#### GRIZ TAKING ONE-MATCH-AT-A-TIME APPROACH

MONTANA AT IDAHO / THURSDAY, NOV. 8 / 8 P.M. (MT) / MOSCOW, IDAHO.

MONTANA AT EASTERN WASHINGTON / FRIDAY, NOV. 9 / 8 P.M. (MT) / CHENEY, WASH.

The talk – both internally and externally – has been about making the conference tournament for the first time since 2014. And after a hot start over the first month, the noise grew louder.

Now head volleyball coach Allison Lawrence is trying to reel it in.

From 2014 through the start to Big Sky play this year, Montana's volleyball program went just 30-94. Nearly every match, Montana was seen as the underdog, and the Grizzlies played with nothing to lose and everything to prove.

Montana then won its first three conference matches, all against teams picked to finish ahead of the Grizzlies in the preseason poll. The team's 5-2 start had been matched just one other time in the past two decades. For the first time in a while, the Grizzlies were tasting success.

"I think we were in a position that we had never been in before, and all of a sudden we began to tighten up because we didn't know how to respond to it," Lawrence said.

The good news for the Grizzlies is that their 5-2 start built a cushion, and even today, in the midst of a seven-match skid, Montana still is in the driver's seat to make the conference tournament. Montana is tied with Montana State for seventh place, with Portland State and Southern Utah one game back.

Lawrence wants her team to go back to playing free, and more than that, trusting the process, and trusting that by focusing on themselves the results will take care of themselves.

"It's not about who's on the other side of the net, or even our outcome," Lawrence said. "It's about the process. Everything we're told is to have the carrot in front of you and play for that, whether it's a win, a playoff spot or whatever.

"The external reward is an imposter. When you shift your focus to that, you really lose a sense of your core identity and what drives you."

So Lawrence is taking a step back, admitting that even she may have focused too much on the outcome after an historic start.

#### **ABOUT MONTANA**

Montana is looking to snap a seven-match losing skid. The Grizzlies' last win came Oct. 11 vs. EWU.

Blocks/Set ...... Baily Permann (0.85)

- Montana has already matched last year's win total (8).
- The Grizzlies' five Big Sky wins are as many as they won in 2016 and 2017 combined.
- Montana won five consecutive home matches from Sept. 1-Oct. 11.
- The Grizzlies have played in eight five-set matches, going 5-3 and winning four of their past five.
- Senior OH Mykaela Hammer was named the Big Sky Conference Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 24. During conference play, she ranks fourth in the league with 3.90 kills per set.
- MB Olivia Bradley ranks fifth in Big Sky play with a .367 hitting percentage, best among all freshmen.
- Junior setter Ashley Watkins has more than 2,300 career assists. She currently ranks eighth in UM history. Her 10.51 assists-per-set average in 2018 ranks sixth during conference play.
- Montana has used three liberos, but freshman Sarina Moreno has started each of the past 22 matches. Her 4.67 Big Sky digs-per-set average ranks seventh.
- Montana has out-dug its opponent in six of the past seven matches.
- UM improved in every statistical category from 2016 to 2017, including a 40-percent increase in blocking (132-spot improvement nationally).
- The Grizzlies returned every player who earned a start in 2017, in addition to 99.9% of their kills, 99.5% of their blocks, 95.7% of their assists, 83.6% of their service aces and 81.6% of their digs.

• Idaho enters Thursday's match in first place in the Big Sky, currently riding a 10-match winning streak.

- Idaho leads the Big Sky in five of six statistical categories, including two categories that rank in the top 30 nationally (blocking and hitting).
- Idaho returned four starters and its libero from last year's team. Among the returners are OH Sarah Sharp (first-team All-Big Sky), MB Devonne Ryter (first-team All-Big Sky), OH Kaela Straw (second-team All-Big Sky) and OH/L Alicia Wodke (Newcomer of the Year).
- Straw, the reigning Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week, ranks third in the conference with 3.94 kills per set.
- Ryter ranks third for hitting (.382), fourth for service aces (0.38 per set) and seventh for blocking (1.10 per set).
- Freshman Nikki Balls leads the league for blocking (1.24 per set) and ranks 63rd nationally.

#### SERIES VS. THE VANDALS

The series vs. Idaho dates back to Montana's first-ever match, in 1975. The Grizzlies are 27-36 vs. the Vandals, including 10-16 on the road. UM took Idaho to five sets at home in 2017, losing a heartbreaker that included a Set-4 score of 30-28 and Set-5 score of 19-17. Last month in Missoula, Idaho snapped UM's five-match home win streak (and created its current losing skid), with a 3-0 win. No Grizzly was in double figures for kills, while Idaho hit .306, led by 15 kills on .520 hitting by Reece Carman. Montana is looking for just its second win vs. Idaho since 2000.

#### ABOUT EASTERN WASHINGTON

- Eastern Washington led all Big Sky schools with an 8-4 record during non-conference play, earning wins over Akron and UC Riverside, but is 0-14 to begin Big Sky play. Most recently, the Eagles lost 3-1 at Portland State.
- Offensively, the Eagles are led by sophomore MB Kamille Langford's 169 kills (2.09 per set). Senior Alexandra Espinosa is averaging 2.64 kills per set but has been out since Sept. 29.
- Puaoolelagi Sao, a sophomore DS, ranks ninth in the Big Sky with 4.35 digs per set.
- Sophomore L Catelyn Linke has 27 service aces.
- The Eagles rank ninth in Big Sky play for blocking (1.68 per set), but rank last in every other statistical category.
- Leslie Flores-Cloud is in her first season leading the Eagles. She wasn't hired until June 15.

#### **SERIES VS. THE EAGLES**

Montana is 55-40 all-time against EWU (17-23 on the road). The Grizzlies have played and beaten the Eagles more than any other opponent aside from Montana State. The two teams have played at least once every season since 1975. The Grizzlies are looking for their third consecutive win over the Eagles after a 3-0 victory to close 2017 and a 3-1 win last month in Missoula. In that match, Montana hit a season-best .328, led by four players in double figures for kills. Mykaela Hammer had 18 kills while Olivia Bradley had 10 without making an

"Getting to the tournament is such a small measure of where we are as a program. It's just one tiny sign that our work is pointed in the right direction," she said. "Whether we get there or not, our work isn't finished. We want to work without end. There is no end. There is constantly work to do, which is why we need to play for more than just an external reward."

Montana is guaranteed four more matches this season, and the team will take it one match at a time.

First up this week is an Idaho squad that not only was picked to win the conference, but has backed up that preseason ranking and is surging at the right time. When the two teams met last month in Missoula, Idaho was on a three-match winning streak after beginning league play 2-2. The Vandals won that afternoon against the Griz, and haven't lost since. Their winning streak has now reached 10 matches, most recently snapping Sacramento State's 31-match Big Sky home win streak.

"They have every weapon at their disposal," Lawrence said. "They have pins that are extremely terminal, they have a right side who's very physical, they have two middles who are as good as they get, and they run a very fast offense with a ton of size."

That's just the offense. The Vandals lead the league for hitting percentage, kills and assists, but also rank at the top for opponent hitting percentage and blocks.

Contrasting Idaho is Eastern Washington. Under a first-year head coach, the Eagles are winless in Big Sky play (0-14) and without a victory on their home court (0-6). EWU may be without a win, but Lawrence knows it can be dangerous. Earlier this year, EWU took Portland State and Montana State to five sets, including the Bobcats on the road.

"They're a gritty and scrappy team and will keep a lot of balls in play," Lawrence said. "They've pushed a lot of teams, and we're not in a position to take any second for granted over these next four matches. You never want to underestimate a team's desire to change the trajectory of their season, whether they can make the playoffs or not."

First serve will be at 8 p.m. MT on both Thursday and Friday and can be watched on Pluto TV and WatchBigSky.com.

#### **ACROSS THE LEAGUE**

Idaho stole a home match from Sacramento State over the weekend in a battle of two of the top teams. The Vandals (12-2) are in position to win the regular-season title, one game up on Northern Arizona (11-3) and two on Sacramento State (10-4). Weber State and Idaho State (9-5) are tied for fourth place, followed by Northern Colorado at 8-6.

With two weeks to play, there are four teams fighting for the final two spots in the eight-team Big Sky Championship (Nov. 22-24 in Greeley, Colo.)

#### TALKING HISTORY

- Still with at least four matches to play, Montana has already matched last season's win total (8) and is currently tied for its most total wins since 2013.
- With five Big Sky wins already under its belt, Montana has matched its conference win total from 2016 and 2017 combined.
- The Grizzlies opened Big Sky Conference play with three consecutive victories, marking their best start since 2006. With five wins through their first seven conference matches entering mid-October, Montana's 5-2 start had only been accomplished one other time since 1995.
- Montana won five consecutive home matches from Sept. 1 through Oct. 11, its longest home winning streak since 2011. Overall, the team's five home wins are its most in a season since 2013. The Grizzlies are nearing the home win total from 2015-17 combined (six).
- The Grizzlies have won two true road matches, matching their total from 2016 and 2017 combined.
- From Sept. 15-25, Montana won four consecutive matches overall, its longest winning streak since 2013.

#### IN THE RANKINGS

Several Grizzlies rank among the Big Sky leaders for several statistical categories:

- Olivia Bradley's .367 Big Sky hitting percentage ranks fifth in the league and first among freshman attackers. She has UM's top-two individual hitting percentages this season, including a .625 clip (10-0-16) vs. Eastern Washington.
- Mykaela Hammer's 3.90 kills-per-set average in Big Sky play ranks fourth. She has been in double figures for kills in each of the past six matches.
- Ashley Watkins ranks sixth in Big Sky play with 10.51 assists per set.
- Sarina Moreno ranks seventh in Big Sky play with 4.67 digs per set.
- Missy Huddleston's 24 kills vs. Gonzaga are the seventh-most by a Big Sky athlete this season. Hammer's 23 vs. Sacramento State rank eighth.
- Ashley Watkins' 46 assists vs. Portland State are the most in a three-set match this season.

#### SENIOR CELEBRATION

Prior to last Saturday's match vs. Southern Utah, Montana celebrated its senior class. After graduating zero seniors a year ago, the Grizzlies recognized six.

Each member of the six-person class has had a different path to Missoula. They'll all be playing their final matches over the next month, but how they started is a different story. Hammer arrived in 2014 and redshirted her first season. Gaogao and Laramee played as a true freshmen in 2015. A year later, Kramer and Urbach joined the group. The Grizzlies added Gay in 2017. The six come from five different states, plus a Canadian province. Two transferred to UM after beginning their careers elsewhere. Another is graduating early.

"For me to go through my transition with this team, it's definitely emotional," said second-year head coach Allison Lawrence, who was previously an assistant. "I'm so proud to work with them and to get to watch them play every day. They've done an incredible job getting this program on the right path."







#### **KEEPING IT 100**

Redshirt senior Mykaela Hammer has been a staple for the Grizzlies over the past five seasons. In addition to playing for three head coaches, she has switched positions multiple times, doing whatever her team has needed from her. As a sophomore in 2016, playing as both an outside and middle, Hammer led the Grizzlies for blocks. A year later in 2017, she was the team leader for kills, and is on pace to again lead Montana in that category in 2018.

Hammer recently surpassed 800 career kills and is nearing 200 career blocks as well. The senior also reached another milestone on Oct. 23, playing in her 100th career match at Montana. Now at 103, she has earned 83 starts, including 30 in a row and 66 of her past 67.



#### FRESHMAN IMPACT

With every starter returning from 2017, there wasn't a lot of room for newcomers to fit into the rotation, but two true freshmen have found their groove.

Middle blocker Olivia Bradley has earned 16 starts this year, including 13 in her past 15 matches played. The freshman not only leads the Griz for hitting (.315), but her .381 Big Sky hitting percentage ranks fifth in the league. Bradley ranks fourth on the team for kills (1.74 per set), second for blocking (0.68 per set) and third for total points (2.35 per set).

Sarina Moreno didn't travel with the Griz to the team's first road trip, but took over at libero midway through the fourth match of the season and has played each match since. Her 4.28 digs-per-set average rank seventh in the Big Sky, and she has increased that number to 4.49 during league play, also adding 16 service aces (second on the team).



#### **SETTING UP THE GRIZ**

Setter Ashley Watkins holds more than 2,300 career assists, and last week moved into seventh place in school history. Making the feat even more impressive, Watkins is just a junior, and she spent her freshman season hitting during half of the team's rotations. At her current pace, Watkins could finish her career near the top five in school history.

#### EFFICIENT HITTING

In Montana's four-set victory over Eastern Washington on Oct. 11, the Grizzlies hit .328, their highest hitting percentage since 2015.

The Grizzlies made just four hitting errors through the first two frames, attacking at a .423 clip in Set 1 and .500 in Set 2. Montana's second-set percentage was the highest this season, while its first-set numbers were the third-best. To no surprise, Montana is 5-1 this season when recording a higher attack percentage than its opponent.

Entering the week, no Griz player had gone a match with at least five kills without making an error. It happened twice that weekend, however, with freshman middle blocker hitting .625 vs. Eastern Washington (10-0-16) and Cassie Laramee attacking at a .474 clip (9-0-19).

#### **CLUTCH DOWN THE STRETCH**

Of Montana's 26 matches, eight have gone to five sets, including four during Big Sky play. Montana is 5-3 in five-setters (3-1 in Big Sky).

"Our fifth-set stats are off the charts," head coach Allison Lawrence said. "There's no more pressure than a fifth set, and we have the ability to step up our game during pressure situations."

In the fifth set, Montana has more kills, digs, and service aces than its opponents. Despite the fifth set being a shortened frame (going to 15 points instead of 25), senior Mykaela Hammer is averaging nearly as many kills (2.86 per set), and doing so at 70 points higher in deciding frames (.286).

#### **HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE**

Sept. 25 was a special night for the Montana volleyball team. Not only did the Grizzlies defeat rival Montana State in come-from-behind fashion to even the all-time series ledger at 56-56, but with the victory, Montana improved to 3-0 in Big Sky play for the first time since 2006.

What's more, though, the match was played in front of 1,314 fans, the largest crowd since 2009 and the 10th-largest on record.

"That was probably one of the most special moments for me in eight years here," head coach Allison Lawrence said. "To see the crowd that showed up for that match, along with the band, it was such a unique energy, and really gave us excitement and motivation. It was a special night for our program, and I'm really proud of our performance."

From Sept. 1 through Oct. 11, Montana won five consecutive home matches, its best stretch since 2011. Overall, the Grizzlies are 5-6 at home this season, with two of their defeats coming against a pair of top-30 teams (Utah and Iowa State). Making the record even more impressive, the team's five home wins in a season are its most since 2013. In fact, the Grizzlies won just six combined home matches from 2015-17.

#### **SEARCHING FOR THE RIGHT LINEUP**

In 26 matches, Montana has used 16 different starting-lineup combinations, not repeating the same one until the eighth match of the season. Overall, just four combinations have been repeated, and none more than six times. Setter Ashley Watkins and outside hitter Mykaela Hammer have started all 26 matches.

"We have a lot of players who, statistically, are very close to each other," head coach Allison Lawrence said. "Competition is what is going to make our team at its best the most often. Playing time might be tough to come by

at times, but when someone goes in and makes a difference, they'll earn a start the next time."

#### HAMMER NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior outside hitter was named the Big Sky Conference Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 24. Hammer averaged a double-double with 19.5 kills and 10.0 digs over two matches, doing so on at an impressive .443 efficiency. Her 4.88 kills-per-set average was nearly double the next-closest Grizzly.

In a come-from-behind victory over Sacramento State, Hammer recorded a career-high 23 kills on .409 hitting, eclipsing her previous high for kills on the final swing of the match. The Grizzlies found themselves trailing two sets to none, but closed the third set on a 10-5 run to extend the match. Hammer had three kills during that stretch. Trailing 15-11 in the fourth set, Montana used a 9-4 run to take the lead. During that period, Hammer had four kills. The Grizzlies then scored three of the final four points to earn a 25-23 advantage, with a pair of kills coming from Hammer. In the deciding fifth frame, the Grizzlies jumped out to a 5-0 lead and never trailed. Hammer had two kills during the 5-0 run, plus the final point of the match.

Two nights later vs. Portland State, Hammer again led the Grizzlies, this time with 16 kills on .500 hitting. The outside hitter also recorded three service aces.

Montana jumped out to an 11-5 lead in the first set, with Hammer recording four kills and serving five points during the run. Leading by just one, 13-12, in the second set, Hammer had three consecutive points – a kill and back-to-back service aces – to force a Vikings timeout. She had seven kills, an ace and a block in Montana's Set-3 victory to seal the match.

#### **CELEBRATING ITS PAST**

For the first time in more than a decade, Montana hosted an alumni weekend (Sept. 21-22), welcoming back 13 former players – including All-Americans, school record-holders, conference champions and some of the top students and athletes in school history.

"That was one of the highlights of my whole coaching career, not just as a head coach," Allison Lawrence said at the time. "The moment that the alumni saw each other, to see them and feel their energy and hear their stories was really special for me and for our team."

The night before the match, the past and present Grizzlies ate dinner together, reminiscing and sharing stories, in addition to passing along advice to the younger group.

"The biggest thing was to see their relationships now," Lawrence continued. "I don't think they talk very frequently; they have their own busy lives. But the way those bonds come back when they're in this environment I think made our team realize what the bigger picture is and what this is all about, which is who you are for your teammates."

#### **NON-CONFERENCE COMPETITION**

Of the 12 teams Montana played in the preseason, four have either been nationally ranked or have received votes in the AVCA top-25 coaches' poll this season. The Grizzlies challenged themselves by playing two teams from the Pac-12 and another from the Big 12, but all around, their opponents had success throughout the first month of the season. The combined non-conference winning percentage of Montana's 12 preseason opponents was .570 (81-61), with nine teams posting a .500 record or better.





#### HIGHLIGHTS FROM PRESEASON

- Montana earned victories over Gonzaga (3-2), UTEP (3-0) and South Dakota (3-2).
- Senior outside hitter Mykaela Hammer was named to the Montana Invitational and Borderland Invitational all-tournament teams. At the Roadrunner Classic, outside hitter Alexis Urbach and setter Ashley Watkins earned all-tournament honors.
- Montana out-blocked its opponents six times during the preseason, averaging 2.1 blocks per set. Sophomore middle blocker Baily Permann has led the Grizzlies for blocking six times.
- During a seven-match stretch from Aug. 31 through Sept. 14, Montana was out-dug just one time (in a victory at UTEP). The stretch featured three matches vs. top-30 opponents.
- Montana hit a season-best .229 in a five-set loss to New Mexico State.
   It marked the first time in more than a year that the Aggies, who now own a 16-match home win streak, had been pushed to five sets at home.
- The Grizzlies out-hit their opponents twice during the Borderland Invitational, holding UTEP to .150 efficiency.
- The Grizzlies recorded more service aces than their opponents in each
  of the final two matches of non-conference play (CSU Bakersfield and
  South Dakota).
- Hammer recorded 20 kills vs. New Mexico State. She has led the Grizzlies for kills a team-high five times this season.
- Junior outside hitter Missy Huddleston has recorded double-figure kill
  totals six times, including 24 on .333 hitting in a five-set win over Gonzaga. Trailing 14-13 in the fifth set, she had a kill and service ace to set
  up match point for Montana. She also has three double-doubles and
  has led UM in hitting percentage a team-high four times.
- Urbach had 21 kills on .390 hitting vs. CSU Bakersfield and 16 kills at a .483 clip in the season opener against UC Riverside. She has led Montana for kills four times this season.
- Watkins has four double-doubles and a team-high 12 service aces.
- Over the past four matches, freshman middle blocker Olivia Bradley is averaging 2.07 kills and 1.07 blocks per set. She has led the Grizzlies in blocking four times this season.
- True freshman Sarina Moreno has started eight matches at libero, averaging 3.71 digs per set in those matches, including a career-high 20 vs. Gonzaga. She also has six service aces.
- During the Montana Invitational, junior middle blocker Janna Grimsrud totaled 12 blocks over two matches. On the season she is averaging 1.50 blocks over 10 sets.
- Against New Mexico State, Montana used an 8-0 run to force a deciding fifth set. The Grizzlies and Aggies were tied at 13-13 in the final frame before NMSU won the final two points.
- The Grizzlies learned how to close out tight sets late at UTEP. They led 23-22 in the first set before winning two of the final three points. The two teams were knotted at 23-23 in Set 2, before Montana won the next two points. Tied at 24-24 in the third set, the Grizzlies got back-toback kills to seal the match.

#### A SIGNATURE WIN

After a 0-5 start to the year, the Grizzlies earned a signature win over Gonzaga (Sept. 1), winning the first two sets before rallying in the fifth frame to win, 17-15. In the deciding set, Montana trailed 14-13 before scoring four of the next five points.

"I think I jumped as high as I have since college," head coach Allison Lawrence said after the match. "I was very emotional. We had players crying, we had coaches hugging. We're a program that has been starved for wins, and I want us to be so hungry that when that last ball falls, it's the feeling of

coming up for air and all of your emotions come pouring out."

The result was even more important considering Gonzaga is one of Montana's regional recruiting rivals.

#### **HANGING WITH THE BEST**

Montana knew the challenge would be steep, facing a pair of top-30 teams nationally. The Grizzlies were up for the challenge, however. Despite losing in straight sets to both Utah and Iowa State (Aug. 31), Montana showed fight, and pushed the Power-5 teams in many sets.

Against No. 22 Utah, the Grizzlies jumped out to an early lead and forced the Utes to call timeout first. Montana led by as many as three points, and as late as 17-16. In the third set, Montana was within a single point, 15-14, midway through the frame. Montana was even better against Iowa State. In the second set, the Grizzlies led by as many as seven points, 15-8, and were tied at 21-21. The two teams were knotted at 20-20 in Set 3, before Iowa State again closed the set on a run.

#### **SARINA'S DEBUT**

Freshman Sarina Moreno, who did not travel with the team to Montana's first tournament in California, made her collegiate debut during the second set vs. Utah (Aug. 31). She had six digs vs. the Utes, and has continued to find her comfortability. In her 22 starts, the libero has averaged 4.28 digs per set, in addition to 16 service aces.

#### **COMING HOME**

Montana played a home match in the month of August for the first time since 2014, hosting the four-team Montana Invitational (Aug. 31-Sept. 1). A year ago, Montana played its first 15 matches away from home, playing its own gym for the first time on Sept. 28.

#### RANKED FOES IN MISSOULA

For just the fourth time ever, and the first time in 15 years, a nationally ranked volleyball team played in Missoula. The Grizzlies hung tough with No. 22 Utah, leading by as many as three points in the first set, and as late as 17-16.

#### TRENDING UP

The Grizzlies saw a three-win improvement during Allison Lawrence's first season as head coach. Even more impressive, UM improved in every statistical category from 2016 to 2017, including a 40-percent increase in blocking (132-spot improvement nationally).

It was a similar trend in Big Sky Conference play, with Montana improving its ranking in hitting percentage, opponent hitting, assists, kills, blocks and service aces.

#### **WELCOME TO UM**

In addition to returning nearly every contributor from 2017, the Grizzlies also added five freshmen to their roster. The newcomers made an immediate impact during fall camp, with Lawrence praising each of them for what they brought to the court.

"Olivia (Bradley) is fast and she thinks on her feet," Lawrence said of the Nampa, Idaho, native. "When she doesn't know what she's supposed to be doing - which is rare - she kind of pushes through it and grinds it out."

Bradley has earned 16 starts and leads the team with a .315 hitting percentage. Missoula native Sarina Moreno has played at libero each match since Aug. 31. Montana's other freshmen are outside hitter Elsa

Godwin (Missoula, Mont.), defensive specialist Sarina Moreno (Missoula, Mont.), defensive specialist Kelsey Nestegard (Pullman, Wash.) and setter Casey Stites (Bozeman, Mont.).

#### LOOKING AHEAD

Montana will close the regular season with a split week against Weber State (Nov. 15 at home) and Idaho State (Nov. 17 on the road). If the Grizzlies finish in the top eight, they will then advance to the Big Sky Championship, held Nov. 22-24 in Greeley, Colo.

## ALLISON LAWRENCE

Head Coach | 2nd Season/9th Overall | Oregon State, 2005

The 2018 season is Allison Lawrence's second year as head coach of the Montana volleyball program, her ninth overall. She was hired in January 2017 after serving the previous seven years as an assistant.

Lawrence joined the Grizzlies in the summer of 2010 after one season as an assistant coach at Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas.

Montana went 8-21 in Lawrence's first year as head coach, matching the most wins for the program since 2013.

In Lawrence's seven seasons as an assis-

tant, Montana three times finished .500 or better in Big Sky Conference matches and three times made the league's postseason tournament.

At the 2013 Big Sky tournament, No. 5 Montana defeated No. 4 Northern Arizona in the quarterfinals, the Grizzlies' first postseason victory since 1996.

Since Lawrence has been on staff, Jaimie Thibeault earned first-team All-Big Sky honors in 2010, Kayla Reno in 2013 and Hannah Sackett in 2015. The Grizzlies also have had three second-team selections during that time.

Lawrence, from Alta Loma, Calif., was a four-year starter at outside hitter for Oregon State, from 2001 to 2004. She graduated from OSU in 2005 with a degree in philosophy and added a master's degree in applied women's studies from Claremont Graduate University in 2008.

Lawrence was a freshman on Oregon State's NCAA tournament team in 2001 and would go on to earn honorable-mention All-Pac-10 honors as a junior and senior. She was awarded Pac-10 academic honors in 2002, 2003 and 2004, and was an academic all-district selection as a junior.

One of the top outside hitters in Beaver history, Lawrence finished her career ranked among OSU's leaders in both kills (1,255) and digs (965).

Lawrence was a volunteer assistant coach at Oregon State in 2005 and an assistant coach at Pomona-Pitzer in 2007 and La Verne in 2008, both NCAA Division III schools in Southern California. She also gained extensive coaching experience at the club level during that time.
