 record during non-conference play, earning wins over Akron and UC Riverside, but is 0-6 to begin Big Sky play. EWU's loss last week to Portland State (3-2) was the only conference match in which the Eagles have won a set.
- Sophomore L Catelyn Linke ranks seventh in the Big Sky with 21 service aces, while teammate MaKenna Davis (sophomore OH) ranks 10th with 18.
- The Eagles have had seven different players lead them in kills in a match this season, including senior OH Alexandra Espinosa (six times) and freshman MB Kennedy Kaminsky (five).
- During conference play, EWU ranks last in every statistical category aside from blocks (10th out of 11).
- Overall, EWU ranks much higher statistically, including third for digs (16.20 per set).
- Leslie Flores-Cloud is in her first season leading the Eagles. She wasn't hired until June 15.

SERIES VS. THE EAGLES

Montana is 54-40 all-time against EWU (27-13 at home). The Grizzlies have played and beaten the Eagles more than any other opponent aside from Montana State. The two teams have played at least once every season since 1975. Montana is looking for back-to-back wins over EWU for the first time since winning three in a row in 2014-15. The Grizzlies ended their 2017 season with a 3-0 home sweep over EWU. In that match, Maddy Marshall had 11 kills on .320 hitting, in addition to 11 digs.

ABOUT IDAHO

- Idaho enters its Thursday match vs. Montana State with a 10-8 record overall, including a 4-2 mark in conference play. With six seniors, the Vandals were picked to win the Big Sky Conference.
- Idaho returned four starters and its libero from last year's team that won 18 matches and advanced to the semifinals of the Big Sky tournament. Among the returners are OH Sarah Sharp (2017 first-team All-Big Sky), MB Devonnie Ryter (2017 first-team All-Big Sky), OH Kaela Straw (2017 second-team All-Big Sky) and OH/L Alicia Wodke (2017 Big Sky Newcomer of the Year).
- Straw leads Idaho with 3.46 kills per set (fifth in BSC), and last weekend racked up her 1,000th career kill.
- Ryter's .357 hitting percentage is the fourth-best in the Big Sky.
- Wodke ranks fourth in the Big Sky with 4.94 digs per set.
- Senior S Haylee Mathis ranks fifth in the Big Sky with 9.90 assists per set.
- The Vandals have two of the league's top blockers, with Ryter and freshman Nikki Ball each averaging 1.17 per set (fourth in BSC).

SERIES VS. THE VANDALS

The series vs. Idaho dates back to Montana's first-ever match, in 1975. The Grizzlies are 27-35 vs. the Vandals, including 13-14 at home. UM took Idaho to five sets at home in 2017, losing a heartbreaker that included a Set-4 score of 30-28 and Set-5 score of 19-17. In that match, four Grizzlies had double-doubles, including 20 kills and 17 digs from Mykaela Hammer, 16 kills and 15 digs from Missy Huddleston, 13 kills and 14 digs from Maddy Marshall and a career-high 66 assists and 13 digs from Ashley Watkins. Across two matches in 2016, Alexis Urbach averaged 15.0 kills on .398 hitting vs. the Vandals. Montana is looking for just its second win vs. Idaho since 2000.

Following its match vs. Eastern Washington on Thursday, the Grizzlies will host Idaho on Saturday afternoon. The Vandals, with six seniors and four all-conference players returning, were picked by the league's head coaches to win the Big Sky in the preseason poll.

Idaho (8-10 overall, 4-2 Big Sky entering Thursday's match at Montana State) has one of the top players at each position, including Kaela Straw (3.46 kills per set; fifth in Big Sky), Devonnie Ryter (.357 hitting percentage; fourth), Alicia Wodke (4.94 digs per set; fourth), Haylee Mathis (9.90 assists per set; fifth), and Ryter and Nikki Ball (1.17 blocks per set; fourth).

"They're big, and we're physical," Lawrence said. "If we execute the way we've seen us do at times, we can slow them down."

The Vandals won 18 matches a year ago and advanced to the semifinals of the Big Sky tournament, and while they were clearly the better team overall, Montana felt as if it let one slip away against Idaho a year ago. Last November, playing in Missoula, Montana took a 2-1 lead on the Vandals.

Montana led Set 4 by as much as 19-13 and held a match-point opportunity at 26-25, before falling 30-28. In the deciding set, the Grizzlies led 13-11 but couldn't hold on, dropping a 19-17 decision.

"I think our last meeting with them showed us what we were capable of," Lawrence said. "It was one of the best matches we've played in the last couple of years. It was right at the end of the year, so it didn't help us last season, but I think mentally it was a turning point."

Montana won just three conference matches a year ago, but that showing on the final weekend of November – a five-set heartbreaker to Idaho and a three-set win over Eastern Washington – gave the Grizzlies a confidence moving forward that they could be a team that could play with anybody in the league. Something that's now showing up on the court.

"I think we're more healthy and productive, both in practice and in matches," Lawrence said. "We're tasting some success, and now we have to keep pushing our standards and keep pushing our level of play."

Saturday is youth day, with all children 12 and under getting in for free. Additionally, all girls and boys who participated in a Montana volleyball camp over the summer can receive free admittance by wearing their camp shirt to the match. Following the match, the team is holding a free youth clinic on the court. The clinic is free but is capped at 40 people, and advanced registration is required.

TALKING HISTORY

Montana has won five of its past seven matches entering the week, and along the way has accomplished several rare feats.

- The Grizzlies opened Big Sky Conference play with three consecutive victories. It marked the fifth time in the 31-year history in the league that UM started Big Sky play 3-0, including the first time since 2006 and second since 1995.
- Currently at 4-2, it is the 10th time a UM team has won four of its first six Big Sky matches, and the first time since 2010. Of the nine previous occasions, seven happened between 1988-1994.
- The Grizzlies are currently on a four-match home winning streak, their longest since 2011.
- From Sept. 15-25, Montana won four consecutive matches overall, its longest winning streak since 2013.

IN THE RANKINGS

Several individuals rank among the Big Sky leaders for several statistical categories:

- Mykaela Hammer's 3.71 kills-per-set average in Big Sky play ranks fifth.
- Ashley Watkins ranks fifth in Big Sky play with 10.57 assists per set.
- Sarina Moreno ranks sixth in Big Sky play with 5.00 digs per set.
- Olivia Bradley's .272 hitting percentage is the highest among freshmen in the Big Sky Conference (10th overall). Her .524 hitting percentage vs. Montana State (14 kills) is the best by a UM player this season.
- Missy Huddleston's 24 kills vs. Gonzaga are the fourth-most by a Big Sky athlete this season.
- Ashley Watkins' 46 assists vs. Portland State are the most in a three-set match this season.

CLUTCH DOWN THE STRETCH

Of Montana's 18 matches, seven have gone to five sets, including three already during Big Sky play. Montana is 5-2 in five-setters and a perfect 3-0 during league action.

"Our fifth-set stats are off the charts," head coach Allison Lawrence said. "There's no more pressure than a fifth set, and we have the ability to step up our game during pressure situations."

In the fifth set, Montana has more kills, digs, and service aces than its opponents, and is hitting .051 higher (.217 compared to .166) than its season average. Despite the fifth set being a shortened frame (going to 15 points instead of 25), senior Mykaela Hammer is averaging 3.14 kills per set on .386 hitting during deciding frames.

HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE

Sept. 25 was a special night for the Montana volleyball team. Not only did the Grizzlies defeat rival Montana State in come-from-behind fashion to even the all-time series ledger at 56-56, but with the victory, Montana improved to 3-0 in Big Sky play for the first time since 2006.

What's more, though, the match was played in front of 1,314 fans, the largest crowd since 2009 and the 10th-largest on record.

"That was probably one of the most special moments for me in eight years here," head coach Allison Lawrence said. "To see the crowd that showed up for that match, along with the band, it was such a unique energy, and really gave us excitement and motivation. It was a special night for our program, and I'm really proud of our performance."

SETTING UP THE GRIZ

Setter Ashley Watkins moved into ninth place in Montana history last week, now holding nearly 2,100 career assists. Making the feat even more impressive, Watkins is just a junior, and she spent her freshman season hitting during half of the team's rotations. At her current pace, Watkins could finish her career near the top five in school history.

SEARCHING FOR THE RIGHT LINEUP

In 18 matches, Montana has used 14 different starting-lineup combinations, not repeating the same one until the eighth match of the season. Overall, just two combinations have been repeated, and none more than four times. Setter Ashley Watkins and outside hitter Mykaela Hammer have started all 18 matches.

“We have a lot of players who, statistically, are very close to each other,” head coach Allison Lawrence said. “Competition is what is going to make our team at its best the most often. Playing time might be tough to come by at times, but when someone goes in and makes a difference, they’ll earn a start the next time.”

HAMMER NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior outside hitter was named the Big Sky Conference Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 24. Hammer averaged a double-double with 19.5 kills and 10.0 digs over two matches, doing so on at an impressive .443 efficiency. Her 4.88 kills-per-set average was nearly double the next-closest Grizzly.



In a come-from-behind victory over Sacramento State, Hammer recorded a career-high 23 kills on .409 hitting, eclipsing her previous high for kills on the final swing of the match. The Grizzlies found themselves trailing two sets to none, but closed the third set on a 10-5 run to extend the match. Hammer had three kills during that stretch. Trailing 15-11 in the fourth set, Montana used a 9-4 run to take the lead. During that period, Hammer had four kills. The Grizzlies then scored three of the final four points to earn a 25-23 advantage, with a pair of kills coming from Hammer. In the deciding fifth frame, the Grizzlies jumped out to a 5-0 lead and never trailed. Hammer had two kills during the 5-0 run, plus the final point of the match.

Two nights later vs. Portland State, Hammer again led the Grizzlies, this time with 16 kills on .500 hitting. The outside hitter also recorded three service aces.

Montana jumped out to an 11-5 lead in the first set, with Hammer recording four kills and serving five points during the run. Leading by just one, 13-12, in the second set, Hammer had three consecutive points – a kill and back-to-back service aces – to force a Vikings timeout. She had seven kills, an ace and a block in Montana’s Set-3 victory to seal the match.

CELEBRATING ITS PAST

For the first time in more than a decade, Montana hosted an alumni weekend (Sept. 21-22), welcoming back 13 former players – including All-Americans, school record-holders, conference champions and some of the top students and athletes in school history.

“That was one of the highlights of my whole coaching career, not just as a head coach,” Allison Lawrence said at the time. “The moment that the alumni saw each other, to see them and feel their energy and hear their stories was really special for me and for our team.”

The night before the match, the past and present Grizzlies ate dinner together, reminiscing and sharing stories, in addition to passing along advice to the younger group.

“The biggest thing was to see their relationships now,” Lawrence continued. “I don’t think they talk very frequently; they have their own busy lives. But the way those bonds come back when they’re in this environment I think made our team realize what the bigger picture is and what this is all about, which is who you are for your teammates.”

NON-CONFERENCE COMPETITION

Of the 12 teams Montana played in the preseason, four have either been nationally ranked or have received votes in the AVCA top-25 coaches’ poll this season. The Grizzlies challenged themselves by playing two teams from the Pac-12 and another from the Big 12, but all around, their opponents had success throughout the first month of the season. The combined non-conference winning percentage of Montana’s 12 preseason opponents was .570 (81-61), with nine teams posting a .500 record or better.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM PRESEASON

- Montana earned victories over Gonzaga (3-2), UTEP (3-0) and South Dakota (3-2).
- Senior outside hitter Mykaela Hammer was named to the Montana Invitational and Borderland Invitational all-tournament teams. At the Roadrunner Classic, outside hitter Alexis Urbach and setter Ashley Watkins earned all-tournament honors.
- Montana out-blocked its opponents six times during the preseason, averaging 2.1 blocks per set. Sophomore middle blocker Baily Permann has led the Grizzlies for blocking six times.
- During a seven-match stretch from Aug. 31 through Sept. 14, Montana was out-dug just one time (in a victory at UTEP). The stretch featured three matches vs. top-30 opponents.
- Montana hit a season-best .229 in a five-set loss to New Mexico State. It marked the first time in more than a year that the Aggies, who now own a 16-match home win streak, had been pushed to five sets at home.
- The Grizzlies out-hit their opponents twice during the Borderland Invitational, holding UTEP to .150 efficiency.
- The Grizzlies recorded more service aces than their opponents in each of the final two matches of non-conference play (CSU Bakersfield and South Dakota).
- Hammer recorded 20 kills vs. New Mexico State. She has led the Grizzlies for kills a team-high five times this season.
- Junior outside hitter Missy Huddleston has recorded double-figure kill totals six times, including 24 on .333 hitting in a five-set win over Gonzaga. Trailing 14-13 in the fifth set, she had a kill and service ace to set up match point for Montana. She also has three double-doubles and has led UM in hitting percentage a team-high four times.
- Urbach had 21 kills on .390 hitting vs. CSU Bakersfield and 16 kills at a .483 clip in the season opener against UC Riverside. She has led Montana for kills four times this season.
- Watkins has four double-doubles and a team-high 12 service aces.
- Over the past four matches, freshman middle blocker Olivia Bradley is averaging 2.07 kills and 1.07 blocks per set. She has led the Grizzlies in blocking four times this season.
- True freshman Sarina Moreno has started eight matches at libero, averaging 3.71 digs per set in those matches, including a career-high 20 vs. Gonzaga. She also has six service aces.
- During the Montana Invitational, junior middle blocker Janna Grimsrud totaled 12 blocks over two matches. On the season she is averaging 1.50 blocks over 10 sets.
- Against New Mexico State, Montana used an 8-0 run to force a deciding fifth set. The Grizzlies and Aggies were tied at 13-13 in the final frame before NMSU won the final two points.
- The Grizzlies learned how to close out tight sets late at UTEP. They led 23-22 in the first set before winning two of the final three points. The two teams were knotted at 23-23 in Set 2, before Montana won the next two points. Tied at 24-24 in the third set, the Grizzlies got back-to-back kills to seal the match.

A SIGNATURE WIN

After a 0-5 start to the year, the Grizzlies earned a signature win over Gonzaga (Sept. 1), winning the first two sets before rallying in the fifth frame to win, 17-15. In the deciding set, Montana trailed 14-13 before scoring four of the next five points.

“I think I jumped as high as I have since college,” head coach Allison Lawrence said after the match. “I was very emotional. We had players crying, we had coaches hugging. We’re a program that has been starved for wins, and I want us to be so hungry that when that last ball falls, it’s the feeling of coming up for air and all of your emotions come pouring out.”

The result was even more important considering Gonzaga is one of Montana’s regional recruiting rivals.

HANGING WITH THE BEST

Montana knew the challenge would be steep, facing a pair of top-30 teams nationally. The Grizzlies were up for the challenge, however. Despite losing in straight sets to both Utah and Iowa State (Aug. 31), Montana showed fight, and pushed the Power-5 teams in many sets.

Against No. 22 Utah, the Grizzlies jumped out to an early lead and forced the Utes to call timeout first. Montana led by as many as three points, and as late as 17-16. In the third set, Montana was within a single point, 15-14, midway through the frame. Montana was even better against Iowa State. In the second set, the Grizzlies led by as many as seven points, 15-8, and were tied at 21-21. The two teams were knotted at 20-20 in Set 3, before Iowa State again closed the set on a run.

SARINA'S DEBUT

Freshman Sarina Moreno, who did not travel with the team to Montana's first tournament in California, made her collegiate debut during the second set vs. Utah (Aug. 31). She had six digs vs. the Utes, and has continued to find her comfortability. In her 14 starts, the libero has averaged 4.27 digs per set, in addition to 10 service aces.

COMING HOME

Montana played a home match in the month of August for the first time since 2014, hosting the four-team Montana Invitational (Aug. 31-Sept. 1). A year ago, Montana played its first 15 matches away from home, playing its own gym for the first time on Sept. 28.

RANKED FOES IN MISSOULA

For just the fourth time ever, and the first time in 15 years, a nationally ranked volleyball team played in Missoula. The Grizzlies hung tough with No. 22 Utah, leading by as many as three points in the first set, and as late as 17-16.

The Grizzlies saw a three-win improvement during Alison Lawrence's first season as head coach. Even more impressive, UM improved in every statistical category from 2016 to 2017, including a 40-percent increase in blocking (132-spot improvement nationally).

It was a similar trend in Big Sky Conference play, with Montana improving its ranking in hitting percentage, opponent hitting, assists, kills, blocks and service aces.

WELCOME TO UM

In addition to returning nearly every contributor from 2017, the Grizzlies also added five freshmen to their roster. The newcomers made an immediate impact during fall camp, with Lawrence praising each of them for what they brought to the court.

"Olivia (Bradley) is fast and she thinks on her feet," Lawrence said of the Nampa, Idaho, native. "When she doesn't know what she's supposed to be doing – which is rare – she kind of pushes through it and grinds it out."

Bradley made two starts during her opening weekend, leading the team with five blocks vs. Akron (Aug. 25). She has played in 16 of UM's 18 matches (11 starts), and is averaging 1.62 kills on a team-best .272 hitting, plus 0.73 blocks per set.

Montana's other freshmen are outside hitter Elsa Godwin (Missoula, Mont.), defensive specialist Sarina Moreno (Missoula, Mont.), defensive specialist Kelsey Nestegard (Pullman, Wash.) and setter Casey Stites (Bozeman, Mont.). Moreno has started at libero each of Montana's last 14 matches.

ALLISON LAWRENCE

Head Coach | 2nd Season/9th Overall | Oregon State, 2005

The 2018 season is Allison Lawrence's second year as head coach of the Montana volleyball program, her ninth overall. She was hired in January 2017 after serving the previous seven years as an assistant.

Lawrence joined the Grizzlies in the summer of 2010 after one season as an assistant coach at Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas.

Montana went 8-21 in Lawrence's first year as head coach, matching the most wins for the program since 2013.

In Lawrence's seven seasons as an assistant, Montana three times finished .500 or better in Big Sky Conference matches and three times made the league's postseason tournament.

At the 2013 Big Sky tournament, No. 5 Montana defeated No. 4 Northern Arizona in the quarterfinals, the Grizzlies' first postseason victory since 1996.

Since Lawrence has been on staff, Jaimie Thibeault earned first-team All-Big Sky honors in 2010, Kayla Reno in 2013 and Hannah Sackett in 2015. The Grizzlies also have had three second-team selections during that time.

Lawrence, from Alta Loma, Calif., was a four-year starter at outside hitter for Oregon State, from 2001 to 2004. She graduated from OSU in 2005 with a degree in philosophy and added a master's degree in applied women's studies from Claremont Graduate University in 2008.

Lawrence was a freshman on Oregon State's NCAA tournament team in 2001 and would go on to earn honorable-mention All-Pac-10 honors as a junior and senior. She was awarded Pac-10 academic honors in 2002, 2003 and 2004, and was an academic all-district selection as a junior.

One of the top outside hitters in Beaver history, Lawrence finished her career ranked among OSU's leaders in both kills (1,255) and digs (965).

Lawrence was a volunteer assistant coach at Oregon State in 2005 and an assistant coach at Pomona-Pitzer in 2007 and La Verne in 2008, both NCAA Division III schools in Southern California. She also gained extensive coaching experience at the club level during that time.
