MONTANA IN THE BIG SKY CHAMPIONSHIP

- Montana qualified for the Big Sky Championship for the first time since 2014.
- Overall, this is the Grizzlies' 18th appearance in the tournament, more than all current and past teams aside from Northern Arizona (21) and Eastern Washington (19).
- The Grizzlies are Montana is looking for its first win in the tournament since 2013 (quarterfinals vs. Northern Arizona).
- The No. 7 seed is 0-4 all-time vs. the No. 2 seed. Montana has played as the No. 7 seed one other time, falling to North Dakota in 2014.
- Montana advanced to the tournament finals five years in a row from 1990-94, winning it all in 1991.
- The Grizzlies and Vandals have met three times in the tournament, playing each other in the finals in three consecutive seasons (1992-94).

BACK IN THE TOURNAMENT

The Montana volleyball team made it a stated goal throughout the season that this group wanted to be the team that broke through and returned to the Big Sky tournament. It was a feat that hadn't happened since 2014, before any current player was on the court.

After winning just two conference matches in 2016, Montana increased that number to three in 2017. There was a visible improvement on the court from 2016 to 2017, the first year under head coach Allison Lawrence, but 2018 is when the growth felt real to the head coach.

"It's just so cool to see this group be rewarded and see the things we've been working on, really since January 2017, start to come together," Lawrence said. "There's a visible difference from last year to this year, and I'm just so proud of them."

Montana won its first three conference matches of 2018 and jumped out to a 5-2 start, putting the Grizzlies in strong position to reach their main goal. Then came an eight-match losing skid, and while Montana never fell out of the top eight, the race became much tighter following a Nov. 3 loss to Southern Utah.

Without momentum, Montana showed its mettle by winning two of its final three matches down the stretch – both on the road – to not only qualify for the tournament but also pass rival Montana State and finish as the No. 7 seed. The program's ticket was punched on the final night, knocking off Idaho State, a team that had won six straight matches and entered the week tied for third in the league.

"That win was a big testament to how focused and driven they were to keep going, even through adversity," Lawrence said. "We didn't have the second half of conference that we wanted to, but we kept learning, kept showing up, kept fighting and kept finding ways to be a better team for each other and with each other."

"Being in the tournament for the first time in a long time, it's kind of hard to put into words. I'm incredibly proud of the kids for pulling through and really responding to every situation we were in."

Now that they've qualified, the Grizzlies' first order of business is an Idaho team that led the league for the majority of the season and has won 13 of its past 14 matches. It's a tall order, but Montana is starting to find its form, as well, winning two of its last three and learning more about its identity.

"We feel like we are in charge of how we show up, more than we did in the middle of the season," Lawrence said. "It feels good. If we focus on the right things, we can be the team we want to be. It gives us confidence and it's empowering, and now we just have to figure out how to keep it going and take it to the next level."

Montana and Idaho face off in the quarterfinals Thursday at 4:30 p.m. from Greeley, Colo. The match will be streamed for free on Pluto TV (channel 231) and WatchBigSky.com.

(Lawrence on making the conference tournament)

"Making the conference tournament has always been a No. 1 goal, along with a lot of cultural things we wanted to change. It's been a top priority for us, just to show what road we're walking down and where it's leading. We now have an outcome that reflects the changes we're making. It's a really big deal, and a dream come true, and a big step in the right direction."

ABOUT MONTANA

- Montana won 10 matches during the regular season, its highest total since 2013, including seven conference wins. The Grizzlies won just five conference matches in 2016 and 2017 combined.
- Following an eight-match losing skid, Montana has won two of its past three matches.
- Montana won five consecutive home matches from Sept. 1-Oct. 11.
- Senior OH Mykaela Hammer became Montana's first all-conference selection since 2015. She ranks fifth in the Big Sky with 3.78 kills per set.
- MB Olivia Bradley ranks sixth in Big Sky play with a .340 hitting percentage, best among all freshmen. She also ranks 10th with 0.32 service aces per set.
- Junior setter Ashley Watkins has 2,525 career assists (sixth in UM history). Her 10.56 assists-per-set average in 2018 ranks sixth during conference play.
- Montana has used three liberos, but freshman Sarina Moreno has started each of the past 26 matches. Her 4.49 Big Sky digs-per-set average ranks seventh.
- UM improved in every statistical category from 2016 to 2017, including a 40-percent increase in blocking (132-spot improvement nationally).
- The Grizzlies returned every player who earned a start in 2017, in addition to 99.9% of their kills, 99.5% of their blocks, 95.7% of their assists, 83.6% of their service aces and 81.6% of their digs.

ABOUT IDAHO

- Idaho is 21-9 (15-3 Big Sky) in 2018, finishing tied with Northern Arizona for the regular-season conference championship.
- Idaho enters the week having won 13 of its past 14 matches dating back to the start of October.
- The Vandals lead the Big Sky in four of seven statistical categories (hitting percentage, assists, kills, blocks). They rank second for opponent hitting, third for digs and fifth for service aces.
- Idaho ranks in the top 30 nationally for hitting percentage (.261) and blocking (2.65 per set).
- Idaho returned four starters and its libero from last year's team. Among the returners are OH Sarah Sharp (first-team All-Big Sky), MB Devonnie Ryter (first-team All-Big Sky), OH Kaela Straw (first-team All-Big Sky) and OH/L Alicia Wodke (second-team All-Big Sky). Senior OH Reece Carman also earned second-team honors.
- The Vandals have three players averaging at least 3.0 kills per set, led by Sharp (4.04, fifth in BSC).
- Wodke, the 2018 co-libero of the year, averages 5.33 digs per set (34th in NCAA).
- Freshman Nikki Ball leads the league with 1.23 blocks per set. Ryter ranks fifth, giving the Vandals two of the top five blockers.
- Ryter (.414 in conference play) ranks second in the Big Sky and 16th nationally for hitting. Her 0.33 service aces per set rank ninth in the conference.
- Carman is also in the top 10 in the conference for hitting (.318, eighth) and kills (3.10, ninth).

SERIES VS. THE VANDALS

The series vs. Idaho dates back to Montana's first-ever match, in 1975. The Grizzlies are 27-37 vs. the Vandals, including 0-3 mark in the Big Sky tournament. UM took Idaho to five sets at home in 2017, losing a heartbreaker that included a Set-4 score of 30-28 and Set-5 score of 19-17. The Vandals won both matches during the 2018 regular season. In the first meeting, in Missoula, no Grizzly was in double figures for kills, as Idaho hit .306 in a three-set win. Earlier this month, in Moscow, Montana was competitive in two of the sets, including Set 1, in which Montana led 20-14 before losing 25-23. The Grizzlies were led by sophomore Bailly Permann (10 kills on .600

hitting, four blocks) and were blocked just five times, Idaho's second-lowest blocking total of the season. Montana is looking for just its second win vs. Idaho since 2000.

"They are very physical. They are big athletes in every way. They jump high, they run the fastest offense in the conference, they have the best blocking numbers in the conference. They are a force to be reckoned with, for sure.

"Our physicality matches theirs, but we have to control the ball. Last time we played, when we served the ball well, we were ahead 20-14 (in Set 1), and then we went on a serve-receive breakdown. If we can win the serving and passing game, both teams will hit and block well, so we'll see what happens."

HAMMER TIME

There's been plenty of transition and change surrounding Mykaela Hammer over the past five years, playing for three different head coaches and switching positions four times, but the one thing that has remained the same is the 6-1 player. In a world of transferring and jumping from school to school for the next big thing, Hammer stuck it out.

"We live in an age where instant gratification is paramount, but Mykaela was committed to herself, her program and her university for the long haul," head coach Allison Lawrence said.

The persistence and dedication became even more rewarding on Tuesday, when Hammer was named to the All-Big Sky Conference first team, a 12-member team selected by the league's head coaches. She is the first Grizzly to earn all-conference recognition since 2015, and the 14th player to ever earn first-team recognition.



Not only does she lead the Griz offense, but her 3.78 kills-per-set average ranks fifth in the entire conference. She's led the team for kills 18 times this season, including a career-high 23 in a come-from-behind win over Sacramento State, a team that enters this week's conference tournament as a top-four seed. The six-rotation player does it all for the Griz, ranking second on the team for digs, second for blocks and fourth for service aces.

During her career, she's played in more than 100 career matches and recently surpassed 900 career kills. The senior will also graduate (with two degrees, mind you) with more than 600 career digs, 200 blocks and 50 service aces. Just seven other players in the history of the program have reached each of those milestones, and just one other during the 21st century.

TALKING HISTORY

- Montana's 10 victories are its most in a season since 2013.
- Montana's seven Big Sky wins are also its most since 2013. The Grizzlies won just five conference matches in 2016 and 2017 combined.
- Montana's five home victories were its most since 2013.

- Montana won four true road matches. The Grizzlies had just one each of the past two seasons.
- With its wins over Eastern Washington (Oct. 11 and Nov. 9), Montana earned a season sweep over a Big Sky opponent for the first time since 2015.
- The Grizzlies opened Big Sky Conference play with three consecutive victories, marking their best start since 2006. With five wins through their first seven conference matches entering mid-October, Montana's 5-2 start had only been accomplished one other time since 1995.
- Montana won five consecutive home matches from Sept. 1 through Oct. 11, its longest home winning streak since 2011.
- From Sept. 15-25, Montana won four consecutive matches overall, its longest winning streak since 2013.
- Montana averaged 583 fans per match in 2018, a 20 percent increase from 2017 and the highest average in 23 years.

NUMBERS WATCHING

- Outside hitter Mykaela Hammer is one of eight players in UM history with 900 career kills, 600 digs, 200 blocks and 50 service aces.
- Hammer has played in 107 career matches, starting 87 of them. She has started 34 matches in a row and 70 of her past 71.
- Junior setter Ashley Watkins has 2,525 career assists, a figure which ranks sixth in UM history.
- Watkins won't reach triple digits for career matches played until next year, but the setter is on pace to, and has started 45 matches in a row and 61 of Montana's last 62.
- True freshman middle blocker Olivia Bradley is currently hitting at a .303 clip, which would be the fifth-best in UM single-season history.
- True freshman libero Sarina Moreno enters the tournament with 413 digs on the season, 24 away from cracking Montana's single-season top-10 list.
- Senior outside hitter Cassie Laramée is 12 kills away from reaching 500 for her career.
- McKenzie Kramer last week reached 150 blocks for her career.
- Junior outside hitter Missy Huddleston earlier this month surpassed 600 career kills.
- Senior defensive specialist Silerolia Gaogao surpassed 500 career digs earlier this month, an impressive feat considering she was an outside hitter for her first two seasons.

IN THE RANKINGS

Several Grizzlies rank among the Big Sky leaders for several statistical categories:

- Olivia Bradley's .340 Big Sky hitting percentage ranks sixth in the league and first among freshman attackers. She has two of UM's top-three individual hitting percentages this season, including a .625 clip (10-0-16) vs. Eastern Washington. Bradley also ranks 10th in Big Sky play with 0.32 service aces per set.
- Mykaela Hammer's 3.78 kills-per-set average in Big Sky play ranks fifth. She has led the Grizzlies for kills 18 times this season, hitting in double figures 18 times.
- Ashley Watkins ranks sixth in Big Sky play with 10.56 assists per set.
- Sarina Moreno ranks seventh in Big Sky play with 4.49 digs per set.
- Missy Huddleston's 24 kills vs. Gonzaga are the seventh-most by a Big Sky athlete this season. Hammer's 23 vs. Sacramento State rank eighth.
- Watkins' 46 assists vs. Portland State are the most in a three-set match this season.

SENIOR CELEBRATION

Prior to Montana's match vs. Southern Utah (Nov. 3), the team celebrated its senior class. After graduating zero seniors a year ago, the Grizzlies recognized six players that night.

Each member of the six-person class has had a different path to Missoula. They'll all be playing their final matches few weeks, but how they started is a different story. Mykaela Hammer arrived in 2014 and redshirted her first season. Silerolia Gaogao and Cassie Laramée played as true freshmen in 2015. A year later, McKenzie Kramer and Alexis Urbach joined the group. The Grizzlies added Brittany Gay in 2017. The six come from five different states, plus a Canadian province. Two transferred to UM after beginning their careers elsewhere. Another is graduating early.



"For me to go through my transition with this team, it's definitely emotional," said second-year head coach Allison Lawrence, who was previously an assistant. "I'm so proud to work with them and to get to watch them play every day. They've done an incredible job getting this program on the right path."

KEEPING IT 100

Redshirt senior Mykaela Hammer has been a staple for the Grizzlies over the past five seasons. In addition to playing for three head coaches, she has switched positions multiple times, doing whatever her team has needed from her. As a sophomore in 2016, playing as both an outside and middle, Hammer led the Grizzlies for blocks. A year later in 2017, she was the team leader for kills, and again leads Montana in that category in 2018.

Hammer recently surpassed 900 career kills and 200 blocks. The senior also reached another milestone on Oct. 23, playing in her 100th career match at Montana. Now at 107, she has earned 87 starts, including 34 in a row and 70 of her past 71.

SETTING UP THE GRIZ

Setter Ashley Watkins holds more than 2,500 career assists, currently ranked sixth in school history. Making the feat even more impressive, Watkins is just a junior, and she spent her freshman season hitting during half of the team's rotations. At her current pace, Watkins is expected to finish her career near the top five in school history.



FRESHMAN IMPACT

With every starter returning from 2017, there wasn't a lot of room for newcomers to fit into the rotation, but two true freshmen have found their groove.

Middle blocker Olivia Bradley has earned 16 starts this year, leading the team with a .303 hitting percentage (sixth in Big Sky). Her per-set averages are among the team leaders for a variety of categories, including service aces (0.24, first), blocking (0.66, second) and kills (1.62, fourth). Sarina Moreno didn't travel with the Griz on the team's first road trip, but took over at libero midway through the fourth match of the season and has played each match since. Her 4.21 digs-per-set average ranks seventh in the Big Sky, and she has increased that number to 4.49 during league play. On the year, her 18 service aces are tied for second on the team.

EFFICIENT HITTING

In Montana's four-set victory over Eastern Washington on Oct. 11, the Grizzlies hit .328, their highest hitting percentage since 2015. Nearly a month later, playing the Eagles in Cheney, Montana hit .333 in a three-set win, surpassing the previous high.

In a 25-12 Set-1 victory in Cheney, Montana hit .440, recording just one attack error. In the previous meeting, in Missoula, the Grizzlies hit .423 in Set 1 and .500 in Set 2. To no surprise, Montana is 5-1 this season when recording a higher attack percentage than its opponent.

CLUTCH DOWN THE STRETCH

Of Montana's 30 matches, eight have gone to five sets, including four during Big Sky play. Montana is 5-3 in five-setters (3-1 in Big Sky).

In the fifth set, Montana has more kills, digs, and service aces than its opponents. Despite the fifth set being a shortened frame (going to 15 points instead of 25), senior Mykaela Hammer is averaging nearly as many kills as her season average (2.86 per set), and doing so at a much more efficient rate (.286 to .214).

HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE

Sept. 25 was a special night for the Montana volleyball team. Not only did the Grizzlies defeat rival Montana State in come-from-behind fashion to even the all-time series ledger at 56-56, but with the victory, Montana improved to 3-0 in Big Sky play for the first time since 2006. What's more, though, the match was played in front of 1,314 fans, the largest crowd since 2009 and the 10th-largest on record.

"That was probably one of the most special moments for me in eight years here," head coach Allison Lawrence said. "To see the crowd that showed up for that match, along with the band, it was such a unique energy, and really gave us excitement and motivation. It was a special night for our program, and I'm really proud of our performance."

Montana averaged 589 fans per match in 2018, a 20 percent increase from 2017 and the team's highest attendance average since 1995. From Sept. 1 through Oct. 11, Montana won five consecutive home matches, its best stretch since 2011. Overall, the Grizzlies went 5-7 at home this season, with two of their defeats coming against a pair of top-30 teams (Utah and Iowa State). Making the record even more impressive, the team's five home wins in a season are its most since 2013. In fact, the Grizzlies won just six combined home matches from 2015-17.

SEARCHING FOR THE RIGHT LINEUP

In 30 matches, Montana has used 18 different starting-lineup combinations, not repeating the same one until the eighth match of the season. Overall, just five combinations have been repeated, and none more than six times. Setter Ashley Watkins and outside hitter Mykaela Hammer have started all 30 matches.

"We have a lot of players who, statistically, are very close to each other," head coach Allison Lawrence said. "Competition is what is going to make our team at its best the most often. Playing time might be tough to come by at times, but when someone goes in and makes a difference, they'll earn a start the next time."

HAMMER NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior outside hitter was named the Big Sky Conference Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 24. Hammer averaged a double-double with 19.5 kills (4.88 per set) and 10.0 digs over two matches, doing so on an impres-

sive .443 efficiency. Her 4.88 kills-per-set average was nearly double the next-closest Grizzly.

In a come-from-behind victory over Sacramento State, Hammer recorded a career-high 23 kills on .409 hitting, eclipsing her previous high for kills on the final swing of the match. Two nights later vs. Portland State, Hammer again led the Grizzlies, this time with 16 kills on .500 hitting. The outside hitter also recorded three service aces.

CELEBRATING ITS PAST

For the first time in more than a decade, Montana hosted an alumni weekend (Sept. 21-22), welcoming back 13 former players – including All-Americans, school record-holders, conference champions and some of the top students and athletes in school history.

"That was one of the highlights of my whole coaching career, not just as a head coach," Allison Lawrence said at the time. "The moment that the alumni saw each other, to see them and feel their energy and hear their stories was really special for me and for our team."

The night before the match, the past and present Grizzlies ate dinner together, reminiscing and sharing stories, in addition to passing along advice to the younger group.

"The biggest thing was to see their relationships now," Lawrence continued. "I don't think they talk very frequently; they have their own busy lives. But the way those bonds come back when they're in this environment I think made our team realize what the bigger picture is and what this is all about, which is who you are for your teammates."

NON-CONFERENCE COMPETITION

Of the 12 teams Montana played in the preseason, four have either been nationally ranked or have received votes in the AVCA top-25 coaches' poll this season. The Grizzlies challenged themselves by playing two teams from the Pac-12 and another from the Big 12, but all around, their opponents had success throughout the first month of the season. The combined non-conference winning percentage of Montana's 12 preseason opponents was .570 (81-61), with nine teams posting a .500 record or better.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM PRESEASON

- Montana earned victories over Gonzaga (3-2), UTEP (3-0) and South Dakota (3-2).
- Senior outside hitter Mykaela Hammer was named to the Montana Invitational and Borderland Invitational all-tournament teams. At the Roadrunner Classic, outside hitter Alexis Urbach and setter Ashley Watkins earned all-tournament honors.
- Montana out-blocked its opponents six times during the preseason, averaging 2.1 blocks per set. Sophomore middle blocker Bailey Permann led the Grizzlies for blocking six times.
- During a seven-match stretch from Aug. 31 through Sept. 14, Montana was out-dug just one time (in a victory at UTEP). The stretch featured three matches vs. top-30 opponents.
- Montana hit a then-season-best .229 in a five-set loss to New Mexico State. It marked the first time in more than a year that the Aggies, who at the time owned a 15-match home win streak, had been pushed to five sets at home.
- The Grizzlies out-hit their opponents twice during the Borderland Invitational, holding UTEP to .150 efficiency.
- The Grizzlies recorded more service aces than their opponents in each of the final two matches of non-conference play (CSU Bakersfield and South Dakota).

- Hammer recorded 20 kills vs. New Mexico State. She led the Grizzlies for kills a team-high five times during non-conference play.
- Junior outside hitter Missy Huddleston recorded double-figure kill totals six times in non-conference, including 24 on .333 hitting in a five-set win over Gonzaga. Trailing 14-13 in the fifth set, she had a kill and service ace to set up match point for Montana. She also had three double-doubles and led UM in hitting efficiency a team-high four times.
- Urbach had 21 kills on .390 hitting vs. CSU Bakersfield and 16 kills at a .483 clip in the season opener against UC Riverside. She led Montana for kills four times in the preseason.
- Watkins had four double-doubles and a team-high 12 service aces during non-conference action.
- Over the final four non-conference matches, freshman middle blocker Olivia Bradley averaged 2.07 kills and 1.07 blocks per set. She led the Grizzlies in blocking four times during the preseason.
- True freshman Sarina Moreno started eight matches at libero during preseason, averaging 3.71 digs per set in those matches, including a career-high 20 vs. Gonzaga. She also has six service aces.
- During the Montana Invitational, junior middle blocker Janna Grimsrud totaled 12 blocks over two matches.
- Against New Mexico State, Montana used an 8-0 run to force a deciding fifth set. The Grizzlies and Aggies were tied at 13-13 in the final frame before NMSU won the final two points.
- The Grizzlies learned how to close out tight sets late at UTEP. They led 23-22 in the first set before winning two of the final three points. The two teams were knotted at 23-23 in Set 2, before Montana won the next two points. Tied at 24-24 in the third set, the Grizzlies got back-to-back kills to seal the match.

A SIGNATURE WIN

After a 0-5 start to the year, the Grizzlies earned a signature win over Gonzaga (Sept. 1), winning the first two sets before rallying in the fifth frame to win, 17-15. In the deciding set, Montana trailed 14-13 before scoring four of the next five points.

"I think I jumped as high as I have since college," head coach Allison Lawrence said after the match. "I was very emotional. We had players crying, we had coaches hugging. We're a program that has been starved for wins, and I want us to be so hungry that when that last ball falls, it's the feeling of coming up for air and all of your emotions come pouring out."

The result was even more important considering Gonzaga is one of Montana's regional recruiting rivals.

HANGING WITH THE BEST

Montana knew the challenge would be steep, facing a pair of top-30 teams nationally. The Grizzlies were up for the challenge, however. Despite losing in straight sets to both Utah and Iowa State (Aug. 31), Montana showed fight, and pushed the Power-5 teams in many sets.

Against No. 22 Utah, the Grizzlies jumped out to an early lead and forced the Utes to call timeout first. Montana led by as many as three points, and as late as 17-16. In the third set, Montana was within a single point, 15-14, midway through the frame. Montana was even better against Iowa State. In the second set, the Grizzlies led by as many as seven points, 15-8, and were tied at 21-21. The two teams were knotted at 20-20 in Set 3, before Iowa State again closed the set on a run.

SARINA'S DEBUT

Freshman Sarina Moreno, who did not travel with the team to Montana's first tournament in California, made her collegiate debut during the second

set vs. Utah (Aug. 31). She had six digs vs. the Utes and has started at libero each match since.

COMING HOME

Montana played a home match in the month of August for the first time since 2014, hosting the four-team Montana Invitational (Aug. 31-Sept. 1). A year ago, Montana played its first 15 matches away from home, playing its own gym for the first time on Sept. 28.

RANKED FOES IN MISSOULA

For just the fourth time ever, and the first time in 15 years, a nationally ranked volleyball team played in Missoula. The Grizzlies hung tough with No. 22 Utah (Aug. 31), leading by as many as three points in the first set, and as late as 17-16.

The Grizzlies saw a three-win improvement during Allison Lawrence's first season as head coach. Even more impressive, UM improved in every statistical category from 2016 to 2017, including a 40-percent increase in blocking (132-spot improvement nationally).

It was a similar trend in Big Sky Conference play, with Montana improving its ranking in hitting percentage, opponent hitting, assists, kills, blocks and service aces.

WELCOME TO UM

In addition to returning nearly every contributor from 2017, the Grizzlies also added five freshmen to their roster. The newcomers made an immediate impact during fall camp, with Lawrence praising each of them for what they brought to the court.

"Olivia (Bradley) is fast and she thinks on her feet," Lawrence said of the Nampa, Idaho, native. "When she doesn't know what she's supposed to be doing – which is rare – she kind of pushes through it and grinds it out."

Bradley has earned 16 starts and leads the team with a .303 hitting percentage. Missoula native Sarina Moreno has played at libero each match since Aug. 31. Montana's other freshmen are outside hitter Elsa Godwin (Missoula, Mont.), defensive specialist Kelsey Nestegard (Pullman, Wash.) and setter Casey Stites (Bozeman, Mont.).

ALLISON LAWRENCE

Head Coach | 2nd Season/9th Overall | Oregon State, 2005

The 2018 season is Allison Lawrence's second year as head coach of the Montana volleyball program, her ninth overall. She was hired in January 2017 after serving the previous seven years as an assistant.

Lawrence joined the Grizzlies in the summer of 2010 after one season as an assistant coach at Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas.

Montana went 8-21 in Lawrence's first year as head coach, matching the most wins for the program since 2013.

In Lawrence's seven seasons as an assistant, Montana three times finished .500 or better in Big Sky Conference matches and three times made the league's postseason tournament.

At the 2013 Big Sky tournament, No. 5 Montana defeated No. 4 Northern Arizona in the quarterfinals, the Grizzlies' first postseason victory since 1996.

Since Lawrence has been on staff, Jaimie Thibeault earned first-team All-Big Sky honors in 2010, Kayla Reno in 2013 and Hannah Sackett in 2015. The Grizzlies also have had three second-team selections during that time.

Lawrence, from Alta Loma, Calif., was a four-year starter at outside hitter for Oregon State, from 2001 to 2004. She graduated from OSU in 2005 with a degree in philosophy and added a master's degree in applied women's studies from Claremont Graduate University in 2008.

Lawrence was a freshman on Oregon State's NCAA tournament team in 2001 and would go on to earn honorable-mention All-Pac-10 honors as a junior and senior. She was awarded Pac-10 academic honors in 2002, 2003 and 2004, and was an academic all-district selection as a junior.

One of the top outside hitters in Beaver history, Lawrence finished her career ranked among OSU's leaders in both kills (1,255) and digs (965).

Lawrence was a volunteer assistant coach at Oregon State in 2005 and an assistant coach at Pomona-Pitzer in 2007 and La Verne in 2008, both NCAA Division III schools in Southern California. She also gained extensive coaching experience at the club level during that time.

Lawrence spent the 2009 season at Trinity. She helped lead the Tigers to a 30-win season and a spot in the NCAA Division III national quarterfinals. She is married to Nate Michael. They are the parents of two sons, Wyatt and Carson.


