The Holy Cross men's basketball team will play its final regular season game of the year when it faces American at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 29. Prior to tip-off, the lone member of the Crusaders' senior class, guard **Clayton Le Sann**, will be honored in a special pregame ceremony. The contest between Holy Cross and American will be shown live on the Patriot League Network, and can be heard on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

The Crusaders stand 3-26 overall this year with a 2-14 mark in the Patriot League. Holy Cross will be the No. 10 seed in the Patriot League Tournament, with its opponent determined by the final round of conference games on Saturday.

Freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** has led the team by averaging 17.5 points and 6.8 rebounds per game, while hitting 56.0 percent of his field goal attempts. Junior guard **Austin Butler** has added 12.1 points, 6.4 boards and 2.5 assists per contest, while junior forward **Connor Niego** is chipping in with 8.7 points and 4.8 rebounds per game.

American stands 15-13 overall this year with an 11-6 mark in Patriot League play. The Eagles are coming off a 79-59 victory over Lafayette on Wednesday, and will be seeded either second or third in the Patriot League Tournament.

Senior guard Sa'eed Nelson has led the team by averaging 18.7 points, 5.1 rebounds, 4.7 assists and 2.7 steals per game. Junior guard Jamir Harris has added 10.6 points and 3.2 boards per contest, while junior guard Stacy Beckton is putting up 9.8 points and 4.8 rebounds per game.

Following the contest with American, the Crusaders will play in the first round of the Patriot League Tournament on Tuesday, March 3.

THE SERIES WITH AMERICAN: This will be the 45th meeting between the Crusaders and the Eagles on the hardwood, with the all-time series tied at 22-22. American has won the last three games between the schools, but Holy Cross was victorious in the previous four meetings. The Crusaders hold a 13-7 advantage for games played in Worcester. Holy Cross and American first played on Dec. 21, 1967, with the Crusaders winning 81-57 on the road.

PRIDGEN CLIMBS FRESHMAN SCORING LISTS: Freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** enters the American game with 490 points scored on the season. He currently stands in second place on the all-time Holy Cross freshman scoring list, while standing in third place on the all-time Patriot League freshman scoring chart. Ronnie Perry holds the school freshman record with 574 points in 1976-77, while Lehigh's C.J. McCollum (631 points in 2009-10) and Colgate's Adonal Foyle (509 points in 1994-95) own the top two spots on the Patriot League freshman scoring list (since the conference began play in 1990-91). Pridgen currently needs 10 points to hit the 500-point mark on the season, while standing 19 points away from second place in all-time Patriot League freshman scoring.

PRIDGEN HITS 20-POINT MARK AGAIN: Freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** had 21 points at Army on Feb. 26, marking the 13th time this season he has scored at least 20 points in a game. Pridgen's 13 total 20-point games this year are the most by a Crusader since **Rob Feaster** hit the 20-point mark 19 times during the 1994-95 campaign. Earlier this season, Pridgen had four consecutive 20-point games from Jan. 18-29, against American, Lehigh, Boston University and Navy. He became the first Holy Cross player with four straight 20-point performances since **Kevin Hamilton** in 2006.

PRIDGEN MAKES PRESENCE FELT: Freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** has been one of Holy Cross' top all-around players this year. In 28 games played, Pridgen has averaged a team-best 17.5 points, 6.8 rebounds and 2.1 assists per contest while hitting 56.0 percent of his shots from the floor. During the Army game, Pridgen posted his second career double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds. Previously at Colgate, he led the team with 25 points, nine rebounds and five assists. Pridgen also played well against Lafayette, totaling 25 points, eight rebounds, two assists and two blocks. A few of his other top games this season have come against UMass Boston (career-high 32 points, eight rebounds, three assists), at Lehigh (30 points), at American (28 points, 12 rebounds, three assists, first career double-double), at Loyola (26 points, four assists), against Sacred Heart (23 points, eight rebounds, four assists), at Boston University (22 points, eight rebounds), against Mercer (21 points, nine rebounds), against Lehigh (20 points, nine rebounds, five assists, three steals), against Boston University (20 points, eight rebounds, three assists), at Navy (20 points, six rebounds), at Siena (17 points, nine rebounds), against Army (17 points, six rebounds), at San Diego (16 points, nine rebounds), against Hofstra (16 points, seven rebounds, two steals), at Canisius (16 points, six rebounds), at New Hampshire (13 points, eight rebounds, five assists) and at No. 7 Maryland (12 points, eight rebounds, three assists). Pridgen came to the Crusaders from the Governor's Academy in Byfield, Mass., where he was named All-New England during his senior year.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 101st season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,421-1,031, while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 11 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

ARMY RECAP

Joe Pridgen posted his second career double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds, but the Crusaders were defeated by Army West Point 67-61 at Christl Arena. Holy Cross was only able to connect on 40.0 percent of its field goal attempts and 30.4 percent of its three-pointers on the night. Army hit 45.2 percent of its shots from the floor, while holding a 15-3 advantage in free throw attempts. The Crusaders started the game hot, jumping out to a quick 6-2 lead. Holy Cross was later up 18-14 with nine minutes left in the first half, when the Black Knights used an 8-2 spurt to claim the lead. Army went on to take a 31-28 advantage into the locker room at halftime. Holy Cross pulled back in front early the second half, outscoring the Black Knights 17-7 over the first seven minutes to take a seven-point lead (45-38). But Army responded with a 16-4 run of its own to reclaim the lead. It was still a two-point game (58-56) with 5:47 left to play, but the Crusaders would hit just two of 10 shots the rest of the way as the Black Knights held on for the win. Austin Butler finished the game with 17 points, eight rebounds and three assists, while Ryan Wade added 10 points. Army was led by Tommy Funk with 22 points, seven assists and six rebounds.

BUTLER ENJOYING ANOTHER STRONG SEASON: Junior guard **Austin Butler** is once again among the top players for the Crusaders this year. Through 28 games played, Butler has averaged 12.1 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.5 assists per contest, while hitting 36.4 percent of his three-pointers and 75.0 percent of his foul shots. During the Army game, he posted 17 points, eight rebounds and three assists. Previously at Colgate, Butler recorded 12 points, five rebounds, three assists and two steals. He also played well at Lehigh, totaling 15 points, seven rebounds, four assists and three steals. A few of Butler's other top games this season have come at Navy (20 points, four rebounds), against Navy (18 points, five rebounds), against Sacred Heart (17 points, career-high 17 rebounds, career-best seven assists), against Mercer (17 points, 11 rebounds, three assists), at Bucknell (17 points), at Florida Atlantic (16 points, five rebounds), against Loyola (16 points, three rebounds, three assists), at American (15 points, three assists), against Colgate (14 points, nine rebounds), against Lehigh (14 points, six rebounds), against Hofstra (13 points, six rebounds, three assists), against Boston University (13 points, five rebounds, three assists), against Fairfield (12 points, six rebounds, three assists), at Canisius (11 points, six rebounds, three assists, three steals) and at Siena (11 points, four assists, three rebounds). Last year, Butler averaged 12.6 points, 4.1 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game, while making 40.0 percent of his shots from three-point range. In 2017-18, he was selected to the Patriot League All-Rookie team after averaging 9.8 points and 3.7 rebounds per game. Over the course of his collegiate career, Butler has now totaled 1,050 points, 424 rebounds, 166 assists and 99 steals, while making 36.6 percent of his attempts from three-point range (131 of 358).

HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 389-179 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including a 2-11 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-07 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 37 out of 44 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 176-86 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 114-53 record against Patriot League foes.

THE LAST MEETING

Joe Pridgen posted his first career double-double with 28 points and 12 rebounds, but the Crusaders were defeated by American 81-69 at Bender Arena on Jan. 18, 2020. Holy Cross made 48.2 percent of its field goal attempts and held a 31-24 rebounding advantage, but only connected on 26.7 percent of its shots from three-point range. American was able to hit 61.5 percent of its shots from the floor and committed just eight turnovers. The score was tied at 9-9 after the first four minutes of play, when the Eagles went on a 21-6 run to take a 30-15 lead. American was still up by 15 (35-20) with 5:46 left before the break, when the Crusaders used a 12-2 spurt to close the gap. The Eagles eventually took a 43-36 advantage into the locker room at half-time. American expanded its lead back to double figures (49-38) early in the second half, before a 10-2 run brought Holy Cross to within three (51-48). The score then stayed close for the majority of the half, and the Eagles were up by just four (65-61) with 7:35 left to play. But American scored the next five points to regain control, and eventually pulled away for a 12-point victory. Matt Faw finished the game with 15 points and eight rebounds, while Austin Butler added 15 points and three rebounds. Sa'eed Nelson led the Eagles with 21 points and five assists.

FAW MAKING PLAYS DOWN LOW: Junior forward **Matt Faw** has emerged as a key player along the Holy Cross front line this season. In 28 games played, he has averaged 8.4 points, 4.2 rebounds and 1.4 blocked shots per contest, while hitting 45.0 percent of his field goal attempts. Faw has stepped up his game since the start of Patriot League play, averaging 11.5 points, 5.1 boards and 1.9 blocks against conference foes. During the Bucknell game, he posted his first career double-double with 16 points, 10 rebounds and two blocks. Previously against Lafayette, Faw recorded 19 points, eight rebounds and two steals. He also played well at Lehigh, finishing with 18 points, three rebounds, two assists and two steals. A few of Faw's other top games this season have come against Lehigh (22 points, nine rebounds, four blocks), against Army (22 points, six rebounds, three blocks), at American (15 points, eight rebounds), at Navy (12 points, four rebounds), against Boston University (12 points), at Lafayette (11 points, eight rebounds) and against Colgate (11 points, six rebounds, three steals). During the 2018-19 season, he averaged 6.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 0.7 blocked shots per contest. Over the course of his collegiate career, Faw has now totaled 584 points, 268 rebounds, 74 blocks, 55 steals and 50 assists, while making 92 of 245 three-point attempts (37.6 percent).

SENIOR SALUTE: One member of the Holy Cross basketball program will be concluding his collegiate career at the end of the 2019-20 season. Senior guard **Clayton Le Sann** will be honored prior to the game against American, with the pregame ceremony scheduled for approximately 1:45 p.m.

WADE TAKES OVER STARTING ROLE: Freshman guard **Ryan Wade** has been one of the top players in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 30 games played, Wade has averaged 5.7 points and 2.0 rebounds. During the Army game, he recorded 10 points, two rebounds and two assists. Previously in the win over Lehigh, Wade totaled 16 points and four assists, including the game-tying three-pointer with 7.3 seconds left to force overtime. A few of his other top performances have come at New Hampshire (career-high 22 points), against Sacred Heart (13 points), at Lafayette (12 points, two assists) and against Navy (11 points, two assists). Wade came to Holy Cross from Ann Arbor (Mich.) Skyline High School, where he was named first team all-state as a senior.

PRIDGEN AMONG NATION'S TOP FRESHMEN: Freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** currently ranks among the top freshmen in the nation with his scoring average of 17.5 points per game. Through games of Feb. 27, he stands third among all freshmen in the country in scoring, and first among freshmen from outside the power five conferences. NELSON LEADS THE CRUSADERS: **Brett Nelson** is in his first season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2019-20, with an overall record of 3-27. This is the first collegiate head coaching position in the career of Nelson, who is the 18th head coach in program history. Nelson came to Holy Cross after spending five seasons on the coaching staff at Marquette University. During his five years at Marquette, including two seasons as associate head coach, Nelson helped the Golden Eagles to an overall record of 97-69 and two trips to the NCAA Tournament. Prior to his time at Marquette, Nelson was an assistant coach at Arkansas, Ball State, Drake and Marshall. A 2004 graduate of the University of Florida, Nelson was a three-year starter for the Gators and a member of four NCAA tournament teams.

NIEGO STEPS UP IN THE POST: Junior forward **Connor Niego** has been one of Holy Cross' top front court players this season. In 29 games played Niego has averaged 8.7 points and 4.8 rebounds while hitting 34.4 percent of his three-point attempts. He has been even more impressive since the start of conference play, averaging 9.8 points and 6.1 boards against Patriot League foes. During the Lafayette game, Niego totaled 11 points and five rebounds. Previously at Lehigh, he finished with 14 points and two rebounds. Niego also played well against Loyola, posting 13 points and six rebounds. A few of his other top games have come against Lehigh (career-high 19 points, three rebounds), against Colgate (16 points, seven rebounds), at Lafayette (16 points, seven rebounds), against Fairfield (14 points, four rebounds, three blocks), against Army (13 points, six rebounds, four assists), at Siena (12 points), at Bucknell (11 points, 10 rebounds), at Canisius (11 points, eight rebounds), at Navy (11 points, three rebounds) and at Loyola (10 points, career-best 11 rebounds). Last year, Niego averaged 5.0 points and 1.5 rebounds per contest while making 52.6 percent of his field goal attempts, but played in only 10 games due to injury. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Niego has now totaled 372 points, 195 rebounds and 46 assists, while hitting 51 of 149 three-point attempts (34.2 percent).

MILLER MAKES HIS WAY TO THE NBA: Former Crusader **Malcolm Miller** (Class of 2015) is currently in his third season playing for the Toronto Raptors in the National Basketball Association. During the 2018-19 campaign, Miller was a part of the Raptors' NBA championship team. He became the fourth Holy Cross basketball player to win an NBA title, joining the likes of Bob Cousy and Tom Heinsohn (former Crusaders now own 16 NBA championships). Miller is also the first Patriot League player to ever be part of an NBA title team since the league's formation in 1990. Miller appeared in 10 of Toronto's 24 playoff games in 2018-19, totaling eight points, five rebounds, one assist and one block. In 48 career regular season games played with the Raptors (as of Feb. 23), he has recorded 96 points, 34 rebounds, 12 assists, five blocks and six steals, while hitting 40.0 percent of his three-point attempts (24 of 60). During his career with the Crusaders, Miller totaled 1,013 points, 532 rebounds, 164 assists, 143 blocked shots and 93 steals. He ranks fourth all-time at Holy Cross in career blocked shots and seventh in career games started (93).

PRIDGEN DOMINATES ROOKIE OF THE WEEK SELECTIONS:

With just one week remaining in the regular season, freshman forward **Joe Pridgen** has earned more than half of the Rookie of the Week selections in the Patriot League. Pridgen has been recognized eight times in 16 weeks of action, as much as every other player in the conference combined. His eight awards are tied for the fourth-most in league history, only one away from the record of nine (shared by Bucknell's Kevin Bettencourt and Lehigh's Marquis Hall and C.J. McCollum). In addition, Pridgen's stretch of five consecutive Rookie of the Week honors from Dec. 9-Jan. 6 tied for the second-longest streak in conference history, and the most since Navy's J.J. THE COMEBACK KIDS: During the 96-95 overtime win over Lehigh on Jan. 22, the Crusaders came back from a 17-point deficit to earn the win. Holy Cross trailed the Mountain Hawks 59-42 with less than 14 minutes left in the second half before rallying for the victory. That marked the Crusaders' largest comeback win since defeating Army on Jan. 18, 2017. In that game, Holy Cross trailed the Black Knights 56-39 with 16:56 to go in the second half, and came back to post an 85-76 victory.

CRUSADERS HEAT UP ON OFFENSE: Holy Cross turned in an outstanding offensive performance during the 96-95 overtime victory over Lehigh on Jan. 22. The Crusaders' 96 points scored were their most in a single-game since defeating Nichols 101-70 on Nov. 23, 2014, and their most against a Division I opponent since a 122-118 double overtime win over Sacred Heart on Nov. 13, 2013. Holy Cross also hit a season-high 56.0 percent (14 of 25) of its three-point field goal attempts against Lehigh, while draining 52.5 percent (32 of 61) of its shots from the floor overall. The Crusaders have now made over 50 percent of their field goal attempts in a game four times this season, going 2-2 in those contests.

THE 1,000-POINT CLUB: During the game against Loyola (Md.) on Feb. 5, junior guard **Austin Butler** became the 52nd 1,000-point scorer in the history of Holy Cross men's basketball. He scored his 1,000th career point on a put back with 11:12 remaining in the second half. Butler has now scored 1,050 points in 91 career games as a Crusader, good for an average of 11.5 points per contest.

HOLY CROSS KNOCKS DOWN THREE-POINTERS: The Crusaders have been a solid three-point shooting team this year, making 32.4 percent (212 of 654) of their shots from behind the arc. Holy Cross has improved its shooting since the start of Patriot League play, averaging 7.2 three-pointers made and hitting 33.0 percent from long range (122 of 370) against conference foes. The Crusaders have made at least 10 three-pointers three times in conference play, while hitting that mark seven times overall this year. Holy Cross knocked down a season-best 14 shots from beyond the arc during the victory over Lehigh, tying for the third-highest single-game total in school history. The Crusaders also connected on 11 shots from long range at Lafayette, at Florida Atlantic and against Harvard.

CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SEVENTH PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT CROWN: This year, Holy Cross will be looking to win the Patriot League Tournament for the seventh time in school history. Three years ago, the Crusaders captured their sixth Patriot League Tournament crown with a 59-56 victory at Lehigh on March 9, 2016. Holy Cross' previous tournament titles came in 2007 (74-66 over Bucknell), 2003 (72-64 over American), 2002 (58-54 at American), 2001 (68-64 over Navy in overtime) and 1993 (98-73 at Bucknell). Holy Cross' six conference tournament championships are tied for the most in Patriot League history with Bucknell (2005, 2006, 2011, 2013, 2017 and 2018). The Crusaders have also played in the Patriot League championship game 11 times, the second-most appearances in conference history behind only Bucknell (13).

DRIBBLES: Senior guard **Clayton Le Sann** posted a season-high 11 points, three assists, two rebounds and two steals during the Feb. 8 game at Boston University. Overall this season, he is now averaging 2.9 points in 16 games played ... Sophomore forward **Blake Verbeek** totaled a career-high 11 points and five rebounds at Boston University on Feb. 8. He previously scored 10 points against Hofstra, and is averaging 4.4 points and 2.4 rebounds on the year ... Junior forward **Matt Faw** has blocked 33 shots since the start of Patriot League play, 14 more than any other player in the conference ... Holy Cross blocked a season-high seven shots during the victory over Lehigh on Jan. 22, then matched that mark with seven blocks against Boston University on Jan. 25. Since the start of Patriot League play, the Crusaders are averaging 3.3 blocks per game ... Holy Cross committed a season-low seven turnovers during the Jan. 25 contest against Boston University, then matched that mark with just seven turnovers against Lafayette on Feb. 15 ... All five of the Crusaders' starters scored in double figures during the Jan. 22 victory over Lehigh, with each of them netting at least 12 points prior to the start of overtime ... Holy Cross had a +7 rebound margin (31-24) at American on Jan. 18, its best mark against a Patriot League foe since outrebounding Lafayette 33-26 on Jan. 12, 2019 ... The Crusaders hit 92.9 percent (13 of 14) of their free throws at Loyola (Md.) on Jan. 2, their best percentage in a single game since making 94.1 percent (16 of 17) of their foul shots at Boston University on Feb. 20, 2018 ... Holy Cross was picked to finish in 10th place in the 2019-20 Patriot League preseason poll of head coaches and sports information directors ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2009 through 2012, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 98 percent, tied for the seventh-best mark among all Division I schools ... The Crusaders received a Team Academic Excellence Award from the National Association of Basketball Coaches last year, for posting a cumulative team grade point average of 3.0 or better for the 2018-19 season.
