The Holy Cross men's basketball team returns to action on Sunday, Dec. 29, when it travels to Siena for a 2:00 p.m. game. The contest between the Crusaders and the Saints will be televised live by My4 Albany and ESPN+, and can be heard on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross owns an overall record of 1-11 so far this season. The Crusaders have dropped their last four games since picking up their first victory of the year against Mercer on Dec. 2 (81-67). Freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** has led the team by averaging 16.2 points and 7.3 rebounds per game, while hitting 57.7 percent of his field goal attempts. Freshman guard **Drew Lowder** has added 14.3 points and 3.3 assists per contest, while junior guard **Austin Butler** is chipping in with 11.0 points and 8.3 boards per game. The Crusaders are in their first year under head coach **Brett Nelson**, and are coming off a 2018-19 season in which they went 16-17 overall and 6-12 in the Patriot League.

Siena stands 4-5 overall this year and has won its last two contests. Sophomore guard Jalen Pickett has led the team by averaging 16.3 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.9 assists per game, while hitting 77.3 percent of his free throws. Senior forward Elijah Burns (16.0 points per game), junior forward Manny Camper (13.6 points per game) and sophomore guard Donald Carey (13.4 points per game) are also scoring in double figures for the Saints. Siena is coming off a 2018-19 season in which it went 17-16 overall and tied for second place in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference with an 11-7 mark in league play.

Following the game with the Saints, Holy Cross will open up Patriot League play at Loyola (Md.) on Thursday, Jan. 2, at 7:00 p.m.

THE SERIES WITH SIENA: This will be the 16th meeting between the Crusaders and the Saints on the hardwood, with Siena leading the all-time series 9-6. Holy Cross has won two straight games in the series, but Siena came out on top in seven of previous eight meetings. The schools first played on Feb. 6, 1990, with Holy Cross winning 103-76 at the Hart Center.

BUTLER ENJOYING ANOTHER STRONG SEASON: Junior guard **Austin Butler** is once again among the top players for the Crusaders this year. Through the first 12 games of the season, Butler has averaged 11.0 points and 8.3 rebounds per contest. During the Sacred Heart game, he posted his second double-double of the season with 17 points and a career-high 17 rebounds. Previously at Canisius, Butler totaled 11 points, six rebounds, three assists and three steals. He also played well at San Diego, scoring nine points and pulling down 13 rebounds. A few of Butler's other top games this season have come against Mercer (17 points, 11 rebounds, three assists), Florida Atlantic (16 points, five rebounds), Hofstra (13 points, six rebounds, three assists) and Fairfield (12 points, six rebounds, three assists). Last year, he averaged 12.6 points, 4.1 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game, while making 40.0 percent of his shots from three-point range. Butler's top game a year ago came against Sacred Heart, when he scored 26 points while hitting 10 of 13 field goal attempts and four of five shots from three-point range. In 2017-18, he was selected to the Patriot League All-Rookie team after averaging 9.8 points and 3.7 rebounds per game. Over the course of his collegiate career, Butler has now totaled 842 points, 344 rebounds, 124 assists and 82 steals, while making 36.5 percent of his attempts from three-point range (110 of 301).

PRIDGEN MAKES PRESENCE FELT: Freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** has been one of Holy Cross' top all-around players so far this year. In 10 games played, Pridgen has averaged a team-best 16.2 points, 7.3 rebounds and 1.4 steals per contest while hitting 57.7 percent of his shots from the floor. He has played particularly well over the last six games, putting up 20.7 points and 7.8 boards in that span. During the Sacred Heart game, Pridgen totaled 23 points, eight rebounds and three assists. Previously at Canisius, he recorded 16 points and six rebounds. Pridgen also played well against UMass Boston, leading the team with a career-high 32 points, eight rebounds and three assists. A few of his other top games this season have come against Mercer (21 points, nine rebounds), San Diego (16 points, nine rebounds), Hofstra (16 points, seven rebounds, two steals), New Hampshire (13 points, eight rebounds, five assists) and No. 7 Maryland (12 points, eight rebounds, three assists). Pridgen came to the Crusaders from the Governor's Academy in Byfield, Mass., where he was named All-New England during his senior year.

MILLER MAKES HIS WAY TO THE NBA: Former Crusader **Malcolm Miller** (Class of 2015) is currently in his third season playing for the Toronto Raptors in the National Basketball Association. During the 2018-19 campaign, Miller was a part of the Raptors' NBA championship team. He became the fourth Holy Cross basketball player to win an NBA title, joining the likes of Bob Cousy and Tom Heinsohn (former Crusaders now own 16 NBA championships). Miller is also the first Patriot League player to ever be part of an NBA title team, since the league's formation in 1990. Miller appeared in 10 of Toronto's 24 playoff games in 2018-19, totaling eight points, five rebounds, one assist and one block. In 42 career regular season games played with the Raptors (as of Dec. 16), he has recorded 91 points, 34 rebounds, 11 assists, five blocks and six steals, while hitting 40.4 percent of his three-point attempts (23 of 57). During his career with the Crusaders, Miller totaled 1,013 points, 532 rebounds, 164 assists, 143 blocked shots and 93 steals. He ranks fourth all-time at Holy Cross in career blocked shots and seventh in career games started (93).

SACRED HEART RECAP

Austin Butler posted a double-double with 17 points and a career-high 17 rebounds, but the Crusaders were defeated by Sacred Heart 89-68 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Dec. 22, 2019. Holy Cross hit just 38.2 percent of its field goal attempts and 25.0 percent of its three-pointers on the day, while committing 14 turnovers. The Pioneers were able to connect on 51.5 percent of their shots from the floor, while giving the ball away just 10 times. The game was close early on, as Sacred Heart led 10-8 with 13:20 left in the first half. Sacred Heart then used a 26-4 run over the next 7:39 to take a commanding 36-12 advantage. The Pioneers went on to take a 29-point lead (50-21) into the locker room at halftime. Sacred Heart expanded its advantage to 32 early in the second half, and was still up by 31 (61-30) with 17:37 left to play. The Crusaders then used a 13-2 run to close the gap to 20 points (63-43) with 13:20 left to play. But that was as close as Holy Cross would get, as the Pioneers went on to post a 21-point victory. Joe Pridgen finished the day with a game-high 23 points, eight rebounds and three assists, while Ryan Wade scored 13 points. E.J. Anosike led Sacred Heart with 19 points and 14 rebounds.

CRUSADERS AGAINST THE METRO ATLANTIC ATHLETIC CONFERENCE: Holy Cross has an all-time record of 109-86 against the 11 schools which currently compete in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. Over the last five years, the Crusaders are 7-7 against MAAC foes. Holy Cross stands 14-7 all-time against Canisius, 22-20 vs. Fairfield, 16-16 against Iona, 21-10 vs. Manhattan, 5-2 against Marist, 0-1 vs. Monmouth, 8-7 against Niagara, 3-1 vs. Quinnipiac, 14-13 against St. Peter's and 6-9 vs. Siena. The Crusaders played in the MAAC for seven seasons from 1983-1990, posting a 52-48 record in conference action. Holy Cross' top season in the league came in 1989-1990, when it recorded a 14-2 mark to win the MAAC North Division title.

NIEGO STEPS UP IN THE POST: Junior forward **Connor Niego** has been one of Holy Cross' top front court players this season. In 12 games played Niego has averaged 7.0 points and 3.3 rebounds. During the Canisius game, he scored 11 points and pulled down a career-best eight rebounds. Previously against Fairfield, Niego totaled 14 points, four rebounds and three blocked shots. He also posted nine points and five boards at New Hampshire, while scoring nine points at No. 7 Maryland and at San Diego. Last year, Niego averaged 5.0 points and 1.5 rebounds per contest while making 52.6 percent of his field goal attempts, but played in only 10 games due to injury. His top performance in 2018-19 came at No. 19 Michigan, when he scored a season-high 13 points. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Niego has totaled 203 points and 96 rebounds.

NELSON LEADS THE CRUSADERS: **Brett Nelson** is in his first season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2019-20, with an overall record of 1-11. This is the first collegiate head coaching position in the career of Nelson, who is the 18th head coach in program history. Nelson came to Holy Cross after spending five seasons on the coaching staff at Marquette University. During his five years at Marquette, including two seasons as associate head coach, Nelson helped the Golden Eagles to an overall record of 97-69 and two trips to the NCAA Tournament. Prior to his time at Marquette, Nelson was an assistant coach at Arkansas, Ball State, Drake and Marshall. A 2004 graduate of the University of Florida, Nelson was a three-year starter for the Gators and a member of four NCAA tournament teams.

Austin Butler totaled 18 points and five rebounds to lead Holy Cross to a 60-57 victory over Siena at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Dec. 22, 2018. After trailing 47-37 with 11:48 left to play in the second half, the Crusaders outscored Siena 17-2 over the next 6:09 to take a 54-49 lead. Butler hit a pair of three-pointers to begin that run, while the Saints made just one of seven field goal attempts. The score stayed close the rest of the way, and Siena would pull back in front (57-56) with 2:17 to go on a three-pointer by Kevin Degnan. A layup by Butler with 1:15 remaining gave Holy Cross the lead for good, then Caleb Green scored with just 23.4 seconds on the clock to make the score 60-57. The Saints would have one last possession, but Jalen

Pickett's three-point attempt was off the mark in the closing seconds as the Crusaders pulled out the win. Holy Cross had opened the game by jumping out to an early 5-0 lead, and was later up 21-17 with 6:57 left before the break. Siena then went on a 14-1 run to pull in front, and would hold a 31-26 advantage heading into the locker room. The Saints then extended their lead to 10 points early in the second half, before the Crusaders rallied for the victory. Jehyve Floyd finished the game with 14 points, eight rebounds and five assists, while hitting seven of 11 field goal attempts. Jacob Grandison posted 14 points, seven rebounds and three assists, and Green finished with 12 points and five assists. Evan Fisher led Siena with 17 points and nine rebounds. Holy Cross made 54.3 percent of its field goal attempts and 53.8 percent of its three-pointers on the day, while committing just eight turnovers. The Saints hit just 42.6 percent of their shots from the floor and 27.3 percent of their attempts from beyond the arc.

HARGIS BECOMING A FACTOR ON THE WING: Sophomore forward **Marlon Hargis** is developing into one of the Crusaders' top players this season. In 12 games played, Hargis has averaged 8.4 points and 3.0 rebounds while hitting 44.9 percent of his field goal attempts and 34.2 percent of his three-pointers. During the Hofstra game, he totaled 16 points, three rebounds, three assists and three steals. Previously against Harvard, Hargis led the team with a career-high 18 points, seven rebounds, three blocks and two assists. He also played well at No. 7 Maryland, posting 13 points and three rebounds. Over the course of his collegiate career, Hargis has now totaled 111 points and 43 rebounds while making 41.9 percent (39 of 93) of his field goal attempts.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 101st season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,419-1,016, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 11 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SIXTH PATRIOT LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON TITLE: During the 2019-20 campaign, Holy Cross will attempt to win the Patriot League regular season title for the sixth time in school history. The last championship for the Crusaders came in 2006-07, when they tied for first place in the conference with Bucknell, as both teams posted 13-1 records in league play. Prior to that, Holy Cross won outright Patriot League regular season titles in 2000-01, 2002-03 and 2004-05, while sharing the regular season championship in 1993-94. The Crusaders' five total championships are tied for the second-most in conference history with Navy (one outright, four shared), behind only Bucknell (nine outright, four shared).

HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 387-173 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including an 0-5 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-07 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 37 out of 44 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 174-80 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 112-47 record against Patriot League foes.

LOWDER STARTS CAREER STRONG: Freshman guard **Drew Lowder** has been one of the top players in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In eight games, Lowder has averaged 14.3 points and 3.3 assists per contest, while hitting 39.6 percent of his three-point field goal attempts. During the Canisius game, he led the team with 18 points and four rebounds. Previously at Florida Atlantic, Lowder scored 14 points on five of seven shooting from the field. He also played well against Harvard, posting 18 points and six assists. A few of Lowder's other top games have come against No. 7 Maryland (career-high 24 points, five assists), Fairfield (16 points, six assists, four rebounds, two steals) and New Hampshire (14 points, two assists, two steals). His 24 points in the season opener at Maryland were the most by a Crusader in his first collegiate game in over 30 years. Lowder came to Holy Cross from Ann Arbor (Mich.) Pioneer High School, where he earned second team all-state honors as a senior.

DRIBBLES: Freshman guard **Ryan Wade** scored a career-high 22 points at New Hampshire, then had 13 points against Sacred Heart. He is currently averaging 4.7 points per game this year ... Sophomore forward **Blake Verbeek** scored a career-high 10 points against Hofstra, then netted nine points in the win over Mercer. He is averaging 5.6 points and 2.8 rebounds on the year ... Junior guard **Kyle Copeland** posted season highs with 10 points and five rebounds at Florida Atlantic. On the season, he is averaging 4.9 points and 1.9 boards per contest ... Junior forward **Matt Faw** scored seven points against both Northeastern and Florida Atlantic, while pulling down a career-high eight rebounds against Harvard. Overall this year, he is averaging 3.5 points and 2.6 boards per game ... During the season opener at Maryland, Holy Cross had two freshmen — **Drew Lowder** (24 points) and **Joe Pridgen** (12 points) — score in double figures in their collegiate debut for the first time since 1998 against Yale (Patrick Whearty 14, Ryan Serravalle 11) ... Following this year's 95-71 loss at Maryland, the Crusaders now stand 70-31 all-time in season openers ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2009 through 2012, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 98 percent, tied for the seventh-best mark among all Division I schools ... The Crusaders received a Team Academic Excellence Award from the National Association of Basketball Coaches last year, for posting a cumulative team grade point average of 3.0 or better for the 2018-19 season ... Holy Cross won the Springfield Bracket of last year's Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament for the 15th regular season tournament championship in program history.
